chief about the 13_1CH_18_17 # And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada [was] over the Cherethites and the Pelethites; and the sons of David [were] chief about the king.

chief among the <u>10_2SA_23_08</u># These [be] the names of the mighty men whom David had: The Tachmonite that sat in the seat, chief among the captains; the same [was] Adino the Eznite: [he lift up his spear] against eight hundred, whom he slew at one time.

chief and next 13 1CH 16 05 # Asaph the chief, and next to him Zechariah, Jeiel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Mattithiah, and Eliab, and Benaiah, and Obededom: and Jeiel with psalteries and with harps; but Asaph made a sound with cymbals;

chief and said 14_2CH_24_06 # And the king called for Jehoiada the chief, and said unto him, Why hast thou not required of the Levites to bring in out of Judah and out of Jerusalem the collection, [according to the commandment] of Moses the servant of the LORD, and of the congregation of Israel, for the tabernacle of witness?

chief as he <u>42_LUK_22_26</u># But ye [shall] not [be] so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.

chief at the <u>15_EZR_08_17</u># And I sent them with commandment unto Iddo the chief at the place Casiphia, and I told them what they should say unto Iddo, [and] to his brethren the Nethinims, at the place Casiphia, that they should bring unto us ministers for the house of our God.

chief butler unto <u>01_GEN_40_21</u> # And he restored the chief butler unto his butlership again; and he gave the cup into Pharaoh's hand:

chief butler unto <u>01_GEN_41_09</u># Then spake the chief butler unto Pharaoh, saying, I do remember my faults this day:

chief captain also <u>44_ACT_22_29</u># Then straightway they departed from him which should have examined him: and the chief captain also was afraid, after he knew that he was a Roman, and because he had bound him.

chief captain and <u>44_ACT_21_32</u># Who immediately took soldiers and centurions, and ran down unto them: and when they saw the chief captain and the soldiers, they left beating of Paul.

chief for though 13_1CH_26_10 # Also Hosah, of the children of Merari, had sons; Simri the chief, [for [though]] he was not the firstborn, yet his father made him the chief;

chief friends 20_PRO_16_28 # A froward man soweth strife: and a whisperer separateth chief friends.

chief governor and 13_1CH_29_22 # And did eat and drink before the LORD on that day with great gladness. And they made Solomon the son of David king the second time, and anointed [him] unto the LORD [to be] the chief governor, and Zadok [to be] priest.

chief governor in <u>24_JER_20_01</u> # Now Pashur the son of Immer the priest, who [was] also chief governor in the house of the LORD, heard that Jeremiah prophesied these things.

chief her enemies <u>25_LAM_01_05</u># Her adversaries are the chief, her enemies prosper; for the LORD hath afflicted her for the multitude of her transgressions: her children are gone into captivity before the enemy.

chief Musician upon 19 PSA 45 01 # To the chief Musician upon Shoshannim, for the sons of Korah, Maschil, A Song of loves. My heart is inditing a good matter: I speak of the things which I have made touching the king: my tongue [is] the pen of a ready writer.

chief Musician upon 19 PSA 53 01 # To the chief Musician upon Mahalath, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity: [there is] none that doeth good.

chief Musician upon 19 PSA 56 01 # To the chief Musician upon Jonathelemrechokim, Michtam of David, when the Philistines took him in Gath. Be merciful unto me, O God: for man would swallow me up; he fighting daily oppresseth me.

chief Musician upon 19_PSA_60_01 # To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Joab returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. chief of all <u>07_JUD_20_02</u> # And the chief of all the people, [even] of all the tribes of Israel, presented themselves in the assembly of the people of God, four hundred thousand footmen that drew sword.

chief of all 19_PSA_105_36 # He smote also all the firstborn in their land, the chief of all their strength.

chief of Asia 44_ACT_19_31 # And certain of the chief of Asia, which were his friends, sent unto him, desiring [him] that he would not adventure himself into the theatre.

chief of his 14_2CH_08_09 # But of the children of Israel did Solomon make no servants for his work; but they [were] men of war, and chief of his captains, and captains of his chariots and horsemen.

chief of Israel <u>04_NUM_04_46</u># All those that were numbered of the Levites, whom Moses and Aaron and the chief of Israel numbered, after their families, and after the house of their fathers,

chief of king 14_2CH_08_10 # And these [were] the chief of king Solomon's officers, [even] two hundred and fifty, that bare rule over the people.

