Abidan the son <u>04_NUM_01_11</u># Of Benjamin; Abidan the son of Gideoni.

Abidan the son <u>04_NUM_02_22</u># Then the tribe of Benjamin: and the captain of the sons of Benjamin [shall be] Abidan the son of Gideoni.

Abidan the son <u>04_NUM_07_60</u># On the ninth day Abidan the son of Gideoni, prince of the children of Benjamin, [offered]:

Abidan the son <u>04_NUM_07_65</u> # And for a sacrifice of peace offerings, two oxen, five rams, five he goats, five lambs of the first year: this [was] the offering of Abidan the son of Gideoni.

Abidan the son <u>04_NUM_10_24</u> # And over the host of the tribe of the children of Benjamin [was] Abidan the son of Gideoni.

abundance according to <u>17_EST_01_07</u> # And they gave [them] drink in vessels of gold, [the vessels being diverse one from another,] and royal wine in abundance, according to the state of the king.

abundance also may <u>47_2CO_08_14</u> # But by an equality, [that] now at this time your abundance [may be a supply] for their want, that their abundance also may be [a supply] for your want: that there may be equality:

abundance and for <u>14_2CH_18_02</u> # And after [certain] years he went down to Ahab to Samaria. And Ahab killed sheep and oxen for him in abundance, and for the people that [he had] with him, and persuaded him to go up [with him] to Ramothgilead.

abundance and hath <u>11_1KI_01_19</u># And he hath slain oxen and fat cattle and sheep in abundance, and hath called all the sons of the king, and Abiathar the priest, and Joab the captain of the host: but Solomon thy servant hath he not called.

abundance and joined <u>14_2CH_18_01</u> # Now Jehoshaphat had riches and honour in abundance, and joined affinity with Ahab.

abundance and precious <u>14_2CH_09_01</u># And when the queen of Sheba heard of the fame of Solomon, she came to prove Solomon with hard questions at Jerusalem, with a very great company, and camels that bare spices, and gold in abundance, and precious stones: and when she was come to Solomon, she communed with him of all that was in her heart.

abundance and precious <u>14_2CH_09_09</u> # And she gave the king an hundred and twenty talents of gold, and of spices great abundance, and precious stones: neither was there any such spice as the queen of Sheba gave king Solomon.

abundance and returned <u>14_2CH_14_15</u># They smote also the tents of cattle, and carried away sheep and camels in abundance, and returned to Jerusalem.

abundance both riches <u>14_2CH_20_25</u> # And when Jehoshaphat and his people came to take away the spoil of them, they found among them in abundance both riches with the dead bodies, and precious jewels, which they stripped off for themselves, more than they could carry away: and they were three days in gathering of the spoil, it was so much.

abundance but from <u>40_MAT_25_29</u># For unto every one that hath shall be given, and he shall have abundance: but from him that hath not shall be taken away even that which he hath.

abundance but whosoever <u>40_MAT_13_12</u># For whosoever hath, to him shall be given, and he shall have more abundance: but whosoever hath not, from him shall be taken away even that he hath.

abundance cast in <u>42_LUK_21_04</u># For all these have of their abundance cast in unto the offerings of God: but she of her penury hath cast in all the living that she had.

abundance for all <u>13_1CH_29_21</u># And they sacrificed sacrifices unto the LORD, and offered burnt offerings unto the LORD, on the morrow after that day, [even] a thousand bullocks, a thousand rams, [and] a thousand lambs, with their drink offerings, and sacrifices in abundance for all Israel:

abundance for God <u>14_2CH_32_29</u> # Moreover he provided him cities, and possessions of flocks and herds in abundance: for God had given him substance very much.

abundance for the <u>14_2CH_04_18</u># Thus Solomon made all these vessels in great abundance: for the weight of the brass could not be found out.

abundance hewers and <u>13_1CH_22_15</u># Moreover [there are] workmen with thee in abundance, hewers and workers of stone and timber, and all manner of cunning men for every manner of work.

abundance in the <u>19_PSA_105_30</u># Their land brought forth frogs in abundance, in the chambers of their kings.

abundance may be <u>47_2CO_08_14</u> # But by an equality, [that] now at this time your abundance [may be a supply] for their want, that their abundance also may be [a supply] for your want: that there may be equality:

abundance of her <u>66_REV_18_03</u> # For all nations have drunk of the wine of the wrath of her fornication, and the kings of the earth have committed fornication with her, and the merchants of the earth are waxed rich through the abundance of her delicacies.

abundance of thine <u>23_ISA_47_09</u># But these two [things] shall come to thee in a moment in one day, the loss of children, and widowhood: they shall come upon thee in their perfection for the multitude of thy sorceries, [and] for the great abundance of thine enchantments.

abundance of waters <u>18_JOB_22_11</u># Or darkness, [that] thou canst not see; and abundance of waters cover thee.

abundant in stripes <u>47_2CO_11_23</u># Are they ministers of Christ? [I speak as a fool] I [am] more; in labours more abundant, in stripes above measure, in prisons more frequent, in deaths oft.

abundant in treasures <u>24_JER_51_13</u> # O thou that dwellest upon many waters, abundant in treasures, thine end is come, [and] the measure of thy covetousness.

abundant mercy hath <u>60_1PE_01_03</u> # Blessed [be] the God and Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, which according to his abundant mercy hath begotten us again unto a lively hope by the resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead,

abundant toward you <u>47_2CO_07_15</u> # And his inward affection is more abundant toward you, whilst he remembereth the obedience of you all, how with fear and trembling ye received him.

abundant with faith <u>54_1TI_01_14</u># And the grace of our Lord was exceeding abundant with faith and love which is in Christ Jesus.

Dan also and <u>26_EZE_27_19</u># Dan also and Javan going to and fro occupied in thy fairs: bright iron, cassia, and calamus, were in thy market.

Dan Ammiel the <u>04_NUM_13_12</u># Of the tribe of Dan, Ammiel the son of Gemalli.

