David A Prayer <u>19_PSA_142_01</u> # Maschil of David; A Prayer when he was in the cave. I cried unto the LORD with my voice; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my supplication.

David a prince <u>26_EZE_34_24</u> # And I the LORD will be their God, and my servant David a prince among them; I the LORD have spoken [it].

David a righteous <u>24_JER_23_05</u> # Behold, the days come, saith the LORD, that I will raise unto David a righteous Branch, and a King shall reign and prosper, and shall execute judgment and justice in the earth.

David a Saviour <u>42_LUK_02_11</u># For unto you is born this day in the city of David a Saviour, which is Christ the Lord.

David a wise <u>11_1KI_05_07</u> # And it came to pass, when Hiram heard the words of Solomon, that he rejoiced greatly, and said, Blessed [be] the LORD this day, which hath given unto David a wise son over this great people.

David Abide not <u>09_1SA_22_05</u># And the prophet Gad said unto David, Abide not in the hold; depart, and get thee into the land of Judah. Then David departed, and came into the forest of Hareth.

David abode in <u>09_1SA_23_14</u> # And David abode in the wilderness in strong holds, and remained in a mountain in the wilderness of Ziph. And Saul sought him every day, but God delivered him not into his hand.

David abode in <u>09_1SA_23_18</u># And they two made a covenant before the LORD: and David abode in the wood, and Jonathan went to his house.

David abode in <u>09_1SA_26_03</u># And Saul pitched in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] before Jeshimon, by the way. But David abode in the wilderness, and he saw that Saul came after him into the wilderness.

David about four <u>09_1SA_25_13</u> # And David said unto his men, Gird ye on every man his sword. And they girded on every man his sword; and David also girded on his sword: and there went up after David about four hundred men; and two hundred abode by the stuff.

David according to <u>10_2SA_24_19</u> # And David, according to the saying of Gad, went up as the LORD commanded.

David according to <u>45_ROM_01_03</u># Concerning his Son Jesus Christ our Lord, which was made of the seed of David according to the flesh;

David after he <u>44_ACT_13_36</u># For David, after he had served his own generation by the will of God, fell on sleep, and was laid unto his fathers, and saw corruption:

David against the <u>13_1CH_12_21</u> # And they helped David against the band [of the rovers]: for they [were] all mighty men of valour, and were captains in the host.

David against them <u>10_2SA_24_01</u> # And again the anger of the LORD was kindled against Israel, and he moved David against them to say, Go, number Israel and Judah.

David all that <u>10_2SA_11_22</u># So the messenger went, and came and showed David all that Joab had sent him for.

David all the <u>10_2SA_11_18</u># Then Joab sent and told David all the things concerning the war;

David also and <u>58_HEB_11_32</u># And what shall I more say? for the time would fail me to tell of Gedeon, and [of] Barak, and [of] Samson, and [of] Jephthae; [of] David also, and Samuel, and [of] the prophets:

David also arose <u>09_1SA_24_08</u># David also arose afterward, and went out of the cave, and cried after Saul, saying, My lord the king. And when Saul looked behind him, David stooped with his face to the earth, and bowed himself.

David also girded <u>09_1SA_25_13</u># And David said unto his men, Gird ye on every man his sword. And they girded on every man his sword; and David also girded on his sword: and there went up after David about four hundred men; and two hundred abode by the stuff.

David also had <u>13_1CH_15_27</u> # And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.

David also his <u>19_PSA_78_70</u> # He chose David also his servant, and took him from the sheepfolds:

David also hocked <u>13_1CH_18_04</u># And David took from him a thousand chariots, and seven thousand horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: David also hocked all the chariot [horses], but reserved of them an hundred chariots.

David also took <u>09_1SA_25_43</u># David also took Ahinoam of Jezreel; and they were also both of them his wives.

David Am I <u>09_1SA_17_43</u> # And the Philistine said unto David, [Am] I a dog, that thou comest to me with staves? And the Philistine cursed David by his gods.

David among the <u>14_2CH_24_16</u># And they buried him in the city of David among the kings, because he had done good in Israel, both toward God, and toward his house.

David an house <u>10_2SA_05_11</u> # And Hiram king of Tyre sent messengers to David, and cedar trees, and carpenters, and masons: and they built David an house.

David and a <u>09_1SA_20_35</u> # And it came to pass in the morning, that Jonathan went out into the field at the time appointed with David, and a little lad with him.

David and Abijah <u>14_2CH_12_16</u># And Rehoboam slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David: and Abijah his son reigned in his stead.

David and Abishai <u>09_18A_26_07</u># So David and Abishai came to the people by night: and, behold, Saul lay sleeping within the trench, and his spear stuck in the ground at his bolster: but Abner and the people lay round about him.

David and all <u>13_1CH_11_04</u># And David and all Israel went to Jerusalem, which [is] Jebus; where the Jebusites [were], the inhabitants of the land.

David and all <u>13_1CH_13_08</u> # And David and all Israel played before God with all [their] might, and with singing, and with harps, and with psalteries, and with timbrels, and with cymbals, and with trumpets.

David and all <u>13_1CH_20_03</u> # And he brought out the people that [were] in it, and cut [them] with saws, and with harrows of iron, and with axes. Even so dealt David with all the cities of the children of Ammon. And David and all the people returned to Jerusalem.

David And all <u>13_1CH_21_05</u> # And Joab gave the sum of the number of the people unto David. And all [they of] Israel were a thousand thousand and an hundred thousand men that drew sword: and Judah [was] four hundred threescore and ten thousand men that drew sword.

David and all <u>10_2SA_06_15</u># So David and all the house of Israel brought up the ark of the LORD with shouting, and with the sound of the trumpet.

David and all <u>10_2SA_12_31</u> # And he brought forth the people that [were] therein, and put [them] under saws, and under harrows of iron, and under axes of iron, and made them pass through the brickkiln: and thus did he unto all the cities of the children of Ammon. So David and all the people returned unto Jerusalem.

David and all <u>10_2SA_16_06</u># And he cast stones at David, and at all the servants of king David: and all the people and all the mighty men [were] on his right hand and on his left.

David and all <u>19_PSA_132_01</u> # A Song of degrees. LORD, remember David, [and] all his afflictions:

David and Amaziah <u>12_2KI_12_21</u># For Jozachar the son of Shimeath, and Jehozabad the son of Shomer, his servants, smote him, and he died; and they buried him with his fathers in the city of David: and Amaziah his son reigned in his stead.

David and as <u>14_2CH_21_07</u> # Howbeit the LORD would not destroy the house of David, because of the covenant that he had made with David, and as he promised to give a light to him and to his sons for ever.

David and Asa <u>11_1KI_15_08</u># And Abijam slept with his fathers; and they buried him in the city of David: and Asa his son reigned in his stead.

David and Asa <u>14_2CH_14_01</u> # So Abijah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the city of David:

and Asa his son reigned in his stead. In his days the land was quiet ten years.

David and Joab <u>10_2SA_03_22</u> # And, behold, the servants of David and Joab came from [pursuing] a troop, and brought in a great spoil with them: but Abner [was] not with David in Hebron; for he had sent him away, and he was gone in peace.

David and Jonathan <u>09_1SA_18_01</u> # And it came to pass, when he had made an end of speaking unto Saul, that the soul of Jonathan was knit with the soul of David, and Jonathan loved him as his own soul.

David and ruling <u>24_JER_22_30</u> # Thus saith the LORD, Write ye this man childless, a man [that] shall not prosper in his days: for no man of his seed shall prosper, sitting upon the throne of David, and ruling any more in Judah.

David and said <u>13_1CH_21_11</u># So Gad came to David, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Choose thee

David and said <u>10_2SA_24_18</u> # And Gad came that day to David, and said unto him, Go up, rear an altar unto the LORD in the threshingfloor of Araunah the Jebusite.

David and Samuel <u>13_1CH_09_22</u> # All these [which were] chosen to be porters in the gates [were] two hundred and twelve. These were reckoned by their genealogy in their villages, whom David and Samuel the seer did ordain in their set office.

David and Saul <u>09_1SA_18_29</u> # And Saul was yet the more afraid of David; and Saul became David's enemy continually.

David And Saul <u>09_1SA_24_16</u> # And it came to pass, when David had made an end of speaking these words unto Saul, that Saul said, [Is] this thy voice, my son David? And Saul lifted up his voice, and wept.

David and say <u>11_1KI_01_13</u># Go and get thee in unto king David, and say unto him, Didst not thou, my lord, O king, swear unto thine handmaid, saying, Assuredly Solomon thy son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my throne? why then doth Adonijah reign?

David and so <u>09_1SA_27_11</u># And David saved neither man nor woman alive, to bring [tidings] to Gath, saying, Lest they should tell on us, saying, So did David, and so [will be] his manner all the while he dwelleth in the country of the Philistines.

David and that <u>09_1SA_18_28</u># And Saul saw and knew that the LORD [was] with David, and [that] Michal Saul's daughter loved him.

David and the <u>13_1CH_15_25</u># So David, and the elders of Israel, and the captains over thousands, went to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the house of Obededom with joy.

David and the <u>13_1CH_21_16</u># And David lifted up his eyes, and saw the angel of the LORD stand between the earth and the heaven, having a drawn sword in his hand stretched out over Jerusalem. Then David and the elders [of Israel, who were] clothed in sackcloth, fell upon their faces.

David and the <u>13_1CH_25_01</u># Moreover David and the captains of the host separated to the service of the sons of Asaph, and of Heman, and of Jeduthun, who should prophesy with harps, with psalteries, and with cymbals: and the number of the workmen according to their service was:

David and the <u>09_1SA_17_41</u> # And the Philistine came on and drew near unto David; and the man that bare the shield [went] before him.

David and the <u>09_1SA_30_04</u> # Then David and the people that [were] with him lifted up their voice and wept, until they had no more power to weep.

David and the <u>14_2CH_29_26</u># And the Levites stood with the instruments of David, and the priests with the trumpets.

David and the <u>15_EZR_08_20</u> # Also of the Nethinims, whom David and the princes had appointed for the service of the Levites, two hundred and twenty Nethinims: all of them were expressed by name.

David and the <u>42_LUK_01_27</u> # To a virgin espoused to a man whose name was Joseph, of the house of David; and the virgin's name [was] Mary.

David and the <u>66_REV_22_16</u> # I Jesus have sent mine angel to testify unto you these things in the churches. I am the root and the offspring of David, [and] the bright and morning star.

David and the <u>38_ZEC_12_07</u> # The LORD also shall save the tents of Judah first, that the glory of the house of David and the glory of the inhabitants of Jerusalem do not magnify [themselves] against Judah.

David and the <u>38_ZEC_12_08</u> # In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem; and he that is feeble among them at that day shall be as David; and the house of David [shall be] as God, as the angel of the LORD before them.

David and there <u>10_2SA_18_07</u> # Where the people of Israel were slain before the servants of David, and there was there a great slaughter that day of twenty thousand [men].

David and they <u>09_1SA_18_20</u> # And Michal Saul's daughter loved David: and they told Saul, and the thing pleased him.

David and they <u>12_2KI_17_21</u># For he rent Israel from the house of David; and they made Jeroboam the son of Nebat king: and Jeroboam drave Israel from following the LORD, and made them sin a great sin.

David and timber <u>13_1CH_14_01</u> # Now Hiram king of Tyre sent messengers to David, and timber of cedars, with masons and carpenters, to build him an house.

David and to <u>09_1SA_30_21</u> # And David came to the two hundred men, which were so faint that they could not follow David, whom they had made also to abide at the brook Besor: and they went forth to meet David, and to meet the people that [were] with him: and when David came near to the people, he saluted them.

David and to <u>14_2CH_07_10</u> # And on the three and twentieth day of the seventh month he sent the people away into their tents, glad and merry in heart for the goodness that the LORD had showed unto David, and to Solomon, and to Israel his people.

David and to <u>14_2CH_33_07</u> # And he set a carved image, the idol which he had made, in the house of God, of which God had said to David and to Solomon his son, In this house, and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen before all the tribes of Israel, will I put my name for ever:

David and to <u>12_2KI_21_07</u> # And he set a graven image of the grove that he had made in the house, of which the LORD said to David, and to Solomon his son, In this house, and in Jerusalem, which I have chosen out of all tribes of Israel, will I put my name for ever:

David and to <u>10_2SA_22_51</u> # [He is] the tower of salvation for his king: and showeth mercy to his anointed, unto David, and to his seed for evermore.

David and to <u>16_NEH_03_16</u># After him repaired Nehemiah the son of Azbuk, the ruler of the half part of Bethzur, unto [the place] over against the sepulchres of David, and to the pool that was made, and unto the house of the mighty.

David and to <u>19_PSA_18_50</u># Great deliverance giveth he to his king; and showeth mercy to his anointed, to David, and to his seed for evermore.

David and to <u>38_ZEC_13_01</u> # In that day there shall be a fountain opened to the house of David and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem for sin and for uncleanness.

David and told <u>10_2SA_24_13</u> # So Gad came to David, and told him, and said unto him, Shall seven years of famine come unto thee in thy land? or wilt thou flee three months before thine enemies, while they pursue thee? or that there be three days' pestilence in thy land? now advise, and see what answer I shall return to him that sent me.

David and upon <u>11_1KI_02_33</u># Their blood shall therefore return upon the head of Joab, and upon the head of his seed for ever: but upon David, and upon his seed, and upon his house, and upon his throne, shall there be peace for ever from the LORD.

David and upon 23_ISA_09_07 # Of the increase of [his] government and peace [there shall be] no end, upon the throne of David, and upon his kingdom, to order it, and to establish it with judgment and with justice from henceforth even for ever. The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

David and upon <u>38_ZEC_12_10</u># And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the spirit of grace and of supplications: and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for [his] only [son], and shall be in bitterness for him, as one that is in bitterness for [his] firstborn.

David and Uriah <u>10_2SA_11_17</u># And the men of the city went out, and fought with Joab: and there fell [some] of the people of the servants of David; and Uriah the Hittite died also.

David and we <u>14_2CH_10_16</u> # And when all Israel [saw] that the king would not hearken unto them, the people answered the king, saying, What portion have we in David? and [we have] none inheritance in the son of Jesse: every man to your tents, O Israel: [and] now, David, see to thine own house. So all Israel went to their tents.

David and went <u>13_1CH_21_21</u> # And as David came to Ornan, Ornan looked and saw David, and went out of the threshingfloor, and bowed himself to David with [his] face to the ground.

David and went <u>09_18A_23_28</u># Wherefore Saul returned from pursuing after David, and went against the Philistines: therefore they called that place Selahammahlekoth.

David and when <u>09_1SA_19_20</u> # And Saul sent messengers to take David: and when they saw the company of the prophets prophesying, and Samuel standing [as] appointed over them, the spirit of God was upon the messengers of Saul, and they also prophesied.

David and who <u>09_1SA_25_10</u> # And Nabal answered David's servants, and said, Who [is] David? and who [is] the son of Jesse? there be many servants now a days that break away every man from his master.

David and will <u>11_1KI_11_38</u># And it shall be, if thou wilt hearken unto all that I command thee, and wilt walk in my ways, and do [that is] right in my sight, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as David my servant did; that I will be with thee, and build thee a sure house, as I built for David, and will give Israel unto thee.

David and with <u>10_2SA_16_23</u> # And the counsel of Ahithophel, which he counselled in those days, [was] as if a man had inquired at the oracle of God: so [was] all the counsel of Ahithophel both with David and with Absalom.

David and ye <u>14_2CH_13_08</u># And now ye think to withstand the kingdom of the LORD in the hand of the sons of David; and ye [be] a great multitude, and [there are] with you golden calves, which Jeroboam made you for gods.

David answered and <u>11_1KI_01_28</u># Then king David answered and said, Call me Bathsheba. And she came into the king's presence, and stood before the king.

David answered and <u>09_1SA_26_22</u> # And David answered and said, Behold the king's spear! and let one of the young men come over and fetch it.

David answered I <u>09_1SA_17_58</u> # And Saul said to him, Whose son [art] thou, [thou] young man? And David answered, I [am] the son of thy servant Jesse the Bethlehemite.

David answered Rechab <u>10_2SA_04_09</u> # And David answered Rechab and Baanah his brother, the sons of Rimmon the Beerothite, and said unto them, [As] the LORD liveth, who hath redeemed my soul out of all adversity,

David answered the <u>09_1SA_21_05</u># And David answered the priest, and said unto him, Of a truth women [have been] kept from us about these three days, since I came out, and the vessels of the young men are holy, and [the bread is] in a manner common, yea, though it were sanctified this day in the vessel.

David apart and <u>38_ZEC_12_12</u> # And the land shall mourn, every family apart; the family of the house of David apart, and their wives apart;

David are fourteen <u>40_MAT_01_17</u># So all the generations from Abraham to David [are] fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon [are] fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ [are] fourteen generations.

