ascribed but thousands <u>09\_1SA\_18\_08</u> # And Saul was very wroth, and the saying displeased him; and he said, They have ascribed unto David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed [but] thousands: and [what] can he have more but the kingdom?

describe it according <u>06\_JOS\_18\_04</u># Give out from among you three men for [each] tribe: and I will send them, and they shall rise, and go through the land, and describe it according to the inheritance of them; and they shall come [again] to me.

describeth the blessedness <u>45\_ROM\_04\_06</u> # Even as David also describeth the blessedness of the man,

unto whom God imputeth righteousness without works,

describeth the righteousness <u>45\_ROM\_10\_05</u># For Moses describeth the righteousness which is of the law, That the man which doeth those things shall live by them.

prescribed <u>23\_ISA\_10\_01</u># Woe unto them that decree unrighteous decrees, and that write grievousness [which] they have prescribed;

prescribing how much <u>15\_EZR\_07\_22</u> # Unto an hundred talents of silver, and to an hundred measures of wheat, and to an hundred baths of wine, and to an hundred baths of oil, and salt without prescribing [how much].

scribe and Asahiah <u>12\_2KI\_22\_12</u> # And the king commanded Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Achbor the son of Michaiah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asahiah a servant of the king's, saying,

scribe and Asaiah <u>14\_2CH\_34\_20</u># And the king commanded Hilkiah, and Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Abdon the son of Micah, and Shaphan the scribe, and Asaiah a servant of the king's, saying,

scribe and Delaiah 24\_JER\_36\_12 # Then he went down into the king's house, into the scribe's chamber: and, lo, all the princes sat there, [even] Elishama the scribe, and Delaiah the son of Shemaiah, and Elnathan the son of Achbor, and Gemariah the son of Shaphan, and Zedekiah the son of Hananiah, and all the princes.

scribe and Jehiel <u>13\_1CH\_27\_32</u> # Also Jonathan David's uncle was a counsellor, a wise man, and a scribe: and Jehiel the son of Hachmoni [was] with the king's sons:

scribe and Jeremiah <u>24\_JER\_36\_26</u># But the king commanded Jerahmeel the son of Hammelech, and Seraiah the son of Azriel, and Shelemiah the son of Abdeel, to take Baruch the scribe and Jeremiah the prophet: but the LORD hid them.

scribe and Joah <u>12\_2KI\_18\_18</u># And when they had called to the king, there came out to them Eliakim the son of Hilkiah, which [was] over the household, and Shebna the scribe, and Joah the son of Asaph the recorder.

scribe and Joah <u>12\_2KI\_18\_37</u># Then came Eliakim the son of Hilkiah, which [was] over the household, and Shebna the scribe, and Joah the son of Asaph the recorder, to Hezekiah with [their] clothes rent, and told him the words of Rabshakeh.

scribe and Joah <u>23\_ISA\_36\_03</u># Then came forth unto him Eliakim, Hilkiah's son, which was over the house, and Shebna the scribe, and Joah, Asaph's son, the recorder.

scribe and Joah <u>23\_ISA\_36\_22</u># Then came Eliakim, the son of Hilkiah, that [was] over the household, and Shebna the scribe, and Joah, the son of Asaph, the recorder, to Hezekiah with [their] clothes rent, and told him the words of Rabshakeh.

scribe and Maaseiah <u>14\_2CH\_26\_11</u> # Moreover Uzziah had an host of fighting men, that went out to war by bands, according to the number of their account by the hand of Jeiel the scribe and Maaseiah the ruler, under the hand of Hananiah, [one] of the king's captains.

scribe and the <u>23\_ISA\_37\_02</u> # And he sent Eliakim, who [was] over the household, and Shebna the scribe, and the elders of the priests covered with sackcloth, unto Isaiah the prophet the son of Amoz.

scribe and the <u>16\_NEH\_08\_09</u> # And Nehemiah, which [is] the Tirshatha, and Ezra the priest the scribe, and the Levites that taught the people, said unto all the people, This day [is] holy unto the LORD your God; mourn not, nor weep. For all the people wept, when they heard the words of the law.

scribe and their <u>15\_EZR\_04\_23</u> # Now when the copy of king Artaxerxes' letter [was] read before Rehum, and Shimshai the scribe, and their companions, they went up in haste to Jerusalem unto the Jews, and made them to cease by force and power.

scribe and to <u>15\_EZR\_04\_17</u> # [Then] sent the king an answer unto Rehum the chancellor, and [to] Shimshai the scribe, and [to] the rest of their companions that dwell in Samaria, and [unto] the rest beyond the river, Peace, and at such a time.