Dan an engraver <u>02_EXO_38_23</u> # And with him [was] Aholiab, son of Ahisamach, of the tribe of Dan, an engraver, and a cunning workman, and an embroiderer in blue, and in purple, and in scarlet, and fine linen.

Dan and Abelbethmaachah <u>11_1KI_15_20</u># So Benhadad hearkened unto king Asa, and sent the captains of the hosts which he had against the cities of Israel, and smote Ijon, and Dan, and Abelbethmaachah, and all Cinneroth, with all the land of Naphtali.

Dan and Naphtali <u>01_GEN_35_25</u> # And the sons of Bilhah, Rachel's handmaid; Dan, and Naphtali:

Dan and out <u>06_JOS_21_05</u># And the rest of the children of Kohath [had] by lot out of the families of the tribe of Ephraim, and out of the tribe of Dan, and out of the half tribe of Manasseh, ten cities.

Dan and publisheth <u>24_JER_04_15</u># For a voice declareth from Dan, and publisheth affliction from mount Ephraim.

Dan And they <u>07_JUD_18_23</u> # And they cried unto the children of Dan. And they turned their faces, and said unto Micah, What aileth thee, that thou comest with such a company?

Dan Azareel the <u>13_1CH_27_22</u># Of Dan, Azareel the son of Jeroham. These [were] the princes of the tribes of Israel.

Dan between Zorah <u>07_JUD_13_25</u># And the spirit of the LORD began to move him at times in the camp of Dan between Zorah and Eshtaol.

Dan Bukki the <u>04_NUM_34_22</u> # And the prince of the tribe of the children of Dan, Bukki the son of Jogli.

Dan by their <u>04_NUM_01_38</u> # Of the children of Dan, by their generations, after their families, by the house of their fathers, according to the number of the names, from twenty years old and upward, all that were able to go forth to war;

Dan Eltekeh with <u>06_JOS_21_23</u> # And out of the tribe of Dan, Eltekeh with her suburbs, Gibbethon with her suburbs,

Dan even to <u>11_1KI_04_25</u># And Judah and Israel dwelt safely, every man under his vine and under his fig tree, from Dan even to Beersheba, all the days of Solomon.

Dan even to <u>09_1SA_03_20</u> # And all Israel from Dan even to Beersheba knew that Samuel [was] established [to be] a prophet of the LORD.

Dan even to <u>10_28A_03_10</u> # To translate the kingdom from the house of Saul, and to set up the throne of David over Israel and over Judah, from Dan even to Beersheba.

Daniel answered with <u>27_DAN_02_14</u># Then Daniel answered with counsel and wisdom to Arioch the captain of the king's guard, which was gone forth to slay the wise [men] of Babylon:

Daniel Art thou <u>27_DAN_05_13</u># Then was Daniel brought in before the king. [And] the king spake and said unto Daniel, [Art] thou that Daniel, which [art] of the children of the captivity of Judah, whom the king my father brought out of Jewry?

Daniel be called <u>27_DAN_05_12</u># Forasmuch as an excellent spirit, and knowledge, and understanding, interpreting of dreams, and showing of hard sentences, and dissolving of doubts, were found in the same Daniel, whom the king named Belteshazzar: now let Daniel be called, and he will show the interpretation.

Daniel before the <u>27_DAN_02_25</u> # Then Arioch brought in Daniel before the king in haste, and said thus unto him, I have found a man of the captives of Judah, that will make known unto the king the interpretation.

Daniel blessed the <u>27_DAN_02_19</u># Then was the secret revealed unto Daniel in a night vision. Then Daniel blessed the God of heaven.

Daniel brought in <u>27_DAN_05_13</u># Then was Daniel brought in before the king. [And] the king spake and said unto Daniel, [Art] thou that Daniel, which [art] of the children of the captivity of Judah, whom the king my father brought out of Jewry?

Daniel came in <u>27_DAN_04_08</u> # But at the last Daniel came in before me, whose name [was] Belteshazzar, according to the name of my god, and in whom [is] the spirit of the holy gods: and before him I told the dream, [saying],

Daniel concerning the <u>27_DAN_06_04</u> # Then the presidents and princes sought to find occasion against Daniel concerning the kingdom; but they could find none occasion nor fault; forasmuch as he [was] faithful, neither was there any error or fault found in him.

Jordan before the <u>07_JUD_12_05</u> # And the Gileadites took the passages of Jordan before the Ephraimites: and it was [so] that when those Ephraimites which were escaped said, Let me go over; that the men of Gilead said unto him, [Art] thou an Ephraimite? If he said, Nay;

Jordan before the <u>04_NUM_32_21</u> # And will go all of you armed over Jordan before the LORD, until he hath driven out his enemies from before him,

Jordan but unto <u>06_JOS_14_03</u> # For Moses had given the inheritance of two tribes and an half tribe on the other side Jordan: but unto the Levites he gave none inheritance among them.

Jordan but ye <u>05_DEU_04_22</u># But I must die in this land, I must not go over Jordan: but ye shall go over, and possess that good land.

Jordan but ye <u>06_JOS_01_14</u> # Your wives, your little ones, and your cattle, shall remain in the land which Moses gave you on this side Jordan; but ye shall pass before your brethren armed, all the mighty men of valour, and help them;

Jordan by Jericho <u>13_1CH_06_78</u># And on the other side Jordan by Jericho, on the east side of Jordan, [were given them] out of the tribe of Reuben, Bezer in the wilderness with her suburbs, and Jahzah with her suburbs,

Jordan by Jericho <u>06_JOS_13_32</u># These [are the countries] which Moses did distribute for inheritance in the plains of Moab, on the other side Jordan, by Jericho, eastward.

Jordan by Jericho <u>06_JOS_16_01</u> # And the lot of the children of Joseph fell from Jordan by Jericho, unto the water of Jericho on the east, to the wilderness that goeth up from Jericho throughout mount Bethel.

Jordan by Jericho <u>06_JOS_20_08</u># And on the other side Jordan by Jericho eastward, they assigned Bezer in the wilderness upon the plain out of the tribe of Reuben, and Ramoth in Gilead out of the tribe of Gad, and Golan in Bashan out of the tribe of Manasseh.