David Arise and <u>10_2SA_17_21</u># And it came to pass, after they were departed, that they came up out of the well, and went and told king David, and said unto David, Arise, and pass quickly over the water: for thus hath Ahithophel counselled against you.

David arose and <u>09_1SA_26_05</u> # And David arose, and came to the place where Saul had pitched: and David beheld the place where Saul lay, and Abner the son of Ner, the captain of his host: and Saul lay in the trench, and the people pitched round about him.

David arose and <u>09_1SA_27_02</u> # And David arose, and he passed over with the six hundred men that [were] with him unto Achish, the son of Maoch, king of Gath.

David arose and <u>10_2SA_06_02</u> # And David arose, and went with all the people that [were] with him from Baale of Judah, to bring up from thence the ark of God, whose name is called by the name of the LORD of hosts that dwelleth [between] the cherubims.

David arose and <u>10_2SA_17_22</u> # Then David arose, and all the people that [were] with him, and they passed over Jordan: by the morning light there lacked not one of them that was not gone over Jordan.

David arose from <u>10_2SA_11_02</u> # And it came to pass in an eveningtide, that David arose from off his bed, and walked upon the roof of the king's house: and from the roof he saw a woman washing herself; and the woman [was] very beautiful to look upon.

David arose from <u>10_2SA_12_20</u> # Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed [himself], and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.

David arose out <u>09_1SA_20_41</u> # [And] as soon as the lad was gone, David arose out of [a place] toward the south, and fell on his face to the ground, and bowed himself three times: and they kissed one another, and

David assembled all <u>13_1CH_28_01</u> # And David assembled all the princes of Israel, the princes of the tribes, and the captains of the companies that ministered to the king by course, and the captains over the thousands, and captains over the hundreds, and the stewards over all the substance and possession of the king, and of his sons, with the officers, and with the mighty men, and with all the valiant men, unto Jerusalem.

David assembled the <u>13_1CH_15_04</u># And David assembled the children of Aaron, and the Levites:

David at Pasdammim <u>13_1CH_11_13</u># He was with David at Pasdammim, and there the Philistines were gathered together to battle, where was a parcel of ground full of barley; and the people fled from before the Philistines.

David at the <u>16_NEH_12_37</u> # And at the fountain gate, which was over against them, they went up by the stairs of the city of David, at the going up of the wall, above the house of David, even unto the water gate eastward.

David because he <u>09_1SA_18_16</u># But all Israel and Judah loved David, because he went out and came in before them.

David because he <u>09_1SA_19_04</u> # And Jonathan spake good of David unto Saul his father, and said unto him, Let not the king sin against his servant, against David; because he hath not sinned against thee, and because his works [have been] to thee ward very good:

David because his <u>09_18A_20_34</u> # So Jonathan arose from the table in fierce anger, and did eat no meat the second day of the month: for he was grieved for David, because his father had done him shame.

David because of <u>14_2CH_21_07</u> # Howbeit the LORD would not destroy the house of David, because of the covenant that he had made with David, and as he promised to give a light to him and to his sons for ever.

David because the <u>09_1SA_18_12</u> # And Saul was afraid of David, because the LORD was with him, and was departed from Saul.

David begat more <u>13_1CH_14_03</u># And David took more wives at Jerusalem: and David begat more sons and daughters.

David behaved himself <u>09_1SA_18_14</u> # And David behaved himself wisely in all his ways; and the LORD [was] with him.

David behaved himself <u>09_1SA_18_30</u> # Then the princes of the Philistines went forth: and it came to pass, after they went forth, [that] David behaved himself more wisely than all the servants of Saul; so that his name was much set by.

David beheld the <u>09_18A_26_05</u># And David arose, and came to the place where Saul had pitched: and David beheld the place where Saul lay, and Abner the son of Ner, the captain of his host: and Saul lay in the trench, and the people pitched round about him.

David Behold how 19_PSA_133_01 # A Song of degrees of David. Behold, how good and how pleasant [it is]

for brethren to dwell together in unity!

David beside the <u>13_1CH_03_09</u># [These were] all the sons of David, beside the sons of the concubines, and Tamar their sister.

David Bless the <u>19_PSA_103_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David. Bless the LORD, O my soul: and all that is within me, [bless] his holy name.

David Blessed be <u>09_18A_26_25</u># Then Saul said to David, Blessed [be] thou, my son David: thou shalt both do great [things], and also shalt still prevail. So David went on his way, and Saul returned to his place.

David Blessed be <u>19_PSA_144_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David. Blessed [be] the LORD my strength, which teacheth my hands to war, [and] my fingers to fight:

David came near <u>09_1SA_30_21</u> # And David came to the two hundred men, which were so faint that they could not follow David, whom they had made also to abide at the brook Besor: and they went forth to meet David, and to meet the people that [were] with him: and when David came near to the people, he saluted them.

David came to <u>13_1CH_21_21</u> # And as David came to Ornan, Ornan looked and saw David, and went out of the threshingfloor, and bowed himself to David with [his] face to the ground.

David came to <u>09_1SA_16_21</u> # And David came to Saul, and stood before him: and he loved him greatly; and he became his armourbearer.

David came to <u>09_1SA_30_21</u> # And David came to the two hundred men, which were so faint that they could not follow David, whom they had made also to abide at the brook Besor: and they went forth to meet David, and to meet the people that [were] with him: and when David came near to the people, he saluted them.

David came to <u>09_1SA_30_26</u># And when David came to Ziklag, he sent of the spoil unto the elders of Judah, [even] to his friends, saying, Behold a present for you of the spoil of the enemies of the LORD;

David came to <u>10_2SA_05_20</u> # And David came to Baalperazim, and David smote them there, and said, The LORD hath broken forth upon mine enemies before me, as the breach of waters. Therefore he called the name of that place Baalperazim.

David came to <u>10_2SA_16_05</u> # And when king David came to Bahurim, behold, thence came out a man of the family of the house of Saul, whose name [was] Shimei, the son of Gera: he came forth, and cursed still as he came.

David came to <u>10_2SA_17_24</u># Then David came to Mahanaim. And Absalom passed over Jordan, he and all the men of Israel with him.

David came to <u>10_2SA_20_03</u> # And David came to his house at Jerusalem; and the king took the ten women [his] concubines, whom he had left to keep the house, and put them in ward, and fed them, but went not in unto them. So they were shut up unto the day of their death, living in widowhood.

David cannot come <u>10_2SA_05_06</u> # And the king and his men went to Jerusalem unto the Jebusites, the inhabitants of the land: which spake unto David, saying, Except thou take away the blind and the lame, thou shalt not come in hither: thinking, David cannot come in hither.

David carried it <u>10_2SA_06_10</u># So David would not remove the ark of the LORD unto him into the city of David: but David carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite.

David Come and <u>09_1SA_20_11</u># And Jonathan said unto David, Come, and let us go out into the field. And they went out both of them into the field.

David Come to <u>09_1SA_17_44</u> # And the Philistine said to David, Come to me, and I will give thy flesh unto the fowls of the air, and to the beasts of the field.

David comforted Bathsheba <u>10_2SA_12_24</u> # And David comforted Bathsheba his wife, and went in unto her, and lay with her: and she bare a son, and he called his name Solomon: and the LORD loved him.

David commanded his <u>10_2SA_04_12</u> # And David commanded his young men, and they slew them, and cut off their hands and their feet, and hanged [them] up over the pool in Hebron. But they took the head of Ishbosheth, and buried [it] in the sepulchre of Abner in Hebron.

David commanded to <u>13_1CH_22_02</u># And David commanded to gather together the strangers that [were] in the land of Israel; and he set masons to hew wrought stones to build the house of God.

David consulted with <u>13_1CH_13_01</u># And David consulted with the captains of thousands and hundreds, [and] with every leader.

David could not <u>13_1CH_21_30</u># But David could not go before it to inquire of God: for he was afraid because of the sword of the angel of the LORD.

David cried to <u>09_1SA_26_14</u> # And David cried to the people, and to Abner the son of Ner, saying, Answerest thou not, Abner? Then Abner answered and said, Who [art] thou [that] criest to the king?

David danced before <u>10_2SA_06_14</u># And David danced before the LORD with all [his] might; and David [was] girded with a linen ephod.

David dancing and <u>13_1CH_15_29</u> # And it came to pass, [as] the ark of the covenant of the LORD came to the city of David, that Michal the daughter of Saul looking out at a window saw king David dancing and playing: and she despised him in her heart.

David David the <u>10_2SA_23_01</u> # Now these [be] the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man [who was] raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said,

David dedicated unto <u>13_1CH_18_11</u># Them also king David dedicated unto the LORD, with the silver and the gold that he brought from all [these] nations; from Edom, and from Moab, and from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines, and from Amalek.

David deliver him <u>10_28A_20_21</u># The matter [is] not so: but a man of mount Ephraim, Sheba the son of Bichri by name, hath lifted up his hand against the king, [even] against David: deliver him only, and I will depart from the city. And the woman said unto Joab, Behold, his head shall be thrown to thee over the wall.

David Deliver me <u>19_PSA_140_01</u># To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Deliver me, O LORD, from the evil man: preserve me from the violent man;

David delivered first <u>13_1CH_16_07</u># Then on that day David delivered first [this psalm] to thank the LORD into the hand of Asaph and his brethren.

David demanded of <u>10_2SA_11_07</u># And when Uriah was come unto him, David demanded [of him] how Joab did, and how the people did, and how the war prospered.

David departed and <u>09_1SA_22_05</u> # And the prophet Gad said unto David, Abide not in the hold; depart, and get thee into the land of Judah. Then David departed, and came into the forest of Hareth.

David did dedicate <u>10_2SA_08_11</u># Which also king David did dedicate unto the LORD, with the silver and gold that he had dedicated of all nations which he subdued;

David did so <u>10_2SA_05_25</u># And David did so, as the LORD had commanded him; and smote the Philistines from Geba until thou come to Gazer.

David did that <u>11_1KI_15_05</u># Because David did [that which was] right in the eyes of the LORD, and turned not aside from any [thing] that he commanded him all the days of his life, save only in the matter of Uriah the Hittite.

David did walk <u>11_1KI_03_14</u># And if thou wilt walk in my ways, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as thy father David did walk, then I will lengthen thy days.

David did when <u>42_LUK_06_03</u> # And Jesus answering them said, Have ye not read so much as this, what David did, when himself was an hungered, and they which were with him;

David did when <u>41_MAR_02_25</u> # And he said unto them, Have ye never read what David did, when he had need, and was an hungred, he, and they that were with him?

David did when <u>40_MAT_12_03</u># But he said unto them, Have ye not read what David did, when he was an hungred, and they that were with him;

David distributed them <u>13_1CH_24_03</u># And David distributed them, both Zadok of the sons of Eleazar, and Ahimelech of the sons of Ithamar, according to their offices in their service.

David divided them <u>13_1CH_23_06</u> # And David divided them into courses among the sons of Levi, [namely], Gershon, Kohath, and Merari.

David Do all <u>13_1CH_17_02</u> # Then Nathan said unto David, Do all that [is] in thine heart; for God [is] with thee.

David Do ye <u>19_PSA_58_01</u># To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David. Do ye indeed speak righteousness, O congregation? do ye judge uprightly, O ye sons of men?

David doth honour <u>13_1CH_19_03</u> # But the princes of the children of Ammon said to Hanun, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? are not his servants come unto thee for to search, and to overthrow, and to spy out the land?

David doth honour <u>10_2SA_10_03</u> # And the princes of the children of Ammon said unto Hanun their lord, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? hath not David [rather] sent his servants unto thee, to search the city, and to spy it out, and to overthrow it?

David down through <u>09_1SA_19_12</u># So Michal let David down through a window: and he went, and fled, and escaped.

David drew nigh <u>11_1KI_02_01</u># Now the days of David drew nigh that he should die; and he charged Solomon his son, saying,

David dwelt add <u>23_ISA_29_01</u># Woe to Ariel, to Ariel, the city [where] David dwelt! add ye year to year; let them kill sacrifices.

David dwelt in <u>13_1CH_11_07</u># And David dwelt in the castle; therefore they called it the city of David.

David dwelt in <u>09_1SA_27_07</u># And the time that David dwelt in the country of the Philistines was a full year and four months.

David dwelt in <u>10_2SA_05_09</u># So David dwelt in the fort, and called it the city of David. And David built round about from Millo and inward.

David dwelt with <u>09_1SA_27_03</u> # And David dwelt with Achish at Gath, he and his men, every man with his household, [even] David with his two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the Carmelitess, Nabal's wife.

David earnestly asked <u>09_1SA_20_06</u> # If thy father at all miss me, then say, David earnestly asked [leave] of me that he might run to Bethlehem his city: for [there is] a yearly sacrifice there for all the family.

David earnestly asked <u>09_1SA_20_28</u># And Jonathan answered Saul, David earnestly asked [leave] of me [to go] to Bethlehem:

David encouraged himself <u>09_1SA_30_06</u> # And David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.

David even so <u>10_2SA_03_09</u> # So do God to Abner, and more also, except, as the LORD hath sworn to David, even so I do to him;

David even to <u>09_18A_18_11</u># And Saul cast the javelin; for he said, I will smite David even to the wall [with it]. And David avoided out of his presence twice.

David even to <u>09_1SA_19_10</u># And Saul sought to smite David even to the wall with the javelin; but he slipped away out of Saul's presence, and he smote the javelin into the wall: and David fled, and escaped that night.

David even unto <u>16_NEH_12_37</u> # And at the fountain gate, which was over against them, they went up by the stairs of the city of David, at the going up of the wall, above the house of David, even unto the water gate eastward.

David every one <u>09_1SA_20_15</u> # But [also] thou shalt not cut off thy kindness from my house for ever: no, not when the LORD hath cut off the enemies of David every one from the face of the earth.

David exceeded <u>09_1SA_20_41</u> # [And] as soon as the lad was gone, David arose out of [a place] toward the south, and fell on his face to the ground, and bowed himself three times: and they kissed one another, and wept one with another, until David exceeded.

David executed judgment <u>10_2SA_08_15</u> # And David reigned over all Israel; and David executed judgment and justice unto all his people.

David fall by <u>09_1SA_18_25</u> # And Saul said, Thus shall ye say to David, The king desireth not any dowry, but an hundred foreskins of the Philistines, to be avenged of the king's enemies. But Saul thought to make David fall by the hand of the Philistines.

David fasted and <u>10_2SA_12_16</u># David therefore besought God for the child; and David fasted, and went in, and lay all night upon the earth.

David fear not <u>40_MAT_01_20</u>[#] But while he thought on these things, behold, the angel of the Lord appeared unto him in a dream, saying, Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.

David feared to <u>10_2SA_12_18</u> # And it came to pass on the seventh day, that the child died. And the servants of David feared to tell him that the child was dead: for they said, Behold, while the child was yet alive, we spake unto him, and he would not hearken unto our voice: how will he then vex himself, if we tell him that the child is dead?

David fled and <u>09_1SA_19_10</u># And Saul sought to smite David even to the wall with the javelin; but he slipped away out of Saul's presence, and he smote the javelin into the wall: and David fled, and escaped that night.

David fled and <u>09_18A_19_18</u># So David fled, and escaped, and came to Samuel to Ramah, and told him all that Saul had done to him. And he and Samuel went and dwelt in Naioth.

David fled from <u>09_1SA_20_01</u> # And David fled from Naioth in Ramah, and came and said before Jonathan, What have I done? what [is] mine iniquity? and what [is] my sin before thy father, that he seeketh my life?

David for ever <u>14_2CH_13_05</u> # Ought ye not to know that the LORD God of Israel gave the kingdom over Israel to David for ever, [even] to him and to his sons by a covenant of salt?

David for I <u>09_1SA_26_21</u> # Then said Saul, I have sinned: return, my son David: for I will no more do thee harm, because my soul was precious in thine eyes this day: behold, I have played the fool, and have erred exceedingly.

David Fret not <u>19_PSA_37_01</u># [A Psalm] of David. Fret not thyself because of evildoers, neither be thou envious against the workers of iniquity.

David from that <u>09_1SA_16_13</u># Then Samuel took the horn of oil, and anointed him in the midst of his brethren: and the spirit of the LORD came upon David from that day forward. So Samuel rose up, and went to Ramah.

David from that <u>09_1SA_18_09</u> # And Saul eyed David from that day and forward.

David gat him <u>10_2SA_08_13</u> # And David gat [him] a name when he returned from smiting of the Syrians in the valley of salt, [being] eighteen thousand [men].

David gathered all <u>13_1CH_13_05</u> # So David gathered all Israel together, from Shihor of Egypt even unto the entering of Hemath, to bring the ark of God from Kirjathjearim.

