doth a little <u>21\_ECC\_10\_01</u> # Dead flies cause the ointment of the apothecary to send forth a stinking savour: [so doth] a little folly him that is in reputation for wisdom [and] honour.

doth a living **25\_LAM\_03\_39**# Wherefore doth a living man complain, a man for the punishment of his sins?

doth Adonijah reign <u>11\_1KI\_01\_13</u># Go and get thee in unto king David, and say unto him, Didst not thou, my lord, O king, swear unto thine handmaid, saying, Assuredly Solomon thy son shall reign after me, and he shall sit upon my throne? why then doth Adonijah reign?

doth already work <u>53\_2TH\_02\_07</u># For the mystery of iniquity doth already work: only he who now letteth [will let], until he be taken out of the way.

doth also in <u>51\_COL\_01\_06</u># Which is come unto you, as [it is] in all the world; and bringeth forth fruit, as [it doth] also in you, since the day ye heard [of it], and knew the grace of God in truth:

doth also now <u>60\_1PE\_03\_21</u> # The like figure whereunto [even] baptism doth also now save us [not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,] by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

doth an angry 20\_PRO\_25\_23 # The north wind driveth away rain: so [doth] an angry countenance a

backbiting tongue.

doth any son <u>24\_JER\_51\_43</u># Her cities are a desolation, a dry land, and a wilderness, a land wherein no man dwelleth, neither doth [any] son of man pass thereby.

doth bear his <u>05\_DEU\_01\_31</u># And in the wilderness, where thou hast seen how that the LORD thy God bare thee, as a man doth bear his son, in all the way that ye went, until ye came into this place.

doth bear me <u>44\_ACT\_22\_05</u># As also the high priest doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the brethren, and went to Damascus, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.

doth behold the 19\_PSA\_11\_07# For the righteous LORD loveth righteousness; his countenance doth behold the upright.

doth betray me 40\_MAT\_26\_46 # Rise, let us be going: behold, he is at hand that doth betray me.

doth bless the <u>09\_18A\_09\_13</u> # As soon as ye be come into the city, ye shall straightway find him, before he go up to the high place to eat: for the people will not eat until he come, because he doth bless the sacrifice; [and] afterwards they eat that be bidden. doth establish them <u>18\_JOB\_36\_07</u> # He withdraweth not his eyes from the righteous: but with kings [are they] on the throne; yea, he doth establish them for ever, and they are exalted.

doth every one 19\_PSA\_29\_09 # The voice of the LORD maketh the hinds to calve, and discovereth the forests: and in his temple doth every one speak of [his] glory.

doth execute the <u>05\_DEU\_10\_18</u># He doth execute the judgment of the fatherless and widow, and loveth the stranger, in giving him food and raiment.

Doth God take <u>46\_1CO\_09\_09</u> # For it is written in the law of Moses, Thou shalt not muzzle the mouth of the ox that treadeth out the corn. Doth God take care for oxen?

doth he bring 36\_ZEP\_03\_05 # The just LORD [is] in the midst thereof; he will not do iniquity: every morning doth he bring his judgment to light, he faileth not; but the unjust knoweth no shame.

doth he not 40 MAT\_18\_12# How think ye? if a man have an hundred sheep, and one of them be gone astray, doth he not leave the ninety and nine, and goeth into the mountains, and seeketh that which is gone astray?

doth he now 43\_JOH\_09\_19 # And they asked them, saying, Is this your son, who ye say was born blind? how then doth he now see?

doth he open 23\_ISA\_28\_24 # Doth the plowman plow all day to sow? doth he open and break the clods of his ground?

doth hear 19\_PSA\_59\_07 # Behold, they belch out with their mouth: swords [are] in their lips: for who, [say they], doth hear?

doth hinder me <u>44\_ACT\_08\_36</u> # And as they went on [their] way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, [here is] water; what doth hinder me to be baptized?

