cloth and dipped <u>12_2KI_08_15</u># And it came to pass on the morrow, that he took a thick cloth, and dipped [it] in water, and spread [it] on his face, so that he died: and Hazael reigned in his stead.

cloth and fled <u>41_MAR_14_52</u> # And he left the linen cloth, and fled from them naked.

cloth before the <u>05_DEU_22_17</u> # And, lo, he hath given occasions of speech [against her], saying, I found not thy daughter a maid; and yet these [are the tokens of] my daughter's virginity. And they shall spread the cloth before the elders of the city.

cloth behind the <u>09_1SA_21_09</u> # And the priest said, The sword of Goliath the Philistine, whom thou slewest in the valley of Elah, behold, it [is here] wrapped in a cloth behind the ephod: if thou wilt take that, take [it]: for [there is] no other save that here. And David said, [There is] none like that; give it me.

cloth cast about <u>41_MAR_14_51</u> # And there followed him a certain young man, having a linen cloth cast about [his] naked [body]; and the young men laid hold on him:

cloth of blue <u>04_NUM_04_07</u> # And upon the table of showbread they shall spread a cloth of blue, and put thereon the dishes, and the spoons, and the bowls, and covers to cover withal: and the continual bread shall be thereon:

cloth of blue <u>04_NUM_04_09</u> # And they shall take a cloth of blue, and cover the candlestick of the light, and his lamps, and his tongs, and his snuffdishes, and all the oil vessels thereof, wherewith they minister unto it:

cloth of blue <u>04_NUM_04_11</u># And upon the golden altar they shall spread a cloth of blue, and cover it with a covering of badgers' skins, and shall put to the staves thereof:

cloth of blue <u>04_NUM_04_12</u># And they shall take all the instruments of ministry, wherewith they minister in the sanctuary, and put [them] in a cloth of blue, and cover them with a covering of badgers' skins, and shall put [them] on a bar:

cloth of scarlet <u>04_NUM_04_08</u> # And they shall spread upon them a cloth of scarlet, and cover the same with a covering of badgers' skins, and shall put in the staves thereof.

cloth on an <u>41_MAR_02_21</u> # No man also seweth a piece of new cloth on an old garment: else the new piece that filled it up taketh away from the old, and the rent is made worse.

cloth thereon <u>04_NUM_04_13</u># And they shall take away the ashes from the altar, and spread a purple cloth thereon:

cloth thou shalt <u>23_ISA_30_22</u> # Ye shall defile also the covering of thy graven images of silver, and the ornament of thy molten images of gold: thou shalt cast them away as a menstruous cloth; thou shalt say unto it, Get thee hence.

cloth unto an <u>40_MAT_09_16</u># No man putteth a piece of new cloth unto an old garment, for that which is put in to fill it up taketh from the garment, and the rent is made worse.

cloth upon him <u>10_2SA_20_12</u># And Amasa wallowed in blood in the midst of the highway. And when the

man saw that all the people stood still, he removed Amasa out of the highway into the field, and cast a cloth upon him, when he saw that every one that came by him stood still.

cloth wholly of <u>04_NUM_04_06</u># And shall put thereon the covering of badgers' skins, and shall spread over [it] a cloth wholly of blue, and shall put in the staves thereof.

cloth <u>09_1SA_19_13</u># And Michal took an image, and laid [it] in the bed, and put a pillow of goats' [hair] for his bolster, and covered [it] with a cloth.

cloth <u>40_MAT_27_59</u># And when Joseph had taken the body, he wrapped it in a clean linen cloth,

clothe a man <u>20_PRO_23_21</u> # For the drunkard and the glutton shall come to poverty: and drowsiness shall clothe [a man] with rags.

clothe her priests <u>19_PSA_132_16</u># I will also clothe her priests with salvation: and her saints shall shout aloud for joy.

clothe him with <u>23_ISA_22_21</u> # And I will clothe him with thy robe, and strengthen him with thy girdle, and I will commit thy government into his hand: and he shall be a father to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, and to the house of Judah.

clothe Mordecai and <u>17_EST_04_04</u># So Esther's maids and her chamberlains came and told [it] her. Then was the queen exceedingly grieved; and she sent raiment to clothe Mordecai, and to take away his sackcloth from him: but he received [it] not.

clothe the grass <u>42_LUK_12_28</u> # If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more [will he clothe] you, O ye of little faith?

clothe the grass <u>40_MAT_06_30</u># Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, [shall he] not much more [clothe] you, O ye of little faith?

clothe the heavens <u>23_ISA_50_03</u> # I clothe the heavens with blackness, and I make sackcloth their covering.