David gathered all <u>13_1CH_15_03</u> # And David gathered all Israel together to Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the LORD unto his place, which he had prepared for it.

David gathered all <u>10_2SA_12_29</u> # And David gathered all the people together, and went to Rabbah, and fought against it, and took it.

David gathered together <u>10_2SA_06_01</u> # Again, David gathered together all [the] chosen [men] of Israel, thirty thousand.

David gave a <u>13_1CH_14_12</u> # And when they had left their gods there, David gave a commandment, and they were burned with fire.

David gave to <u>13_1CH_21_25</u> # So David gave to Ornan for the place six hundred shekels of gold by weight.

David gave to <u>13_1CH_28_11</u># Then David gave to Solomon his son the pattern of the porch, and of the houses thereof, and of the treasuries thereof, and of the upper chambers thereof, and of the inner parlours thereof, and of the place of the mercy seat,

David girded his <u>09_1SA_17_39</u># And David girded his sword upon his armour, and he assayed to go; for he had not proved [it]. And David said unto Saul, I cannot go with these; for I have not proved [them]. And David put them off him.

David Give ear <u>19_PSA_05_01</u># To the chief Musician upon Nehiloth, A Psalm of David. Give ear to my words, O LORD, consider my meditation.

David Give ear <u>19_PSA_55_01</u> # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David. Give ear to my prayer, O God; and hide not thyself from my supplication.

David Give unto <u>19_PSA_29_01</u># A Psalm of David. Give unto the LORD, O ye mighty, give unto the LORD glory and strength.

David Go and <u>09_1SA_17_37</u> # David said moreover, The LORD that delivered me out of the paw of the lion, and out of the paw of the bear, he will deliver me out of the hand of this Philistine. And Saul said unto David, Go, and the LORD be with thee.

David Go and <u>09_1SA_23_02</u> # Therefore David inquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go and smite these Philistines? And the LORD said unto David, Go, and smite the Philistines, and save Keilah.

David go forth <u>09_1SA_17_55</u># And when Saul saw David go forth against the Philistine, he said unto Abner, the captain of the host, Abner, whose son [is] this youth? And Abner said, [As] thy soul liveth, O

king, I cannot tell.

David Go in <u>09_1SA_20_42</u> # And Jonathan said to David, Go in peace, forasmuch as we have sworn both of us in the name of the LORD, saying, The LORD be between me and thee, and between my seed and thy seed for ever. And he arose and departed: and Jonathan went into the city.

David Go up <u>10_2SA_05_19</u> # And David inquired of the LORD, saying, Shall I go up to the Philistines? wilt thou deliver them into mine hand? And the LORD said unto David, Go up: for I will doubtless deliver the Philistines into thine hand.

David God hath <u>09_1SA_26_08</u> # Then said Abishai to David, God hath delivered thine enemy into thine hand this day: now therefore let me smite him, I pray thee, with the spear even to the earth at once, and I will not [smite] him the second time.

David had a <u>10_2SA_13_01</u> # And it came to pass after this, that Absalom the son of David had a fair sister, whose name [was] Tamar; and Amnon the son of David loved her.

David had abode <u>10_2SA_01_01</u> # Now it came to pass after the death of Saul, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Amalekites, and David had abode two days in Ziklag;

David had called <u>10_28A_11_13</u># And when David had called him, he did eat and drink before him; and he made him drunk: and at even he went out to lie on his bed with the servants of his lord, but went not down to his house.

David had distributed <u>14_2CH_23_18</u># Also Jehoiada appointed the offices of the house of the LORD by the hand of the priests the Levites, whom David had distributed in the house of the LORD, to offer the burnt offerings of the LORD, as [it is] written in the law of Moses, with rejoicing and with singing, [as it was ordained] by David.

David had done <u>10_28A_11_27</u># And when the mourning was past, David sent and fetched her to his house, and she became his wife, and bare him a son. But the thing that David had done displeased the LORD.

David had Jashobeam <u>13_1CH_11_11</u># And this [is] the number of the mighty men whom David had; Jashobeam, an Hachmonite, the chief of the captains: he lifted up his spear against three hundred slain [by him] at one time.

David had made <u>13_1CH_16_02</u> # And when David had made an end of offering the burnt offerings and the peace offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD.

David had made <u>09_1SA_24_16</u># And it came to pass, when David had made an end of speaking these words unto Saul, that Saul said, [Is] this thy voice, my son David? And Saul lifted up his voice, and wept.

David had made <u>10_2SA_06_18</u># And as soon as David had made an end of offering burnt offerings and peace offerings, he blessed the people in the name of the LORD of hosts.

David had pitched <u>13_1CH_16_01</u># So they brought the ark of God, and set it in the midst of the tent that David had pitched for it: and they offered burnt sacrifices and peace offerings before God.

David had pitched <u>10_2SA_06_17</u> # And they brought in the ark of the LORD, and set it in his place, in the midst of the tabernacle that David had pitched for it: and David offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the LORD.

David had prepared <u>14_2CH_01_04</u># But the ark of God had David brought up from Kirjathjearim to [the place which] David had prepared for it: for he had pitched a tent for it at Jerusalem.

David had prepared <u>14_2CH_03_01</u> # Then Solomon began to build the house of the LORD at Jerusalem in mount Moriah, where [the Lord] appeared unto David his father, in the place that David had prepared in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.

David had put <u>13_1CH_19_17</u># And it was told David; and he gathered all Israel, and passed over Jordan, and came upon them, and set [the battle] in array against them. So when David had put the battle in array against the Syrians, they fought with him.

David had said <u>09_18A_25_21</u># Now David had said, Surely in vain have I kept all that this [fellow] hath in the wilderness, so that nothing was missed of all that [pertained] unto him: and he hath requited me evil for good.

David had smitten <u>13_1CH_18_09</u> # Now when Tou king of Hamath heard how David had smitten all the host of Hadarezer king of Zobah;

David had smitten <u>10_2SA_02_31</u># But the servants of David had smitten of Benjamin, and of Abner's men, [so that] three hundred and threescore men died.

David had smitten <u>10_2SA_08_09</u> # When Toi king of Hamath heard that David had smitten all the host of Hadadezer,

David had The <u>10_28A_23_08</u># These [be] the names of the mighty men whom David had: The Tachmonite that sat in the seat, chief among the captains; the same [was] Adino the Eznite: [he lift up his spear] against eight hundred, whom he slew at one time.

David had who <u>13_1CH_11_10</u># These also [are] the chief of the mighty men whom David had, who strengthened themselves with him in his kingdom, [and] with all Israel, to make him king, according to the word of the LORD concerning Israel.

David Hanun and <u>13_1CH_19_06</u> # And when the children of Ammon saw that they had made themselves odious to David, Hanun and the children of Ammon sent a thousand talents of silver to hire them chariots and horsemen out of Mesopotamia, and out of Syriamaachah, and out of Zobah.

David hast said <u>44_ACT_04_25</u> # Who by the mouth of thy servant David hast said, Why did the heathen rage, and the people imagine vain things?

David hasted and <u>09_1SA_17_48</u># And it came to pass, when the Philistine arose, and came and drew nigh to meet David, that David hasted, and ran toward the army to meet the Philistine.

David hath made <u>11_1KI_01_43</u># And Jonathan answered and said to Adonijah, Verily our lord king David hath made Solomon king.

David hath prevailed <u>66_REV_05_05</u># And one of the elders saith unto me, Weep not: behold, the Lion of the tribe of Juda, the Root of David, hath prevailed to open the book, and to loose the seven seals thereof.

David Hattush <u>15_EZR_08_02</u> # Of the sons of Phinehas; Gershom: of the sons of Ithamar; Daniel: of the sons of David; Hattush.

David have mercy <u>42_LUK_18_38</u> # And he cried, saying, Jesus, [thou] son of David, have mercy on me.

David have mercy <u>42_LUK_18_39</u> # And they which went before rebuked him, that he should hold his peace: but he cried so much the more, [Thou] son of David, have mercy on me.

David have mercy <u>41_MAR_10_47</u> # And when he heard that it was Jesus of Nazareth, he began to cry out,

and say, Jesus, [thou] son of David, have mercy on me.

David have mercy <u>41_MAR_10_48</u> # And many charged him that he should hold his peace: but he cried the more a great deal, [Thou] son of David, have mercy on me.

David have mercy <u>40_MAT_09_27</u># And when Jesus departed thence, two blind men followed him, crying, and saying, [Thou] son of David, have mercy on us.

David he disdained <u>09_1SA_17_42</u> # And when the Philistine looked about, and saw David, he disdained him: for he was [but] a youth, and ruddy, and of a fair countenance.

David he fell <u>10_2SA_09_06</u># Now when Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul, was come unto David, he fell on his face, and did reverence. And David said, Mephibosheth. And he answered, Behold thy servant!

David he gathered <u>10_2SA_10_17</u> # And when it was told David, he gathered all Israel together, and passed over Jordan, and came to Helam. And the Syrians set themselves in array against David, and fought with him.

David he sent <u>10_2SA_03_26</u> # And when Joab was come out from David, he sent messengers after Abner, which brought him again from the well of Sirah: but David knew [it] not.

David he sent <u>10_2SA_10_05</u># When they told [it] unto David, he sent to meet them, because the men were greatly ashamed: and the king said, Tarry at Jericho until your beards be grown, and [then] return.

David he shall <u>26_EZE_34_23</u> # And I will set up one shepherd over them, and he shall feed them, [even] my servant David; he shall feed them, and he shall be their shepherd.

David he that <u>66_REV_03_07</u># And to the angel of the church in Philadelphia write; These things saith he that is holy, he that is true, he that hath the key of David, he that openeth, and no man shutteth; and shutteth, and no man openeth;

David he will <u>19_PSA_132_11</u># The LORD hath sworn [in] truth unto David; he will not turn from it; Of the fruit of thy body will I set upon thy throne.

David Hear me <u>19_PSA_04_01</u># To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm of David. Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me [when I was] in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.

David Hear my <u>19_PSA_143_01</u> # A Psalm of David. Hear my prayer, O LORD, give ear to my supplications: in thy faithfulness answer me, [and] in thy righteousness.

David Hear my <u>19_PSA_61_01</u># To the chief Musician upon Neginah, [A Psalm] of David. Hear my cry, O God; attend unto my prayer.

David Hear my <u>19_PSA_64_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Hear my voice, O God, in my prayer: preserve my life from fear of the enemy.

David Hear the <u>19_PSA_17_01</u># A prayer of David. Hear the right, O LORD, attend unto my cry, give ear unto my prayer, [that goeth] not out of feigned lips.

David heard in <u>09_1SA_25_04</u> # And David heard in the wilderness that Nabal did shear his sheep.

David heard it <u>10_2SA_03_28</u> # And afterward when David heard [it], he said, I and my kingdom [are] guiltless before the LORD for ever from the blood of Abner the son of Ner:

David heard of <u>13_1CH_14_08</u># And when the Philistines heard that David was anointed king over all Israel, all the Philistines went up to seek David. And David heard [of it], and went out against them.

David heard of <u>13_1CH_19_08</u># And when David heard [of it], he sent Joab, and all the host of the mighty men.

David heard of <u>10_2SA_05_17</u># But when the Philistines heard that they had anointed David king over Israel, all the Philistines came up to seek David; and David heard [of it], and went down to the hold.

David heard of <u>10_2SA_10_07</u># And when David heard of [it], he sent Joab, and all the host of the mighty men.

David heard of <u>10_2SA_13_21</u> # But when king David heard of all these things, he was very wroth.

David heard that <u>09_1SA_25_39</u> # And when David heard that Nabal was dead, he said, Blessed [be] the LORD, that hath pleaded the cause of my reproach from the hand of Nabal, and hath kept his servant from evil: for the LORD hath returned the wickedness of Nabal upon his own head. And David sent and communed with Abigail, to take her to him to wife.

David heard them <u>09_1SA_17_23</u> # And as he talked with them, behold, there came up the champion, the Philistine of Gath, Goliath by name, out of the armies of the Philistines, and spake according to the same words: and David heard [them].

David Help LORD <u>19_PSA_12_01</u># To the chief Musician upon Sheminith, A Psalm of David. Help, LORD; for the godly man ceaseth; for the faithful fail from among the children of men.

David hid himself <u>09_1SA_20_24</u># So David hid himself in the field: and when the new moon was come, the king sat him down to eat meat.

David hide himself <u>09_18A_23_19</u># Then came up the Ziphites to Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself with us in strong holds in the wood, in the hill of Hachilah, which [is] on the south of Jeshimon?

David hide himself <u>09_1SA_26_01</u> # And the Ziphites came unto Saul to Gibeah, saying, Doth not David hide himself in the hill of Hachilah, [which is] before Jeshimon?

David hide himself <u>19_PSA_54_01</u> # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when the Ziphims came and said to Saul, Doth not David hide himself with us? Save me, O God, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength.

David himself and <u>09_1SA_30_31</u> # And to [them] which [were] in Hebron, and to all the places where David himself and his men were wont to haunt.

David himself followed <u>10_28A_03_31</u># And David said to Joab, and to all the people that [were] with him, Rend your clothes, and gird you with sackcloth, and mourn before Abner. And king David [himself] followed the bier.

David himself said <u>41_MAR_12_36</u> # For David himself said by the Holy Ghost, The LORD said to my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand, till I make thine enemies thy footstool.

David himself saith <u>42_LUK_20_42</u> # And David himself saith in the book of Psalms, The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,

David his father <u>13_1CH_29_23</u># Then Solomon sat on the throne of the LORD as king instead of David

his father, and prospered; and all Israel obeyed him.

David his father <u>11_1KI_02_12</u># Then sat Solomon upon the throne of David his father; and his kingdom was established greatly.

David his father <u>11_1KI_03_03</u># And Solomon loved the LORD, walking in the statutes of David his father: only he sacrificed and burnt incense in high places.

David his father <u>11_1KI_07_51</u># So was ended all the work that king Solomon made for the house of the LORD. And Solomon brought in the things which David his father had dedicated; [even] the silver, and the gold, and the vessels, did he put among the treasures of the house of the LORD.

David his father <u>11_1KI_11_04</u># For it came to pass, when Solomon was old, [that] his wives turned away his heart after other gods: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as [was] the heart of David his father.

David his father <u>11_1KI_11_06</u># And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as [did] David his father.

David his father <u>11_1KI_11_27</u># And this [was] the cause that he lifted up [his] hand against the king: Solomon built Millo, [and] repaired the breaches of the city of David his father.

David his father <u>11_1KI_11_33</u># Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do [that which is] right in mine eyes, and [to keep] my statutes and my judgments, as [did] David his father.

David his father <u>11_1KI_11_43</u># And Solomon slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David his father: and Rehoboam his son reigned in his stead.

David his father <u>11_1KI_15_03</u># And he walked in all the sins of his father, which he had done before him: and his heart was not perfect with the LORD his God, as the heart of David his father.

David his father <u>11_1KI_15_11</u># And Asa did [that which was] right in the eyes of the LORD, as [did] David his father.

David his father <u>11_1KI_15_24</u># And Asa slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Jehoshaphat his son reigned in his stead.

David his father <u>11_1KI_22_50</u># And Jehoshaphat slept with his fathers, and was buried with his fathers in the city of David his father: and Jehoram his son reigned in his stead.

David his father <u>14_2CH_02_17</u> # And Solomon numbered all the strangers that [were] in the land of Israel, after the numbering wherewith David his father had numbered them; and they were found an hundred and fifty thousand and three thousand and six hundred.

David his father <u>14_2CH_03_01</u> # Then Solomon began to build the house of the LORD at Jerusalem in mount Moriah, where [the Lord] appeared unto David his father, in the place that David had prepared in the threshingfloor of Ornan the Jebusite.

David his father <u>14_2CH_05_01</u> # Thus all the work that Solomon made for the house of the LORD was finished: and Solomon brought in [all] the things that David his father had dedicated; and the silver, and the gold, and all the instruments, put he among the treasures of the house of God.

David his father <u>14_2CH_08_14</u># And he appointed, according to the order of David his father, the courses

of the priests to their service, and the Levites to their charges, to praise and minister before the priests, as the duty of every day required: the porters also by their courses at every gate: for so had David the man of God commanded.

David his father <u>14_2CH_09_31</u> # And Solomon slept with his fathers, and he was buried in the city of David his father: and Rehoboam his son reigned in his stead.

David his father <u>14_2CH_28_01</u> # Ahaz [was] twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem: but he did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, like David his father:

David his father <u>14_2CH_29_02</u># And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that David his father had done.

David his father <u>14_2CH_34_02</u> # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the ways of David his father, and declined [neither] to the right hand, nor to the left.

David his father <u>14_2CH_34_03</u> # For in the eighth year of his reign, while he was yet young, he began to seek after the God of David his father: and in the twelfth year he began to purge Judah and Jerusalem from the high places, and the groves, and the carved images, and the molten images.

