corn after him <u>08\_RUT\_02\_02</u># And Ruth the Moabitess said unto Naomi, Let me now go to the field, and glean ears of corn after [him] in whose sight I shall find grace. And she said unto her, Go, my daughter.

corn among those <u>01\_GEN\_42\_05</u># And the sons of Israel came to buy [corn] among those that came: for the famine was in the land of Canaan.

corn and an <u>09\_1SA\_25\_18</u># Then Abigail made haste, and took two hundred loaves, and two bottles of wine, and five sheep ready dressed, and five measures of parched [corn], and an hundred clusters of raisins, and two hundred cakes of figs, and laid [them] on asses.

corn and beans <u>10\_2SA\_17\_28</u> # Brought beds, and basins, and earthen vessels, and wheat, and barley, and flour, and parched [corn], and beans, and lentiles, and parched [pulse],