clothe thee with 23_ISA_49_18 # Lift up thine eyes round about, and behold: all these gather themselves together, [and] come to thee. [As] I live, saith the LORD, thou shalt surely clothe thee with them all, as with an ornament, and bind them [on thee], as a bride [doeth].

clothe thee with <u>38_ZEC_03_04</u> # And he answered and spake unto those that stood before him, saying, Take away the filthy garments from him. And unto him he said, Behold, I have caused thine iniquity to pass from thee, and I will clothe thee with change of raiment.

clothe them with <u>02_EXO_40_14</u> # And thou shalt bring his sons, and clothe them with coats:

clothe themselves with <u>26_EZE_26_16</u># Then all the princes of the sea shall come down from their thrones, and lay away their robes, and put off their broidered garments: they shall clothe themselves with trembling; they shall sit upon the ground, and shall tremble at [every] moment, and be astonished at thee.

clothe with shame <u>19_PSA_132_18</u># His enemies will I clothe with shame: but upon himself shall his crown flourish.

clothe you but <u>37_HAG_01_06</u> # Ye have sown much, and bring in little; ye eat, but ye have not enough; ye drink, but ye are not filled with drink; ye clothe you, but there is none warm; and he that earneth wages earneth wages [to put it] into a bag with holes.

clothe you O <u>42_LUK_12_28</u># If then God so clothe the grass, which is to day in the field, and to morrow is cast into the oven; how much more [will he clothe] you, O ye of little faith?

clothe you O <u>40_MAT_06_30</u># Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which to day is, and to morrow is cast into the oven, [shall he] not much more [clothe] you, O ye of little faith?

clothe you with <u>26 EZE 34 03</u> # Ye eat the fat, and ye clothe you with the wool, ye kill them that are fed: [but] ye feed not the flock.

clothed all that <u>14_2CH_28_15</u> # And the men which were expressed by name rose up, and took the captives, and with the spoil clothed all that were naked among them, and arrayed them, and shod them, and gave them to eat and to drink, and anointed them, and carried all the feeble of them upon asses, and brought them to Jericho, the city of palm trees, to their brethren: then they returned to Samaria.

clothed and in <u>42_LUK_08_35</u> # Then they went out to see what was done; and came to Jesus, and found the man, out of whom the devils were departed, sitting at the feet of Jesus, clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

clothed and in <u>41_MAR_05_15</u># And they come to Jesus, and see him that was possessed with the devil, and had the legion, sitting, and clothed, and in his right mind: and they were afraid.

clothed and that <u>66_REV_03_18</u> # I counsel thee to buy of me gold tried in the fire, that thou mayest be rich; and white raiment, that thou mayest be clothed, and [that] the shame of thy nakedness do not appear; and anoint thine eyes with eyesalve, that thou mayest see.

clothed Daniel with <u>27_DAN_05_29</u> # Then commanded Belshazzar, and they clothed Daniel with scarlet, and [put] a chain of gold about his neck, and made a proclamation concerning him, that he should be the third ruler in the kingdom.

clothed him with <u>03_LEV_08_07</u># And he put upon him the coat, and girded him with the girdle, and clothed him with the robe, and put the ephod upon him, and he girded him with the curious girdle of the ephod, and bound [it] unto him therewith.

clothed him with <u>41_MAR_15_17</u> # And they clothed him with purple, and platted a crown of thorns, and put it about his [head],

clothed him with <u>38_ZEC_03_05</u> # And I said, Let them set a fair mitre upon his head. So they set a fair mitre upon his head, and clothed him with garments. And the angel of the LORD stood by.

clothed himself with <u>19_PSA_109_18</u># As he clothed himself with cursing like as with his garment, so let it come into his bowels like water, and like oil into his bones.

clothed his neck <u>18_JOB_39_19</u># Hast thou given the horse strength? hast thou clothed his neck with thunder?

clothed in a <u>41_MAR_16_05</u> # And entering into the sepulchre, they saw a young man sitting on the right side, clothed in a long white garment; and they were affrighted.

clothed in fine <u>66_REV_18_16</u> # And saying, Alas, alas, that great city, that was clothed in fine linen, and purple, and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls!

clothed in fine <u>66_REV_19_14</u> # And the armies [which were] in heaven followed him upon white horses, clothed in fine linen, white and clean.

clothed in linen 27_DAN_10_05 # Then I lifted up mine eyes, and looked, and behold a certain man clothed

in linen, whose loins [were] girded with fine gold of Uphaz:

clothed in linen <u>27 DAN_12_06</u> # And [one] said to the man clothed in linen, which [was] upon the waters of the river, How long [shall it be to] the end of these wonders?

