contention and his <u>20_PRO_18_06</u> # A fool's lips enter into contention, and his mouth calleth for strokes.

contention before it <u>20_PRO_17_14</u> # The beginning of strife [is as] when one letteth out water: therefore leave off contention, before it be meddled with.

contention but with <u>20_PRO_13_10</u> # Only by pride cometh contention: but with the well advised [is] wisdom.

contention not sincerely <u>50_PHP_01_16</u># The one preach Christ of contention, not sincerely, supposing to add affliction to my bonds:

contention shall go <u>20_PRO_22_10</u># Cast out the scorner, and contention shall go out; yea, strife and reproach shall cease.

contention to the <u>24_JER_15_10</u> # Woe is me, my mother, that thou hast borne me a man of strife and a man of contention to the whole earth! I have neither lent on usury, nor men have lent to me on usury; [yet] every one of them doth curse me.

contention was so <u>44_ACT_15_39</u> # And the contention was so sharp between them, that they departed asunder one from the other: and so Barnabas took Mark, and sailed unto Cyprus;

contention <u>52_1TH_02_02</u> # But even after that we had suffered before, and were shamefully entreated, as ye know, at Philippi, we were bold in our God to speak unto you the gospel of God with much contention.

contention <u>35_HAB_01_03</u> # Why dost thou show me iniquity, and cause [me] to behold grievance? for spoiling and violence [are] before me: and there are [that] raise up strife and contention.

contentions among you <u>46_1CO_01_11</u># For it hath been declared unto me of you, my brethren, by them [which are of the house] of Chloe, that there are contentions among you.

contentions and strivings <u>56_TIT_03_09</u> # But avoid foolish questions, and genealogies, and contentions, and strivings about the law; for they are unprofitable and vain.

contentions are like <u>20_PRO_18_19</u># A brother offended [is harder to be won] than a strong city: and [their] contentions [are] like the bars of a castle.

contentions of a <u>20_PRO_19_13</u># A foolish son [is] the calamity of his father: and the contentions of a wife [are] a continual dropping.

contentions to cease <u>20_PRO_18_18</u># The lot causeth contentions to cease, and parteth between the mighty.

contentions who hath <u>20_PRO_23_29</u> # Who hath woe? who hath sorrow? who hath contentions? who hath babbling? who hath wounds without cause? who hath redness of eyes?