doth his children <u>52\_1TH\_02\_11</u> # As ye know how we exhorted and comforted and charged every one of you, as a father [doth] his children,

doth his flock 24\_JER\_31\_10 # Hear the word of the LORD, O ye nations, and declare [it] in the isles afar off, and say, He that scattered Israel will gather him, and keep him, as a shepherd [doth] his flock.

doth his heart <u>23\_ISA\_10\_07</u> # Howbeit he meaneth not so, neither doth his heart think so; but [it is] in his heart to destroy and cut off nations not a few.

doth honour thy 10\_2SA\_10\_03# And the princes of the children of Ammon said unto Hanun their lord, Thinkest thou that David doth honour thy father, that he hath sent comforters unto thee? hath not David [rather] sent his servants unto thee, to search the city, and to spy it out, and to overthrow it?

doth hunt a <u>09\_1SA\_26\_20</u># Now therefore, let not my blood fall to the earth before the face of the LORD: for the king of Israel is come out to seek a flea, as when one doth hunt a partridge in the mountains.

doth inhabit let 23\_ISA\_42\_11# Let the wilderness and the cities thereof lift up [their voice], the villages [that] Kedar doth inhabit: let the inhabitants of the rock sing, let them shout from the top of the mountains.

doth instruct him 23\_ISA\_28\_26 # For his God doth instruct him to discretion, [and] doth teach him.

doth justice overtake <u>23\_ISA\_59\_09</u># Therefore is judgment far from us, neither doth justice overtake us: we wait for light, but behold obscurity; for brightness, [but] we walk in darkness.

doth keep his <u>20\_PRO\_22\_05</u># Thorns [and] snares [are] in the way of the froward: he that doth keep his soul shall be far from them.

doth kindle it <u>23\_ISA\_30\_33</u># For Tophet [is] ordained of old; yea, for the king it is prepared; he hath made [it] deep [and] large: the pile thereof [is] fire and much wood; the breath of the LORD, like a stream of brimstone, doth kindle it.

doth not mine 18\_JOB\_17\_02 # [Are there] not mockers with me? and doth not mine eye continue in their provocation?

doth not profit 24\_JER\_02\_11 # Hath a nation changed [their] gods, which [are] yet no gods? but my people have changed their glory for [that which] doth not profit.

doth not prophesy <u>11\_1KI\_22\_08</u># And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, [There is] yet one man, Micaiah the son of Imlah, by whom we may inquire of the LORD: but I hate him; for he doth not prophesy good concerning me, but evil. And Jehoshaphat said, Let not the king say so.

doth not regard <u>45\_ROM\_14\_06</u> # He that regardeth the day, regardeth [it] unto the Lord; and he that regardeth not the day, to the Lord he doth not regard [it]. He that eateth, eateth to the Lord, for he giveth God thanks; and he that eateth not, to the Lord he eateth not, and giveth God thanks.

doth not resist 59\_JAM\_05\_06 # Ye have condemned [and] killed the just; [and] he doth not resist you.

doth not sin <u>26\_EZE\_03\_21</u># Nevertheless if thou warn the righteous [man], that the righteous sin not, and he doth not sin, he shall surely live, because he is warned; also thou hast delivered thy soul.

doth not spare <u>18\_JOB\_16\_13</u> # His archers compass me round about, he cleaveth my reins asunder, and doth not spare; he poureth out my gall upon the ground.

doth not the <u>26\_EZE\_18\_19</u> # Yet say ye, Why? doth not the son bear the iniquity of the father? When the son hath done that which is lawful and right, [and] hath kept all my statutes, and hath done them, he shall surely live.

Doth not the 18\_JOB\_12\_11 # Doth not the ear try words? and the mouth taste his meat?

Doth not their <u>18\_JOB\_04\_21</u> # Doth not their excellency [which is] in them go away? they die, even without wisdom.

doth not triumph 19\_PSA\_41\_11# By this I know that thou favourest me, because mine enemy doth not triumph over me.

doth not understand <u>28\_HOS\_04\_14</u># I will not punish your daughters when they commit whoredom, nor your spouses when they commit adultery: for themselves are separated with whores, and they sacrifice with harlots: therefore the people [that] doth not understand shall fall.