scribe came and <u>40\_MAT\_08\_19</u># And a certain scribe came, and said unto him, Master, I will follow thee whithersoever thou goest.

scribe came to <u>12\_2KI\_22\_09</u> # And Shaphan the scribe came to the king, and brought the king word again, and said, Thy servants have gathered the money that was found in the house, and have delivered it into the hand of them that do the work, that have the oversight of the house of the LORD.

scribe even a <u>15\_EZR\_07\_11</u># Now this [is] the copy of the letter that the king Artaxerxes gave unto Ezra the priest, the scribe, [even] a scribe of the words of the commandments of the LORD, and of his statutes to Israel.

scribe even to <u>16\_NEH\_08\_13</u> # And on the second day were gathered together the chief of the fathers of all the people, the priests, and the Levites, unto Ezra the scribe, even to understand the words of the law.

scribe for they <u>24\_JER\_37\_15</u> # Wherefore the princes were wroth with Jeremiah, and smote him, and put him in prison in the house of Jonathan the scribe: for they had made that the prison.

scribe I have <u>14\_2CH\_34\_15</u># And Hilkiah answered and said to Shaphan the scribe, I have found the book of the law in the house of the LORD. And Hilkiah delivered the book to Shaphan.

scribe in the <u>24\_JER\_36\_10</u># Then read Baruch in the book the words of Jeremiah in the house of the LORD, in the chamber of Gemariah the son of Shaphan the scribe, in the higher court, at the entry of the new gate of the LORD'S house, in the ears of all the people.

scribe lest I <u>24\_JER\_37\_20</u># Therefore hear now, I pray thee, O my lord the king: let my supplication, I pray thee, be accepted before thee; that thou cause me not to return to the house of Jonathan the scribe, lest I die there.

scribe of the <u>12\_2KI\_25\_19</u># And out of the city he took an officer that was set over the men of war, and five men of them that were in the king's presence, which were found in the city, and the principal scribe of the host, which mustered the people of the land, and threescore men of the people of the land [that were] found in the city:

scribe of the <u>15\_EZR\_07\_11</u># Now this [is] the copy of the letter that the king Artaxerxes gave unto Ezra the priest, the scribe, [even] a scribe of the words of the commandments of the LORD, and of his statutes to Israel.

scribe of the <u>24\_JER\_52\_25</u> # He took also out of the city an eunuch, which had the charge of the men of war; and seven men of them that were near the king's person, which were found in the city; and the principal scribe of the host, who mustered the people of the land; and threescore men of the people of the land, that were found in the midst of the city.

scribe one of <u>13\_1CH\_24\_06</u> # And Shemaiah the son of Nethaneel the scribe, [one] of the Levites, wrote them before the king, and the princes, and Zadok the priest, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, and [before] the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites: one principal household being taken for Eleazar, and [one] taken for Ithamar.

scribe said unto <u>41\_MAR\_12\_32</u> # And the scribe said unto him, Well, Master, thou hast said the truth: for there is one God; and there is none other but he:

scribe showed the <u>12\_2KI\_22\_10</u> # And Shaphan the scribe showed the king, saying, Hilkiah the priest hath delivered me a book. And Shaphan read it before the king.

scribe stood upon <u>16\_NEH\_08\_04</u># And Ezra the scribe stood upon a pulpit of wood, which they had made for the purpose; and beside him stood Mattithiah, and Shema, and Anaiah, and Urijah, and Hilkiah, and Maaseiah, on his right hand; and on his left hand, Pedaiah, and Mishael, and Malchiah, and Hashum, and Hashbadana, Zechariah, [and] Meshullam. scribe the son <u>24\_JER\_36\_32</u> # Then took Jeremiah another roll, and gave it to Baruch the scribe, the son of Neriah; who wrote therein from the mouth of Jeremiah all the words of the book which Jehoiakim king of Judah had burned in the fire: and there were added besides unto them many like words.

scribe to bring <u>16\_NEH\_08\_01</u> # And all the people gathered themselves together as one man into the street that [was] before the water gate; and they spake unto Ezra the scribe to bring the book of the law of Moses, which the LORD had commanded to Israel.

scribe to the <u>12\_2KI\_22\_03</u># And it came to pass in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [that] the king sent Shaphan the son of Azaliah, the son of Meshullam, the scribe, to the house of the LORD, saying,

scribe where is <u>23\_ISA\_33\_18</u># Thine heart shall meditate terror. Where [is] the scribe? where [is] the receiver? where [is] he that counted the towers?

