

KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Damascus about noon 44_ACT_22_06 # And it came to pass, that, as I made my journey, and was come nigh unto Damascus about noon, suddenly there shone from heaven a great light round about me.

Damascus and at <u>44_ACT_26_20</u># But showed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and [then] to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance.

Damascus and Benhadad 12_2KI_08_07 # And Elisha came to Damascus; and Benhadad the king of Syria was sick; and it was told him, saying, The man of God is come hither.

Damascus and cut <u>30_AMO_01_05</u># I will break also the bar of Damascus, and cut off the inhabitant from the plain of Aven, and him that holdeth the sceptre from the house of Eden: and the people of Syria shall go into captivity unto Kir, saith the LORD.

Damascus and dwelt <u>11_1KI_11_24</u># And he gathered men unto him, and became captain over a band, when David slew them [of Zobah]: and they went to Damascus, and dwelt therein, and reigned in Damascus.

Damascus and for 30_AMO_01_03 # Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Damascus, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they have threshed Gilead with threshing instruments of iron:

Damascus and from <u>26_EZE_47_18</u># And the east side ye shall measure from Hauran, and from Damascus, and from Gilead, and from the land of Israel [by] Jordan, from the border unto the east sea. And [this is] the east side.

Damascus and Hamath 12 2KI 14 28 # Now the rest of the acts of Jeroboam, and all that he did, and his might, how he warred, and how he recovered Damascus, and Hamath, [which belonged] to Judah, for Israel, are they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Israel?

Damascus And he 14_2CH_28_05 # Wherefore the LORD his God delivered him into the hand of the king of Syria; and they smote him, and carried away a great multitude of them captives, and brought [them] to Damascus. And he was also delivered into the hand of the king of Israel, who smote him with a great slaughter.

Damascus and it <u>24_JER_49_27</u> # And I will kindle a fire in the wall of Damascus, and it shall consume the palaces of Benhadad.

Damascus and king 12_2KI_16_10 # And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that [was] at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.

Damascus and suddenly 44_ACT_09_03 # And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven:

Damascus and the <u>10_2SA_08_06</u> # Then David put garrisons in Syria of Damascus: and the Syrians became servants to David, [and] brought gifts. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

Damascus and the <u>26_EZE_47_16</u># Hamath, Berothah, Sibraim, which [is] between the border of Damascus and the border of Hamath; Hazarhatticon, which [is] by the coast of Hauran.

Damascus and the <u>26_EZE_47_17</u># And the border from the sea shall be Hazarenan, the border of Damascus, and the north northward, and the border of Hamath. And [this is] the north side.

Damascus and the <u>23_ISA_07_08</u> # For the head of Syria [is] Damascus, and the head of Damascus [is] Rezin; and within threescore and five years shall Ephraim be broken, that it be not a people.

Damascus and the <u>23_ISA_08_04</u># For before the child shall have knowledge to cry, My father, and my mother, the riches of Damascus and the spoil of Samaria shall be taken away before the king of Assyria.

Damascus and the <u>23_ISA_17_03</u># The fortress also shall cease from Ephraim, and the kingdom from Damascus, and the remnant of Syria: they shall be as the glory of the children of Israel, saith the LORD of hosts.

Damascus and there 44_ACT_22_10 # And I said, What shall I do, Lord? And the Lord said unto me, Arise, and go into Damascus; and there it shall be told thee of all things which are appointed for thee to do.

Damascus and took 12_2KI_16_09 # And the king of Assyria hearkened unto him: for the king of Assyria went up against Damascus, and took it, and carried [the people of] it captive to Kir, and slew Rezin.

Damascus and when <u>11_1KI_19_15</u># And the LORD said unto him, Go, return on thy way to the wilderness of Damascus: and when thou comest, anoint Hazael [to be] king over Syria:

Damascus as my 11_1KI_20_34# And [Benhadad] said unto him, The cities, which my father took from thy father, I will restore; and thou shalt make streets for thee in Damascus, as my father made in Samaria. Then [said Ahab], I will send thee away with this covenant. So he made a covenant with him, and sent him away.

Damascus Behold Damascus <u>23_ISA_17_01</u> # The burden of Damascus. Behold, Damascus is taken away from [being] a city, and it shall be a ruinous heap.

Damascus better than 12_2KI_05_12 # [Are] not Abana and Pharpar, rivers of Damascus, better than all the waters of Israel? may I not wash in them, and be clean? So he turned and went away in a rage.

Damascus came to <u>13_1CH_18_05</u> # And when the Syrians of Damascus came to help Hadarezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men.

Damascus came to <u>10_2SA_08_05</u> # And when the Syrians of Damascus came to succour Hadadezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men.

Damascus forty camels' <u>12_2KI_08_09</u># So Hazael went to meet him, and took a present with him, even of every good thing of Damascus, forty camels' burden, and came and stood before him, and said, Thy son Benhadad king of Syria hath sent me to thee, saying, Shall I recover of this disease?

Damascus Hamath is <u>24_JER_49_23</u> # Concerning Damascus. Hamath is confounded, and Arpad: for they have heard evil tidings: they are fainthearted; [there is] sorrow on the sea; it cannot be quiet.