Doth not wisdom 20\_PRO\_08\_01 # Doth not wisdom cry? and understanding put forth her voice?

doth not yet <u>62\_1JO\_03\_02</u># Beloved, now are we the sons of God, and it doth not yet appear what we shall be: but we know that, when he shall appear, we shall be like him; for we shall see him as he is.

Doth not your 40 MAT 17 24 # And when they were come to Capernaum, they that received tribute [money] came to Peter, and said, Doth not your master pay tribute?

doth nourish it <u>23\_ISA\_44\_14</u> # He heweth him down cedars, and taketh the cypress and the oak, which he strengtheneth for himself among the trees of the forest: he planteth an ash, and the rain doth nourish [it].

Doth our law 43\_JOH\_07\_51 # Doth our law judge [any] man, before it hear him, and know what he doeth?

doth persecute the 19\_PSA\_10\_02 # The wicked in [his] pride doth persecute the poor: let them be taken in

the devices that they have imagined.

doth put a <u>02\_EXO\_11\_07</u># But against any of the children of Israel shall not a dog move his tongue, against man or beast: that ye may know how that the LORD doth put a difference between the Egyptians and Israel.

doth rebel against <u>06\_JOS\_01\_18</u> # Whosoever [he be] that doth rebel against thy commandment, and will not hearken unto thy words in all that thou commandest him, he shall be put to death: only be strong and of a good courage.

doth reign and 11\_1KI\_01\_11# Wherefore Nathan spake unto Bathsheba the mother of Solomon, saying, Hast thou not heard that Adonijah the son of Haggith doth reign, and David our lord knoweth [it] not?

doth rest on 12 2KI 02 15 # And when the sons of the prophets which [were] to view at Jericho saw him, they said, The spirit of Elijah doth rest on Elisha. And they came to meet him, and bowed themselves to the ground before him.

doth return from <u>24 JER\_23 14</u># I have seen also in the prophets of Jerusalem an horrible thing: they commit adultery, and walk in lies: they strengthen also the hands of evildoers, that none doth return from his wickedness: they are all of them unto me as Sodom, and the inhabitants thereof as Gomorrah.

doth safely trust <u>20\_PRO\_31\_11</u># The heart of her husband doth safely trust in her, so that he shall have no need of spoil.

doth sanctify you <u>02\_EXO\_31\_13</u> # Speak thou also unto the children of Israel, saying, Verily my sabbaths ye shall keep: for it [is] a sign between me and you throughout your generations; that [ye] may know that I [am] the LORD that doth sanctify you.

doth send out 19\_PSA\_68\_33 # To him that rideth upon the heavens of heavens, [which were] of old; lo, he doth send out his voice, [and that] a mighty voice.

doth send unto 12 2KI 05 07 # And it came to pass, when the king of Israel had read the letter, that he rent his clothes, and said, [Am] I God, to kill and to make alive, that this man doth send unto me to recover a man of his leprosy? wherefore consider, I pray you, and see how he seeketh a quarrel against me.

doth serve <u>42\_LUK\_22\_26</u># But ye [shall] not [be] so: but he that is greatest among you, let him be as the younger; and he that is chief, as he that doth serve.

doth set forth <u>43\_JOH\_02\_10</u># And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: [but] thou hast kept the good wine until now.

doth shine and <u>18\_JOB\_41\_18</u># By his neesings a light doth shine, and his eyes [are] like the eyelids of the morning.

doth sing and 20\_PRO\_29\_06 # In the transgression of an evil man [there is] a snare: but the righteous doth sing and rejoice.

doth sit in 10\_2SA\_19\_08 # Then the king arose, and sat in the gate. And they told unto all the people, saying, Behold, the king doth sit in the gate. And all the people came before the king: for Israel had fled every man to his tent.

