corrupt according to <u>49\_EPH\_04\_22</u># That ye put off concerning the former conversation the old man, which is corrupt according to the deceitful lusts;

corrupt and his <u>40\_MAT\_12\_33</u># Either make the tree good, and his fruit good; or else make the tree corrupt, and his fruit corrupt: for the tree is known by [his] fruit.

corrupt and speak 19\_PSA\_73\_08 # They are corrupt, and speak wickedly [concerning] oppression: they speak loftily.

corrupt and where <u>40\_MAT\_06\_20</u># But lay up for yourselves treasures in heaven, where neither moth nor rust doth corrupt, and where thieves do not break through nor steal:

Corrupt are they <u>19\_PSA\_53\_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Mahalath, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. Corrupt are they, and have done abominable iniquity: [there is] none that doeth good.

corrupt because of 19\_PSA\_38\_05 # My wounds stink [and] are corrupt because of my foolishness.

corrupt before God <u>01\_GEN\_06\_11</u># The earth also was corrupt before God, and the earth was filled with violence.

corrupt by flatteries <u>27\_DAN\_11\_32</u># And such as do wickedly against the covenant shall he corrupt by flatteries: but the people that do know their God shall be strong, and do [exploits].

corrupt communication proceed <u>49\_EPH\_04\_29</u> # Let no corrupt communication proceed out of your mouth, but that which is good to the use of edifying, that it may minister grace unto the hearers.

corrupt spring <u>20\_PRO\_25\_26</u> # A righteous man falling down before the wicked [is as] a troubled fountain, and a corrupt spring.

corrupt the earth <u>66\_REV\_19\_02</u># For true and righteous [are] his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.

corrupt the word <u>47\_2CO\_02\_17</u># For we are not as many, which corrupt the word of God: but as of sincerity, but as of God, in the sight of God speak we in Christ.

corrupt themselves <u>65\_JDE\_01\_10</u> # But these speak evil of those things which they know not: but what they know naturally, as brute beasts, in those things they corrupt themselves.

corrupt they have <u>19\_PSA\_14\_01</u> # To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David. The fool hath said in his heart, [There is] no God. They are corrupt, they have done abominable works, [there is] none that doeth good.