Damascus in a <u>30_AMO_03_12</u> # Thus saith the LORD; As the shepherd taketh out of the mouth of the lion two legs, or a piece of an ear; so shall the children of Israel be taken out that dwell in Samaria in the corner of a bed, and in Damascus [in] a couch.

Damascus in the 44_ACT_09_27 # But Barnabas took him, and brought [him] to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached

boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.

Damascus is Rezin <u>23_ISA_07_08</u> # For the head of Syria [is] Damascus, and the head of Damascus [is] Rezin; and within threescore and five years shall Ephraim be broken, that it be not a people.

Damascus is taken 23 ISA 17_01 # The burden of Damascus. Behold, Damascus is taken away from [being] a city, and it shall be a ruinous heap.

Damascus is waxed 24_JER_49_24 # Damascus is waxed feeble, [and] turneth herself to flee, and fear hath seized on [her]: anguish and sorrows have taken her, as a woman in travail.

Damascus named Ananias <u>44_ACT_09_10</u> # And there was a certain disciple at Damascus, named Ananias; and to him said the Lord in a vision, Ananias. And he said, Behold, I [am here], Lord.

Damascus northward to <u>26_EZE_48_01</u> # Now these [are] the names of the tribes. From the north end to the coast of the way of Hethlon, as one goeth to Hamath, Hazarenan, the border of Damascus northward, to the coast of Hamath; for these are his sides east [and] west; a [portion for] Dan.

Damascus proving that <u>44_ACT_09_22</u># But Saul increased the more in strength, and confounded the Jews which dwelt at Damascus, proving that this is very Christ.

Damascus saith the <u>30_AMO_05_27</u># Therefore will I cause you to go into captivity beyond Damascus, saith the LORD, whose name [is] The God of hosts.

Damascus saying 11_1KI_15_18# Then Asa took all the silver and the gold [that were] left in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, and delivered them into the hand of his servants: and king Asa sent them to Benhadad, the son of Tabrimon, the son of Hezion, king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

Damascus saying 14_2CH_16_02 # Then As a brought out silver and gold out of the treasures of the house of the LORD and of the king's house, and sent to Benhadad king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

Damascus shall be <u>38_ZEC_09_01</u> # The burden of the word of the LORD in the land of Hadrach, and Damascus [shall be] the rest thereof: when the eyes of man, as of all the tribes of Israel, [shall be] toward the LORD.

Damascus so Urijah 12_2KI_16_11 # And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made [it] against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Damascus the governor <u>47_2CO_11_32</u># In Damascus the governor under Aretas the king kept the city of the Damascenes with a garrison, desirous to apprehend me:

Damascus the king 12_2KI_16_12 # And when the king was come from Damascus, the king saw the altar: and the king approached to the altar, and offered thereon.

Damascus to bring 44_ACT_22_05 # As also the high priest doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the brethren, and went to Damascus, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.

Damascus to meet 12 2KI 16 10 # And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that [was] at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.

Damascus to the <u>44_ACT_09_02</u># And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem.

Damascus was thy <u>26_EZE_27_18</u># Damascus [was] thy merchant in the multitude of the wares of thy making, for the multitude of all riches; in the wine of Helbon, and white wool.

Damascus which smote <u>14_2CH_28_23</u># For he sacrificed unto the gods of Damascus, which smote him: and he said, Because the gods of the kings of Syria help them, [therefore] will I sacrifice to them, that they may help me. But they were the ruin of him, and of all Israel.

Damascus with authority 44_ACT_26_12 # Whereupon as I went to Damascus with authority and commission from the chief priests,

Damascus 11_1KI_11_24# And he gathered men unto him, and became captain over a band, when David slew them [of Zobah]: and they went to Damascus, and dwelt therein, and reigned in Damascus.

Damascus 14_2CH_24_23 # And it came to pass at the end of the year, [that] the host of Syria came up against him: and they came to Judah and Jerusalem, and destroyed all the princes of the people from among the people, and sent all the spoil of them unto the king of Damascus.

Damascus 12_2KI_16_11 # And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made [it] against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Damascus 44_ACT_09_08 # And Saul arose from the earth; and when his eyes were opened, he saw no man: but they led him by the hand, and brought [him] into Damascus.

Damascus <u>44_ACT_09_19</u> # And when he had received meat, he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus.

Damascus <u>44_ACT_22_11</u># And when I could not see for the glory of that light, being led by the hand of them that were with me, I came into Damascus.

Damascus <u>48_GAL_01_17</u> # Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus.

Damascus <u>01_GEN_14_15</u> # And he divided himself against them, he and his servants, by night, and smote them, and pursued them unto Hobah, which [is] on the left hand of Damascus.

Damascus <u>01_GEN_15_02</u> # And Abram said, Lord GOD, what wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house [is] this Eliezer of Damascus?

Damascus 23_ISA_10_09 # [Is] not Calno as Carchemish? [is] not Hamath as Arpad? [is] not Samaria as Damascus?

Damascus 22_SON_07_04 # Thy neck [is] as a tower of ivory; thine eyes [like] the fishpools in Heshbon, by the gate of Bathrabbim: thy nose [is] as the tower of Lebanon which looketh toward Damascus.

Syriadamascus and the 18_06 # Then David put [garrisons] in Syriadamascus; and the Syrians became David's servants, [and] brought gifts. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.