Jordan by Jericho <u>04_NUM_22_01</u># And the children of Israel set forward, and pitched in the plains of Moab on this side Jordan [by] Jericho.

Jordan by the <u>10_2SA_17_22</u> # Then David arose, and all the people that [were] with him, and they passed over Jordan: by the morning light there lacked not one of them that was not gone over Jordan.

Jordan by the <u>05_DEU_11_30</u># [Are] they not on the other side Jordan, by the way where the sun goeth down, in the land of the Canaanites, which dwell in the champaign over against Gilgal, beside the plains of Moreh?

Jordan confessing their <u>41_MAR_01_05</u> # And there went out unto him all the land of Judaea, and they of Jerusalem, and were all baptized of him in the river of Jordan, confessing their sins.

Jordan confessing their <u>40_MAT_03_06</u># And were baptized of him in Jordan, confessing their sins.

Jordan did Joshua <u>06_JOS_04_20</u># And those twelve stones, which they took out of Jordan, did Joshua pitch in Gilgal.

Jordan did the <u>11_1KI_07_46</u># In the plain of Jordan did the king cast them, in the clay ground between Succoth and Zarthan.

Jordan did the <u>14_2CH_04_17</u># In the plain of Jordan did the king cast them, in the clay ground between Succoth and Zeredathah.

Jordan eastward all <u>12_2KI_10_33</u># From Jordan eastward, all the land of Gilead, the Gadites, and the Reubenites, and the Manassites, from Aroer, which [is] by the river Arnon, even Gilead and Bashan.

Jordan eastward even <u>05_DEU_04_49</u># And all the plain on this side Jordan eastward, even unto the sea of the plain, under the springs of Pisgah.

Jordan eastward even <u>06 JOS 13 08</u> # With whom the Reubenites and the Gadites have received their inheritance, which Moses gave them, beyond Jordan eastward, [even] as Moses the servant of the LORD gave them;

Jordan eastward <u>06_JOS_13_27</u># And in the valley, Betharam, and Bethnimrah, and Succoth, and Zaphon, the rest of the kingdom of Sihon king of Heshbon, Jordan and [his] border, [even] unto the edge of the sea of Chinnereth on the other side Jordan eastward.

Jordan eastward <u>04_NUM_32_19</u># For we will not inherit with them on yonder side Jordan, or forward; because our inheritance is fallen to us on this side Jordan eastward.

Jordan even to <u>10_2SA_20_02</u># So every man of Israel went up from after David, [and] followed Sheba the son of Bichri: but the men of Judah clave unto their king, from Jordan even to Jerusalem.

Jordan every man <u>04_NUM_32_29</u> # And Moses said unto them, If the children of Gad and the children of Reuben will pass with you over Jordan, every man armed to battle, before the LORD, and the land shall be subdued before you; then ye shall give them the land of Gilead for a possession:

Jordan from before <u>06_JOS_04_23</u># For the LORD your God dried up the waters of Jordan from before you, until ye were passed over, as the LORD your God did to the Red sea, which he dried up from before us, until we were gone over:

Jordan from before <u>06_JOS_05_01</u># And it came to pass, when all the kings of the Amorites, which [were] on the side of Jordan westward, and all the kings of the Canaanites, which [were] by the sea, heard that the LORD had dried up the waters of Jordan from before the children of Israel, until we were passed over, that their heart melted, neither was there spirit in them any more, because of the children of Israel.

Jordan from Bethjesimoth <u>04_NUM_33_49</u> # And they pitched by Jordan, from Bethjesimoth [even] unto Abelshittim in the plains of Moab.

Jordan from the <u>05_DEU_03_08</u># And we took at that time out of the hand of the two kings of the Amorites the land that [was] on this side Jordan, from the river of Arnon unto mount Hermon;

Jordan from the <u>26_EZE_47_18</u># And the east side ye shall measure from Hauran, and from Damascus, and from Gilead, and from the land of Israel [by] Jordan, from the border unto the east sea. And [this is] the east side.

Jordan Galilee of <u>40_MAT_04_15</u># The land of Zabulon, and the land of Nephthalim, [by] the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles;

Jordan he and <u>10_2SA_17_24</u># Then David came to Mahanaim. And Absalom passed over Jordan, he and all the men of Israel with him.

Jordan he and <u>06_JOS_03_01</u> # And Joshua rose early in the morning; and they removed from Shittim, and came to Jordan, he and all the children of Israel, and lodged there before they passed over.

Jordan in Galilee 23_ISA_09_01 # Nevertheless the dimness [shall] not [be] such as [was] in her vexation, when at the first he lightly afflicted the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, and afterward did more

grievously afflict [her by] the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, in Galilee of the nations.

Jordan in the <u>13_1CH_12_15</u># These [are] they that went over Jordan in the first month, when it had overflown all his banks; and they put to flight all [them] of the valleys, [both] toward the east, and toward the west.

Jordan in the <u>05_DEU_01_01</u># These [be] the words which Moses spake unto all Israel on this side Jordan in the wilderness, in the plain over against the Red [sea], between Paran, and Tophel, and Laban, and Hazeroth, and Dizahab.

Jordan in the <u>05_DEU_01_05</u># On this side Jordan, in the land of Moab, began Moses to declare this law, saying,

Jordan in the <u>05_DEU_04_46</u> # On this side Jordan, in the valley over against Bethpeor, in the land of Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt at Heshbon, whom Moses and the children of Israel smote, after they were come forth out of Egypt:

Jordan in the <u>06_JOS_04_09</u> # And Joshua set up twelve stones in the midst of Jordan, in the place where the feet of the priests which bare the ark of the covenant stood: and they are there unto this day.

