craftsmen and smiths <u>12\_2KI\_24\_14</u> # And he carried away all Jerusalem, and all the princes, and all the mighty men of valour, [even] ten thousand captives, and all the craftsmen and smiths: none remained, save the poorest sort of the people of the land.

craftsmen and smiths <u>12\_2KI\_24\_16</u> # And all the men of might, [even] seven thousand, and craftsmen and smiths a thousand, all [that were] strong [and] apt for war, even them the king of Babylon brought captive to Babylon.

craftsmen they say <u>28\_HOS\_13\_02</u> # And now they sin more and more, and have made them molten images of their silver, [and] idols according to their own understanding, all of it the work of the craftsmen: they say of them, Let the men that sacrifice kiss the calves.

craftsmen which are <u>44\_ACT\_19\_38</u> # Wherefore if Demetrius, and the craftsmen which are with him, have a matter against any man, the law is open, and there are deputies: let them implead one another.

craftsmen <u>13\_1CH\_04\_14</u># And Meonothai begat Ophrah: and Seraiah begat Joab, the father of the valley of Charashim; for they were craftsmen.

craftsmen <u>44\_ACT\_19\_24</u> # For a certain [man] named Demetrius, a silversmith, which made silver shrines for Diana, brought no small gain unto the craftsmen;

craftsmen <u>16\_NEH\_11\_35</u># Lod, and Ono, the valley of craftsmen.