clothed in linen <u>27_DAN_12_07</u> # And I heard the man clothed in linen, which [was] upon the waters of the river, when he held up his right hand and his left hand unto heaven, and sware by him that liveth for ever that [it shall be] for a time, times, and an half; and when he shall have accomplished to scatter the power of the holy people, all these [things] shall be finished.

clothed in pure <u>66_REV_15_06</u> # And the seven angels came out of the temple, having the seven plagues, clothed in pure and white linen, and having their breasts girded with golden girdles.

clothed in purple <u>42_LUK_16_19</u> # There was a certain rich man, which was clothed in purple and fine linen, and fared sumptuously every day:

clothed in sackcloth <u>13_1CH_21_16</u># And David lifted up his eyes, and saw the angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven, having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem. Then David and the elders [of Israel, who were] clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces.

clothed in sackcloth <u>66_REV_11_03</u># And I will give [power] unto my two witnesses, and they shall prophesy a thousand two hundred [and] threescore days, clothed in sackcloth.

clothed in soft <u>42_LUK_07_25</u> # But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? Behold, they which are gorgeously apparelled, and live delicately, are in kings' courts.

clothed in soft <u>40_MAT_11_08</u># But what went ye out for to see? A man clothed in soft raiment? behold, they that wear soft [clothing] are in kings' houses.

clothed in their <u>14_2CH_18_09</u># And the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat king of Judah sat either of them on his throne, clothed in [their] robes, and they sat in a void place at the entering in of the gate of Samaria; and all the prophets prophesied before them.

clothed in white <u>66_REV_03_05</u># He that overcometh, the same shall be clothed in white raiment; and I will not blot out his name out of the book of life, but I will confess his name before my Father, and before his angels.

clothed in white <u>66_REV_04_04</u> # And round about the throne [were] four and twenty seats: and upon the seats I saw four and twenty elders sitting, clothed in white raiment; and they had on their heads crowns of gold.

clothed me I <u>40_MAT_25_36</u># Naked, and ye clothed me: I was sick, and ye visited me: I was in prison, and ye came unto me.

clothed me my <u>18_JOB_29_14</u># I put on righteousness, and it clothed me: my judgment [was] as a robe and a diadem.

clothed me not <u>40_MAT_25_43</u># I was a stranger, and ye took me not in: naked, and ye clothed me not: sick, and in prison, and ye visited me not.

clothed me with <u>23_ISA_61_10</u> # I will greatly rejoice in the LORD, my soul shall be joyful in my God; for he hath clothed me with the garments of salvation, he hath covered me with the robe of righteousness, as a bridegroom decketh [himself] with ornaments, and as a bride adorneth [herself] with her jewels.

clothed me with <a><u>18_JOB_10_11</u># Thou hast clothed me with skin and flesh, and hast fenced me with bones

and sinews.

clothed most gorgeously <u>26_EZE_23_12</u> # She doted upon the Assyrians [her] neighbours, captains and rulers clothed most gorgeously, horsemen riding upon horses, all of them desirable young men.

clothed thee also <u>26_EZE_16_10</u># I clothed thee also with broidered work, and shod thee with badgers' skin, and I girded thee about with fine linen, and I covered thee with silk.

clothed thee <u>40_MAT_25_38</u># When saw we thee a stranger, and took [thee] in? or naked, and clothed [thee]?

clothed them <u>01_GEN_03_21</u># Unto Adam also and to his wife did the LORD God make coats of skins, and clothed them.

clothed upon that <u>47_2CO_05_04</u> # For we that are in [this] tabernacle do groan, being burdened: not for that we would be unclothed, but clothed upon, that mortality might be swallowed up of life.

clothed upon with <u>47_2CO_05_02</u> # For in this we groan, earnestly desiring to be clothed upon with our house which is from heaven:

clothed we shall <u>47_2CO_05_03</u> # If so be that being clothed we shall not be found naked.

clothed with a <u>13_1CH_15_27</u># And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.

clothed with a <u>66_REV_01_13</u># And in the midst of the seven candlesticks [one] like unto the Son of man, clothed with a garment down to the foot, and girt about the paps with a golden girdle.

clothed with a <u>66_REV_10_01</u># And I saw another mighty angel come down from heaven, clothed with a cloud: and a rainbow [was] upon his head, and his face [was] as it were the sun, and his feet as pillars of fire:

clothed with a <u>66_REV_19_13</u># And he [was] clothed with a vesture dipped in blood: and his name is called The Word of God.