David his father <u>12_2KI_14_03</u> # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, yet not like David his father: he did according to all things as Joash his father did.

David his father <u>12_2KI_16_02</u> # Twenty years old [was] Ahaz when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem, and did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD his God, like David his father.

David his father <u>12_2KI_18_03</u> # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that David his father did.

David his father <u>12_2KI_22_02</u># And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, and walked in all the way of David his father, and turned not aside to the right hand or to the left.

David his servant <u>11_1KI_08_66</u># On the eighth day he sent the people away: and they blessed the king, and went unto their tents joyful and glad of heart for all the goodness that the LORD had done for David his servant, and for Israel his people.

David his servant <u>19_PSA_144_10</u># [It is he] that giveth salvation unto kings: who delivereth David his servant from the hurtful sword.

David hocked all <u>10_2SA_08_04</u># And David took from him a thousand [chariots], and seven hundred horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: and David hocked all the chariot [horses], but reserved of them [for] an hundred chariots.

David Hold not <u>19_PSA_109_01</u># To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. Hold not thy peace, O God of my praise;

David How long <u>19_PSA_13_01</u># To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. How long wilt thou forget me, O LORD? for ever? how long wilt thou hide thy face from me?

David how the <u>13_1CH_19_05</u># Then there went [certain], and told David how the men were served. And he sent to meet them: for the men were greatly ashamed. And the king said, Tarry at Jericho until your beards be grown, and [then] return.

David I know <u>09_1SA_29_09</u> # And Achish answered and said to David, I know that thou [art] good in my sight, as an angel of God: notwithstanding the princes of the Philistines have said, He shall not go up with us to the battle.

David I pray <u>09_18A_16_22</u># And Saul sent to Jesse, saying, Let David, I pray thee, stand before me; for he hath found favour in my sight.

David I waited <u>19_PSA_40_01</u># To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. I waited patiently for the LORD; and he inclined unto me, and heard my cry.

David I was <u>19_PSA_122_01</u> # A Song of degrees of David. I was glad when they said unto me, Let us go into the house of the LORD.

David I will <u>10_2SA_03_18</u> # Now then do [it]: for the LORD hath spoken of David, saying, By the hand of my servant David I will save my people Israel out of the hand of the Philistines, and out of the hand of all their enemies.

David I will <u>10_2SA_03_21</u> # And Abner said unto David, I will arise and go, and will gather all Israel unto my lord the king, that they may make a league with thee, and that thou mayest reign over all that thine heart desireth. And David sent Abner away; and he went in peace.

David I will <u>19_PSA_101_01</u> # A Psalm of David. I will sing of mercy and judgment: unto thee, O LORD,

will I sing.

David I will <u>19_PSA_138_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David. I will praise thee with my whole heart: before the gods will I sing praise unto thee.

David I will <u>19_PSA_30_01</u> # A Psalm [and] Song [at] the dedication of the house of David. I will extol thee, O LORD; for thou hast lifted me up, and hast not made my foes to rejoice over me.

David if I <u>09_18A_25_22</u># So and more also do God unto the enemies of David, if I leave of all that [pertain] to him by the morning light any that pisseth against the wall.

David If it <u>19_PSA_124_01</u> # A Song of degrees of David. If [it had not been] the LORD who was on our side, now may Israel say;

David in and <u>10_2SA_07_18</u># Then went king David in, and sat before the LORD, and he said, Who [am] I, O Lord GOD? and what [is] my house, that thou hast brought me hitherto?

David in Hebron <u>10_28A_03_05</u> # And the sixth, Ithream, by Eglah David's wife. These were born to David in Hebron.

David in Hebron <u>10_2SA_03_19</u> # And Abner also spake in the ears of Benjamin: and Abner went also to speak in the ears of David in Hebron all that seemed good to Israel, and that seemed good to the whole house of Benjamin.

David in Hebron <u>10_28A_03_22</u> # And, behold, the servants of David and Joab came from [pursuing] a troop, and brought in a great spoil with them: but Abner [was] not with David in Hebron; for he had sent him away, and he was gone in peace.

David in spirit <u>40_MAT_22_43</u># He saith unto them, How then doth David in spirit call him Lord, saying,

David inquired at <u>09_1SA_30_08</u># And David inquired at the LORD, saying, Shall I pursue after this troop? shall I overtake them? And he answered him, Pursue: for thou shalt surely overtake [them], and without fail recover [all].

David inquired of <u>13_1CH_14_10</u> # And David inquired of God, saying, Shall I go up against the Philistines? and wilt thou deliver them into mine hand? And the LORD said unto him, Go up; for I will deliver them into thine hand.

David is in <u>09_1SA_24_01</u> # And it came to pass, when Saul was returned from following the Philistines, that it was told him, saying, Behold, David [is] in the wilderness of Engedi.

David Is it <u>23_ISA_07_13</u># And he said, Hear ye now, O house of David; [Is it] a small thing for you to weary men, but will ye weary my God also?

David is not <u>44_ACT_02_34</u> # For David is not ascended into the heavens: but he saith himself, The Lord said unto my Lord, Sit thou on my right hand,

David is risen <u>14_2CH_13_06</u> # Yet Jeroboam the son of Nebat, the servant of Solomon the son of David, is

risen up, and hath rebelled against his lord.

David Josiah by <u>11_1KI_13_02</u># And he cried against the altar in the word of the LORD, and said, O altar, altar, thus saith the LORD; Behold, a child shall be born unto the house of David, Josiah by name; and upon thee shall he offer the priests of the high places that burn incense upon thee, and men's bones shall be burnt upon thee.

David Judge me <u>19_PSA_26_01</u># [A Psalm] of David. Judge me, O LORD; for I have walked in mine integrity: I have trusted also in the LORD; [therefore] I shall not slide.

David left his <u>09_1SA_17_22</u> # And David left his carriage in the hand of the keeper of the carriage, and ran into the army, and came and saluted his brethren.

David Let God <u>19_PSA_68_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm [or] Song of David. Let God arise, let his enemies be scattered: let them also that hate him flee before him.

David let him <u>10_28A_20_11</u># And one of Joab's men stood by him, and said, He that favoureth Joab, and he that [is] for David, [let him go] after Joab.

David Let my <u>10_2SA_24_22</u> # And Araunah said unto David, Let my lord the king take and offer up what [seemeth] good unto him: behold, [here be] oxen for burnt sacrifice, and threshing instruments and [other] instruments of the oxen for wood.

David my servant <u>11_1KI_11_36</u># And unto his son will I give one tribe, that David my servant may have a light alway before me in Jerusalem, the city which I have chosen me to put my name there.

David my servant <u>11_1KI_11_38</u># And it shall be, if thou wilt hearken unto all that I command thee, and wilt walk in my ways, and do [that is] right in my sight, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as David my servant did; that I will be with thee, and build thee a sure house, as I built for David, and will give Israel unto thee.

David my servant <u>26_EZE_37_24</u> # And David my servant [shall be] king over them; and they all shall have one shepherd: they shall also walk in my judgments, and observe my statutes, and do them.

David my servant <u>24_JER_33_21</u> # [Then] may also my covenant be broken with David my servant, that he should not have a son to reign upon his throne; and with the Levites the priests, my ministers.

David my servant 24_JER_33_22 # As the host of heaven cannot be numbered, neither the sand of the sea

measured: so will I multiply the seed of David my servant, and the Levites that minister unto me.

David my servant <u>24_JER_33_26</u># Then will I cast away the seed of Jacob, and David my servant, [so] that I will not take [any] of his seed [to be] rulers over the seed of Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob: for I will cause their captivity to return, and have mercy on them.

David my servant <u>19_PSA_89_03</u> # I have made a covenant with my chosen, I have sworn unto David my servant,

David my servant <u>19_PSA_89_20</u># I have found David my servant; with my holy oil have I anointed him:

David my servant's <u>11_1KI_11_13</u># Howbeit I will not rend away all the kingdom; [but] will give one tribe to thy son for David my servant's sake, and for Jerusalem's sake which I have chosen.

David my servant's <u>11_1KI_11_34</u># Howbeit I will not take the whole kingdom out of his hand: but I will make him prince all the days of his life for David my servant's sake, whom I chose, because he kept my commandments and my statutes:

David neither have <u>11_1KI_12_16</u># So when all Israel saw that the king hearkened not unto them, the people answered the king, saying, What portion have we in David? neither [have we] inheritance in the son of Jesse: to your tents, O Israel: now see to thine own house, David. So Israel departed unto their tents.

David neither have <u>10_2SA_20_01</u># And there happened to be there a man of Belial, whose name [was] Sheba, the son of Bichri, a Benjamite: and he blew a trumpet, and said, We have no part in David, neither have we inheritance in the son of Jesse: every man to his tents, O Israel.

David nevertheless he <u>10_2SA_23_16</u># And the three mighty men brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: nevertheless he would not drink thereof, but poured it out unto the LORD.

David not knowing <u>11_1KI_02_32</u># And the LORD shall return his blood upon his own head, who fell upon two men more righteous and better than he, and slew them with the sword, my father David not knowing [thereof, to wit], Abner the son of Ner, captain of the host of Israel, and Amasa the son of Jether, captain of the host of Judah.

David numbered the <u>10_2SA_18_01</u># And David numbered the people that [were] with him, and set captains of thousands and captains of hundreds over them.

David O God <u>19_PSA_108_01</u># A Song [or] Psalm of David. O God, my heart is fixed; I will sing and give praise, even with my glory.

David O LORD <u>09_1SA_20_12</u> # And Jonathan said unto David, O LORD God of Israel, when I have sounded my father about to morrow any time, [or] the third [day], and, behold, [if there be] good toward David, and I then send not unto thee, and show it thee;

David O LORD <u>09_18A_23_10</u># Then said David, O LORD God of Israel, thy servant hath certainly heard that Saul seeketh to come to Keilah, to destroy the city for my sake.

David O LORD <u>19_PSA_06_01</u> # To the chief Musician on Neginoth upon Sheminith, A Psalm of David. O LORD, rebuke me not in thine anger, neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure.

David O LORD <u>19_PSA_08_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Gittith, A Psalm of David. O LORD our Lord, how excellent [is] thy name in all the earth! who hast set thy glory above the heavens.

David O LORD <a>19_PSA_139_01 # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. O LORD, thou hast searched

David of Issachar <u>13_1CH_27_18</u># Of Judah, Elihu, [one] of the brethren of David: of Issachar, Omri the son of Michael:

David of whom <u>09_1SA_29_05</u> # [Is] not this David, of whom they sang one to another in dances, saying, Saul slew his thousands, and David his ten thousands?

David offered burnt <u>10_2SA_06_17</u> # And they brought in the ark of the LORD, and set it in his place, in the midst of the tabernacle that David had pitched for it: and David offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the LORD.

David on her <u>09_1SA_25_23</u> # And when Abigail saw David, she hasted, and lighted off the ass, and fell before David on her face, and bowed herself to the ground,

David on his <u>10_2SA_03_12</u> # And Abner sent messengers to David on his behalf, saying, Whose [is] the land? saying [also], Make thy league with me, and, behold, my hand [shall be] with thee, to bring about all Israel unto thee.

David on the <u>14_2CH_33_14</u># Now after this he built a wall without the city of David, on the west side of Gihon, in the valley, even to the entering in at the fish gate, and compassed about Ophel, and raised it up a very great height, and put captains of war in all the fenced cities of Judah.

David our lord <u>11_1KI_01_11</u># Wherefore Nathan spake unto Bathsheba the mother of Solomon, saying, Hast thou not heard that Adonijah the son of Haggith doth reign, and David our lord knoweth [it] not?

David over Israel <u>10_2SA_03_10</u> # To translate the kingdom from the house of Saul, and to set up the throne of David over Israel and over Judah, from Dan even to Beersheba.

David perceived that <u>13_1CH_14_02</u> # And David perceived that the LORD had confirmed him king over Israel, for his kingdom was lifted up on high, because of his people Israel.

David perceived that <u>10_2SA_05_12</u> # And David perceived that the LORD had established him king over Israel, and that he had exalted his kingdom for his people Israel's sake.

David perceived that <u>10_2SA_12_19</u> # But when David saw that his servants whispered, David perceived that the child was dead: therefore David said unto his servants, Is the child dead? And they said, He is dead.

David played with <u>09_1SA_18_10</u> # And it came to pass on the morrow, that the evil spirit from God came upon Saul, and he prophesied in the midst of the house: and David played with his hand, as at other times: and [there was] a javelin in Saul's hand.

David played with <u>09_1SA_19_09</u> # And the evil spirit from the LORD was upon Saul, as he sat in his house with his javelin in his hand: and David played with [his] hand.

David Plead my <u>19_PSA_35_01</u># [A Psalm] of David. Plead [my cause], O LORD, with them that strive with me: fight against them that fight against me.

David Praise waiteth <u>19_PSA_65_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm [and] Song of David. Praise waiteth for thee, O God, in Sion: and unto thee shall the vow be performed.

David praised by <u>14_2CH_07_06</u># And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of music of the LORD, which David the king had made to praise the LORD, because his mercy [endureth] for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded trumpets before them, and all

David prepared abundantly <u>13_1CH_22_05</u> # And David said, Solomon my son [is] young and tender, and the house [that is] to be builded for the LORD [must be] exceeding magnifical, of fame and of glory throughout all countries: I will [therefore] now make preparation for it. So David prepared abundantly before his death.

David prepared iron <u>13_1CH_22_03</u># And David prepared iron in abundance for the nails for the doors of the gates, and for the joinings; and brass in abundance without weight;

David Preserve me <u>19_PSA_16_01</u> # Michtam of David. Preserve me, O God: for in thee do I put my trust.

David prevailed over <u>09_1SA_17_50</u># So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and with a stone, and smote the Philistine, and slew him; but [there was] no sword in the hand of David.

David pursued he <u>09_1SA_30_10</u> # But David pursued, he and four hundred men: for two hundred abode behind, which were so faint that they could not go over the brook Besor.

David put garrisons <u>13_1CH_18_06</u># Then David put [garrisons] in Syriadamascus; and the Syrians became David's servants, [and] brought gifts. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

David put garrisons <u>10_2SA_08_06</u> # Then David put garrisons in Syria of Damascus: and the Syrians became servants to David, [and] brought gifts. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

David put his <u>09_1SA_17_49</u> # And David put his hand in his bag, and took thence a stone, and slang [it], and smote the Philistine in his forehead, that the stone sunk into his forehead; and he fell upon his face to the earth.

David put them <u>09_1SA_17_39</u># And David girded his sword upon his armour, and he assayed to go; for he had not proved [it]. And David said unto Saul, I cannot go with these; for I have not proved [them]. And David put them off him.

David ran and <u>09_1SA_17_51</u> # Therefore David ran, and stood upon the Philistine, and took his sword, and drew it out of the sheath thereof, and slew him, and cut off his head therewith. And when the Philistines saw their champion was dead, they fled.

David rather sent <u>10_2SA_10_03</u> # And the princes of the children of Ammon said unto Hanun their lord, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? hath not David [rather] sent his servants unto thee, to search the city, and to spy it out, and to overthrow it?

David received of <u>09_1SA_25_35</u># So David received of her hand [that] which she had brought him, and said unto her, Go up in peace to thine house; see, I have hearkened to thy voice, and have accepted thy person.

David received them <u>13_1CH_12_18</u># Then the spirit came upon Amasai, [who was] chief of the captains, [and he said], Thine [are we], David, and on thy side, thou son of Jesse: peace, peace [be] unto thee, and peace [be] to thine helpers; for thy God helpeth thee. Then David received them, and made them captains of the band.

David recovered all <u>09_1SA_30_18</u># And David recovered all that the Amalekites had carried away: and David rescued his two wives.

David recovered all <u>09_1SA_30_19</u># And there was nothing lacking to them, neither small nor great, neither sons nor daughters, neither spoil, nor any [thing] that they had taken to them: David recovered all.

David reigned over <u>13_1CH_18_14</u># So David reigned over all Israel, and executed judgment and justice among all his people.

David reigned over <u>11_1KI_02_11</u># And the days that David reigned over Israel [were] forty years: seven years reigned he in Hebron, and thirty and three years reigned he in Jerusalem.

David reigned over <u>10_2SA_08_15</u># And David reigned over all Israel; and David executed judgment and justice unto all his people.

David rescued his <u>09_1SA_30_18</u># And David recovered all that the Amalekites had carried away: and David rescued his two wives.

David returned from <u>09_18A_17_57</u># And as David returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, Abner took him, and brought him before Saul with the head of the Philistine in his hand.

David returned to <u>13_1CH_16_43</u> # And all the people departed every man to his house: and David returned to bless his house.