Jordan in the <u>06_JOS_09_01</u># And it came to pass, when all the kings which [were] on this side Jordan, in the hills, and in the valleys, and in all the coasts of the great sea over against Lebanon, the Hittite, and the Amorite, the Canaanite, the Perizzite, the Hivite, and the Jebusite, heard [thereof];

Jordan in the <u>07_JUD_10_08</u># And that year they vexed and oppressed the children of Israel: eighteen years, all the children of Israel that [were] on the other side Jordan in the land of the Amorites, which [is] in Gilead.

Jordan into his <u>18_JOB_40_23</u># Behold, he drinketh up a river, [and] hasteth not: he trusteth that he can draw up Jordan into his mouth.

Jordan into the <u>05_DEU_02_29</u> # [As the children of Esau which dwell in Seir, and the Moabites which dwell in Ar, did unto me;] until I shall pass over Jordan into the land which the LORD our God giveth us.

Jordan into the <u>43_JOH_10_40</u># And went away again beyond Jordan into the place where John at first baptized; and there he abode.

Jordan into the <u>04_NUM_33_51</u># Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye are passed over Jordan into the land of Canaan;

Jordan into the <u>04_NUM_35_10</u># Speak unto the children of Israel, and say unto them, When ye be come over Jordan into the land of Canaan;

Jordan is spoiled <u>38_ZEC_11_03</u># [There is] a voice of the howling of the shepherds; for their glory is spoiled: a voice of the roaring of young lions; for the pride of Jordan is spoiled.

Jordan may be <u>04_NUM_32_32</u> # We will pass over armed before the LORD into the land of Canaan, that the possession of our inheritance on this side Jordan [may be] ours.

Jordan near Jericho <u>04_NUM_26_03</u> # And Moses and Eleazar the priest spake with them in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho, saying,

Jordan near Jericho <u>04_NUM_26_63</u># These [are] they that were numbered by Moses and Eleazar the priest, who numbered the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho.

Jordan near Jericho <u>04_NUM_31_12</u> # And they brought the captives, and the prey, and the spoil, unto Moses, and Eleazar the priest, and unto the congregation of the children of Israel, unto the camp at the plains of Moab, which [are] by Jordan [near] Jericho.

Jordan near Jericho <u>04_NUM_33_48</u> # And they departed from the mountains of Abarim, and pitched in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho.

Jordan near Jericho <u>04_NUM_33_50</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho, saying,

Jordan near Jericho <u>04_NUM_34_15</u># The two tribes and the half tribe have received their inheritance on this side Jordan [near] Jericho eastward, toward the sunrising.

Jordan near Jericho <u>04_NUM_35_01</u> # And the LORD spake unto Moses in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho, saying,

Jordan near Jericho <u>04_NUM_36_13</u> # These [are] the commandments and the judgments, which the LORD commanded by the hand of Moses unto the children of Israel in the plains of Moab by Jordan [near] Jericho.

Jordan now therefore <u>07_JUD_11_13</u># And the king of the children of Ammon answered unto the messengers of Jephthah, Because Israel took away my land, when they came up out of Egypt, from Arnon even unto Jabbok, and unto Jordan: now therefore restore those [lands] again peaceably.

Jordan of the <u>13_1CH_12_37</u> # And on the other side of Jordan, of the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and of the half tribe of Manasseh, with all manner of instruments of war for the battle, an hundred and twenty thousand.

Jordan on dry <u>06_JOS_04_22</u># Then ye shall let your children know, saying, Israel came over this Jordan on dry land.

Jordan on the <u>06_JOS_04_19</u> # And the people came up out of Jordan on the tenth [day] of the first month, and encamped in Gilgal, in the east border of Jericho.

Jordan on the <u>06_JOS_12_07</u> # And these [are] the kings of the country which Joshua and the children of Israel smote on this side Jordan on the west, from Baalgad in the valley of Lebanon even unto the mount Halak, that goeth up to Seir; which Joshua gave unto the tribes of Israel [for] a possession according to their divisions;

Jordan on the <u>06_JOS_18_07</u> # But the Levites have no part among you; for the priesthood of the LORD [is] their inheritance: and Gad, and Reuben, and half the tribe of Manasseh, have received their inheritance beyond Jordan on the east, which Moses the servant of the LORD gave them.

Jordan or forward <u>04_NUM_32_19</u> # For we will not inherit with them on yonder side Jordan, or forward; because our inheritance is fallen to us on this side Jordan eastward.

Jordan out of <u>06_JOS_04_03</u># And command ye them, saying, Take you hence out of the midst of Jordan, out of the place where the priests' feet stood firm, twelve stones, and ye shall carry them over with you, and leave them in the lodging place, where ye shall lodge this night.

Jordan overfloweth all <u>06_JOS_03_15</u># And as they that bare the ark were come unto Jordan, and the feet of the priests that bare the ark were dipped in the brim of the water, [for Jordan overfloweth all his banks all the time of harvest,]

Jordan preaching the <u>42_LUK_03_03</u> # And he came into all the country about Jordan, preaching the

baptism of repentance for the remission of sins;

Jordan returned unto <u>06_JOS_04_18</u># And it came to pass, when the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD were come up out of the midst of Jordan, [and] the soles of the priests' feet were lifted up unto the dry land, that the waters of Jordan returned unto their place, and flowed over all his banks, as [they did] before.

Jordan saw that <u>09 1SA 31 07</u> # And when the men of Israel that [were] on the other side of the valley, and [they] that [were] on the other side Jordan, saw that the men of Israel fled, and that Saul and his sons were dead, they forsook the cities, and fled; and the Philistines came and dwelt in them.

Jordan seven times <u>12_2KI_05_10</u># And Elisha sent a messenger unto him, saying, Go and wash in Jordan seven times, and thy flesh shall come again to thee, and thou shalt be clean.

Jordan shall be <u>06_JOS_03_13</u> # And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of Jordan, [that] the waters of Jordan shall be cut off [from] the waters that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap.

Jordan Sihon and <u>06_JOS_02_10</u># For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt; and what ye did unto the two kings of the Amorites, that [were] on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed.