clothed with all <u>26_EZE_38_04</u> # And I will turn thee back, and put hooks into thy jaws, and I will bring thee forth, and all thine army, horses and horsemen, all of them clothed with all sorts [of armour, even] a great company [with] bucklers and shields, all of them handling swords:

clothed with blue <u>26_EZE_23_06</u># [Which were] clothed with blue, captains and rulers, all of them desirable young men, horsemen riding upon horses.

clothed with camel's <u>41_MAR_01_06</u># And John was clothed with camel's hair, and with a girdle of a skin about his loins; and he did eat locusts and wild honey;

clothed with desolation <u>26_EZE_07_27</u> # The king shall mourn, and the prince shall be clothed with desolation, and the hands of the people of the land shall be troubled: I will do unto them after their way, and according to their deserts will I judge them; and they shall know that I [am] the LORD.

clothed with filthy <u>38_ZEC_03_03</u> # Now Joshua was clothed with filthy garments, and stood before the angel.

clothed with flocks <u>19_PSA_65_13</u> # The pastures are clothed with flocks; the valleys also are covered over with corn; they shout for joy, they also sing.

clothed with honour <u>19_PSA_104_01</u># Bless the LORD, O my soul. O LORD my God, thou art very great; thou art clothed with honour and majesty.

clothed with humility <u>60_1PE_05_05</u># Likewise, ye younger, submit yourselves unto the elder. Yea, all [of you] be subject one to another, and be clothed with humility: for God resisteth the proud, and giveth grace to the humble.

clothed with linen <u>26_EZE_09_02</u> # And, behold, six men came from the way of the higher gate, which lieth toward the north, and every man a slaughter weapon in his hand; and one man among them [was] clothed with linen, with a writer's inkhorn by his side: and they went in, and stood beside the brazen altar.

clothed with linen <u>26_EZE_09_03</u> # And the glory of the God of Israel was gone up from the cherub, whereupon he was, to the threshold of the house. And he called to the man clothed with linen, which [had] the writer's inkhorn by his side;

clothed with majesty <u>19_PSA_93_01</u> # The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, [wherewith] he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.

clothed with righteousness <u>19_PSA_132_09</u># Let thy priests be clothed with righteousness; and let thy saints shout for joy.

clothed with sackcloth <u>17_EST_04_02</u> # And came even before the king's gate: for none [might] enter into the king's gate clothed with sackcloth.

clothed with salvation <u>14_2CH_06_41</u> # Now therefore arise, O LORD God, into thy resting place, thou, and the ark of thy strength: let thy priests, O LORD God, be clothed with salvation, and let thy saints rejoice in goodness.

clothed with scarlet <u>27_DAN_05_07</u># The king cried aloud to bring in the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers. [And] the king spake, and said to the wise [men] of Babylon, Whosoever shall read this writing, and show me the interpretation thereof, shall be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about his neck, and shall be the third ruler in the kingdom.

clothed with scarlet <u>27_DAN_05_16</u># And I have heard of thee, that thou canst make interpretations, and dissolve doubts: now if thou canst read the writing, and make known to me the interpretation thereof, thou

shalt be clothed with scarlet, and [have] a chain of gold about thy neck, and shalt be the third ruler in the kingdom.

clothed with scarlet <u>20_PRO_31_21</u># She is not afraid of the snow for her household: for all her household [are] clothed with scarlet.

clothed with shame <u>18_JOB_08_22</u> # They that hate thee shall be clothed with shame; and the dwelling place of the wicked shall come to nought.

clothed with shame <u>19_PSA_109_29</u># Let mine adversaries be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their own confusion, as with a mantle.

clothed with shame <u>19_PSA_35_26</u># Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonour that magnify [themselves] against me.

clothed with strange <u>36_ZEP_01_08</u># And it shall come to pass in the day of the LORD'S sacrifice, that I will punish the princes, and the king's children, and all such as are clothed with strange apparel.

clothed with strength <u>19_PSA_93_01</u> # The LORD reigneth, he is clothed with majesty; the LORD is clothed with strength, [wherewith] he hath girded himself: the world also is stablished, that it cannot be moved.

clothed with the <u>66_REV_12_01</u># And there appeared a great wonder in heaven; a woman clothed with the sun, and the moon under her feet, and upon her head a crown of twelve stars:

clothes also and <u>09_1SA_19_24</u># And he stripped off his clothes also, and prophesied before Samuel in like manner, and lay down naked all that day and all that night. Wherefore they say, [Is] Saul also among the prophets?

clothes also he <u>03_LEV_14_09</u> # But it shall be on the seventh day, that he shall shave all his hair off his head and his beard and his eyebrows, even all his hair he shall shave off: and he shall wash his clothes, also he shall wash his flesh in water, and he shall be clean.