David returned to <u>10_2SA_06_20</u> # Then David returned to bless his household. And Michal the daughter of Saul came out to meet David, and said, How glorious was the king of Israel to day, who uncovered himself to day in the eyes of the handmaids of his servants, as one of the vain fellows shamelessly uncovereth himself!

David riding in <u>24_JER_17_25</u> # Then shall there enter into the gates of this city kings and princes sitting upon the throne of David, riding in chariots and on horses, they, and their princes, the men of Judah, and the inhabitants of Jerusalem: and this city shall remain for ever.

David riding in <u>24_JER_22_04</u># For if ye do this thing indeed, then shall there enter in by the gates of this house kings sitting upon the throne of David, riding in chariots and on horses, he, and his servants, and his people.

David rose up <u>09_1SA_17_20</u> # And David rose up early in the morning, and left the sheep with a keeper, and took, and went, as Jesse had commanded him; and he came to the trench, as the host was going forth to the fight, and shouted for the battle.

David said Against <u>09_1SA_27_10</u># And Achish said, Whither have ye made a road to day? And David said, Against the south of Judah, and against the south of the Jerahmeelites, and against the south of the Kenites.

David said Blessed <u>13_1CH_29_10</u> # Wherefore David blessed the LORD before all the congregation: and David said, Blessed [be] thou, LORD God of Israel our father, for ever and ever.

David said Call <u>11_1KI_01_32</u># And king David said, Call me Zadok the priest, and Nathan the prophet, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada. And they came before the king.

David said furthermore <u>09_1SA_26_10</u> # David said furthermore, [As] the LORD liveth, the LORD shall smite him; or his day shall come to die; or he shall descend into battle, and perish.

David said God <u>13_1CH_14_11</u># So they came up to Baalperazim; and David smote them there. Then David said, God hath broken in upon mine enemies by mine hand like the breaking forth of waters: therefore they called the name of that place Baalperazim.

David said I <u>13_1CH_19_02</u># And David said, I will show kindness unto Hanun the son of Nahash, because his father showed kindness to me. And David sent messengers to comfort him concerning his father. So the servants of David came into the land of the children of Ammon to Hanun, to comfort him.

David said If <u>10_2SA_15_33</u># Unto whom David said, If thou passest on with me, then thou shalt be a burden unto me:

David said in <u>09_1SA_27_01</u> # And David said in his heart, I shall now perish one day by the hand of Saul: [there is] nothing better for me than that I should speedily escape into the land of the Philistines; and Saul shall despair of me, to seek me any more in any coast of Israel: so shall I escape out of his hand.

David said Is <u>10_2SA_09_01</u># And David said, Is there yet any that is left of the house of Saul, that I may show him kindness for Jonathan's sake?

David said It <u>09_1SA_26_17</u># And Saul knew David's voice, and said, [Is] this thy voice, my son David? And David said, [It is] my voice, my lord, O king.

David said Mephibosheth <u>10_2SA_09_06</u> # Now when Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul, was come unto David, he fell on his face, and did reverence. And David said, Mephibosheth. And he answered, Behold thy servant!

David said moreover <u>09_1SA_17_37</u># David said moreover, The LORD that delivered me out of the paw of the lion, and out of the paw of the bear, he will deliver me out of the hand of this Philistine. And Saul said unto David, Go, and the LORD be with thee.

David said None <u>13_1CH_15_02</u># Then David said, None ought to carry the ark of God but the Levites: for them hath the LORD chosen to carry the ark of God, and to minister unto him for ever.

David said O <u>10_2SA_15_31</u> # And [one] told David, saying, Ahithophel [is] among the conspirators with Absalom. And David said, O LORD, I pray thee, turn the counsel of Ahithophel into foolishness.

David said on <u>10_2SA_05_08</u># And David said on that day, Whosoever getteth up to the gutter, and smiteth the Jebusites, and the lame and the blind, [that are] hated of David's soul, [he shall be chief and captain]. Wherefore they said, The blind and the lame shall not come into the house.

David said Seemeth <u>09_1SA_18_23</u> # And Saul's servants spake those words in the ears of David. And David said, Seemeth it to you [a] light [thing] to be a king's son in law, seeing that I [am] a poor man, and lightly esteemed?

David said Solomon <u>13_1CH_22_05</u> # And David said, Solomon my son [is] young and tender, and the house [that is] to be builded for the LORD [must be] exceeding magnifical, of fame and of glory throughout all countries: I will [therefore] now make preparation for it. So David prepared abundantly before his death.

David said The <u>13_1CH_23_25</u> # For David said, The LORD God of Israel hath given rest unto his people, that they may dwell in Jerusalem for ever:

David said There <u>09_1SA_21_09</u> # And the priest said, The sword of Goliath the Philistine, whom thou slewest in the valley of Elah, behold, it [is here] wrapped in a cloth behind the ephod: if thou wilt take that, take [it]: for [there is] no other save that here. And David said, [There is] none like that; give it me.

David said This <u>13_1CH_22_01</u> # Then David said, This [is] the house of the LORD God, and this [is] the altar of the burnt offering for Israel.

David said to <u>13_1CH_17_01</u># Now it came to pass, as David sat in his house, that David said to Nathan the prophet, Lo, I dwell in an house of cedars, but the ark of the covenant of the LORD [remaineth] under curtains.

David said to <u>13_1CH_21_02</u># And David said to Joab and to the rulers of the people, Go, number Israel from Beersheba even to Dan; and bring the number of them to me, that I may know [it].

David said to <u>13_1CH_21_22</u> # Then David said to Ornan, Grant me the place of [this] threshingfloor, that I may build an altar therein unto the LORD: thou shalt grant it me for the full price: that the plague may be stayed from the people.

David said to <u>13_1CH_21_24</u> # And king David said to Ornan, Nay; but I will verily buy it for the full price: for I will not take [that] which [is] thine for the LORD, nor offer burnt offerings without cost.

David said to <u>13_1CH_22_07</u> # And David said to Solomon, My son, as for me, it was in my mind to build an house unto the name of the LORD my God:

David said to <u>13_1CH_28_20</u> # And David said to Solomon his son, Be strong and of good courage, and do [it]: fear not, nor be dismayed: for the LORD God, [even] my God, [will be] with thee; he will not fail thee, nor forsake thee, until thou hast finished all the work for the service of the house of the LORD.

David said to <u>13_1CH_29_20</u> # And David said to all the congregation, Now bless the LORD your God. And all the congregation blessed the LORD God of their fathers, and bowed down their heads, and worshipped the LORD, and the king.

David said to <u>09_1SA_17_32</u># And David said to Saul, Let no man's heart fail because of him; thy servant will go and fight with this Philistine.

David said to <u>09_1SA_24_09</u># And David said to Saul, Wherefore hearest thou men's words, saying, Behold, David seeketh thy hurt?

David said to <u>09_1SA_25_32</u># And David said to Abigail, Blessed [be] the LORD God of Israel, which sent thee this day to meet me:

David said to <u>09_1SA_26_09</u># And David said to Abishai, Destroy him not: for who can stretch forth his hand against the LORD'S anointed, and be guiltless?

David said to <u>09_1SA_26_15</u> # And David said to Abner, [Art] not thou a [valiant] man? and who [is] like to thee in Israel? wherefore then hast thou not kept thy lord the king? for there came one of the people in to destroy the king thy lord.

David said to <u>09_1SA_28_02</u> # And David said to Achish, Surely thou shalt know what thy servant can do. And Achish said to David, Therefore will I make thee keeper of mine head for ever.

David said to <u>09_1SA_30_07</u> # And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David.

David said to <u>09_1SA_30_15</u> # And David said to him, Canst thou bring me down to this company? And he said, Swear unto me by God, that thou wilt neither kill me, nor deliver me into the hands of my master, and I will bring thee down to this company.

David said to <u>10_2SA_03_31</u> # And David said to Joab, and to all the people that [were] with him, Rend your clothes, and gird you with sackcloth, and mourn before Abner. And king David [himself] followed the bier.

David said to <u>10_2SA_11_08</u># And David said to Uriah, Go down to thy house, and wash thy feet. And Uriah departed out of the king's house, and there followed him a mess [of meat] from the king.

David said to <u>10_2SA_11_12</u># And David said to Uriah, Tarry here to day also, and to morrow I will let

thee depart. So Uriah abode in Jerusalem that day, and the morrow.

David said to <u>10_2SA_15_22</u> # And David said to Ittai, Go and pass over. And Ittai the Gittite passed over, and all his men, and all the little ones that [were] with him.

David said to <u>10_2SA_16_11</u># And David said to Abishai, and to all his servants, Behold, my son, which came forth of my bowels, seeketh my life: how much more now [may this] Benjamite [do it]? let him alone, and let him curse; for the LORD hath bidden him.

David said to <u>10_2SA_20_06</u> # And David said to Abishai, Now shall Sheba the son of Bichri do us more harm than [did] Absalom: take thou thy lord's servants, and pursue after him, lest he get him fenced cities, and escape us.

David said To <u>10_2SA_24_21</u> # And Araunah said, Wherefore is my lord the king come to his servant? And David said, To buy the threshingfloor of thee, to build an altar unto the LORD, that the plague may be stayed from the people.

David said unto <u>13_1CH_13_02</u> # And David said unto all the congregation of Israel, If [it seem] good unto you, and [that it be] of the LORD our God, let us send abroad unto our brethren every where, [that are] left in all the land of Israel, and with them [also] to the priests and Levites [which are] in their cities [and] suburbs, that they may gather themselves unto us:

David said unto <u>13_1CH_21_08</u> # And David said unto God, I have sinned greatly, because I have done this thing: but now, I beseech thee, do away the iniquity of thy servant; for I have done very foolishly.

David said unto <u>13_1CH_21_13</u> # And David said unto Gad, I am in a great strait: let me fall now into the hand of the LORD; for very great [are] his mercies: but let me not fall into the hand of man.

David said unto <u>13_1CH_21_17</u> # And David said unto God, [Is it] not I [that] commanded the people to be numbered? even I it is that have sinned and done evil indeed; but [as for] these sheep, what have they done? let thine hand, I pray thee, O LORD my God, be on me, and on my father's house; but not on thy people, that they should be plagued.

David said unto <u>09_1SA_17_34</u> # And David said unto Saul, Thy servant kept his father's sheep, and there came a lion, and a bear, and took a lamb out of the flock:

David said unto <u>09_1SA_17_39</u># And David girded his sword upon his armour, and he assayed to go; for he had not proved [it]. And David said unto Saul, I cannot go with these; for I have not proved [them]. And David put them off him.

David said unto 09_18A_18_18 # And David said unto Saul, Who [am] I? and what [is] my life, [or] my father's family in Israel, that I should be son in law to the king?

David said unto <u>09_1SA_20_05</u># And David said unto Jonathan, Behold, to morrow [is] the new moon, and I should not fail to sit with the king at meat: but let me go, that I may hide myself in the field unto the third [day] at even.

David said unto <u>09_1SA_21_02</u># And David said unto Ahimelech the priest, The king hath commanded me a business, and hath said unto me, Let no man know any thing of the business whereabout I send thee, and what I have commanded thee: and I have appointed [my] servants to such and such a place.

David said unto <u>09_1SA_21_08</u># And David said unto Ahimelech, And is there not here under thine hand spear or sword? for I have neither brought my sword nor my weapons with me, because the king's business required haste.

David said unto <u>09_18A_22_22</u># And David said unto Abiathar, I knew [it] that day, when Doeg the Edomite [was] there, that he would surely tell Saul: I have occasioned [the death] of all the persons of thy father's house.

David said unto <u>09_1SA_24_04</u> # And the men of David said unto him, Behold the day of which the LORD said unto thee, Behold, I will deliver thine enemy into thine hand, that thou mayest do to him as it shall seem good unto thee. Then David arose, and cut off the skirt of Saul's robe privily.

David said unto <u>09_1SA_25_05</u># And David sent out ten young men, and David said unto the young men, Get you up to Carmel, and go to Nabal, and greet him in my name:

David said unto <u>09_1SA_25_13</u> # And David said unto his men, Gird ye on every man his sword. And they girded on every man his sword; and David also girded on his sword: and there went up after David about four hundred men; and two hundred abode by the stuff.

David said unto <u>09_18A_27_05</u># And David said unto Achish, If I have now found grace in thine eyes, let them give me a place in some town in the country, that I may dwell there: for why should thy servant dwell in the royal city with thee?

David said unto <u>09_1SA_29_08</u># And David said unto Achish, But what have I done? and what hast thou found in thy servant so long as I have been with thee unto this day, that I may not go fight against the enemies of my lord the king?

David said unto <u>09_1SA_30_13</u> # And David said unto him, To whom [belongest] thou? and whence [art] thou? And he said, I [am] a young man of Egypt, servant to an Amalekite; and my master left me, because three days ago I fell sick.

David said unto <u>10_28A_01_03</u> # And David said unto him, From whence comest thou? And he said unto him, Out of the camp of Israel am I escaped.

David said unto <u>10_28A_01_04</u># And David said unto him, How went the matter? I pray thee, tell me. And he answered, That the people are fled from the battle, and many of the people also are fallen and dead; and Saul and Jonathan his son are dead also.

David said unto <u>10_2SA_01_05</u># And David said unto the young man that told him, How knowest thou that Saul and Jonathan his son be dead?

David said unto <u>10_2SA_01_13</u> # And David said unto the young man that told him, Whence [art] thou? And he answered, I [am] the son of a stranger, an Amalekite.

David said unto <u>10_2SA_01_14</u> # And David said unto him, How wast thou not afraid to stretch forth thine hand to destroy the LORD'S anointed?

David said unto <u>10_2SA_01_16</u># And David said unto him, Thy blood [be] upon thy head; for thy mouth hath testified against thee, saying, I have slain the LORD'S anointed.

David saved neither <u>09_18A_27_11</u># And David saved neither man nor woman alive, to bring [tidings] to Gath, saying, Lest they should tell on us, saying, So did David, and so [will be] his manner all the while he

dwelleth in the country of the Philistines.

David saved the <u>09_18A_23_05</u># So David and his men went to Keilah, and fought with the Philistines, and brought away their cattle, and smote them with a great slaughter. So David saved the inhabitants of Keilah.

David The heavens <u>19_PSA_19_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. The heavens declare the glory of God; and the firmament showeth his handiwork.

David the king <u>13_1CH_17_16</u># And David the king came and sat before the LORD, and said, Who [am] I,

O LORD God, and what [is] mine house, that thou hast brought me hitherto?

David the king <u>13_1CH_24_31</u> # These likewise cast lots over against their brethren the sons of Aaron in the presence of David the king, and Zadok, and Ahimelech, and the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites, even the principal fathers over against their younger brethren.

David the king <u>13_1CH_26_26</u># Which Shelomith and his brethren [were] over all the treasures of the dedicated things, which David the king, and the chief fathers, the captains over thousands and hundreds, and the captains of the host, had dedicated.

David the king <u>13_1CH_28_02</u> # Then David the king stood up upon his feet, and said, Hear me, my brethren, and my people: [As for me], I [had] in mine heart to build an house of rest for the ark of the covenant of the LORD, and for the footstool of our God, and had made ready for the building:

David the king <u>13_1CH_29_01</u> # Furthermore David the king said unto all the congregation, Solomon my son, whom alone God hath chosen, [is yet] young and tender, and the work [is] great: for the palace [is] not for man, but for the LORD God.

David the king <u>13_1CH_29_09</u> # Then the people rejoiced, for that they offered willingly, because with perfect heart they offered willingly to the LORD: and David the king also rejoiced with great joy.

David the king <u>13_1CH_29_29</u> # Now the acts of David the king, first and last, behold, they [are] written in the book of Samuel the seer, and in the book of Nathan the prophet, and in the book of Gad the seer,

David The king <u>09_1SA_18_25</u> # And Saul said, Thus shall ye say to David, The king desireth not any dowry, but an hundred foreskins of the Philistines, to be avenged of the king's enemies. But Saul thought to make David fall by the hand of the Philistines.

David the king <u>09_1SA_21_11</u># And the servants of Achish said unto him, [Is] not this David the king of the land? did they not sing one to another of him in dances, saying, Saul hath slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands?

David the king <u>14_2CH_02_12</u> # Huram said moreover, Blessed [be] the LORD God of Israel, that made heaven and earth, who hath given to David the king a wise son, endued with prudence and understanding, that might build an house for the LORD, and an house for his kingdom.

David the king <u>14_2CH_07_06</u> # And the priests waited on their offices: the Levites also with instruments of music of the LORD, which David the king had made to praise the LORD, because his mercy [endureth] for ever, when David praised by their ministry; and the priests sounded trumpets before them, and all Israel stood.