chief of Solomon's <u>11_1KI_05_16</u># Beside the chief of Solomon's officers which [were] over the work, three thousand and three hundred, which ruled over the people that wrought in the work.

chief of the 13_1CH_05_15 # Ahi the son of Abdiel, the son of Guni, chief of the house of their fathers.

chief of the <u>13_1CH_07_40</u> # All these [were] the children of Asher, heads of [their] father's house, choice [and] mighty men of valour, chief of the princes. And the number throughout the genealogy of them that were apt to the war [and] to battle [was] twenty and six thousand men.

chief of the <u>13_1CH_09_09</u> # And their brethren, according to their generations, nine hundred and fifty and six. All these men [were] chief of the fathers in the house of their fathers.

chief of the <u>13_1CH_09_33</u> # And these [are] the singers, chief of the fathers of the Levites, [who remaining] in the chambers [were] free: for they were employed in [that] work day and night.

chief of the <u>13_1CH_11_10</u># These also [are] the chief of the mighty men whom David had, who strengthened themselves with him in his kingdom, [and] with all Israel, to make him king, according to the word of the LORD concerning Israel.

chief of the <u>16_NEH_12_23</u># The sons of Levi, the chief of the fathers, [were] written in the book of the chronicles, even until the days of Johanan the son of Eliashib.

chief of the <u>16_NEH_12_24</u># And the chief of the Levites: Hashabiah, Sherebiah, and Jeshua the son of Kadmiel, with their brethren over against them, to praise [and] to give thanks, according to the commandment of David the man of God, ward over against ward.

chief of the <u>16_NEH_12_46</u># For in the days of David and Asaph of old [there were] chief of the singers, and songs of praise and thanksgiving unto God.

chief of the <u>04_NUM_03_24</u># And the chief of the house of the father of the Gershonites [shall be] Eliasaph the son of Lael.

chief of the <u>04_NUM_03_30</u> # And the chief of the house of the father of the families of the Kohathites [shall be] Elizaphan the son of Uzziel.

chief of the <u>04_NUM_03_32</u> # And Eleazar the son of Aaron the priest [shall be] chief over the chief of the Levites, [and have] the oversight of them that keep the charge of the sanctuary.

chief of the <u>04_NUM_03_35</u> # And the chief of the house of the father of the families of Merari [was] Zuriel the son of Abihail: [these] shall pitch on the side of the tabernacle northward.

chief priests and <u>40_MAT_02_04</u># And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he demanded of them where Christ should be born.

chief priests and <u>40_MAT_16_21</u># From that time forth began Jesus to show unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed, and be raised again the third day.

chief priests and <u>40_MAT_20_18</u># Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn him to death,

chief priests and <u>40_MAT_21_15</u># And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased,

chief priests and <u>40_MAT_21_23</u># And when he was come into the temple, the chief priests and the elders of the people came unto him as he was teaching, and said, By what authority doest thou these things? and who gave thee this authority?

chief priests and <u>40_MAT_21_45</u># And when the chief priests and Pharisees had heard his parables, they perceived that he spake of them.

chief priests and 40_MAT_26_03# Then assembled together the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders of the people, unto the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas,

chief priests and <u>40_MAT_26_47</u># And while he yet spake, lo, Judas, one of the twelve, came, and with him a great multitude with swords and staves, from the chief priests and elders of the people.

chief priests and <u>40_MAT_26_59</u># Now the chief priests, and elders, and all the council, sought false witness against Jesus, to put him to death;

chief priests and 40_MAT_27_01# When the morning was come, all the chief priests and elders of the people took counsel against Jesus to put him to death:

chief priests and 40_MAT_27_03# Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was

condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,

chief priests and <u>40_MAT_27_12</u># And when he was accused of the chief priests and elders, he answered nothing.

chief priests and 40_MAT_27_20# But the chief priests and elders persuaded the multitude that they should ask Barabbas, and destroy Jesus.

chief priests and 40_MAT_27_62# Now the next day, that followed the day of the preparation, the chief priests and Pharisees came together unto Pilate,

chief priests answered 43_JOH_19_15 # But they cried out, Away with [him], away with [him], crucify him. Pilate saith unto them, Shall I crucify your King? The chief priests answered, We have no king but Caesar.

