curses in a 04_NUM_05_23 \# And the priest shall write these curses in a book, and he shall blot [them] out with the bitter water:
curses of the $05 \_$DEU_29_21 \# And the LORD shall separate him unto evil out of all the tribes of Israel, according to all the curses of the covenant that are written in this book of the law:
curses shall come 05 _DEU_28_15 \# But it shall come to pass, if thou wilt not hearken unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to observe to do all his commandments and his statutes which I command thee this day; that all these curses shall come upon thee, and overtake thee:
curses shall come 05 DEU_28_45 \# Moreover all these curses shall come upon thee, and shall pursue thee, and overtake thee, till thou be destroyed; because thou hearkenedst not unto the voice of the LORD thy God, to keep his commandments and his statutes which he commanded thee:
curses that are $14 \_2 \mathrm{CH} \_34 \_24$ \# Thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will bring evil upon this place, and upon the inhabitants thereof, [even] all the curses that are written in the book which they have read before the king of Judah:
curses that are 05_DEU_29_20 \# The LORD will not spare him, but then the anger of the LORD and his jealousy shall smoke against that man, and all the curses that are written in this book shall lie upon him, and the LORD shall blot out his name from under heaven.
curses that are 05_DEU_29_27 \# And the anger of the LORD was kindled against this land, to bring upon it all the curses that are written in this book:
curses upon thine 05_DEU_30_07 \# And the LORD thy God will put all these curses upon thine enemies, and on them that hate thee, which persecuted thee.
cursest is cursed 04_NUM_22_06\# Come now therefore, I pray thee, curse me this people; for they [are] too mighty for me: peradventure I shall prevail, [that] we may smite them, and [that] I may drive them out of the land: for $I$ wot that he whom thou blessest [is] blessed, and he whom thou cursest is cursed.