Jordan Simeon and <u>05_DEU_27_12</u># These shall stand upon mount Gerizim to bless the people, when ye are come over Jordan; Simeon, and Levi, and Judah, and Issachar, and Joseph, and Benjamin:

Jordan sixteen cities <u>06_JOS_19_22</u> # And the coast reacheth to Tabor, and Shahazimah, and Bethshemesh; and the outgoings of their border were at Jordan: sixteen cities with their villages.

Jordan that are <u>06_JOS_22_10</u># And when they came unto the borders of Jordan, that [are] in the land of Canaan, the children of Reuben and the children of Gad and the half tribe of Manasseh built there an altar by Jordan, a great altar to see to.

Jordan that goodly <u>05_DEU_03_25</u># I pray thee, let me go over, and see the good land that [is] beyond Jordan, that goodly mountain, and Lebanon.

Jordan that it <u>01_GEN_13_10</u> # And Lot lifted up his eyes, and beheld all the plain of Jordan, that it [was] well watered every where, before the LORD destroyed Sodom and Gomorrah, [even] as the garden of the LORD, like the land of Egypt, as thou comest unto Zoar.

Jordan that the <u>06_JOS_03_13</u> # And it shall come to pass, as soon as the soles of the feet of the priests that bear the ark of the LORD, the Lord of all the earth, shall rest in the waters of Jordan, [that] the waters of Jordan shall be cut off [from] the waters that come down from above; and they shall stand upon an heap.

Jordan that the <u>06_JOS_04_01</u># And it came to pass, when all the people were clean passed over Jordan, that the LORD spake unto Joshua, saying,

Jordan that thou <u>19_PSA_114_05</u># What [ailed] thee, O thou sea, that thou fleddest? thou Jordan, [that] thou wast driven back?

Jordan that ye <u>05_DEU_27_04</u> # Therefore it shall be when ye be gone over Jordan, [that] ye shall set up these stones, which I command you this day, in mount Ebal, and thou shalt plaster them with plaster.

Jordan the waters <u>06_JOS_04_07</u> # Then ye shall answer them, That the waters of Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD; when it passed over Jordan, the waters of Jordan were cut off: and these stones shall be for a memorial unto the children of Israel for ever.

Jordan Then all <u>07_JUD_07_24</u># And Gideon sent messengers throughout all mount Ephraim, saying, Come down against the Midianites, and take before them the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan. Then all the men of Ephraim gathered themselves together, and took the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan.

Jordan they cut <u>12_2KI_06_04</u># So he went with them. And when they came to Jordan, they cut down wood.

Jordan this day <u>05_DEU_09_01</u># Hear, O Israel: Thou [art] to pass over Jordan this day, to go in to possess nations greater and mightier than thyself, cities great and fenced up to heaven,

Jordan this was <u>06_JOS_18_19</u> # And the border passed along to the side of Bethhoglah northward: and the outgoings of the border were at the north bay of the salt sea at the south end of Jordan: this [was] the south coast.

Jordan thou and <u>06_JOS_01_02</u># Moses my servant is dead; now therefore arise, go over this Jordan, thou, and all this people, unto the land which I do give to them, [even] to the children of Israel.

Jordan to deliver <u>06_JOS_07_07</u> # And Joshua said, Alas, O Lord GOD, wherefore hast thou at all brought this people over Jordan, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us? would to God we had been content, and dwelt on the other side Jordan!

Jordan to fight <u>07_JUD_10_09</u> # Moreover the children of Ammon passed over Jordan to fight also against Judah, and against Benjamin, and against the house of Ephraim; so that Israel was sore distressed.

Jordan to go <u>05_DEU_11_31</u># For ye shall pass over Jordan to go in to possess the land which the LORD your God giveth you, and ye shall possess it, and dwell therein.

Jordan to go <u>05_DEU_30_18</u> # I denounce unto you this day, that ye shall surely perish, [and that] ye shall not prolong [your] days upon the land, whither thou passest over Jordan to go to possess it.

Jordan to go <u>06_JOS_01_11</u># Pass through the host, and command the people, saying, Prepare you victuals; for within three days ye shall pass over this Jordan, to go in to possess the land, which the LORD your God giveth you to possess it.

Jordan to possess <u>05_DEU_04_26</u> # I call heaven and earth to witness against you this day, that ye shall soon utterly perish from off the land whereunto ye go over Jordan to possess it; ye shall not prolong [your] days upon it, but shall utterly be destroyed.

Jordan to possess <u>05_DEU_31_13</u> # And [that] their children, which have not known [any thing], may hear, and learn to fear the LORD your God, as long as ye live in the land whither ye go over Jordan to possess it.

Jordan to possess <u>05_DEU_32_47</u> # For it [is] not a vain thing for you; because it [is] your life: and through this thing ye shall prolong [your] days in the land, whither ye go over Jordan to possess it.

Jordan to Sihon <u>06_JOS_09_10</u> # And all that he did to the two kings of the Amorites, that [were] beyond Jordan, to Sihon king of Heshbon, and to Og king of Bashan, which [was] at Ashtaroth.

Jordan to the <u>09_1SA_13_07</u> # And [some of] the Hebrews went over Jordan to the land of Gad and Gilead. As for Saul, he [was] yet in Gilgal, and all the people followed him trembling.

Jordan to whom <u>43_JOH_03_26</u> # And they came unto John, and said unto him, Rabbi, he that was with thee beyond Jordan, to whom thou barest witness, behold, the same baptizeth, and all [men] come to him.

Jordan toward Moab <u>07_JUD_03_28</u> # And he said unto them, Follow after me: for the LORD hath

delivered your enemies the Moabites into your hand. And they went down after him, and took the fords of Jordan toward Moab, and suffered not a man to pass over.

Jordan toward the <u>05_DEU_04_41</u># Then Moses severed three cities on this side Jordan toward the sun rising;

Jordan toward the <u>05_DEU_04_47</u> # And they possessed his land, and the land of Og king of Bashan, two kings of the Amorites, which [were] on this side Jordan toward the sun rising;

Jordan toward the <u>06_JOS_01_15</u># Until the LORD have given your brethren rest, as [he hath given] you, and they also have possessed the land which the LORD your God giveth them: then ye shall return unto the land of your possession, and enjoy it, which Moses the LORD'S servant gave you on this side Jordan toward the sunrising.