chief priests consulted <u>43_JOH_12_10</u># But the chief priests consulted that they might put Lazarus also to death;

chief priests had 41_MAR_15_10 # For he knew that the chief priests had delivered him for envy.

chief priests have <u>43_JOH_18_35</u> # Pilate answered, Am I a Jew? Thine own nation and the chief priests have delivered thee unto me: what hast thou done?

chief priests heard 44_ACT_05_24 # Now when the high priest and the captain of the temple and the chief priests heard these things, they doubted of them whereunto this would grow.

chief priests heard 41_MAR_11_18# And the scribes and chief priests heard [it], and sought how they might destroy him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.

chief priests held <u>41_MAR_15_01</u># And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried [him] away, and delivered [him] to Pilate.

chief priests mocking 41_MAR_15_31_# Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He saved others; himself he cannot save.

chief priests mocking 40_MAT_27_41 # Likewise also the chief priests mocking [him], with the scribes and elders, said,

chief priests moved <u>41_MAR_15_11</u># But the chief priests moved the people, that he should rather release Barabbas unto them.

chief priests of 43_JOH_19_21 # Then said the chief priests of the Jews to Pilate, Write not, The King of the Jews; but that he said, I am King of the Jews.

chief priests prevailed <u>42_LUK_23_23</u> # And they were instant with loud voices, requiring that he might be crucified. And the voices of them and of the chief priests prevailed.

chief priests sent <u>43_JOH_07_32</u># The Pharisees heard that the people murmured such things concerning him; and the Pharisees and the chief priests sent officers to take him.

chief priests the <u>15_EZR_10_05</u># Then arose Ezra, and made the chief priests, the Levites, and all Israel, to swear that they should do according to this word. And they sware.

chief priests therefore 43_JOH_19_06 # When the chief priests therefore and officers saw him, they cried out, saying, Crucify [him], crucify [him]. Pilate saith unto them, Take ye him, and crucify [him]: for I find

no fault in him.

chief priests to <u>44_ACT_09_14</u># And here he hath authority from the chief priests to bind all that call on thy name.

chief priests to <u>41_MAR_14_10</u> # And Judas Iscariot, one of the twelve, went unto the chief priests, to betray him unto them.

chief priests took <u>40_MAT_27_06</u># And the chief priests took the silver pieces, and said, It is not lawful for to put them into the treasury, because it is the price of blood.

chief priests <u>44_ACT_09_21</u> # But all that heard [him] were amazed, and said; Is not this he that destroyed them which called on this name in Jerusalem, and came hither for that intent, that he might bring them bound unto the chief priests?

chief priests <u>44_ACT_26_12</u> # Whereupon as I went to Damascus with authority and commission from the chief priests,

chief priests 40_MAT_26_14# Then one of the twelve, called Judas Iscariot, went unto the chief priests,

chief prince of <u>26_EZE_38_02</u> # Son of man, set thy face against Gog, the land of Magog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal, and prophesy against him,

chief prince of <u>26_EZE_38_03</u> # And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against thee, O Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal:

chief prince of <u>26_EZE_39_01</u> # Therefore, thou son of man, prophesy against Gog, and say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Behold, I [am] against thee, O Gog, the chief prince of Meshech and Tubal:

chief princes came <u>27_DAN_10_13</u># But the prince of the kingdom of Persia withstood me one and twenty days: but, lo, Michael, one of the chief princes, came to help me; and I remained there with the kings of Persia.

chief rooms at <u>42_LUK_20_46</u> # Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts;

chief rooms saying <u>42_LUK_14_07</u># And he put forth a parable to those which were bidden, when he marked how they chose out the chief rooms; saying unto them,

chief ruler about 10_2SA_20_26 # And Ira also the Jairite was a chief ruler about David.

chief ruler but <u>13_1CH_05_02</u># For Judah prevailed above his brethren, and of him [came] the chief ruler; but the birthright [was] Joseph's:]

chief ruler of <u>44_ACT_18_08</u># And Crispus, the chief ruler of the synagogue, believed on the Lord with all his house; and many of the Corinthians hearing believed, and were baptized.

chief ruler of <u>44_ACT_18_17</u># Then all the Greeks took Sosthenes, the chief ruler of the synagogue, and beat [him] before the judgment seat. And Gallio cared for none of those things.

