Adam gave names <u>01_GEN_02_20</u> # And Adam gave names to all cattle, and to the fowl of the air, and to every beast of the field; but for Adam there was not found an help meet for him.

Adam he said <u>01_GEN_03_17</u> # And unto Adam he said, Because thou hast hearkened unto the voice of thy wife, and hast eaten of the tree, of which I commanded thee, saying, Thou shalt not eat of it: cursed [is] the ground for thy sake; in sorrow shalt thou eat [of] it all the days of thy life;

Adam he set <u>05_DEU_32_08</u># When the Most High divided to the nations their inheritance, when he separated the sons of Adam, he set the bounds of the people according to the number of the children of Israel.

Adam's transgression who <u>45_ROM_05_14</u># Nevertheless death reigned from Adam to Moses, even over them that had not sinned after the similitude of Adam's transgression, who is the figure of him that was to come.

Adamah and Ramah 06_JOS_19_36 # And Adamah, and Ramah, and Hazor,

adamant harder than 26_EZE_03_09 # As an adamant harder than flint have I made thy forehead: fear

them not, neither be dismayed at their looks, though they [be] a rebellious house.

adamant stone lest <u>38_ZEC_07_12</u> # Yea, they made their hearts [as] an adamant stone, lest they should hear the law, and the words which the LORD of hosts hath sent in his spirit by the former prophets: therefore came a great wrath from the LORD of hosts.

Adami Nekeb and <u>06_JOS_19_33</u> # And their coast was from Heleph, from Allon to Zaanannim, and Adami, Nekeb, and Jabneel, unto Lakum; and the outgoings thereof were at Jordan:

Damaris and others <u>44_ACT_17_34</u> # Howbeit certain men clave unto him, and believed: among the which [was] Dionysius the Areopagite, and a woman named Damaris, and others with them.

Damascenes with a <u>47_2CO_11_32</u># In Damascus the governor under Aretas the king kept the city of the Damascenes with a garrison, desirous to apprehend me:

Damascus about noon 44_ACT_22_06 # And it came to pass, that, as I made my journey, and was come nigh unto Damascus about noon, suddenly there shone from heaven a great light round about me.

Damascus and at <u>44_ACT_26_20</u># But showed first unto them of Damascus, and at Jerusalem, and throughout all the coasts of Judaea, and [then] to the Gentiles, that they should repent and turn to God, and do works meet for repentance.

Damascus and Benhadad 12_2KI_08_07 # And Elisha came to Damascus; and Benhadad the king of Syria was sick; and it was told him, saying, The man of God is come hither.

Damascus and cut <u>30_AMO_01_05</u> # I will break also the bar of Damascus, and cut off the inhabitant from the plain of Aven, and him that holdeth the sceptre from the house of Eden: and the people of Syria shall go into captivity unto Kir, saith the LORD.

Damascus and dwelt <u>11_1KI_11_24</u># And he gathered men unto him, and became captain over a band, when David slew them [of Zobah]: and they went to Damascus, and dwelt therein, and reigned in Damascus.

Damascus and for <u>30_AMO_01_03</u> # Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Damascus, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they have threshed Gilead with threshing instruments of iron:

Damascus and it <u>24_JER_49_27</u> # And I will kindle a fire in the wall of Damascus, and it shall consume the palaces of Benhadad.

Damascus and king 12_2KI_16_10 # And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that [was] at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.

Damascus and suddenly <u>44_ACT_09_03</u> # And as he journeyed, he came near Damascus: and suddenly there shined round about him a light from heaven:

Damascus and the <u>10_2SA_08_06</u> # Then David put garrisons in Syria of Damascus: and the Syrians became servants to David, [and] brought gifts. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

Damascus and the <u>26_EZE_47_16</u> # Hamath, Berothah, Sibraim, which [is] between the border of Damascus and the border of Hamath; Hazarhatticon, which [is] by the coast of Hauran.

Damascus and the <u>26_EZE_47_17</u># And the border from the sea shall be Hazarenan, the border of Damascus, and the north northward, and the border of Hamath. And [this is] the north side.

Damascus and the <u>23_ISA_07_08</u># For the head of Syria [is] Damascus, and the head of Damascus [is] Rezin; and within threescore and five years shall Ephraim be broken, that it be not a people.

Damascus and the 23_ISA_08_04 # For before the child shall have knowledge to cry, My father, and my

mother, the riches of Damascus and the spoil of Samaria shall be taken away before the king of Assyria.