Jordan toward the <u>06_JOS_12_01</u># Now these [are] the kings of the land, which the children of Israel smote, and possessed their land on the other side Jordan toward the rising of the sun, from the river Arnon unto mount Hermon, and all the plain on the east:

Jordan toward the <u>06_JOS_19_34</u># And [then] the coast turneth westward to Aznothtabor, and goeth out from thence to Hukkok, and reacheth to Zebulun on the south side, and reacheth to Asher on the west side, and to Judah upon Jordan toward the sunrising.

Jordan until every <u>06_JOS_04_10</u># For the priests which bare the ark stood in the midst of Jordan, until every thing was finished that the LORD commanded Joshua to speak unto the people, according to all that Moses commanded Joshua: and the people hasted and passed over.

Jordan unto John <u>40_MAT_03_13</u># Then cometh Jesus from Galilee to Jordan unto John, to be baptized of him.

Jordan unto the <u>05_DEU_27_02</u> # And it shall be on the day when ye shall pass over Jordan unto the land which the LORD thy God giveth thee, that thou shalt set thee up great stones, and plaster them with plaster:

Jordan unto the <u>24_JER_50_44</u> # Behold, he shall come up like a lion from the swelling of Jordan unto the habitation of the strong: but I will make them suddenly run away from her: and who [is] a chosen [man, that] I may appoint over her? for who [is] like me? and who will appoint me the time? and who [is] that shepherd that will stand before me?

Jordan unto the <u>06_JOS_02_07</u> # And the men pursued after them the way to Jordan unto the fords: and as soon as they which pursued after them were gone out, they shut the gate.

Jordan was driven <u>19_PSA_114_03</u># The sea saw [it], and fled: Jordan was driven back.

Jordan was the <u>06_JOS_18_20</u> # And Jordan was the border of it on the east side. This [was] the inheritance of the children of Benjamin, by the coasts thereof round about, according to their families.

Jordan were cut <u>06_JOS_04_07</u> # Then ye shall answer them, That the waters of Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD; when it passed over Jordan, the waters of Jordan were cut off: and these stones shall be for a memorial unto the children of Israel for ever.

Jordan were cut <u>06_JOS_04_07</u> # Then ye shall answer them, That the waters of Jordan were cut off before the ark of the covenant of the LORD; when it passed over Jordan, the waters of Jordan were cut off: and these stones shall be for a memorial unto the children of Israel for ever.

Jordan were given <u>13_1CH_06_78</u> # And on the other side Jordan by Jericho, on the east side of Jordan,

[were given them] out of the tribe of Reuben, Bezer in the wilderness with her suburbs, and Jahzah with her suburbs,

Jordan westward and <u>06_JOS_05_01</u> # And it came to pass, when all the kings of the Amorites, which [were] on the side of Jordan westward, and all the kings of the Canaanites, which [were] by the sea, heard that the LORD had dried up the waters of Jordan from before the children of Israel, until we were passed over, that their heart melted, neither was there spirit in them any more, because of the children of Israel.

Jordan westward And <u>06_JOS_22_07</u> # Now to the [one] half of the tribe of Manasseh Moses had given [possession] in Bashan: but unto the [other] half thereof gave Joshua among their brethren on this side Jordan westward. And when Joshua sent them away also unto their tents, then he blessed them,

Jordan westward in <u>13_1CH_26_30</u> # [And] of the Hebronites, Hashabiah and his brethren, men of valour, a thousand and seven hundred, [were] officers among them of Israel on this side Jordan westward in all the business of the LORD, and in the service of the king.

Jordan where John <u>43_JOH_01_28</u># These things were done in Bethabara beyond Jordan, where John was baptizing.

Jordan with all <u>06_JOS_23_04</u># Behold, I have divided unto you by lot these nations that remain, to be an inheritance for your tribes, from Jordan, with all the nations that I have cut off, even unto the great sea westward.

Jordan with the <u>10_2SA_19_31</u> # And Barzillai the Gileadite came down from Rogelim, and went over Jordan with the king, to conduct him over Jordan.

Jordan with the <u>10_2SA_19_36</u> # Thy servant will go a little way over Jordan with the king: and why should the king recompense it me with such a reward?

Jordan ye shall <u>06_JOS_03_08</u> # And thou shalt command the priests that bear the ark of the covenant, saying, When ye are come to the brink of the water of Jordan, ye shall stand still in Jordan.

Jordan <u>11_1KI_17_03</u># Get thee hence, and turn thee eastward, and hide thyself by the brook Cherith, that [is] before Jordan.

Jordan <u>11_1KI_17_05</u># So he went and did according unto the word of the LORD: for he went and dwelt by the brook Cherith, that [is] before Jordan.

Jordan <u>12_2KI_02_07</u> # And fifty men of the sons of the prophets went, and stood to view afar off: and they two stood by Jordan.

Jordan <u>12_2KI_02_13</u># He took up also the mantle of Elijah that fell from him, and went back, and stood by the bank of Jordan;

Jordan <u>10_2SA_17_22</u> # Then David arose, and all the people that [were] with him, and they passed over Jordan: by the morning light there lacked not one of them that was not gone over Jordan.

Jordan <u>10_2SA_19_15</u># So the king returned, and came to Jordan. And Judah came to Gilgal, to go to meet the king, to conduct the king over Jordan.

Jordan <u>10_2SA_19_18</u> # And there went over a ferry boat to carry over the king's household, and to do what he thought good. And Shimei the son of Gera fell down before the king, as he was come over Jordan;

Jordan <u>10_2SA_19_31</u> # And Barzillai the Gileadite came down from Rogelim, and went over Jordan with the king, to conduct him over Jordan.

Jordan <u>10_2SA_19_41</u> # And, behold, all the men of Israel came to the king, and said unto the king, Why have our brethren the men of Judah stolen thee away, and have brought the king, and his household, and all David's men with him, over Jordan?

