convenient but rather <u>49_EPH_05_04</u> # Neither filthiness, nor foolish talking, nor jesting, which are not convenient: but rather giving of thanks.

convenient day was <u>41_MAR_06_21</u># And when a convenient day was come, that Herod on his birthday made a supper to his lords, high captains, and chief [estates] of Galilee;

convenient for me <u>20_PRO_30_08</u># Remove far from me vanity and lies: give me neither poverty nor riches; feed me with food convenient for me:

convenient for thee <u>24_JER_40_04</u> # And now, behold, I loose thee this day from the chains which [were] upon thine hand. If it seem good unto thee to come with me into Babylon, come; and I will look well unto thee: but if it seem ill unto thee to come with me into Babylon, forbear: behold, all the land [is] before thee: whither it seemeth good and convenient for thee to go, thither go.

convenient season I <u>44_ACT_24_25</u> # And as he reasoned of righteousness, temperance, and judgment to come, Felix trembled, and answered, Go thy way for this time; when I have a convenient season, I will call for thee.

convenient time <u>46_1CO_16_12</u> # As touching [our] brother Apollos, I greatly desired him to come unto you with the brethren: but his will was not at all to come at this time; but he will come when he shall have convenient time.

convenient unto thee 24_JER_40_05 # Now while he was not yet gone back, [he said], Go back also to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, whom the king of Babylon hath made governor over the cities of Judah, and dwell with him among the people: or go wheresoever it seemeth convenient unto thee to go. So the captain of the guard gave him victuals and a reward, and let him go.

convenient <u>57_PHM_01_08</u> # Wherefore, though I might be much bold in Christ to enjoin thee that which is convenient,

convenient <u>45_ROM_01_28</u> # And even as they did not like to retain God in [their] knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

conveniently betray him <u>41_MAR_14_11</u># And when they heard [it], they were glad, and promised to give him money. And he sought how he might conveniently betray him.