Damascus and the <u>23_ISA_17_03</u># The fortress also shall cease from Ephraim, and the kingdom from Damascus, and the remnant of Syria: they shall be as the glory of the children of Israel, saith the LORD of hosts.

Damascus and there <u>44_ACT_22_10</u># And I said, What shall I do, Lord? And the Lord said unto me, Arise, and go into Damascus; and there it shall be told thee of all things which are appointed for thee to do.

Damascus and took 12 2KI 16 09 # And the king of Assyria hearkened unto him: for the king of Assyria went up against Damascus, and took it, and carried [the people of] it captive to Kir, and slew Rezin.

Damascus came to <u>13_1CH_18_05</u> # And when the Syrians of Damascus came to help Hadarezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men.

Damascus came to 10_2SA_08_05 # And when the Syrians of Damascus came to succour Hadadezer king of Zobah, David slew of the Syrians two and twenty thousand men.

Damascus forty camels' <u>12_2KI_08_09</u># So Hazael went to meet him, and took a present with him, even of every good thing of Damascus, forty camels' burden, and came and stood before him, and said, Thy son Benhadad king of Syria hath sent me to thee, saying, Shall I recover of this disease?

Damascus Hamath is 24_JER_49_23 # Concerning Damascus. Hamath is confounded, and Arpad: for they have heard evil tidings: they are fainthearted; [there is] sorrow on the sea; it cannot be quiet.

Damascus in a <u>30_AMO_03_12</u># Thus saith the LORD; As the shepherd taketh out of the mouth of the lion two legs, or a piece of an ear; so shall the children of Israel be taken out that dwell in Samaria in the corner of a bed, and in Damascus [in] a couch.

Damascus in the <u>44_ACT_09_27</u> # But Barnabas took him, and brought [him] to the apostles, and declared unto them how he had seen the Lord in the way, and that he had spoken to him, and how he had preached boldly at Damascus in the name of Jesus.

Damascus is Rezin <u>23_ISA_07_08</u># For the head of Syria [is] Damascus, and the head of Damascus [is] Rezin; and within threescore and five years shall Ephraim be broken, that it be not a people.

Damascus is taken <u>23_ISA_17_01</u> # The burden of Damascus. Behold, Damascus is taken away from [being] a city, and it shall be a ruinous heap.

Damascus is waxed 24_JER_49_24 # Damascus is waxed feeble, [and] turneth herself to flee, and fear hath seized on [her]: anguish and sorrows have taken her, as a woman in travail.

Damascus named Ananias <u>44_ACT_09_10</u> # And there was a certain disciple at Damascus, named Ananias; and to him said the Lord in a vision, Ananias. And he said, Behold, I [am here], Lord.

Damascus northward to <u>26_EZE_48_01</u># Now these [are] the names of the tribes. From the north end to the coast of the way of Hethlon, as one goeth to Hamath, Hazarenan, the border of Damascus northward, to the coast of Hamath; for these are his sides east [and] west; a [portion for] Dan.

Damascus saying 11_1KI_15_18# Then Asa took all the silver and the gold [that were] left in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, and delivered them into the hand of his servants: and king Asa sent them to Benhadad, the son of Tabrimon, the son of Hezion, king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

Damascus the governor <u>47_2CO_11_32</u># In Damascus the governor under Aretas the king kept the city of the Damascenes with a garrison, desirous to apprehend me:

Damascus the king 12_2KI_16_12# And when the king was come from Damascus, the king saw the altar: and the king approached to the altar, and offered thereon.

Damascus to bring 44_ACT_22_05 # As also the high priest doth bear me witness, and all the estate of the elders: from whom also I received letters unto the brethren, and went to Damascus, to bring them which were there bound unto Jerusalem, for to be punished.

Damascus to meet 12 2KI 16 10 # And king Ahaz went to Damascus to meet Tiglathpileser king of Assyria, and saw an altar that [was] at Damascus: and king Ahaz sent to Urijah the priest the fashion of the altar, and the pattern of it, according to all the workmanship thereof.

Damascus to the <u>44_ACT_09_02</u> # And desired of him letters to Damascus to the synagogues, that if he found any of this way, whether they were men or women, he might bring them bound unto Jerusalem.

Damascus was thy <u>26_EZE_27_18</u> # Damascus [was] thy merchant in the multitude of the wares of thy making, for the multitude of all riches; in the wine of Helbon, and white wool.

Damascus which smote <u>14_2CH_28_23</u># For he sacrificed unto the gods of Damascus, which smote him: and he said, Because the gods of the kings of Syria help them, [therefore] will I sacrifice to them, that they may help me. But they were the ruin of him, and of all Israel.