David the king <u>10_2SA_09_02</u> # And [there was] of the house of Saul a servant whose name [was] Ziba. And when they had called him unto David, the king said unto him, [Art] thou Ziba? And he said, Thy servant [is he].

David the king <u>40_MAT_01_06</u># And Jesse begat David the king; and David the king begat Solomon of her [that had been the wife] of Urias;

David the king <u>40_MAT_01_06</u># And Jesse begat David the king; and David the king begat Solomon of her [that had been the wife] of Urias;

David The king <u>19_PSA_21_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. The king shall joy in thy strength, O LORD; and in thy salvation how greatly shall he rejoice!

David the Levites <u>13_1CH_23_27</u> # For by the last words of David the Levites [were] numbered from

David The LORD <u>10_28A_12_13</u> # And David said unto Nathan, I have sinned against the LORD. And Nathan said unto David, The LORD also hath put away thy sin; thou shalt not die.

David The LORD <u>19_PSA_110_01</u># A Psalm of David. The LORD said unto my Lord, Sit thou at my right hand, until I make thine enemies thy footstool.

David The LORD <u>19_PSA_20_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David. The LORD hear thee in the day of trouble; the name of the God of Jacob defend thee;

David The LORD 19_PSA_23_01 # A Psalm of David. The LORD [is] my shepherd; I shall not want.

David The LORD <u>19_PSA_27_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David. The LORD [is] my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the LORD [is] the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?

David the man <u>14_2CH_08_14</u> # And he appointed, according to the order of David his father, the courses of the priests to their service, and the Levites to their charges, to praise and minister before the priests, as the duty of every day required: the porters also by their courses at every gate: for so had David the man of God commanded.

David the man <u>16_NEH_12_24</u># And the chief of the Levites: Hashabiah, Sherebiah, and Jeshua the son of Kadmiel, with their brethren over against them, to praise [and] to give thanks, according to the commandment of David the man of God, ward over against ward.

David the man <u>16_NEH_12_36</u># And his brethren, Shemaiah, and Azarael, Milalai, Gilalai, Maai, Nethaneel, and Judah, Hanani, with the musical instruments of David the man of God, and Ezra the scribe before them.

David the servant <u>09_1SA_29_03</u> # Then said the princes of the Philistines, What [do] these Hebrews [here]? And Achish said unto the princes of the Philistines, [Is] not this David, the servant of Saul the king of Israel, which hath been with me these days, or these years, and I have found no fault in him since he fell [unto me] unto this day?

David the servant <u>19_PSA_18_01</u> # To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David, the servant of the LORD, who spake unto the LORD the words of this song in the day [that] the LORD delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul: And he said, I will love thee, O LORD, my strength.

David the servant <u>19_PSA_36_01</u># To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David the servant of the LORD. The transgression of the wicked saith within my heart, [that there is] no fear of God before his eyes.

David the seventh <u>13_1CH_02_15</u> # Ozem the sixth, David the seventh:

David the son <u>13_1CH_10_14</u> # And inquired not of the LORD: therefore he slew him, and turned the kingdom unto David the son of Jesse.

David the son <u>13_1CH_29_26</u># Thus David the son of Jesse reigned over all Israel.

David the son <u>10_2SA_23_01</u> # Now these [be] the last words of David. David the son of Jesse said, and the man [who was] raised up on high, the anointed of the God of Jacob, and the sweet psalmist of Israel, said,

David the son <u>44_ACT_13_22</u> # And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their

king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the [son] of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.

David the son <u>40_MAT_01_01</u># The book of the generation of Jesus Christ, the son of David, the son of Abraham.

David the son <u>19_PSA_72_20</u> # The prayers of David the son of Jesse are ended.

David their king <u>28_HOS_03_05</u># Afterward shall the children of Israel return, and seek the LORD their God, and David their king; and shall fear the LORD and his goodness in the latter days.

David their king <u>24_JER_30_09</u> # But they shall serve the LORD their God, and David their king, whom I will raise up unto them.

David then call <u>40_MAT_22_45</u># If David then call him Lord, how is he his son?

David therefore besought <u>10_2SA_12_16</u> # David therefore besought God for the child; and David fasted, and went in, and lay all night upon the earth.

David therefore calleth <u>42_LUK_20_44</u> # David therefore calleth him Lord, how is he then his son?

David therefore departed <u>09_1SA_22_01</u> # David therefore departed thence, and escaped to the cave Adullam: and when his brethren and all his father's house heard [it], they went down thither to him.

David therefore did <u>13_1CH_14_16</u># David therefore did as God commanded him: and they smote the host of the Philistines from Gibeon even to Gazer.

David therefore himself <u>41_MAR_12_37</u> # David therefore himself calleth him Lord; and whence is he [then] his son? And the common people heard him gladly.

David therefore sent <u>09_1SA_26_04</u> # David therefore sent out spies, and understood that Saul was come in very deed.

David Therefore will <u>09_1SA_28_02</u> # And David said to Achish, Surely thou shalt know what thy servant can do. And Achish said to David, Therefore will I make thee keeper of mine head for ever.

David these words <u>09_1SA_18_26</u># And when his servants told David these words, it pleased David well to be the king's son in law: and the days were not expired.

David they were <u>13_1CH_26_31</u> # Among the Hebronites [was] Jerijah the chief, [even] among the Hebronites, according to the generations of his fathers. In the fortieth year of the reign of David they were sought for, and there were found among them mighty men of valour at Jazer of Gilead.

David they were <u>40_MAT_21_15</u># And when the chief priests and scribes saw the wonderful things that he did, and the children crying in the temple, and saying, Hosanna to the son of David; they were sore displeased,

David this night <u>10_2SA_17_01</u> # Moreover Ahithophel said unto Absalom, Let me now choose out twelve thousand men, and I will arise and pursue after David this night:

David thou and <u>24_JER_22_02</u># And say, Hear the word of the LORD, O king of Judah, that sittest upon the throne of David, thou, and thy servants, and thy people that enter in by these gates:

David Thou art <u>09_1SA_17_33</u># And Saul said to David, Thou art not able to go against this Philistine to fight with him: for thou [art but] a youth, and he a man of war from his youth.

David Thou art <u>09_18A_24_17</u> # And he said to David, Thou [art] more righteous than I: for thou hast rewarded me good, whereas I have rewarded thee evil.

David Thou art <u>10_2SA_12_07</u> # And Nathan said to David, Thou [art] the man. Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, I anointed thee king over Israel, and I delivered thee out of the hand of Saul;

David Thou shalt <u>13_1CH_11_05</u># And the inhabitants of Jebus said to David, Thou shalt not come hither. Nevertheless David took the castle of Zion, which [is] the city of David.

David Thou shalt <u>09_1SA_18_21</u> # And Saul said, I will give him her, that she may be a snare to him, and that the hand of the Philistines may be against him. Wherefore Saul said to David, Thou shalt this day be my son in law in [the one of] the twain.

David thou shalt <u>09_1SA_26_25</u># Then Saul said to David, Blessed [be] thou, my son David: thou shalt both do great [things], and also shalt still prevail. So David went on his way, and Saul returned to his place.

David three days <u>13_1CH_12_39</u> # And there they were with David three days, eating and drinking: for their brethren had prepared for them.

David three years <u>10_2SA_21_01</u> # Then there was a famine in the days of David three years, year after year; and David inquired of the LORD. And the LORD answered, [It is] for Saul, and for [his] bloody house, because he slew the Gibeonites.

David Thus saith <u>13_1CH_17_07</u> # Now therefore thus shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, [even] from following the sheep, that thou shouldest be ruler over my people Israel:

David Thus saith <u>10_2SA_07_05</u># Go and tell my servant David, Thus saith the LORD, Shalt thou build me an house for me to dwell in?

David Thus saith <u>10_2SA_07_08</u> # Now therefore so shalt thou say unto my servant David, Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I took thee from the sheepcote, from following the sheep, to be ruler over my people, over Israel:

David Thus saith <u>10_2SA_24_12</u> # Go and say unto David, Thus saith the LORD, I offer thee three [things]; choose thee one of them, that I may [do it] unto thee.

David thus saith <u>24_JER_21_12</u> # O house of David, thus saith the LORD; Execute judgment in the morning, and deliver [him that is] spoiled out of the hand of the oppressor, lest my fury go out like fire, and burn that none can quench [it], because of the evil of your doings.

David thy father <u>11_1KI_06_12</u># [Concerning] this house which thou art in building, if thou wilt walk in my statutes, and execute my judgments, and keep all my commandments to walk in them; then will I perform my word with thee, which I spake unto David thy father:

David thy father <u>11_1KI_09_04</u> # And if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, in integrity of heart, and in uprightness, to do according to all that I have commanded thee, [and] wilt keep my statutes and my judgments:

David thy father <u>11_1KI_09_05</u># Then I will establish the throne of thy kingdom upon Israel for ever, as I promised to David thy father, saying, There shall not fail thee a man upon the throne of Israel.

David thy father <u>14_2CH_02_14</u> # The son of a woman of the daughters of Dan, and his father [was] a man of Tyre, skilful to work in gold, and in silver, in brass, in iron, in stone, and in timber, in purple, in blue,

and in fine linen, and in crimson; also to grave any manner of graving, and to find out every device which shall be put to him, with thy cunning men, and with the cunning men of my lord David thy father.

David thy father <u>14_2CH_07_17</u> # And as for thee, if thou wilt walk before me, as David thy father walked, and do according to all that I have commanded thee, and shalt observe my statutes and my judgments;

David thy father <u>14_2CH_07_18</u># Then will I stablish the throne of thy kingdom, according as I have covenanted with David thy father, saying, There shall not fail thee a man [to be] ruler in Israel.

David thy father <u>14_2CH_21_12</u> # And there came a writing to him from Elijah the prophet, saying, Thus saith the LORD God of David thy father, Because thou hast not walked in the ways of Jehoshaphat thy father, nor in the ways of Asa king of Judah,

David thy father <u>12_2KI_20_05</u> # Turn again, and tell Hezekiah the captain of my people, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will heal thee: on the third day thou shalt go up unto the house of the LORD.

David thy father <u>23_ISA_38_05</u> # Go, and say to Hezekiah, Thus saith the LORD, the God of David thy father, I have heard thy prayer, I have seen thy tears: behold, I will add unto thy days fifteen years.

David thy father's <u>11_1KI_11_12</u># Notwithstanding in thy days I will not do it for David thy father's sake: [but] I will rend it out of the hand of thy son.

David thy servant <u>13_1CH_17_24</u> # Let it even be established, that thy name may be magnified for ever, saying, The LORD of hosts [is] the God of Israel, [even] a God to Israel: and [let] the house of David thy servant [be] established before thee.

David thy servant <u>14_2CH_06_42</u> # O LORD God, turn not away the face of thine anointed: remember the mercies of David thy servant.

David thy son <u>09_1SA_16_19</u> # Wherefore Saul sent messengers unto Jesse, and said, Send me David thy son, which [is] with the sheep.

David to be <u>11_1KI_08_16</u># Since the day that I brought forth my people Israel out of Egypt, I chose no city out of all the tribes of Israel to build an house, that my name might be therein; but I chose David to be over my people Israel.

David to be <u>14_2CH_06_06</u> # But I have chosen Jerusalem, that my name might be there; and have chosen David to be over my people Israel.

David to be <u>44_ACT_13_22</u> # And when he had removed him, he raised up unto them David to be their king; to whom also he gave testimony, and said, I have found David the [son] of Jesse, a man after mine own heart, which shall fulfil all my will.

David to bring <u>19_PSA_38_01</u># A Psalm of David, to bring to remembrance. O LORD, rebuke me not in thy wrath: neither chasten me in thy hot displeasure.

David to bring <u>19_PSA_70_01</u># To the chief Musician, [A Psalm] of David, to bring to remembrance. [Make haste], O God, to deliver me; make haste to help me, O LORD.

David to bud <u>19_PSA_132_17</u># There will I make the horn of David to bud: I have ordained a lamp for mine anointed.

David To day <u>58_HEB_04_07</u> # Again, he limiteth a certain day, saying in David, To day, after so long a time; as it is said, To day if ye will hear his voice, harden not your hearts.

David to eat <u>10_2SA_03_35</u> # And when all the people came to cause David to eat meat while it was yet day, David sware, saying, So do God to me, and more also, if I taste bread, or ought else, till the sun be down.

David to Hebron <u>13_1CH_12_23</u> # And these [are] the numbers of the bands [that were] ready armed to the war, [and] came to David to Hebron, to turn the kingdom of Saul to him, according to the word of the LORD.

David to Hebron <u>10_2SA_03_20</u> # So Abner came to David to Hebron, and twenty men with him. And David made Abner and the men that [were] with him a feast.

David to Hebron <u>10_2SA_04_08</u># And they brought the head of Ishbosheth unto David to Hebron, and said to the king, Behold the head of Ishbosheth the son of Saul thine enemy, which sought thy life; and the LORD hath avenged my lord the king this day of Saul, and of his seed.

David to help <u>13_1CH_12_22</u> # For at [that] time day by day there came to David to help him, until [it was] a great host, like the host of God.

David to inquire <u>13_1CH_18_10</u># He sent Hadoram his son to king David, to inquire of his welfare, and to congratulate him, because he had fought against Hadarezer, and smitten him; [for Hadarezer had war with Tou;] and [with him] all manner of vessels of gold and silver and brass.

David to Jonathan <u>09_1SA_20_10</u> # Then said David to Jonathan, Who shall tell me? or what [if] thy father answer thee roughly?

David to Keilah <u>09_18A_23_06</u># And it came to pass, when Abiathar the son of Ahimelech fled to David to Keilah, [that] he came down [with] an ephod in his hand.

David To morrow <u>09_1SA_20_18</u> # Then Jonathan said to David, To morrow [is] the new moon: and thou shalt be missed, because thy seat will be empty.

David to Nob <u>09_1SA_21_01</u># Then came David to Nob to Ahimelech the priest: and Ahimelech was afraid at the meeting of David, and said unto him, Why [art] thou alone, and no man with thee?

David to number <u>13_1CH_21_01</u># And Satan stood up against Israel, and provoked David to number Israel.

David to praise <u>13_1CH_23_05</u> # Moreover four thousand [were] porters; and four thousand praised the LORD with the instruments which I made, [said David], to praise [therewith].

David to salute <u>10_2SA_08_10</u> # Then Toi sent Joram his son unto king David, to salute him, and to bless him, because he had fought against Hadadezer, and smitten him: for Hadadezer had wars with Toi. And [Joram] brought with him vessels of silver, and vessels of gold, and vessels of brass:

David to Saul <u>09_1SA_19_07</u># And Jonathan called David, and Jonathan showed him all those things. And Jonathan brought David to Saul, and he was in his presence, as in times past.

David to swear <u>09_1SA_20_17</u># And Jonathan caused David to swear again, because he loved him: for he loved him as he loved his own soul.

David to teach <u>19_PSA_60_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Joab returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.

David to the <u>09_1SA_17_45</u># Then said David to the Philistine, Thou comest to me with a sword, and with a spear, and with a shield: but I come to thee in the name of the LORD of hosts, the God of the armies of Israel, whom thou hast defied.

David to wife <u>14_2CH_11_18</u># And Rehoboam took him Mahalath the daughter of Jerimoth the son of David to wife, [and] Abihail the daughter of Eliab the son of Jesse;

David to Ziklag <u>13_1CH_12_01</u> # Now these [are] they that came to David to Ziklag, while he yet kept himself close because of Saul the son of Kish: and they [were] among the mighty men, helpers of the war.

David took all <u>09_1SA_30_20</u> # And David took all the flocks and the herds, [which] they drave before those [other] cattle, and said, This [is] David's spoil.

David took an <u>09_1SA_16_23</u># And it came to pass, when the [evil] spirit from God was upon Saul, that David took an harp, and played with his hand: so Saul was refreshed, and was well, and the evil spirit departed from him.

David took exceeding <u>10_2SA_08_08</u> # And from Betah, and from Berothai, cities of Hadadezer, king David took exceeding much brass.

David took from <u>13_1CH_18_04</u> # And David took from him a thousand chariots, and seven thousand horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: David also hocked all the chariot [horses], but reserved of them an hundred chariots.

David took from <u>10_2SA_08_04</u> # And David took from him a thousand [chariots], and seven hundred horsemen, and twenty thousand footmen: and David hocked all the chariot [horses], but reserved of them [for] an hundred chariots.

David took him <u>10_2SA_05_13</u> # And David took [him] more concubines and wives out of Jerusalem, after he was come from Hebron: and there were yet sons and daughters born to David.

David took hold <u>10_2SA_01_11</u># Then David took hold on his clothes, and rent them; and likewise all the men that [were] with him:

David took Methegammah <u>10_2SA_08_01</u> # And after this it came to pass, that David smote the Philistines, and subdued them: and David took Methegammah out of the hand of the Philistines.