Jordan <u>05 DEU 03 27</u># Get thee up into the top of Pisgah, and lift up thine eyes westward, and northward, and southward, and eastward, and behold [it] with thine eyes: for thou shalt not go over this Jordan.

Jordan <u>05_DEU_31_02</u> # And he said unto them, I [am] an hundred and twenty years old this day; I can no more go out and come in: also the LORD hath said unto me, Thou shalt not go over this Jordan.

Jordan <u>01_GEN_50_11</u># And when the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites, saw the mourning in the floor of Atad, they said, This [is] a grievous mourning to the Egyptians: wherefore the name of it was called Abelmizraim, which [is] beyond Jordan.

Jordan <u>24_JER_12_05</u> # If thou hast run with the footmen, and they have wearied thee, then how canst thou contend with horses? and [if] in the land of peace, [wherein] thou trustedst, [they wearied thee], then how wilt thou do in the swelling of Jordan?

Jordan <u>06_JOS_03_08</u> # And thou shalt command the priests that bear the ark of the covenant, saying, When ye are come to the brink of the water of Jordan, ye shall stand still in Jordan.

Jordan <u>06_JOS_03_11</u># Behold, the ark of the covenant of the LORD of all the earth passeth over before you into Jordan.

Jordan <u>06_JOS_03_17</u> # And the priests that bare the ark of the covenant of the LORD stood firm on dry ground in the midst of Jordan, and all the Israelites passed over on dry ground, until all the people were passed clean over Jordan.

Jordan <u>06_JOS_04_16</u># Command the priests that bear the ark of the testimony, that they come up out of Jordan.

Jordan <u>06_JOS_04_17</u> # Joshua therefore commanded the priests, saying, Come ye up out of Jordan.

Jordan <u>06_JOS_07_07</u> # And Joshua said, Alas, O Lord GOD, wherefore hast thou at all brought this people over Jordan, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us? would to God we had been content, and dwelt on the other side Jordan!

Jordan <u>06_JOS_15_05</u> # And the east border [was] the salt sea, [even] unto the end of Jordan. And [their] border in the north quarter [was] from the bay of the sea at the uttermost part of Jordan:

Jordan <u>06_JOS_16_07</u># And it went down from Janohah to Ataroth, and to Naarath, and came to Jericho, and went out at Jordan.

Jordan <u>06_JOS_17_05</u> # And there fell ten portions to Manasseh, beside the land of Gilead and Bashan, which [were] on the other side Jordan;

Jordan <u>06_JOS_19_33</u> # And their coast was from Heleph, from Allon to Zaanannim, and Adami, Nekeb, and Jabneel, unto Lakum; and the outgoings thereof were at Jordan:

Jordan <u>06_JOS_22_04</u> # And now the LORD your God hath given rest unto your brethren, as he promised them: therefore now return ye, and get you unto your tents, [and] unto the land of your possession, which Moses the servant of the LORD gave you on the other side Jordan.

Jordan <u>07_JUD_07_24</u> # And Gideon sent messengers throughout all mount Ephraim, saying, Come down against the Midianites, and take before them the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan. Then all the men of Ephraim gathered themselves together, and took the waters unto Bethbarah and Jordan.

Jordan <u>07_JUD_07_25</u> # And they took two princes of the Midianites, Oreb and Zeeb; and they slew Oreb upon the rock Oreb, and Zeeb they slew at the winepress of Zeeb, and pursued Midian, and brought the heads of Oreb and Zeeb to Gideon on the other side Jordan.

Jordan <u>07_JUD_11_22</u># And they possessed all the coasts of the Amorites, from Arnon even unto Jabbok, and from the wilderness even unto Jordan.

Jordan <u>41_MAR_01_09</u># And it came to pass in those days, that Jesus came from Nazareth of Galilee, and was baptized of John in Jordan.

Jordan <u>40_MAT_03_05</u># Then went out to him Jerusalem, and all Judaea, and all the region round about Jordan,

Jordan <u>40_MAT_04_25</u># And there followed him great multitudes of people from Galilee, and [from] Decapolis, and [from] Jerusalem, and [from] Judaea, and [from] beyond Jordan.

Jordan <u>40_MAT_19_01</u># And it came to pass, [that] when Jesus had finished these sayings, he departed from Galilee, and came into the coasts of Judaea beyond Jordan;

Jordan <u>04_NUM_13_29</u># The Amalekites dwell in the land of the south: and the Hittites, and the Jebusites, and the Amorites, dwell in the mountains: and the Canaanites dwell by the sea, and by the coast of Jordan.

Jordan <u>04_NUM_32_05</u> # Wherefore, said they, if we have found grace in thy sight, let this land be given unto thy servants for a possession, [and] bring us not over Jordan.

Laadan and Shimei <u>13_1CH_23_07</u> # Of the Gershonites [were], Laadan, and Shimei.

Laadan chief fathers <u>13_1CH_26_21</u> # [As concerning] the sons of Laadan; the sons of the Gershonite Laadan, chief fathers, [even] of Laadan the Gershonite, [were] Jehieli.

Laadan his son <u>13_1CH_07_26</u> # Laadan his son, Ammihud his son, Elishama his son,

Laadan the chief <u>13_1CH_23_08</u> # The sons of Laadan; the chief [was] Jehiel, and Zetham, and Joel, three.

Laadan the Gershonite <u>13_1CH_26_21</u> # [As concerning] the sons of Laadan; the sons of the Gershonite Laadan, chief fathers, [even] of Laadan the Gershonite, [were] Jehieli.

Laadan the sons <u>13_1CH_26_21</u> # [As concerning] the sons of Laadan; the sons of the Gershonite Laadan, chief fathers, [even] of Laadan the Gershonite, [were] Jehieli.

Laadan <u>13_1CH_23_09</u># The sons of Shimei; Shelomith, and Haziel, and Haran, three. These [were] the chief of the fathers of Laadan.