doth so easily <u>58\_HEB\_12\_01</u># Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset [us], and let us run with patience the race that is set before us,

doth speak behold <u>23\_ISA\_52\_06</u> # Therefore my people shall know my name: therefore [they shall know] in that day that I [am] he that doth speak: behold, [it is] I.

doth speak this <u>10\_2SA\_14\_13</u># And the woman said, Wherefore then hast thou thought such a thing against the people of God? for the king doth speak this thing as one which is faulty, in that the king doth not fetch home again his banished.

doth take away 23\_ISA\_03\_01\_# For, behold, the Lord, the LORD of hosts, doth take away from Jerusalem and from Judah the stay and the staff, the whole stay of bread, and the whole stay of water.

doth talk with <u>05\_DEU\_05\_24</u># And ye said, Behold, the LORD our God hath showed us his glory and his greatness, and we have heard his voice out of the midst of the fire: we have seen this day that God doth talk with man, and he liveth.

doth teach him 23\_ISA\_28\_26 # For his God doth instruct him to discretion, [and] doth teach him.

doth testify to <u>28\_HOS\_05\_05</u># And the pride of Israel doth testify to his face: therefore shall Israel and Ephraim fall in their iniquity; Judah also shall fall with them.

doth the Almighty 18\_JOB\_08\_03\_# Doth God pervert judgment? or doth the Almighty pervert justice?

doth the cause <u>23\_ISA\_01\_23</u> # Thy princes [are] rebellious, and companions of thieves: every one loveth gifts, and followeth after rewards: they judge not the fatherless, neither doth the cause of the widow come unto them.

doth the city <u>25\_LAM\_01\_01</u># How doth the city sit solitary, [that was] full of people! [how] is she become as a widow! she [that was] great among the nations, [and] princess among the provinces, [how] is she become tributary!

doth the crown 20\_PRO\_27\_24 # For riches [are] not for ever: and doth the crown [endure] to every generation?

Doth the eagle 18\_JOB\_39\_27 # Doth the eagle mount up at thy command, and make her nest on high?

doth the grave <u>18\_JOB\_24\_19</u> # Drought and heat consume the snow waters: [so doth] the grave [those which] have sinned.

Doth the hawk 18\_JOB\_39\_26 # Doth the hawk fly by thy wisdom, [and] stretch her wings toward the south?

doth the LORD <u>05\_DEU\_10\_12</u> # And now, Israel, what doth the LORD thy God require of thee, but to fear the LORD thy God, to walk in all his ways, and to love him, and to serve the LORD thy God with all thy heart and with all thy soul,

doth the LORD <u>33\_MIC\_06\_08</u># He hath showed thee, O man, what [is] good; and what doth the LORD require of thee, but to do justly, and to love mercy, and to walk humbly with thy God?

doth the LORD <u>20\_PRO\_06\_16</u> # These six [things] doth the LORD hate: yea, seven [are] an abomination unto him:

doth the ministration <u>47\_2CO\_03\_09</u> # For if the ministration of condemnation [be] glory, much more doth the ministration of righteousness exceed in glory.

Doth the plowman 23\_ISA\_28\_24 # Doth the plowman plow all day to sow? doth he open and break the clods of his ground?

doth the slothful <u>20\_PRO\_26\_14</u> # [As] the door turneth upon his hinges, so [doth] the slothful upon his bed.

doth the sweetness <u>20\_PRO\_27\_09</u> # Ointment and perfume rejoice the heart: so [doth] the sweetness of a man's friend by hearty counsel.

doth the way 24\_JER\_12\_01 # Righteous [art] thou, O LORD, when I plead with thee: yet let me talk with thee of [thy] judgments: Wherefore doth the way of the wicked prosper? [wherefore] are all they happy that deal very treacherously?

doth the wicked 19 PSA 10 13 # Wherefore doth the wicked contemn God? he hath said in his heart, Thou wilt not require [it].

