condemn he shall <u>02\_EXO\_22\_09</u> # For all manner of trespass, [whether it be] for ox, for ass, for sheep, for raiment, [or] for any manner of lost thing, which [another] challengeth to be his, the cause of both parties shall come before the judges; [and] whom the judges shall condemn, he shall pay double unto his neighbour.

condemn him that <u>18\_JOB\_34\_17</u># Shall even he that hateth right govern? and wilt thou condemn him that is most just?

condemn him to <u>41\_MAR\_10\_33</u> # [Saying], Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be delivered unto the chief priests, and unto the scribes; and they shall condemn him to death, and shall deliver him to the Gentiles:

condemn him to <u>40\_MAT\_20\_18</u># Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn him to death,

condemn him when 19\_PSA\_37\_33 # The LORD will not leave him in his hand, nor condemn him when he is judged.

condemn his soul <u>19\_PSA\_109\_31</u># For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save [him] from those that condemn his soul.

condemn it because <u>40\_MAT\_12\_41</u># The men of Nineveh shall rise in judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: because they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas [is] here.

condemn it for <u>42\_LUK\_11\_32</u># The men of Nineve shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for they repented at the preaching of Jonas; and, behold, a greater than Jonas [is] here.

condemn it for <u>40\_MAT\_12\_42</u># The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with this generation, and shall condemn it: for she came from the uttermost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon [is] here.

condemn me if <u>18\_JOB\_09\_20</u> # If I justify myself, mine own mouth shall condemn me: [if I say], I [am] perfect, it shall also prove me perverse.

condemn me lo <u>23\_ISA\_50\_09</u> # Behold, the Lord GOD will help me; who [is] he [that] shall condemn me? lo, they all shall wax old as a garment; the moth shall eat them up.

condemn me show <u>18\_JOB\_10\_02</u># I will say unto God, Do not condemn me; show me wherefore thou contendest with me.

condemn me that <u>18\_JOB\_40\_08</u># Wilt thou also disannul my judgment? wilt thou condemn me, that thou mayest be righteous?

condemn not and <u>42\_LUK\_06\_37</u> # Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:

condemn the innocent 19\_PSA\_94\_21 # They gather themselves together against the soul of the righteous,

and condemn the innocent blood.

condemn the wicked <u>05\_DEU\_25\_01</u># If there be a controversy between men, and they come unto judgment, that [the judges] may judge them; then they shall justify the righteous, and condemn the wicked.

condemn the world <u>43\_JOH\_03\_17</u># For God sent not his Son into the world to condemn the world; but that the world through him might be saved.

condemn thee go 43 JOH 08 11 # She said, No man, Lord. And Jesus said unto her, Neither do I condemn thee: go, and sin no more.

condemn them for <u>42\_LUK\_11\_31</u># The queen of the south shall rise up in the judgment with the men of this generation, and condemn them: for she came from the utmost parts of the earth to hear the wisdom of Solomon; and, behold, a greater than Solomon [is] here.

condemn This is <u>23\_ISA\_54\_17</u> # No weapon that is formed against thee shall prosper; and every tongue [that] shall rise against thee in judgment thou shalt condemn. This [is] the heritage of the servants of the LORD, and their righteousness [is] of me, saith the LORD.

condemn us God  $\underline{62\_1JO\_03\_20}$ # For if our heart condemn us, God is greater than our heart, and knoweth all things.

condemn us not <u>62\_1JO\_03\_21</u> # Beloved, if our heart condemn us not, [then] have we confidence toward God.

condemn you for <u>47\_2CO\_07\_03</u># I speak not [this] to condemn [you]: for I have said before, that ye are in our hearts to die and live with [you].

condemn **20\_PRO\_12\_02** # A good [man] obtaineth favour of the LORD: but a man of wicked devices will he condemn.

condemnation And the <u>46\_1CO\_11\_34</u># And if any man hunger, let him eat at home; that ye come not together unto condemnation. And the rest will I set in order when I come.

condemnation be glory <u>47\_2CO\_03\_09</u> # For if the ministration of condemnation [be] glory, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in glory.

condemnation but is <u>43\_JOH\_05\_24</u> # Verily, verily, I say unto you, He that heareth my word, and believeth on him that sent me, hath everlasting life, and shall not come into condemnation; but is passed from death unto life.

condemnation but the <u>45\_ROM\_05\_16</u># And not as [it was] by one that sinned, [so is] the gift: for the judgment [was] by one to condemnation, but the free gift [is] of many offences unto justification.

condemnation even so <u>45\_ROM\_05\_18</u># Therefore as by the offence of one [judgment came] upon all men to condemnation; even so by the righteousness of one [the free gift came] upon all men unto justification of life.

condemnation of the <u>54\_1TI\_03\_06</u> # Not a novice, lest being lifted up with pride he fall into the condemnation of the devil.

condemnation that light <u>43\_JOH\_03\_19</u> # And this is the condemnation, that light is come into the world, and men loved darkness rather than light, because their deeds were evil.

condemnation to them 45\_ROM\_08\_01 # [There is] therefore now no condemnation to them which are in

Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit.

condemnation ungodly men <u>65\_JDE\_01\_04</u># For there are certain men crept in unawares, who were before of old ordained to this condemnation, ungodly men, turning the grace of our God into lasciviousness, and denying the only Lord God, and our Lord Jesus Christ.

condemnation <u>59\_JAM\_03\_01</u># My brethren, be not many masters, knowing that we shall receive the greater condemnation.