scribe which is <u>40\_MAT\_13\_52</u># Then said he unto them, Therefore every scribe [which is] instructed unto the kingdom of heaven is like unto a man [that is] an householder, which bringeth forth out of his treasure [things] new and old.

scribe wrote a <u>15\_EZR\_04\_08</u># Rehum the chancellor and Shimshai the scribe wrote a letter against Jerusalem to Artaxerxes the king in this sort:

scribe <u>13\_1CH\_18\_16</u># And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Abimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Shavsha was scribe;

scribe <u>10\_2SA\_08\_17</u> # And Zadok the son of Ahitub, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, [were] the priests; and Seraiah [was] the scribe;

scribe <u>16\_NEH\_12\_26</u># These [were] in the days of Joiakim the son of Jeshua, the son of Jozadak, and in the days of Nehemiah the governor, and of Ezra the priest, the scribe.

scribe's chamber and <u>24\_JER\_36\_12</u> # Then he went down into the king's house, into the scribe's chamber: and, lo, all the princes sat there, [even] Elishama the scribe, and Delaiah the son of Shemaiah, and Elnathan the son of Achbor, and Gemariah the son of Shaphan, and Zedekiah the son of Hananiah, and all the princes.

scribe's chamber And <u>24\_JER\_36\_21</u> # So the king sent Jehudi to fetch the roll: and he took it out of Elishama the scribe's chamber. And Jehudi read it in the ears of the king, and in the ears of all the princes which stood beside the king.

scribes and be <u>42\_LUK\_09\_22</u> # Saying, The Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be slain, and be raised the third day.

scribes and be <u>41\_MAR\_08\_31</u> # And he began to teach them, that the Son of man must suffer many things, and be rejected of the elders, and [of] the chief priests, and scribes, and be killed, and after three days rise again.

scribes and be <u>40\_MAT\_16\_21</u># From that time forth began Jesus to show unto his disciples, how that he must go unto Jerusalem, and suffer many things of the elders and chief priests and scribes, and be killed,

and be raised again the third day.

scribes and came <u>44\_ACT\_06\_12</u># And they stirred up the people, and the elders, and the scribes, and came upon [him], and caught him, and brought [him] to the council,

scribes and chief <u>41\_MAR\_11\_18</u># And the scribes and chief priests heard [it], and sought how they might destroy him: for they feared him, because all the people was astonished at his doctrine.

scribes and elders <u>40\_MAT\_27\_41</u># Likewise also the chief priests mocking [him], with the scribes and elders, said,

scribes and of <u>40\_MAT\_12\_38</u># Then certain of the scribes and of the Pharisees answered, saying, Master, we would see a sign from thee.

scribes and officers <u>14\_2CH\_34\_13</u> # Also [they were] over the bearers of burdens, and [were] overseers of all that wrought the work in any manner of service: and of the Levites [there were] scribes, and officers, and porters.

scribes and Pharisees <u>43\_JOH\_08\_03</u> # And the scribes and Pharisees brought unto him a woman taken in adultery; and when they had set her in the midst,

scribes and Pharisees <u>42\_LUK\_05\_30</u> # But their scribes and Pharisees murmured against his disciples, saying, Why do ye eat and drink with publicans and sinners?

scribes and Pharisees <u>42\_LUK\_06\_07</u> # And the scribes and Pharisees watched him, whether he would heal on the sabbath day; that they might find an accusation against him.

scribes and Pharisees <u>42\_LUK\_11\_44</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are as graves which appear not, and the men that walk over [them] are not aware [of them].

scribes and Pharisees <u>41 MAR\_02\_16</u> # And when the scribes and Pharisees saw him eat with publicans and sinners, they said unto his disciples, How is it that he eateth and drinketh with publicans and sinners?

scribes and Pharisees <u>40\_MAT\_05\_20</u># For I say unto you, That except your righteousness shall exceed [the righteousness] of the scribes and Pharisees, ye shall in no case enter into the kingdom of heaven.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40\_MAT\_15\_01</u># Then came to Jesus scribes and Pharisees, which were of Jerusalem, saying,

scribes and Pharisees <u>40\_MAT\_23\_13</u># But woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye shut up the kingdom of heaven against men: for ye neither go in [yourselves], neither suffer ye them that are entering to go in.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40\_MAT\_23\_14</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40\_MAT\_23\_15</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye compass sea and land to make one proselyte, and when he is made, ye make him twofold more the child of hell than yourselves.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40\_MAT\_23\_23</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye pay tithe of mint and anise and cummin, and have omitted the weightier [matters] of the law, judgment, mercy, and faith: these ought ye to have done, and not to leave the other undone.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40\_MAT\_23\_25</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye make clean

the outside of the cup and of the platter, but within they are full of extortion and excess.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40\_MAT\_23\_27</u> # Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye are like unto whited sepulchres, which indeed appear beautiful outward, but are within full of dead [men's] bones, and of all uncleanness.