Mahanehdan unto this <u>07_JUD_18_12</u># And they went up, and pitched in Kirjathjearim, in Judah: wherefore they called that place Mahanehdan unto this day: behold, [it is] behind Kirjathjearim.

Medan and Midian <u>13_1CH_01_32</u> # Now the sons of Keturah, Abraham's concubine: she bare Zimran, and Jokshan, and Medan, and Midian, and Ishbak, and Shuah. And the sons of Jokshan; Sheba, and Dedan.

Medan and Midian <u>01_GEN_25_02</u> # And she bare him Zimran, and Jokshan, and Medan, and Midian,

Merodachbaladan the son <u>23_ISA_39_01</u> # At that time Merodachbaladan, the son of Baladan, king of Babylon, sent letters and a present to Hezekiah: for he had heard that he had been sick, and was recovered.

Nebuzaradan captain of <u>12_2KI_25_08</u># And in the fifth month, on the seventh [day] of the month, which [is] the nineteenth year of king Nebuchadnezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, a servant of the king of Babylon, unto Jerusalem:

Nebuzaradan captain of <u>12_2KI_25_20</u># And Nebuzaradan captain of the guard took these, and brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah:

Nebuzaradan captain of <u>24_JER_52_12</u> # Now in the fifth month, in the tenth [day] of the month, which [was] the nineteenth year of Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon, came Nebuzaradan, captain of the guard, [which] served the king of Babylon, into Jerusalem,

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>12_2KI_25_11</u># Now the rest of the people [that were] left in the city, and the fugitives that fell away to the king of Babylon, with the remnant of the multitude, did Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carry away.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_39_09</u># Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive into Babylon the remnant of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to him, with the rest of the people that remained.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_39_10</u># But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left of the poor of the people, which had nothing, in the land of Judah, and gave them vineyards and fields at the same time.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_39_11</u># Now Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon gave charge concerning Jeremiah to Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard, saying,

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_39_13</u> # So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard sent, and Nebushasban, Rabsaris, and Nergalsharezer, Rabmag, and all the king of Babylon's princes;

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_40_01</u> # The word that came to Jeremiah from the LORD, after that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had let him go from Ramah, when he had taken him being bound in chains among all that were carried away captive of Jerusalem and Judah, which were carried away captive unto Babylon.

Nebuzaradan the captain 24_JER_41_10 # Then Ishmael carried away captive all the residue of the people that [were] in Mizpah, [even] the king's daughters, and all the people that remained in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had committed to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam: and Ishmael the son of Nethaniah carried them away captive, and departed to go over to the Ammonites.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_43_06</u> # [Even] men, and women, and children, and the king's daughters, and every person that Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had left with Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, and Jeremiah the prophet, and Baruch the son of Neriah.

Nebuzaradan the captain 24_JER_52_15 # Then Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive [certain] of the poor of the people, and the residue of the people that remained in the city, and those that fell away, that fell to the king of Babylon, and the rest of the multitude.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_52_16</u> # But Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard left [certain] of the poor of the land for vinedressers and for husbandmen.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_52_26</u># So Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard took them, and

brought them to the king of Babylon to Riblah.

Nebuzaradan the captain <u>24_JER_52_30</u> # In the three and twentieth year of Nebuchadrezzar Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carried away captive of the Jews seven hundred forty and five persons: all the persons [were] four thousand and six hundred.

Padan Rachel died <u>01_GEN_48_07</u> # And as for me, when I came from Padan, Rachel died by me in the land of Canaan in the way, when yet [there was] but a little way to come unto Ephrath: and I buried her there in the way of Ephrath; the same [is] Bethlehem.

Padanaram and blessed <u>01_GEN_35_09</u># And God appeared unto Jacob again, when he came out of Padanaram, and blessed him.

Padanaram and pitched <u>01_GEN_33_18</u># And Jacob came to Shalem, a city of Shechem, which [is] in the land of Canaan, when he came from Padanaram; and pitched his tent before the city.

Padanaram for to <u>01_GEN_31_18</u># And he carried away all his cattle, and all his goods which he had gotten, the cattle of his getting, which he had gotten in Padanaram, for to go to Isaac his father in the land of Canaan.

Padanaram the sister <u>01_GEN_25_20</u> # And Isaac was forty years old when he took Rebekah to wife, the daughter of Bethuel the Syrian of Padanaram, the sister to Laban the Syrian.

Padanaram to take <u>01_GEN_28_06</u> # When Esau saw that Isaac had blessed Jacob, and sent him away to Padanaram, to take him a wife from thence; and that as he blessed him he gave him a charge, saying, Thou shalt not take a wife of the daughters of Canaan;

Padanaram to the <u>01_GEN_28_02</u># Arise, go to Padanaram, to the house of Bethuel thy mother's father; and take thee a wife from thence of the daughters of Laban thy mother's brother.

Padanaram unto Laban <u>01_GEN_28_05</u> # And Isaac sent away Jacob: and he went to Padanaram unto Laban, son of Bethuel the Syrian, the brother of Rebekah, Jacob's and Esau's mother.

Padanaram with his <u>01_GEN_46_15</u># These [be] the sons of Leah, which she bare unto Jacob in Padanaram, with his daughter Dinah: all the souls of his sons and his daughters [were] thirty and three.

Padanaram <u>01_GEN_28_07</u># And that Jacob obeyed his father and his mother, and was gone to Padanaram;

Padanaram <u>01_GEN_35_26</u># And the sons of Zilpah, Leah's handmaid; Gad, and Asher: these [are] the sons of Jacob, which were born to him in Padanaram.

riddance of all <u>36_ZEP_01_18</u># Neither their silver nor their gold shall be able to deliver them in the day of the LORD'S wrath; but the whole land shall be devoured by the fire of his jealousy: for he shall make even a speedy riddance of all them that dwell in the land.

riddance of the <u>03_LEV_23_22</u># And when ye reap the harvest of your land, thou shalt not make clean riddance of the corners of thy field when thou reapest, neither shalt thou gather any gleaning of thy harvest: thou shalt leave them unto the poor, and to the stranger: I [am] the LORD your God.
