clear as crystal 66 REV 21 11# Having the glory of God: and her light [was] like unto a stone most precious, even like a jasper stone, clear as crystal;

clear as crystal 66 REV 22 01 # And he showed me a pure river of water of life, clear as crystal, proceeding out of the throne of God and of the Lamb.

clear as the 22 SON 06 10 # Who [is] she [that] looketh forth as the morning, fair as the moon, clear as the sun, [and] terrible as [an army] with banners?

clear day 30 AMO 08 09 # And it shall come to pass in that day, saith the Lord GOD, that I will cause the sun to go down at noon, and I will darken the earth in the clear day:

clear from my 01 GEN 24 41 # Then shalt thou be clear from [this] my oath, when thou comest to my kindred; and if they give not thee [one], thou shalt be clear from my oath.

clear from this 01 GEN 24 08 # And if the woman will not be willing to follow thee, then thou shalt be clear from this my oath: only bring not my son thither again.

clear from this 01 GEN 24 41 # Then shalt thou be clear from [this] my oath, when thou comest to my kindred; and if they give not thee [one], thou shalt be clear from my oath.

clear glass 66 REV 21 18 # And the building of the wall of it was [of] jasper: and the city [was] pure gold, like unto clear glass.

clear heat upon 23 ISA 18 04 # For so the LORD said unto me, I will take my rest, and I will consider in my dwelling place like a clear heat upon herbs, [and] like a cloud of dew in the heat of harvest.

clear nor dark 38 ZEC 14 06 # And it shall come to pass in that day, [that] the light shall not be clear, [nor] dark:

clear ourselves God 01 GEN 44 16# And Judah said, What shall we say unto my lord? what shall we speak? or how shall we clear ourselves? God hath found out the iniquity of thy servants: behold, we [are] my lord's servants, both we, and [he] also with whom the cup is found.

clear shining after 10 2SA 23 04 # And [he shall be] as the light of the morning, [when] the sun riseth, [even] a morning without clouds; [as] the tender grass [springing] out of the earth by clear shining after rain.

clear the guilty 02 EXO 34 07 # Keeping mercy for thousands, forgiving iniquity and transgression and sin, and that will by no means clear [the guilty]; visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children, and upon the children's children, unto the third and to the fourth [generation].

clear when thou 19 PSA 51 04 # Against thee, thee only, have I sinned, and done [this] evil in thy sight: that thou mightest be justified when thou speakest, [and] be clear when thou judgest.

clearer than the 18 JOB 11 17 # And [thine] age shall be clearer than the noonday; thou shalt shine forth, thou shalt be as the morning.

clearing of yourselves 47 2C0 07 11 # For behold this selfsame thing, that ye sorrowed after a godly sort, what carefulness it wrought in you, yea, [what] clearing of yourselves, yea, [what] indignation, yea, [what] fear, yea, [what] vehement desire, yea, [what] zeal, yea, [what] revenge! clearing the guilty 04 NUM 14 18 # The LORD [is] longsuffering, and of great mercy, forgiving iniquity and transgression, and by no means clearing [the guilty], visiting the iniquity of the fathers upon the children unto the third and fourth [generation].

clearly seen being 45 ROM 01 20 # For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, [even] his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

clearly to cast 40 MAT 07 05# Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

clearly to pull <u>42 LUK 06 42</u> # Either how canst thou say to thy brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.

clearly 18 JOB 33 03 # My words [shall be of] the uprightness of my heart: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly.

clearly 41 MAR 08 25 # After that he put [his] hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.

clearness 02 EXO 24 10 # And they saw the God of Israel: and [there was] under his feet as it were a paved work of a sapphire stone, and as it were the body of heaven in [his] clearness.