David took more <u>13_1CH_14_03</u> # And David took more wives at Jerusalem: and David begat more sons and daughters.

David took not <u>13_1CH_27_23</u> # But David took not the number of them from twenty years old and under: because the LORD had said he would increase Israel like to the stars of the heavens.

David took the <u>13_1CH_11_05</u># And the inhabitants of Jebus said to David, Thou shalt not come hither. Nevertheless David took the castle of Zion, which [is] the city of David.

David took the <u>13_1CH_18_07</u> # And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadarezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.

David took the <u>13_1CH_20_02</u> # And David took the crown of their king from off his head, and found it to weigh a talent of gold, and [there were] precious stones in it; and it was set upon David's head: and he brought also exceeding much spoil out of the city.

David took the <u>09_18A_17_54</u># And David took the head of the Philistine, and brought it to Jerusalem; but he put his armour in his tent.

David took the <u>09_1SA_26_12</u> # So David took the spear and the cruse of water from Saul's bolster; and they gat them away, and no man saw [it], nor knew [it], neither awaked: for they [were] all asleep; because a deep sleep from the LORD was fallen upon them.

David took the <u>10_2SA_05_07</u># Nevertheless David took the strong hold of Zion: the same [is] the city of David.

David took the <u>10_2SA_08_07</u># And David took the shields of gold that were on the servants of Hadadezer, and brought them to Jerusalem.

David Truly my <u>19_PSA_62_01</u># To the chief Musician, to Jeduthun, A Psalm of David. Truly my soul waiteth upon God: from him [cometh] my salvation.

David two and <u>13_1CH_07_02</u> # And the sons of Tola; Uzzi, and Rephaiah, and Jeriel, and Jahmai, and Jibsam, and Shemuel, heads of their father's house, [to wit], of Tola: [they were] valiant men of might in their generations; whose number [was] in the days of David two and twenty thousand and six hundred.

David until he <u>11_1KI_03_01</u># And Solomon made affinity with Pharaoh king of Egypt, and took Pharaoh's daughter, and brought her into the city of David, until he had made an end of building his own house, and the house of the LORD, and the wall of Jerusalem round about.

David until the <u>40_MAT_01_17</u># So all the generations from Abraham to David [are] fourteen generations; and from David until the carrying away into Babylon [are] fourteen generations; and from the carrying away into Babylon unto Christ [are] fourteen generations.

David unto Hebron <u>13_1CH_11_01</u># Then all Israel gathered themselves to David unto Hebron, saying, Behold, we [are] thy bone and thy flesh.

David unto Hebron <u>10_2SA_05_01</u> # Then came all the tribes of Israel to David unto Hebron, and spake, saying, Behold, we [are] thy bone and thy flesh.

David unto her <u>11_1KI_09_24</u># But Pharaoh's daughter came up out of the city of David unto her house which [Solomon] had built for her: then did he build Millo.

David unto Saul <u>09_1SA_19_04</u> # And Jonathan spake good of David unto Saul his father, and said unto him, Let not the king sin against his servant, against David; because he hath not sinned against thee, and because his works [have been] to thee ward very good:

David unto the <u>14_2CH_08_11</u> # And Solomon brought up the daughter of Pharaoh out of the city of David unto the house that he had built for her: for he said, My wife shall not dwell in the house of David king of Israel, because [the places are] holy, whereunto the ark of the LORD hath come.

David Unto thee <u>19_PSA_25_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David. Unto thee, O LORD, do I lift up my soul.

David Unto thee <u>19_PSA_28_01</u># [A Psalm] of David. Unto thee will I cry, O LORD my rock; be not silent to me: lest, [if] thou be silent to me, I become like them that go down into the pit.

David unto this <u>11_1KI_12_19</u># So Israel rebelled against the house of David unto this day.

David unto this <u>14_2CH_10_19</u> # And Israel rebelled against the house of David unto this day.

David very much <u>13_1CH_18_08</u># Likewise from Tibhath, and from Chun, cities of Hadarezer, brought David very much brass, wherewith Solomon made the brazen sea, and the pillars, and the vessels of brass.

David was a <u>10_2SA_16_01</u> # And when David was a little past the top [of the hill], behold, Ziba the servant of Mephibosheth met him, with a couple of asses saddled, and upon them two hundred [loaves] of bread, and an hundred bunches of raisins, and an hundred of summer fruits, and a bottle of wine.

David was afraid <u>13_1CH_13_12</u># And David was afraid of God that day, saying, How shall I bring the ark of God [home] to me?

David was afraid <u>10_2SA_06_09</u># And David was afraid of the LORD that day, and said, How shall the ark of the LORD come to me?

David was anointed <u>13_1CH_14_08</u> # And when the Philistines heard that David was anointed king over all Israel, all the Philistines went up to seek David. And David heard [of it], and went out against them.

David was clothed <u>13_1CH_15_27</u># And David [was] clothed with a robe of fine linen, and all the Levites that bare the ark, and the singers, and Chenaniah the master of the song with the singers: David also [had] upon him an ephod of linen.

David was come <u>09_1SA_23_07</u> # And it was told Saul that David was come to Keilah. And Saul said, God hath delivered him into mine hand; for he is shut in, by entering into a town that hath gates and bars.

David was come <u>10_2SA_15_32</u> # And it came to pass, that [when] David was come to the top [of the mount], where he worshipped God, behold, Hushai the Archite came to meet him with his coat rent, and earth upon his head:

David was come <u>10_2SA_17_27</u> # And it came to pass, when David was come to Mahanaim, that Shobi the son of Nahash of Rabbah of the children of Ammon, and Machir the son of Ammiel of Lodebar, and Barzillai the Gileadite of Rogelim,

David was discovered <u>09_1SA_22_06</u># When Saul heard that David was discovered, and the men that [were] with him, [now Saul abode in Gibeah under a tree in Ramah, having his spear in his hand, and all his servants [were] standing about him;]

David was displeased <u>13_1CH_13_11</u># And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzza: wherefore that place is called Perezuzza to this day.

David was displeased <u>10_2SA_06_08</u> # And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzzah: and he called the name of the place Perezuzzah to this day.

David was escaped <u>09_1SA_23_13</u># Then David and his men, [which were] about six hundred, arose and departed out of Keilah, and went whithersoever they could go. And it was told Saul that David was escaped from Keilah; and he forbare to go forth.

David was fled <u>09_18A_27_04</u># And it was told Saul that David was fled to Gath: and he sought no more again for him.

David was girded <u>10_2SA_06_14</u> # And David danced before the LORD with all [his] might; and David [was] girded with a linen ephod.

David was greatly <u>09_1SA_30_06</u> # And David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.

David was in <u>11_1KI_11_15</u># For it came to pass, when David was in Edom, and Joab the captain of the host was gone up to bury the slain, after he had smitten every male in Edom;

David was in <u>09_1SA_22_04</u> # And he brought them before the king of Moab: and they dwelt with him all the while that David was in the hold.

David was in <u>09_1SA_23_15</u> # And David saw that Saul was come out to seek his life: and David [was] in the wilderness of Ziph in a wood.

David was king <u>10_2SA_02_11</u># And the time that David was king in Hebron over the house of Judah was seven years and six months.

David was old <u>13_1CH_23_01</u># So when David was old and full of days, he made Solomon his son king over Israel.

David was old <u>11_1KI_01_01</u># Now king David was old [and] stricken in years; and they covered him with clothes, but he gat no heat.

David was raised <u>55_2TI_02_08</u># Remember that Jesus Christ of the seed of David was raised from the dead according to my gospel:

David was returned <u>09_1SA_18_06</u># And it came to pass as they came, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Philistine, that the women came out of all cities of Israel, singing and dancing, to meet king Saul, with tabrets, with joy, and with instruments of music.

David was returned <u>10_2SA_01_01</u># Now it came to pass after the death of Saul, when David was returned from the slaughter of the Amalekites, and David had abode two days in Ziklag;

David was strengthened <u>14_2CH_01_01</u> # And Solomon the son of David was strengthened in his kingdom, and the LORD his God [was] with him, and magnified him exceedingly.

David was the <u>09_1SA_17_12</u> # Now David [was] the son of that Ephrathite of Bethlehemjudah, whose name [was] Jesse; and he had eight sons: and the man went among men [for] an old man in the days of Saul.

David was the <u>09_1SA_17_14</u> # And David [was] the youngest: and the three eldest followed Saul.

David was then <u>13_1CH_11_16</u># And David [was] then in the hold, and the Philistines' garrison [was] then at Bethlehem.

David was then <u>10_2SA_23_14</u> # And David [was] then in an hold, and the garrison of the Philistines [was] then [in] Bethlehem.

David was thirty <u>10_2SA_05_04</u> # David [was] thirty years old when he began to reign, [and] he reigned forty years.

David was up <u>10_2SA_24_11</u># For when David was up in the morning, the word of the LORD came unto the prophet Gad, David's seer, saying,

David was <u>43_JOH_07_42</u> # Hath not the scripture said, That Christ cometh of the seed of David, and out of the town of Bethlehem, where David was?

David waxed faint <u>10_2SA_21_15</u> # Moreover the Philistines had yet war again with Israel; and David went down, and his servants with him, and fought against the Philistines: and David waxed faint.

David waxed greater <u>13_1CH_11_09</u># So David waxed greater and greater: for the LORD of hosts [was] with him.

David waxed stronger <u>10_2SA_03_01</u># Now there was long war between the house of Saul and the house of David: but David waxed stronger and stronger, and the house of Saul waxed weaker and weaker.

David well to <u>09_1SA_18_26</u> # And when his servants told David these words, it pleased David well to be the king's son in law: and the days were not expired.

David went and <u>09_1SA_17_15</u># But David went and returned from Saul to feed his father's sheep at Bethlehem.

David went and <u>10_2SA_06_12</u># And it was told king David, saying, The LORD hath blessed the house of Obededom, and all that [pertaineth] unto him, because of the ark of God. So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obededom into the city of David with gladness.

David went and <u>10_28A_21_12</u># And David went and took the bones of Saul and the bones of Jonathan his son from the men of Jabeshgilead, which had stolen them from the street of Bethshan, where the Philistines had hanged them, when the Philistines had slain Saul in Gilboa:

David went down <u>10_2SA_21_15</u> # Moreover the Philistines had yet war again with Israel; and David went down, and his servants with him, and fought against the Philistines: and David waxed faint.

David went he <u>09_1SA_30_09</u> # So David went, he and the six hundred men that [were] with him, and came to the brook Besor, where those that were left behind stayed.

David went on <u>09_1SA_26_25</u># Then Saul said to David, Blessed [be] thou, my son David: thou shalt both do great [things], and also shalt still prevail. So David went on his way, and Saul returned to his place.

David went on <u>10_2SA_05_10</u># And David went on, and grew great, and the LORD God of hosts [was] with him.

David went out <u>13_1CH_12_17</u># And David went out to meet them, and answered and said unto them, If ye be come peaceably unto me to help me, mine heart shall be knit unto you: but if [ye be come] to betray me to mine enemies, seeing [there is] no wrong in mine hands, the God of our fathers look [thereon], and rebuke [it].

David went out <u>13_1CH_14_17</u># And the fame of David went out into all lands; and the LORD brought the fear of him upon all nations.

David went out <u>09_1SA_18_05</u> # And David went out whithersoever Saul sent him, [and] behaved himself wisely: and Saul set him over the men of war, and he was accepted in the sight of all the people, and also in the sight of Saul's servants.

David went out <u>09_1SA_19_08</u># And there was war again: and David went out, and fought with the Philistines, and slew them with a great slaughter; and they fled from him.

David went out <u>10_2SA_02_13</u> # And Joab the son of Zeruiah, and the servants of David, went out, and met together by the pool of Gibeon: and they sat down, the one on the one side of the pool, and the other on the other side of the pool.

David went over <u>09_18A_26_13</u># Then David went over to the other side, and stood on the top of an hill afar off; a great space [being] between them:

David went thence <u>09_1SA_22_03</u># And David went thence to Mizpeh of Moab: and he said unto the king of Moab, Let my father and my mother, I pray thee, come forth, [and be] with you, till I know what God will do for me.

David went up <u>13_1CH_13_06</u> # And David went up, and all Israel, to Baalah, [that is], to Kirjathjearim, which [belonged] to Judah, to bring up thence the ark of God the LORD, that dwelleth [between] the cherubims, whose name is called [on it].

David went up <u>13_1CH_21_19</u> # And David went up at the saying of Gad, which he spake in the name of the LORD.

David went up <u>09_1SA_23_29</u># And David went up from thence, and dwelt in strong holds at Engedi.

David went up <u>10_2SA_02_02</u> # So David went up thither, and his two wives also, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail Nabal's wife the Carmelite.

David went up <u>10_2SA_15_30</u># And David went up by the ascent of [mount] Olivet, and wept as he went up, and had his head covered, and he went barefoot: and all the people that [was] with him covered every man his head, and they went up, weeping as they went up.

David were chief <u>13_1CH_18_17</u> # And Benaiah the son of Jehoiada [was] over the Cherethites and the Pelethites; and the sons of David [were] chief about the king.

David were come <u>09_1SA_25_40</u> # And when the servants of David were come to Abigail to Carmel, they spake unto her, saying, David sent us unto thee, to take thee to him to wife.

David were not <u>11_1KI_01_08</u># But Zadok the priest, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and Nathan the prophet, and Shimei, and Rei, and the mighty men which [belonged] to David, were not with Adonijah.

David were sons <u>10_2SA_03_02</u> # And unto David were sons born in Hebron: and his firstborn was Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess;

David what Rizpah <u>10_2SA_21_11</u># And it was told David what Rizpah the daughter of Aiah, the concubine of Saul, had done.

David Whatsoever thy <u>09_1SA_20_04</u># Then said Jonathan unto David, Whatsoever thy soul desireth, I will even do [it] for thee.

David when Doeg <u>19_PSA_52_01</u> # To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

David when he <u>13_1CH_12_19</u> # And there fell [some] of Manasseh to David, when he came with the Philistines against Saul to battle: but they helped them not: for the lords of the Philistines upon advisement sent him away, saying, He will fall to his master Saul to [the jeopardy of] our heads.

David when he <u>19_PSA_03_01</u> # A Psalm of David, when he fled from Absalom his son. LORD, how are they increased that trouble me! many [are] they that rise up against me.

David when he <u>19_PSA_34_01</u> # [A Psalm] of David, when he changed his behaviour before Abimelech; who drove him away, and he departed. I will bless the LORD at all times: his praise [shall] continually [be] in my mouth.

David when he <u>19_PSA_57_01</u> # To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David, when he fled from Saul in the cave. Be merciful unto me, O God, be merciful unto me: for my soul trusteth in thee: yea, in the shadow of thy wings will I make my refuge, until [these] calamities be overpast.

David when he <u>19_PSA_63_01</u> # A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O God, thou [art] my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty

David when Nathan <u>19_PSA_51_01</u> # To the chief Musician, A Psalm of David, when Nathan the prophet came unto him, after he had gone in to Bathsheba. Have mercy upon me, O God, according to thy lovingkindness: according unto the multitude of thy tender mercies blot outmy transgressions.

David when Saul <u>19_PSA_59_01</u> # To the chief Musician, Altaschith, Michtam of David; when Saul sent, and they watched the house to kill him. Deliver me from mine enemies, O my God: defend me from them that rise up against me.

David when the <u>19_PSA_54_01</u># To the chief Musician on Neginoth, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when the Ziphims came and said to Saul, Doth not David hide himself with us? Save me, O God, by thy name, and judge me by thy strength.

David when the <u>19_PSA_56_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Jonathelemrechokim, Michtam of David, when the Philistines took him in Gath. Be merciful unto me, O God: for man would swallow me up; he fighting daily oppresseth me.

David when they <u>10_28A_23_09</u> # And after him [was] Eleazar the son of Dodo the Ahohite, [one] of the three mighty men with David, when they defied the Philistines [that] were there gathered together to battle, and the men of Israel were gone away:

David wherefore he <u>09_18A_23_25</u># Saul also and his men went to seek [him]. And they told David: wherefore he came down into a rock, and abode in the wilderness of Maon. And when Saul heard [that], he pursued after David in the wilderness of Maon.

David which he <u>19_PSA_07_01</u> # Shiggaion of David, which he sang unto the LORD, concerning the words of Cush the Benjamite. O LORD my God, in thee do I put my trust: save me from all them that persecute me, and deliver me:

David which is <u>11_1KI_08_01</u># Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto king Solomon in Jerusalem, that they might bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which [is] Zion.

David which is <u>09_1SA_22_14</u># Then Ahimelech answered the king, and said, And who [is so] faithful among all thy servants as David, which is the king's son in law, and goeth at thy bidding, and is honourable in thine house?