scribes and Pharisees <u>40\_MAT\_23\_29</u># Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! because ye build the tombs of the prophets, and garnish the sepulchres of the righteous,

scribes and some <u>40\_MAT\_23\_34</u># Wherefore, behold, I send unto you prophets, and wise men, and scribes: and [some] of them ye shall kill and crucify; and [some] of them shall ye scourge in your synagogues, and persecute [them] from city to city:

scribes and the <u>42\_LUK\_05\_21</u># And the scribes and the Pharisees began to reason, saying, Who is this which speaketh blasphemies? Who can forgive sins, but God alone?

scribes and the <u>42\_LUK\_11\_53</u> # And as he said these things unto them, the scribes and the Pharisees began to urge [him] vehemently, and to provoke him to speak of many things:

scribes and the <u>42\_LUK\_19\_47</u> # And he taught daily in the temple. But the chief priests and the scribes and the chief of the people sought to destroy him,

scribes and the <u>41\_MAR\_14\_43</u># And immediately, while he yet spake, cometh Judas, one of the twelve, and with him a great multitude with swords and staves, from the chief priests and the scribes and the elders.

scribes and the <u>41\_MAR\_15\_01</u> # And straightway in the morning the chief priests held a consultation with the elders and scribes and the whole council, and bound Jesus, and carried [him] away, and delivered [him] to Pilate.

scribes and the <u>40\_MAT\_23\_02</u># Saying, The scribes and the Pharisees sit in Moses' seat:

scribes and the <u>40\_MAT\_26\_03</u># Then assembled together the chief priests, and the scribes, and the elders of the people, unto the palace of the high priest, who was called Caiaphas,

scribes and the <u>40\_MAT\_26\_57</u># And they that had laid hold on Jesus led [him] away to Caiaphas the high priest, where the scribes and the elders were assembled.

scribes and they <u>40\_MAT\_20\_18</u># Behold, we go up to Jerusalem; and the Son of man shall be betrayed unto the chief priests and unto the scribes, and they shall condemn him to death,

scribes answering said <u>42\_LUK\_20\_39</u># Then certain of the scribes answering said, Master, thou hast well said.

scribes asked him <u>41\_MAR\_07\_05</u># Then the Pharisees and scribes asked him, Why walk not thy disciples according to the tradition of the elders, but eat bread with unwashen hands?

scribes called at <u>17\_EST\_08\_09</u> # Then were the king's scribes called at that time in the third month, that

[is], the month Sivan, on the three and twentieth [day] thereof; and it was written according to all that Mordecai commanded unto the Jews, and to the lieutenants, and the deputies and rulers of the provinces which [are] from India unto Ethiopia, an hundred twenty and seven provinces, unto every province according to the writing thereof, and unto every people after their language, and to the Jews according to their writing, and according to their language.

scribes called on <u>17\_EST\_03\_12</u><sup>#</sup> Then were the king's scribes called on the thirteenth day of the first month, and there was written according to all that Haman had commanded unto the king's lieutenants, and to the governors that [were] over every province, and to the rulers of every people of every province according to the writing thereof, and [to] every people after their language; in the name of king Ahasuerus was it written, and sealed with the king's ring.

scribes came and <u>41\_MAR\_12\_28</u># And one of the scribes came, and having heard them reasoning together, and perceiving that he had answered them well, asked him, Which is the first commandment of all?

scribes came together <u>42\_LUK\_22\_66</u> # And as soon as it was day, the elders of the people and the chief priests and the scribes came together, and led him into their council, saying,

scribes came upon <u>42\_LUK\_20\_01</u> # And it came to pass, [that] on one of those days, as he taught the people in the temple, and preached the gospel, the chief priests and the scribes came upon [him] with the elders,

scribes He saved <u>41\_MAR\_15\_31</u># Likewise also the chief priests mocking said among themselves with the scribes, He saved others; himself he cannot save.

scribes is in 24\_JER\_08\_08 # How do ye say, We [are] wise, and the law of the LORD [is] with us? Lo, certainly in vain made he [it]; the pen of the scribes [is] in vain.

scribes Jehoshaphat the <u>11\_1KI\_04\_03</u># Elihoreph and Ahiah, the sons of Shisha, scribes; Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud, the recorder.