chief rulers also 43_JOH_12_42 # Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many believed on him; but because of the Pharisees they did not confess [him], lest they should be put out of the synagogue:

chief rulers <u>10_2SA_08_18</u> # And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada [was over] both the Cherethites and the Pelethites; and David's sons were chief rulers.

chief seats in 41_MAR_12_39 # And the chief seats in the synagogues, and the uppermost rooms at feasts:

chief seats in 40 MAT 23 06 # And love the uppermost rooms at feasts, and the chief seats in the synagogues,

chief Shepherd shall <u>60_1PE_05_04</u> # And when the chief Shepherd shall appear, ye shall receive a crown of glory that fadeth not away.

chief singer on 35_HAB_03_19 # The LORD God [is] my strength, and he will make my feet like hinds' [feet], and he will make me to walk upon mine high places. To the chief singer on my stringed instruments.

chief speaker <u>44_ACT_14_12</u> # And they called Barnabas, Jupiter; and Paul, Mercurius, because he was the chief speaker.

chief spices <u>22_SON_04_14</u> # Spikenard and saffron; calamus and cinnamon, with all trees of frankincense; myrrh and aloes, with all the chief spices:

chief things of <u>05_DEU_33_15</u># And for the chief things of the ancient mountains, and for the precious things of the lasting hills,

chief throughout their <u>13_1CH_09_34</u> # These chief fathers of the Levites [were] chief throughout their generations; these dwelt at Jerusalem.

chief to be 14_2CH_11_22# And Rehoboam made Abijah the son of Maachah the chief, [to be] ruler among his brethren: for [he thought] to make him king.

chief was Ahiezer <u>13_1CH_12_03</u># The chief [was] Ahiezer, then Joash, the sons of Shemaah the Gibeathite; and Jeziel, and Pelet, the sons of Azmaveth; and Berachah, and Jehu the Antothite,

chief was Jehiel 13_1CH_23_08 # The sons of Laadan; the chief [was] Jehiel, and Zetham, and Joel, three.

chief went down 10_2SA_23_13 # And three of the thirty chief went down, and came to David in the harvest time unto the cave of Adullam: and the troop of the Philistines pitched in the valley of Rephaim.

chief women not <u>44_ACT_17_04</u> # And some of them believed, and consorted with Paul and Silas; and of the devout Greeks a great multitude, and of the chief women not a few.

chief <u>13_1CH_09_17</u># And the porters [were], Shallum, and Akkub, and Talmon, and Ahiman, and their brethren: Shallum [was] the chief;

chief <u>13_1CH_11_06</u># And David said, Whosoever smiteth the Jebusites first shall be chief and captain. So Joab the son of Zeruiah went first up, and was chief.

chief 13_1CH_23_16 # Of the sons of Gershom, Shebuel [was] the chief.

chief 13_1CH_23_18 # Of the sons of Izhar; Shelomith the chief.

chief <u>13_1CH_26_10</u> # Also Hosah, of the children of Merari, had sons; Simri the chief, [for [though] he was not the firstborn, yet his father made him the chief;]

chief <u>54_1TI_01_15</u> # This [is] a faithful saying, and worthy of all acceptation, that Christ Jesus came into the world to save sinners; of whom I am chief.

chiefest among ten 22_SON_05_10 # My beloved [is] white and ruddy, the chiefest among ten thousand.

chiefest apostles though <u>47_2CO_12_11</u># I am become a fool in glorying; ye have compelled me: for I ought to have been commended of you: for in nothing am I behind the very chiefest apostles, though I be nothing.

chiefest apostles 47_2CO_11_05 # For I suppose I was not a whit behind the very chiefest apostles.

chiefest of all <u>09_1SA_02_29</u># Wherefore kick ye at my sacrifice and at mine offering, which I have commanded [in my] habitation; and honourest thy sons above me, to make yourselves fat with the chiefest of all the offerings of Israel my people?

chiefest of the <u>09_1SA_21_07</u># Now a certain man of the servants of Saul [was] there that day, detained before the LORD; and his name [was] Doeg, an Edomite, the chiefest of the herdmen that [belonged] to Saul.

chiefest of the <u>14_2CH_32_33</u> # And Hezekiah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the chiefest of the sepulchres of the sons of David: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem did him honour at his death. And Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.

chiefest place among <u>09_1SA_09_22</u># And Samuel took Saul and his servant, and brought them into the parlour, and made them sit in the chiefest place among them that were bidden, which [were] about thirty persons.

