Deborah a prophetess <u>07_JUD_04_04</u> # And Deborah, a prophetess, the wife of Lapidoth, she judged Israel at that time.

Deborah and Barak <u>07_JUD_05_01</u># Then sang Deborah and Barak the son of Abinoam on that day, saying,

Deborah arose and <u>07_JUD_04_09</u> # And she said, I will surely go with thee: notwithstanding the journey that thou takest shall not be for thine honour; for the LORD shall sell Sisera into the hand of a woman. And Deborah arose, and went with Barak to Kedesh.

Deborah arose that <u>07_JUD_05_07</u># [The inhabitants of] the villages ceased, they ceased in Israel, until that I Deborah arose, that I arose a mother in Israel.

Deborah awake awake <u>07_JUD_05_12</u> # Awake, awake, Deborah: awake, awake, utter a song: arise, Barak, and lead thy captivity captive, thou son of Abinoam.

Deborah between Ramah <u>07_JUD_04_05</u># And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment.

Deborah even Issachar <u>07_JUD_05_15</u> # And the princes of Issachar [were] with Deborah; even Issachar, and also Barak: he was sent on foot into the valley. For the divisions of Reuben [there were] great thoughts of heart.

Deborah Rebekah's nurse <u>01_GEN_35_08</u> # But Deborah Rebekah's nurse died, and she was buried beneath Bethel under an oak: and the name of it was called Allonbachuth.

Deborah said unto <u>07_JUD_04_14</u># And Deborah said unto Barak, Up; for this [is] the day in which the LORD hath delivered Sisera into thine hand: is not the LORD gone out before thee? So Barak went down from mount Tabor, and ten thousand men after him.

Deborah went up <u>07_JUD_04_10</u># And Barak called Zebulun and Naphtali to Kedesh; and he went up with ten thousand men at his feet: and Deborah went up with him.