scribes murmured saying <u>42\_LUK\_15\_02</u># And the Pharisees and scribes murmured, saying, This man receiveth sinners, and eateth with them.

scribes of the <u>40\_MAT\_02\_04</u># And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he demanded of them where Christ should be born.

scribes questioning with <u>41\_MAR\_09\_14</u># And when he came to [his] disciples, he saw a great multitude about them, and the scribes questioning with them.

scribes said within <u>40\_MAT\_09\_03</u># And, behold, certain of the scribes said within themselves, This [man] blasphemeth.

scribes saw the <u>40\_MAT\_21\_15</u># And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased,

scribes sitting there <u>41\_MAR\_02\_06</u># But there were certain of the scribes sitting there, and reasoning in their hearts,

scribes sought how <u>42\_LUK\_22\_02</u> # And the chief priests and scribes sought how they might kill him; for they feared the people.

scribes sought how <u>41\_MAR\_14\_01</u> # After two days was [the feast of] the passover, and of unleavened

bread: and the chief priests and the scribes sought how they might take him by craft, and put [him] to death.

scribes stood and <u>42\_LUK\_23\_10</u># And the chief priests and scribes stood and vehemently accused him.

scribes that Christ <u>41\_MAR\_12\_35</u> # And Jesus answered and said, while he taught in the temple, How say the scribes that Christ is the son of David?

scribes that Elias <u>41\_MAR\_09\_11</u># And they asked him, saying, Why say the scribes that Elias must first come?

scribes that Elias <u>40\_MAT\_17\_10</u># And his disciples asked him, saying, Why then say the scribes that Elias must first come?

scribes that were <u>44\_ACT\_23\_09</u> # And there arose a great cry: and the scribes [that were] of the Pharisees' part arose, and strove, saying, We find no evil in this man: but if a spirit or an angel hath spoken to him, let us not fight against God.

scribes the same <u>42\_LUK\_20\_19</u> # And the chief priests and the scribes the same hour sought to lay hands on him; and they feared the people: for they perceived that he had spoken this parable against them.

scribes What question <u>41\_MAR\_09\_16</u># And he asked the scribes, What question ye with them?

scribes which came <u>41\_MAR\_03\_22</u> # And the scribes which came down from Jerusalem said, He hath Beelzebub, and by the prince of the devils casteth he out devils.

scribes which came <u>41\_MAR\_07\_01</u># Then came together unto him the Pharisees, and certain of the scribes, which came from Jerusalem.

scribes which desire <u>42\_LUK\_20\_46</u># Beware of the scribes, which desire to walk in long robes, and love greetings in the markets, and the highest seats in the synagogues, and the chief rooms at feasts;

scribes which dwelt <u>13\_1CH\_02\_55</u> # And the families of the scribes which dwelt at Jabez; the Tirathites, the Shimeathites, [and] Suchathites. These [are] the Kenites that came of Hemath, the father of the house of Rechab.

scribes which love <u>41\_MAR\_12\_38</u># And he said unto them in his doctrine, Beware of the scribes, which love to go in long clothing, and [love] salutations in the marketplaces,

scribes <u>44\_ACT\_04\_05</u> # And it came to pass on the morrow, that their rulers, and elders, and scribes,

scribes <u>41\_MAR\_01\_22</u> # And they were astonished at his doctrine: for he taught them as one that had authority, and not as the scribes.

scribes <u>41\_MAR\_14\_53</u> # And they led Jesus away to the high priest: and with him were assembled all the chief priests and the elders and the scribes.

scribes <u>40\_MAT\_07\_29</u># For he taught them as [one] having authority, and not as the scribes.

subscribe evidences and 24\_JER\_32\_44 # Men shall buy fields for money, and subscribe evidences, and seal [them], and take witnesses in the land of Benjamin, and in the places about Jerusalem, and in the cities of Judah, and in the cities of the mountains, and in the cities of the valley, and in the cities of the south: for I will cause their captivity to return, saith the LORD.

subscribe with his 23\_ISA\_44\_05 # One shall say, I [am] the LORD's; and another shall call [himself] by

the name of Jacob; and another shall subscribe [with] his hand unto the LORD, and surname [himself] by the name of Israel.

subscribed the book 24\_JER\_32\_12 # And I gave the evidence of the purchase unto Baruch the son of Neriah, the son of Maaseiah, in the sight of Hanameel mine uncle's [son], and in the presence of the witnesses that subscribed the book of the purchase, before all the Jews that sat in the court of the prison.

subscribed the evidence <u>24\_JER\_32\_10</u> # And I subscribed the evidence, and sealed [it], and took witnesses, and weighed [him] the money in the balances.