chiefest shall be 41_MAR_10_44 # And whosoever of you will be the chiefest, shall be servant of all.

chiefly because that <u>45_ROM_03_02</u> # Much every way: chiefly, because that unto them were committed the oracles of God.

chiefly them that <u>61_2PE_02_10</u> # But chiefly them that walk after the flesh in the lust of uncleanness, and despise government. Presumptuous [are they], selfwilled, they are not afraid to speak evil of dignities.

chiefly they that 50_PHP_04_22 # All the saints salute you, chiefly they that are of Caesar's household.

handkerchiefs or aprons 44_ACT_19_12 # So that from his body were brought unto the sick handkerchiefs or aprons, and the diseases departed from them, and the evil spirits went out of them.

kerchiefs also will <u>26_EZE_13_21</u> # Your kerchiefs also will I tear, and deliver my people out of your hand, and they shall be no more in your hand to be hunted; and ye shall know that I [am] the LORD.

kerchiefs upon the <u>26_EZE_13_18</u># And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; Woe to the [women] that sew pillows to all armholes, and make kerchiefs upon the head of every stature to hunt souls! Will ye hunt the souls of my people, and will ye save the souls alive [that come] unto you?

mischief against a 19_PSA_62_03 # How long will ye imagine mischief against a man? ye shall be slain all of you: as a bowing wall [shall ye be, and as] a tottering fence.

mischief against him <u>09_1SA_23_09</u># And David knew that Saul secretly practiced mischief against him; and he said to Abiathar the priest, Bring hither the ephod.

mischief against me <u>28_HOS_07_15</u># Though I have bound [and] strengthened their arms, yet do they imagine mischief against me.

mischief also and 19_PSA_55_10 # Day and night they go about it upon the walls thereof: mischief also and sorrow [are] in the midst of it.

mischief and bring 23_ISA_59_04 # None calleth for justice, nor [any] pleadeth for truth: they trust in

vanity, and speak lies; they conceive mischief, and bring forth iniquity.

mischief and bring <u>18_JOB_15_35</u># They conceive mischief, and bring forth vanity, and their belly prepareth deceit.

mischief and brought 19_PSA_07_14_# Behold, he travaileth with iniquity, and hath conceived mischief, and brought forth falsehood.

mischief and give <u>26_EZE_11_02</u># Then said he unto me, Son of man, these [are] the men that devise mischief, and give wicked counsel in this city:

mischief and rumour <u>26_EZE_07_26</u> # Mischief shall come upon mischief, and rumour shall be upon rumour; then shall they seek a vision of the prophet; but the law shall perish from the priest, and counsel from the ancients.

mischief and spite 19 PSA 10 14 # Thou hast seen [it]: for thou beholdest mischief and spite, to requite [it] with thy hand: the poor committeth himself unto thee; thou art the helper of the fatherless.

mischief and their <u>20_PRO_04_16</u># For they sleep not, except they have done mischief; and their sleep is taken away, unless they cause [some] to fall.

mischief and their 19_PSA_26_10 # In whose hands [is] mischief, and their right hand is full of bribes.

mischief and they <u>27_DAN_11_27</u> # And both these kings' hearts [shall be] to do mischief, and they shall speak lies at one table; but it shall not prosper: for yet the end [shall be] at the time appointed.

mischief and vanity 19_PSA_10_07 # His mouth is full of cursing and deceit and fraud: under his tongue [is] mischief and vanity.

mischief because thou <u>10_2SA_16_08</u># The LORD hath returned upon thee all the blood of the house of Saul, in whose stead thou hast reigned; and the LORD hath delivered the kingdom into the hand of Absalom thy son: and, behold, thou [art taken] in thy mischief, because thou [art] a bloody man.

mischief befall him <u>01_GEN_42_04</u># But Benjamin, Joseph's brother, Jacob sent not with his brethren; for he said, Lest peradventure mischief befall him.

mischief befall him <u>01_GEN_42_38</u># And he said, My son shall not go down with you; for his brother is dead, and he is left alone: if mischief befall him by the way in the which ye go, then shall ye bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.

mischief befall him <u>01_GEN_44_29</u> # And if ye take this also from me, and mischief befall him, ye shall bring down my gray hairs with sorrow to the grave.

mischief but a <u>20_PRO_10_23</u> # [It is] as sport to a fool to do mischief: but a man of understanding hath wisdom.