condemnation <u>59\_JAM\_05\_12</u> # But above all things, my brethren, swear not, neither by heaven, neither by the earth, neither by any other oath: but let your yea be yea; and [your] nay, nay; lest ye fall into condemnation.

condemnation <u>42\_LUK\_23\_40</u> # But the other answering rebuked him, saying, Dost not thou fear God, seeing thou art in the same condemnation?

condemned already because <u>43\_JOH\_03\_18</u># He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

condemned and killed <u>59\_JAM\_05\_06</u># Ye have condemned [and] killed the just; [and] he doth not resist you.

condemned and let 19\_PSA\_109\_07 # When he shall be judged, let him be condemned: and let his prayer become sin.

condemned behold the <u>59\_JAM\_05\_09</u># Grudge not one against another, brethren, lest ye be condemned: behold, the judge standeth before the door.

condemned but he <u>43\_JOH\_03\_18</u># He that believeth on him is not condemned: but he that believeth not is condemned already, because he hath not believed in the name of the only begotten Son of God.

condemned forgive and <u>42\_LUK\_06\_37</u> # Judge not, and ye shall not be judged: condemn not, and ye shall not be condemned: forgive, and ye shall be forgiven:

condemned him to <u>41\_MAR\_14\_64</u># Ye have heard the blasphemy: what think ye? And they all condemned him to be guilty of death.

condemned in the <u>30\_AMO\_02\_08</u># And they lay [themselves] down upon clothes laid to pledge by every altar, and they drink the wine of the condemned [in] the house of their god.

condemned Job <u>18\_JOB\_32\_03</u># Also against his three friends was his wrath kindled, because they had found no answer, and [yet] had condemned Job.

condemned of himself <u>56\_TIT\_03\_11</u># Knowing that he that is such is subverted, and sinneth, being condemned of himself.

condemned repented himself <u>40\_MAT\_27\_03</u># Then Judas, which had betrayed him, when he saw that he was condemned, repented himself, and brought again the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders,

condemned sin in <u>45\_ROM\_08\_03</u># For what the law could not do, in that it was weak through the flesh, God sending his own Son in the likeness of sinful flesh, and for sin, condemned sin in the flesh:

condemned that he 56\_TIT\_02\_08 # Sound speech, that cannot be condemned; that he that is of the

contrary part may be ashamed, having no evil thing to say of you.

condemned the guiltless <u>40\_MAT\_12\_07</u># But if ye had known what [this] meaneth, I will have mercy, and not sacrifice, ye would not have condemned the guiltless.

condemned the land 14\_2CH\_36\_03 # And the king of Egypt put him down at Jerusalem, and condemned the land in an hundred talents of silver and a talent of gold.

condemned the world <u>58\_HEB\_11\_07</u># By faith Noah, being warned of God of things not seen as yet, moved with fear, prepared an ark to the saving of his house; by the which he condemned the world, and became heir of the righteousness which is by faith.

condemned thee <u>43\_JOH\_08\_10</u> # When Jesus had lifted up himself, and saw none but the woman, he said unto her, Woman, where are those thine accusers? hath no man condemned thee?

condemned them with <u>61\_2PE\_02\_06</u> # And turning the cities of Sodom and Gomorrha into ashes condemned [them] with an overthrow, making [them] an ensample unto those that after should live ungodly;

condemned to death <u>42\_LUK\_24\_20</u> # And how the chief priests and our rulers delivered him to be condemned to death, and have crucified him.

condemned with the <u>46\_1CO\_11\_32</u># But when we are judged, we are chastened of the Lord, that we should not be condemned with the world.

condemned <u>40\_MAT\_12\_37</u># For by thy words thou shalt be justified, and by thy words thou shalt be condemned.

condemnest thyself for <u>45\_ROM\_02\_01</u># Therefore thou art inexcusable, O man, whosoever thou art that judgest: for wherein thou judgest another, thou condemnest thyself; for thou that judgest doest the same things.

condemneth It is <u>45\_ROM\_08\_34</u> # Who [is] he that condemneth? [It is] Christ that died, yea rather, that is risen again, who is even at the right hand of God, who also maketh intercession for us.

condemneth not himself <u>45\_ROM\_14\_22</u> # Hast thou faith? have [it] to thyself before God. Happy [is] he that condemneth not himself in that thing which he alloweth.

condemneth the just <u>20\_PRO\_17\_15</u># He that justifieth the wicked, and he that condemneth the just, even they both [are] abomination to the LORD.

condemneth thee and <u>18\_JOB\_15\_06</u># Thine own mouth condemneth thee, and not I: yea, thine own lips testify against thee.

condemning him <u>44\_ACT\_13\_27</u># For they that dwell at Jerusalem, and their rulers, because they knew him not, nor yet the voices of the prophets which are read every sabbath day, they have fulfilled [them] in condemning [him].

condemning the wicked <u>11\_1KI\_08\_32</u># Then hear thou in heaven, and do, and judge thy servants, condemning the wicked, to bring his way upon his head; and justifying the righteous, to give him according to his righteousness.

uncondemned being Romans <u>44\_ACT\_16\_37</u> # But Paul said unto them, They have beaten us openly uncondemned, being Romans, and have cast [us] into prison; and now do they thrust us out privily? nay verily; but let them come themselves and fetch us out.

uncondemned <u>44\_ACT\_22\_25</u># And as they bound him with thongs, Paul said unto the centurion that stood by, Is it lawful for you to scourge a man that is a Roman, and uncondemned?
