deck it with [24 JER 10 04](#) # They deck it with silver and with gold; they fasten it with nails and with hammers, that it move not.

Deck thyself now [18 JOB 40 10](#) # Deck thyself now [with] majesty and excellency; and array thyself with glory and beauty.

decked herself with [28 HOS 02 13](#) # And I will visit upon her the days of Baalim, wherein she burned incense to them, and she decked herself with her earrings and her jewels, and she went after her lovers, and forgat me, saith the LORD.

decked my bed [20 PRO 07 16](#) # I have decked my bed with coverings of tapestry, with carved [works], with fine linen of Egypt.

decked thee also [26 EZE 16 11](#) # I decked thee also with ornaments, and I put bracelets upon thy hands, and a chain on thy neck.

decked with gold [26 EZE 16 13](#) # Thus wast thou decked with gold and silver; and thy raiment [was of] fine linen, and silk, and brodered work; thou didst eat fine flour, and honey, and oil: and thou wast exceeding beautiful, and thou didst prosper into a kingdom.

decked with gold [66 REV 17 04](#) # And the woman was arrayed in purple and scarlet colour, and decked with gold and precious stones and pearls, having a golden cup in her hand full of abominations and filthiness of her fornication:

decked with gold [66 REV 18 16](#) # And saying, Alas, alas, that great city, that was clothed in fine linen, and purple, and scarlet, and decked with gold, and precious stones, and pearls!

deckedst thy high [26 EZE 16 16](#) # And of thy garments thou didst take, and deckedst thy high places with divers colours, and playedst the harlot thereupon: [the like things] shall not come, neither shall it be [so].

deckedst thyself with [26 EZE 23 40](#) # And furthermore, that ye have sent for men to come from far, unto whom a messenger [was] sent; and, lo, they came: for whom thou didst wash thyself, paintedst thy eyes, and deckedst thyself with ornaments,

deckest thee with [24 JER 04 30](#) # And [when] thou [art] spoiled, what wilt thou do? Though thou clothest thyself with crimson, though thou deckest thee with ornaments of gold, though thou rentest thy face with painting, in vain shalt thou make thyself fair; [thy] lovers will despise thee, they will seek thy life.