clothes and Aaron <u>04_NUM_08_21</u> # And the Levites were purified, and they washed their clothes; and Aaron offered them [as] an offering before the LORD; and Aaron made an atonement for them to cleanse them.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_05</u> # And whosoever toucheth his bed shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_06</u># And he that sitteth on [any] thing whereon he sat that hath the issue shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_07</u> # And he that toucheth the flesh of him that hath the issue shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_08</u> # And if he that hath the issue spit upon him that is clean; then he shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_10</u># And whosoever toucheth any thing that was under him shall be unclean until the even: and he that beareth [any of] those things shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_11</u># And whomsoever he toucheth that hath the issue, and hath not rinsed his hands in water, he shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_13</u># And when he that hath an issue is cleansed of his issue; then he shall number to himself seven days for his cleansing, and wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in running water, and shall be clean.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_21</u># And whosoever toucheth her bed shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_22</u> # And whosoever toucheth any thing that she sat upon shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_15_27</u> # And whosoever toucheth those things shall be unclean, and shall wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_16_26</u># And he that let go the goat for the scapegoat shall wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in water, and afterward come into the camp.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_16_28</u> # And he that burneth them shall wash his clothes, and bathe his flesh in water, and afterward he shall come into the camp.

clothes and bathe <u>03_LEV_17_15</u> # And every soul that eateth that which died [of itself], or that which was torn [with beasts, whether it be] one of your own country, or a stranger, he shall both wash his clothes, and bathe [himself] in water, and be unclean until the even: then shall he be clean.

clothes and bathe <u>04_NUM_19_19</u># And the clean [person] shall sprinkle upon the unclean on the third day, and on the seventh day: and on the seventh day he shall purify himself, and wash his clothes, and bathe himself in water, and shall be clean at even.

clothes and be <u>03_LEV_11_25</u># And whosoever beareth [ought] of the carcase of them shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and be <u>03_LEV_11_28</u># And he that beareth the carcase of them shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even: they [are] unclean unto you.

clothes and be <u>03_LEV_11_40</u># And he that eateth of the carcase of it shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even: he also that beareth the carcase of it shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even.

clothes and be <u>03_LEV_11_40</u># And he that eateth of the carcase of it shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even: he also that beareth the carcase of it shall wash his clothes, and be unclean until the even.

sackcloth their covering 23_ISA_50_03 # I clothe the heavens with blackness, and I make sackcloth their covering.

sackcloth to Isaiah <u>12_2KI_19_02</u> # And he sent Eliakim, which [was] over the household, and Shebna the scribe, and the elders of the priests, covered with sackcloth, to Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz.

sackcloth unto Isaiah <u>23_ISA_37_02</u> # And he sent Eliakim, who [was] over the household, and Shebna the scribe, and the elders of the priests covered with sackcloth, unto Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz.

sackcloth upon all <u>30_AMO_08_10</u># And I will turn your feasts into mourning, and all your songs into lamentation; and I will bring up sackcloth upon all loins, and baldness upon every head; and I will make it as the mourning of an only [son], and the end thereof as a bitter day.

sackcloth upon his <u>11_1KI_21_27</u># And it came to pass, when Ahab heard those words, that he rent his clothes, and put sackcloth upon his flesh, and fasted, and lay in sackcloth, and went softly.

sackcloth upon his <u>01_GEN_37_34</u> # And Jacob rent his clothes, and put sackcloth upon his loins, and mourned for his son many days.

sackcloth upon my <u>18_JOB_16_15</u># I have sewed sackcloth upon my skin, and defiled my horn in the dust.

sackcloth upon your <u>23_ISA_32_11</u># Tremble, ye women that are at ease; be troubled, ye careless ones: strip you, and make you bare, and gird [sackcloth] upon [your] loins.

sackcloth with ashes <u>17_EST_04_01</u> # When Mordecai perceived all that was done, Mordecai rent his clothes, and put on sackcloth with ashes, and went out into the midst of the city, and cried with a loud and a bitter cry;

sackcloth within upon <u>12_2KI_06_30</u> # And it came to pass, when the king heard the words of the woman, that he rent his clothes; and he passed by upon the wall, and the people looked, and, behold, [he had] sackcloth within upon his flesh.

sackcloth ye ministers <u>29_JOE_01_13</u> # Gird yourselves, and lament, ye priests: howl, ye ministers of the altar: come, lie all night in sackcloth, ye ministers of my God: for the meat offering and the drink offering is withholden from the house of your God.

sackcloth <u>17_EST_04_02</u># And came even before the king's gate: for none [might] enter into the king's gate clothed with sackcloth.