mischief but a <u>20_PRO_13_17</u> # A wicked messenger falleth into mischief: but a faithful ambassador [is] health.

mischief by a 19_PSA_94_20 # Shall the throne of iniquity have fellowship with thee, which frameth mischief by a law?

mischief continually he <u>20_PRO_06_14</u> # Frowardness [is] in his heart, he deviseth mischief continually; he soweth discord.

mischief did he <u>02_EXO_32_12</u># Wherefore should the Egyptians speak, and say, For mischief did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from thy fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against thy people.

mischief follow he <u>02_EXO_21_22</u> # If men strive, and hurt a woman with child, so that her fruit depart [from her], and yet no mischief follow: he shall be surely punished, according as the woman's husband will lay upon him; and he shall pay as the judges [determine].

mischief is in 19_PSA_28_03 # Draw me not away with the wicked, and with the workers of iniquity, which speak peace to their neighbours, but mischief [is] in their hearts.

mischief it shall <u>20_PRO_11_27</u># He that diligently seeketh good procureth favour: but he that seeketh mischief, it shall come unto him.

mischief O mighty 19 PSA 52 01 # To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

mischief of Haman <u>17_EST_08_03</u># And Esther spake yet again before the king, and fell down at his feet, and besought him with tears to put away the mischief of Haman the Agagite, and his device that he had devised against the Jews.

mischief of their 19_PSA_140_09 # [As for] the head of those that compass me about, let the mischief of their own lips cover them.

Mischief shall come <u>26_EZE_07_26</u># Mischief shall come upon mischief, and rumour shall be upon rumour; then shall they seek a vision of the prophet; but the law shall perish from the priest, and counsel from the ancients.

mischief shall fall <u>23_ISA_47_11</u># Therefore shall evil come upon thee; thou shalt not know from whence it riseth: and mischief shall fall upon thee; thou shalt not be able to put it off: and desolation shall come upon thee suddenly, [which] thou shalt not know.

mischief shall return 19_PSA_07_16 # His mischief shall return upon his own head, and his violent dealing shall come down upon his own pate.

mischief that Hadad 11_1KI_11_25# And he was an adversary to Israel all the days of Solomon, beside the mischief that Hadad [did]: and he abhorred Israel, and reigned over Syria.

mischief they are 19_PSA_119_150 # They draw nigh that follow after mischief: they are far from thy law.

mischief thou child <u>44_ACT_13_10</u># And said, O full of all subtlety and all mischief, [thou] child of the devil, [thou] enemy of all righteousness, wilt thou not cease to pervert the right ways of the Lord?

mischief upon his 19_PSA_36_04 # He deviseth mischief upon his bed; he setteth himself in a way [that is] not good; he abhorreth not evil.

mischief will come 12_2KI_07_09 # Then they said one to another, We do not well: this day [is] a day of good tidings, and we hold our peace: if we tarry till the morning light, some mischief will come upon us:

now therefore come, that we may go and tell the king's household.

mischief <u>02_EXO_32_22</u> # And Aaron said, Let not the anger of my lord wax hot: thou knowest the people, that they [are set] on mischief.

mischief <u>16_NEH_06_02</u> # That Sanballat and Geshem sent unto me, saying, Come, let us meet together in [some one of] the villages in the plain of Ono. But they thought to do me mischief.

mischief <u>20_PRO_06_18</u> # An heart that deviseth wicked imaginations, feet that be swift in running to mischief,

mischief **20_PRO_12_21** # There shall no evil happen to the just: but the wicked shall be filled with mischief.

mischief <u>20_PRO_17_20</u> # He that hath a froward heart findeth no good: and he that hath a perverse tongue falleth into mischief.

mischief 20_PRO_24_02 # For their heart studieth destruction, and their lips talk of mischief.

mischief <u>20_PRO_24_16</u># For a just [man] falleth seven times, and riseth up again: but the wicked shall fall into mischief.

mischief **20_PRO_28_14** # Happy [is] the man that feareth alway: but he that hardeneth his heart shall fall into mischief.

mischiefs in their 19_PSA_140_02 # Which imagine mischiefs in [their] heart; continually are they gathered together [for] war.

mischiefs like a 19_PSA_52_02 # Thy tongue deviseth mischiefs; like a sharp razor, working deceitfully.

mischiefs upon them <u>05_DEU_32_23</u># I will heap mischiefs upon them; I will spend mine arrows upon them.