David which is <u>14_2CH_05_02</u> # Then Solomon assembled the elders of Israel, and all the heads of the tribes, the chief of the fathers of the children of Israel, unto Jerusalem, to bring up the ark of the covenant of the LORD out of the city of David, which [is] Zion.

David which is <u>44_ACT_15_16</u> # After this I will return, and will build again the tabernacle of David, which is fallen down; and I will build again the ruins thereof, and I will set it up:

David which is <u>42_LUK_02_04</u> # And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; [because he was of the house and lineage of David:]

David which were <u>13_1CH_03_01</u> # Now these were the sons of David, which were born unto him in Hebron; the firstborn Amnon, of Ahinoam the Jezreelitess; the second Daniel, of Abigail the Carmelitess:

David whithersoever he <u>13_1CH_18_06</u># Then David put [garrisons] in Syriadamascus; and the Syrians became David's servants, [and] brought gifts. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

David whithersoever he <u>13_1CH_18_13</u># And he put garrisons in Edom; and all the Edomites became David's servants. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

David whithersoever he <u>10_2SA_08_06</u># Then David put garrisons in Syria of Damascus: and the Syrians became servants to David, [and] brought gifts. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

David whithersoever he <u>10_2SA_08_14</u># And he put garrisons in Edom; throughout all Edom put he garrisons, and all they of Edom became David's servants. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

David who kept <u>11_1KI_14_08</u># And rent the kingdom away from the house of David, and gave it thee: and [yet] thou hast not been as my servant David, who kept my commandments, and who followed me with all his heart, to do [that] only [which was] right in mine eyes;

David Who shall <u>10_2SA_16_10</u> # And the king said, What have I to do with you, ye sons of Zeruiah? so let him curse, because the LORD hath said unto him, Curse David. Who shall then say, Wherefore hast thou done so?

David whom they <u>09_1SA_30_21</u> # And David came to the two hundred men, which were so faint that they could not follow David, whom they had made also to abide at the brook Besor: and they went forth to meet David, and to meet the people that [were] with him: and when David came near to the people, he saluted them.

David will I <u>23_ISA_22_22</u># And the key of the house of David will I lay upon his shoulder; so he shall open, and none shall shut; and he shall shut, and none shall open.

David Will the <u>09_1SA_23_12</u># Then said David, Will the men of Keilah deliver me and my men into the hand of Saul? And the LORD said, They will deliver [thee] up.

David with all <u>13_1CH_20_03</u> # And he brought out the people that [were] in it, and cut [them] with saws, and with harrows of iron, and with axes. Even so dealt David with all the cities of the children of Ammon. And David and all the people returned to Jerusalem.

David with gladness <u>10_2SA_06_12</u> # And it was told king David, saying, The LORD hath blessed the house of Obededom, and all that [pertaineth] unto him, because of the ark of God. So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obededom into the city of David with gladness.

David with his <u>13_1CH_21_21</u> # And as David came to Ornan, Ornan looked and saw David, and went out of the threshingfloor, and bowed himself to David with [his] face to the ground.

David with his <u>09_1SA_17_38</u># And Saul armed David with his armour, and he put an helmet of brass upon his head; also he armed him with a coat of mail.

David with his <u>09_1SA_27_03</u># And David dwelt with Achish at Gath, he and his men, every man with his household, [even] David with his two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the Carmelitess, Nabal's wife.

David without a <u>09_1SA_19_05</u> # For he did put his life in his hand, and slew the Philistine, and the LORD wrought a great salvation for all Israel: thou sawest [it], and didst rejoice: wherefore then wilt thou sin against innocent blood, to slay David without a cause?

David would not <u>13_1CH_11_18</u># And the three brake through the host of the Philistines, and drew water out of the well of Bethlehem, that [was] by the gate, and took [it], and brought [it] to David: but David would not drink [of] it, but poured it out to the LORD,

David would not <u>10_2SA_06_10</u># So David would not remove the ark of the LORD unto him into the city of David: but David carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite.

David wrote a <u>10_2SA_11_14</u># And it came to pass in the morning, that David wrote a letter to Joab, and sent [it] by the hand of Uriah.

David Ye shall <u>09_1SA_30_23</u># Then said David, Ye shall not do so, my brethren, with that which the LORD hath given us, who hath preserved us, and delivered the company that came against us into our hand.

David <u>13_1CH_04_31</u># And at Bethmarcaboth, and Hazarsusim, and at Bethbirei, and at Shaaraim. These [were] their cities unto the reign of David.

David <u>13_1CH_11_05</u># And the inhabitants of Jebus said to David, Thou shalt not come hither. Nevertheless David took the castle of Zion, which [is] the city of David.

David <u>13_1CH_11_07</u># And David dwelt in the castle; therefore they called it the city of David.

David <u>13_1CH_12_16</u># And there came of the children of Benjamin and Judah to the hold unto David.

David <u>13_1CH_17_15</u> # According to all these words, and according to all this vision, so did Nathan speak unto David.

David <u>13_1CH_22_04</u> # Also cedar trees in abundance: for the Zidonians and they of Tyre brought much cedar wood to David.

David <u>13_1CH_27_24</u> # Joab the son of Zeruiah began to number, but he finished not, because there fell wrath for it against Israel; neither was the number put in the account of the chronicles of king David.

David <u>11_1KI_01_37</u># As the LORD hath been with my lord the king, even so be he with Solomon, and make his throne greater than the throne of my lord king David.

David <u>11_1KI_02_10</u># So David slept with his fathers, and was buried in the city of David.

David <u>11_1KI_05_01</u># And Hiram king of Tyre sent his servants unto Solomon; for he had heard that they had anointed him king in the room of his father: for Hiram was ever a lover of David.

David <u>11_1KI_12_26</u># And Jeroboam said in his heart, Now shall the kingdom return to the house of David:

David <u>09_1SA_17_50</u> # So David prevailed over the Philistine with a sling and with a stone, and smote the Philistine, and slew him; but [there was] no sword in the hand of David.

David <u>09_1SA_18_24</u> # And the servants of Saul told him, saying, On this manner spake David.

David <u>09_1SA_19_01</u> # And Saul spake to Jonathan his son, and to all his servants, that they should kill David.

David <u>09_1SA_20_33</u> # And Saul cast a javelin at him to smite him: whereby Jonathan knew that it was determined of his father to slay David.

David <u>09_1SA_22_20</u># And one of the sons of Ahimelech the son of Ahitub, named Abiathar, escaped, and fled after David.

David <u>09_1SA_25_08</u># Ask thy young men, and they will show thee. Wherefore let the young men find

favour in thine eyes: for we come in a good day: give, I pray thee, whatsoever cometh to thine hand unto thy servants, and to thy son David.

David <u>09_1SA_28_17</u> # And the LORD hath done to him, as he spake by me: for the LORD hath rent the kingdom out of thine hand, and given it to thy neighbour, [even] to David:

David <u>09_1SA_30_07</u> # And David said to Abiathar the priest, Ahimelech's son, I pray thee, bring me hither the ephod. And Abiathar brought thither the ephod to David.

David <u>14_2CH_06_17</u> # Now then, O LORD God of Israel, let thy word be verified, which thou hast spoken unto thy servant David.

David <u>14_2CH_23_03</u> # And all the congregation made a covenant with the king in the house of God. And he said unto them, Behold, the king's son shall reign, as the LORD hath said of the sons of David.

David <u>14_2CH_23_18</u> # Also Jehoiada appointed the offices of the house of the LORD by the hand of the priests the Levites, whom David had distributed in the house of the LORD, to offer the burnt offerings of the LORD, as [it is] written in the law of Moses, with rejoicing and with singing, [as it was ordained] by David.

David <u>12_2KI_09_28</u> # And his servants carried him in a chariot to Jerusalem, and buried him in his sepulchre with his fathers in the city of David.

David <u>12_2KI_14_20</u># And they brought him on horses: and he was buried at Jerusalem with his fathers in the city of David.

David <u>10_2SA_02_10</u> # Ishbosheth Saul's son [was] forty years old when he began to reign over Israel, and reigned two years. But the house of Judah followed David.

David <u>10_2SA_02_15</u> # Then there arose and went over by number twelve of Benjamin, which [pertained] to Ishbosheth the son of Saul, and twelve of the servants of David.

David <u>10_2SA_02_17</u> # And there was a very sore battle that day; and Abner was beaten, and the men of Israel, before the servants of David.

David <u>10_2SA_05_07</u> # Nevertheless David took the strong hold of Zion: the same [is] the city of David.

David <u>10_2SA_05_13</u> # And David took [him] more concubines and wives out of Jerusalem, after he was come from Hebron: and there were yet sons and daughters born to David.

David <u>10_2SA_07_17</u> # According to all these words, and according to all this vision, so did Nathan speak unto David.

David <u>10_2SA_11_06</u># And David sent to Joab, [saying], Send me Uriah the Hittite. And Joab sent Uriah to David.

David <u>10_2SA_17_17</u> # Now Jonathan and Ahimaaz stayed by Enrogel; for they might not be seen to come into the city: and a wench went and told them; and they went and told king David.

David <u>10_2SA_19_16</u> # And Shimei the son of Gera, a Benjamite, which [was] of Bahurim, hasted and came down with the men of Judah to meet king David.

David <u>10_2SA_20_26</u> # And Ira also the Jairite was a chief ruler about David.

David <u>10_2SA_21_16</u># And Ishbibenob, which [was] of the sons of the giant, the weight of whose spear

[weighed] three hundred [shekels] of brass in weight, he being girded with a new [sword], thought to have slain David.

David <u>44_ACT_07_45</u> # Which also our fathers that came after brought in with Jesus into the possession of the Gentiles, whom God drave out before the face of our fathers, unto the days of David;

David <u>44_ACT_13_34</u> # And as concerning that he raised him up from the dead, [now] no more to return to corruption, he said on this wise, I will give you the sure mercies of David.

David <u>30_AMO_06_05</u># That chant to the sound of the viol, [and] invent to themselves instruments of music, like David;

David <u>23 ISA 55 03</u> # Incline your ear, and come unto me: hear, and your soul shall live; and I will make an everlasting covenant with you, [even] the sure mercies of David.

David <u>42_LUK_01_32</u> # He shall be great, and shall be called the Son of the Highest: and the Lord God shall give unto him the throne of his father David:

David <u>42_LUK_01_69</u> # And hath raised up an horn of salvation for us in the house of his servant David;

David <u>42_LUK_02_04</u> # And Joseph also went up from Galilee, out of the city of Nazareth, into Judaea, unto the city of David, which is called Bethlehem; [because he was of the house and lineage of David:]

David <u>42_LUK_03_31</u># Which was [the son] of Melea, which was [the son] of Menan, which was [the son] of Mattatha, which was [the son] of Nathan, which was [the son] of David,

David <u>41_MAR_12_35</u> # And Jesus answered and said, while he taught in the temple, How say the scribes that Christ is the son of David?

David <u>40_MAT_12_23</u># And all the people were amazed, and said, Is not this the son of David?

David <u>40 MAT_20_30</u># And, behold, two blind men sitting by the way side, when they heard that Jesus passed by, cried out, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, [thou] son of David.

David <u>40_MAT_20_31</u> # And the multitude rebuked them, because they should hold their peace: but they cried the more, saying, Have mercy on us, O Lord, [thou] son of David.

David <u>40_MAT_22_42</u># Saying, What think ye of Christ? whose son is he? They say unto him, [The son] of David.

David <u>16_NEH_03_15</u> # But the gate of the fountain repaired Shallun the son of Colhozeh, the ruler of part of Mizpah; he built it, and covered it, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof, and the wall of the pool of Siloah by the king's garden, and unto the stairs that go down from the city of David.

David <u>19_PSA_122_05</u> # For there are set thrones of judgment, the thrones of the house of David.

David <u>19_PSA_89_35</u> # Once have I sworn by my holiness that I will not lie unto David.

David <u>08_RUT_04_17</u> # And the women her neighbours gave it a name, saying, There is a son born to Naomi; and they called his name Obed: he [is] the father of Jesse, the father of David.

David <u>08_RUT_04_22</u> # And Obed begat Jesse, and Jesse begat David.

David's anger was <u>10_2SA_12_05</u> # And David's anger was greatly kindled against the man; and he said to

Nathan, [As] the LORD liveth, the man that hath done this [thing] shall surely die:

David's brother and <u>10_28A_13_03</u># But Amnon had a friend, whose name [was] Jonadab, the son of Shimeah David's brother: and Jonadab [was] a very subtle man.

David's brother answered <u>10_2SA_13_32</u> # And Jonadab, the son of Shimeah David's brother, answered and said, Let not my lord suppose [that] they have slain all the young men the king's sons; for Amnon only is dead: for by the appointment of Absalom this hath been determined from the day that he forced his sister Tamar.

David's brother slew <u>13_1CH_20_07</u># But when he defied Israel, Jonathan the son of Shimea David's brother slew him.

David's enemies <u>09_1SA_20_16</u># So Jonathan made [a covenant] with the house of David, [saying], Let the LORD even require [it] at the hand of David's enemies.

David's enemy continually <u>09_1SA_18_29</u># And Saul was yet the more afraid of David; and Saul became David's enemy continually.

David's friend came <u>10_28A_15_37</u># So Hushai David's friend came into the city, and Absalom came into Jerusalem.

David's friend was <u>10_2SA_16_16</u># And it came to pass, when Hushai the Archite, David's friend, was come unto Absalom, that Hushai said unto Absalom, God save the king, God save the king.

David's head and <u>13_1CH_20_02</u> # And David took the crown of their king from off his head, and found it to weigh a talent of gold, and [there were] precious stones in it; and it was set upon David's head: and he brought also exceeding much spoil out of the city.

David's head And <u>10_2SA_12_30</u> # And he took their king's crown from off his head, the weight whereof [was] a talent of gold with the precious stones: and it was [set] on David's head. And he brought forth the spoil of the city in great abundance.

David's house to <u>09_1SA_19_11</u># Saul also sent messengers unto David's house, to watch him, and to slay him in the morning: and Michal David's wife told him, saying, If thou save not thy life to night, to morrow thou shalt be slain.

David's men said <u>09_1SA_23_03</u> # And David's men said unto him, Behold, we be afraid here in Judah: how much more then if we come to Keilah against the armies of the Philistines?

David's men with <u>10_2SA_19_41</u> # And, behold, all the men of Israel came to the king, and said unto the king, Why have our brethren the men of Judah stolen thee away, and have brought the king, and his household, and all David's men with him, over Jordan?

David's mule and <u>11_1KI_01_38</u># So Zadok the priest, and Nathan the prophet, and Benaiah the son of Jehoiada, and the Cherethites, and the Pelethites, went down, and caused Solomon to ride upon king David's mule, and brought him to Gihon.

David's sake <u>23_ISA_37_35</u># For I will defend this city to save it for mine own sake, and for my servant David's sake.

David's seer saying <u>13_1CH_21_09</u># And the LORD spake unto Gad, David's seer, saying,

David's seer saying <u>10_2SA_24_11</u># For when David was up in the morning, the word of the LORD came unto the prophet Gad, David's seer, saying,

David's servants and <u>13_1CH_18_02</u># And he smote Moab; and the Moabites became David's servants, [and] brought gifts.

David's servants and <u>13_1CH_18_06</u># Then David put [garrisons] in Syriadamascus; and the Syrians became David's servants, [and] brought gifts. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

David's servants and <u>13_1CH_19_04</u># Wherefore Hanun took David's servants, and shaved them, and cut off their garments in the midst hard by their buttocks, and sent them away.

David's voice and <u>09_1SA_26_17</u> # And Saul knew David's voice, and said, [Is] this thy voice, my son David? And David said, [It is] my voice, my lord, O king.

David's which were <u>14_2CH_23_09</u> # Moreover Jehoiada the priest delivered to the captains of hundreds spears, and bucklers, and shields, that [had been] king David's, which [were] in the house of God.

David's wife These <u>10_28A_03_05</u># And the sixth, Ithream, by Eglah David's wife. These were born to David in Hebron.

David's wife to <u>09_18A_25_44</u> # But Saul had given Michal his daughter, David's wife, to Phalti the son of Laish, which [was] of Gallim.

David's wife told <u>09_1SA_19_11</u># Saul also sent messengers unto David's house, to watch him, and to slay him in the morning: and Michal David's wife told him, saying, If thou save not thy life to night, to morrow

David's young men <u>09_1SA_25_09</u> # And when David's young men came, they spake to Nabal according to all those words in the name of David, and ceased.

David's young men <u>09_1SA_25_12</u> # So David's young men turned their way, and went again, and came and told him all those sayings.

David's <u>13_1CH_27_31</u> # And over the flocks [was] Jaziz the Hagerite. All these [were] the rulers of the substance which [was] king David's.