Doth the wild <u>18\_JOB\_06\_05</u> # Doth the wild ass bray when he hath grass? or loweth the ox over his fodder?

doth their king 24\_JER\_49\_01 # Concerning the Ammonites, thus saith the LORD; Hath Israel no sons? hath he no heir? why [then] doth their king inherit Gad, and his people dwell in his cities?

doth thine anger 19\_PSA\_74\_01 # Maschil of Asaph. O God, why hast thou cast [us] off for ever? [why] doth thine anger smoke against the sheep of thy pasture?

doth thine heart 18\_JOB\_15\_12 # Why doth thine heart carry thee away? and what do thy eyes wink at,

doth this generation 41\_MAR\_08\_12 # And he sighed deeply in his spirit, and saith, Why doth this generation seek after a sign? verily I say unto you, There shall no sign be given unto this generation.

doth this man <u>44\_ACT\_04\_10</u># Be it known unto you all, and to all the people of Israel, that by the name of Jesus Christ of Nazareth, whom ye crucified, whom God raised from the dead, [even] by him doth this man stand here before you whole.

doth this man <u>41\_MAR\_02\_07</u> # Why doth this [man] thus speak blasphemies? who can forgive sins but God only?

Doth this offend 43\_JOH\_06\_61 # When Jesus knew in himself that his disciples murmured at it, he said unto them, Doth this offend you?

doth thy people 14\_2CH\_06\_33 # Then hear thou from the heavens, [even] from thy dwelling place, and do according to all that the stranger calleth to thee for; that all people of the earth may know thy name, and fear thee, as [doth] thy people Israel, and may know that this house which I have built is called by thy name.

doth thy wrath <u>02\_EXO\_32\_11</u># And Moses besought the LORD his God, and said, LORD, why doth thy wrath wax hot against thy people, which thou hast brought forth out of the land of Egypt with great power, and with a mighty hand?

doth touch them <u>03\_LEV\_11\_31</u># These [are] unclean to you among all that creep: whosoever doth touch them, when they be dead, shall be unclean until the even.

doth travail with 24\_JER\_30\_06 # Ask ye now, and see whether a man doth travail with child? wherefore do I see every man with his hands on his loins, as a woman in travail, and all faces are turned into paleness?

doth trouble spring <u>18\_JOB\_05\_06</u># Although affliction cometh not forth of the dust, neither doth trouble spring out of the ground;

doth turn from 26\_EZE 03\_20 # Again, When a righteous [man] doth turn from his righteousness, and commit iniquity, and I lay a stumblingblock before him, he shall die: because thou hast not given him warning, he shall die in his sin, and his righteousness which he hath done shall not be remembered; but his blood will I require at thine hand.

doth wait and 19\_PSA\_130\_05 # I wait for the LORD, my soul doth wait, and in his word do I hope.

doth waste it 19\_PSA\_80\_13 # The boar out of the wood doth waste it, and the wild beast of the field doth devour it.

doth witness against <u>23\_ISA\_03\_09</u># The show of their countenance doth witness against them; and they declare their sin as Sodom, they hide [it] not. Woe unto their soul! for they have rewarded evil unto themselves.

doth work but <u>18\_JOB\_23\_09</u> # On the left hand, where he doth work, but I cannot behold [him]: he hideth himself on the right hand, that I cannot see [him]:

doth your arguing 18\_JOB\_06\_25 # How forcible are right words! but what doth your arguing reprove?

Dothan And Joseph <u>01\_GEN\_37\_17</u> # And the man said, They are departed hence; for I heard them say, Let us go to Dothan. And Joseph went after his brethren, and found them in Dothan.

Dothan 12\_2KI\_06\_13 # And he said, Go and spy where he [is], that I may send and fetch him. And it was told him, saying, Behold, [he is] in Dothan.

Dothan <u>01\_GEN\_37\_17</u> # And the man said, They are departed hence; for I heard them say, Let us go to Dothan. And Joseph went after his brethren, and found them in Dothan.
