Adoraim and Lachish 14_2CH_11_09 # And Adoraim, and Lachish, and Azekah,

Adoram was over 10_2SA_20_24 # And Adoram [was] over the tribute: and Jehoshaphat the son of Ahilud [was] recorder:

Adoram who was 11_1KI_12_18 # Then king Rehoboam sent Adoram, who [was] over the tribute; and all Israel stoned him with stones, that he died. Therefore king Rehoboam made speed to get him up to his chariot, to flee to Jerusalem.

adorn the doctrine <u>56_TIT_02_10</u> # Not purloining, but showing all good fidelity; that they may adorn the doctrine of God our Saviour in all things.

adorn themselves in <u>54_1TI_02_09</u> # In like manner also, that women adorn themselves in modest apparel, with shamefacedness and sobriety; not with broided hair, or gold, or pearls, or costly array;

adorned for her <u>66_REV_21_02</u> # And I John saw the holy city, new Jerusalem, coming down from God out of heaven, prepared as a bride adorned for her husband.

adorned themselves being <u>60_1PE_03_05</u># For after this manner in the old time the holy women also, who trusted in God, adorned themselves, being in subjection unto their own husbands:

adorned with goodly <u>42_LUK_21_05</u># And as some spake of the temple, how it was adorned with goodly stones and gifts, he said,

ambassador is health <u>20_PRO_13_17</u> # A wicked messenger falleth into mischief: but a faithful ambassador [is] health.

ambassador is sent <u>24_JER_49_14</u> # I have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent unto the heathen, [saying], Gather ye together, and come against her, and rise up to the battle.

ambassador is sent 31_OBA_01_01 # The vision of Obadiah. Thus saith the Lord GOD concerning Edom;

We have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent among the heathen, Arise ye, and let us rise up against her in battle.

ambassadors and took <u>06_JOS_09_04</u># They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up;

ambassadors by the <u>23_ISA_18_02</u> # That sendeth ambassadors by the sea, even in vessels of bulrushes upon the waters, [saying], Go, ye swift messengers, to a nation scattered and peeled, to a people terrible from their beginning hitherto; a nation meted out and trodden down, whose land the rivers have spoiled!

ambassadors into Egypt <u>26_EZE_17_15</u># But he rebelled against him in sending his ambassadors into Egypt, that they might give him horses and much people. Shall he prosper? shall he escape that doeth such [things]? or shall he break the covenant, and be delivered?

ambassadors of peace 23_ISA_33_07_# Behold, their valiant ones shall cry without: the ambassadors of peace shall weep bitterly.

ambassadors of the <u>14_2CH_32_31</u># Howbeit in [the business of] the ambassadors of the princes of Babylon, who sent unto him to inquire of the wonder that was [done] in the land, God left him, to try him, that he might know all [that was] in his heart.

ambassadors to him 14_2CH_35_21# But he sent ambassadors to him, saying, What have I to do with thee, thou king of Judah? Dor in the <u>06_JOS_12_23</u> # The king of Dor in the coast of Dor, one; the king of the nations of Gilgal, one;

Dor on the <u>06_JOS_11_02</u># And to the kings that [were] on the north of the mountains, and of the plains south of Chinneroth, and in the valley, and in the borders of Dor on the west,

Dor one the Mos. 12_23 # The king of Dor in the coast of Dor, one; the king of the nations of Gilgal, one;

Dor which had 11_1KI_04_11# The son of Abinadab, in all the region of Dor; which had Taphath the daughter of Solomon to wife:

Dorcas made while <u>44_ACT_09_39</u> # Then Peter arose and went with them. When he was come, they brought him into the upper chamber: and all the widows stood by him weeping, and showing the coats and garments which Dorcas made, while she was with them.

Gedor and Ahio 13_1CH_08_31 # And Gedor, and Ahio, and Zacher.

Gedor and Ahio 13_1CH_09_37 # And Gedor, and Ahio, and Zechariah, and Mikloth.

Gedor and Ezer <u>13_1CH_04_04</u> # And Penuel the father of Gedor, and Ezer the father of Hushah. These [are] the sons of Hur, the firstborn of Ephratah, the father of Bethlehem.

Gedor and Heber <u>13_1CH_04_18</u># And his wife Jehudijah bare Jered the father of Gedor, and Heber the father of Socho, and Jekuthiel the father of Zanoah. And these [are] the sons of Bithiah the daughter of Pharaoh, which Mered took.

Gedor even unto 13_1CH_04_39 # And they went to the entrance of Gedor, [even] unto the east side of the valley, to seek pasture for their flocks.

Gedor 13_1CH_12_07 # And Joelah, and Zebadiah, the sons of Jeroham of Gedor.

Gedor 06_JOS_15_58 # Halhul, Bethzur, and Gedor,

Hadoram also and 13_1CH_01_21 # Hadoram also, and Uzal, and Diklah,

Hadoram and Uzal 01_GEN_10_27 # And Hadoram, and Uzal, and Diklah,

Hadoram his son <u>13 1CH 18 10 #</u> He sent Hadoram his son to king David, to inquire of his welfare, and to congratulate him, because he had fought against Hadarezer, and smitten him; [for Hadarezer had war with Tou;] and [with him] all manner of vessels of gold and silver and brass.

Hadoram that was <u>14_2CH_10_18</u> # Then king Rehoboam sent Hadoram that [was] over the tribute; and the children of Israel stoned him with stones, that he died. But king Rehoboam made speed to get him up to [his] chariot, to flee to Jerusalem.