Damascus with authority 44_ACT_26_12 # Whereupon as I went to Damascus with authority and commission from the chief priests,

Damascus 11_1KI_11_24# And he gathered men unto him, and became captain over a band, when David slew them [of Zobah]: and they went to Damascus, and dwelt therein, and reigned in Damascus.

Damascus 14_2CH_24_23 # And it came to pass at the end of the year, [that] the host of Syria came up against him: and they came to Judah and Jerusalem, and destroyed all the princes of the people from among the people, and sent all the spoil of them unto the king of Damascus.

Damascus 12_2KI_16_11# And Urijah the priest built an altar according to all that king Ahaz had sent from Damascus: so Urijah the priest made [it] against king Ahaz came from Damascus.

Damascus 44_ACT_09_08 # And Saul arose from the earth; and when his eyes were opened, he saw no man: but they led him by the hand, and brought [him] into Damascus.

Damascus <u>44_ACT_09_19</u> # And when he had received meat, he was strengthened. Then was Saul certain days with the disciples which were at Damascus.

Damascus <u>44_ACT_22_11</u># And when I could not see for the glory of that light, being led by the hand of them that were with me, I came into Damascus.

Damascus <u>48_GAL_01_17</u> # Neither went I up to Jerusalem to them which were apostles before me; but I went into Arabia, and returned again unto Damascus.

Damascus <u>01_GEN_14_15</u> # And he divided himself against them, he and his servants, by night, and smote them, and pursued them unto Hobah, which [is] on the left hand of Damascus.

Damascus <u>01_GEN_15_02</u> # And Abram said, Lord GOD, what wilt thou give me, seeing I go childless, and the steward of my house [is] this Eliezer of Damascus?

Damascus 23_ISA_10_09 # [Is] not Calno as Carchemish? [is] not Hamath as Arpad? [is] not Samaria as Damascus?

Damascus 22_SON_07_04 # Thy neck [is] as a tower of ivory; thine eyes [like] the fishpools in Heshbon, by the gate of Bathrabbim: thy nose [is] as the tower of Lebanon which looketh toward Damascus.

damnable heresies even <u>61_2PE_02_01</u> # But there were false prophets also among the people, even as there shall be false teachers among you, who privily shall bring in damnable heresies, even denying the Lord that bought them, and bring upon themselves swift destruction.

damnation because they 54_1TI_05_12 # Having damnation, because they have cast off their first faith.

damnation is just <u>45_ROM_03_08</u># And not [rather], [as we be slanderously reported, and as some affirm that we say,] Let us do evil, that good may come? whose damnation is just.

damnation of hell <u>40_MAT_23_33</u> # [Ye] serpents, [ye] generation of vipers, how can ye escape the damnation of hell?

damnation slumbereth not <u>61_2PE_02_03</u># And through covetousness shall they with feigned words make merchandise of you: whose judgment now of a long time lingereth not, and their damnation slumbereth not.

damnation to himself <u>46_1CO_11_29</u># For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.

damnation <u>43_JOH_05_29</u> # And shall come forth; they that have done good, unto the resurrection of life; and they that have done evil, unto the resurrection of damnation.

damnation <u>42_LUK_20_47</u> # Which devour widows' houses, and for a show make long prayers: the same shall receive greater damnation.

damnation <u>41_MAR_03_29</u> # But he that shall blaspheme against the Holy Ghost hath never forgiveness, but is in danger of eternal damnation:

damnation <u>41_MAR_12_40</u> # Which devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayers: these shall receive greater damnation.

damnation 40 MAT 23 14 Woe unto you, scribes and Pharisees, hypocrites! for ye devour widows' houses, and for a pretence make long prayer: therefore ye shall receive the greater damnation.

damnation <u>45_ROM_13_02</u> # Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation.

damned if he <u>45_ROM_14_23</u> # And he that doubteth is damned if he eat, because [he eateth] not of faith: for whatsoever [is] not of faith is sin.

damned who believed <u>53_2TH_02_12</u> # That they all might be damned who believed not the truth, but had pleasure in unrighteousness.

damned <u>41_MAR_16_16</u># He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

damsel abide with <u>01_GEN_24_55</u> # And her brother and her mother said, Let the damsel abide with us [a few] days, at the least ten; after that she shall go.

damsel and her <u>05_DEU_22_15</u># Then shall the father of the damsel, and her mother, take and bring forth [the tokens of] the damsel's virginity unto the elders of the city in the gate:

damsel and inquire 01_GEN_24_57 # And they said, We will call the damsel, and inquire at her mouth.

damsel and she <u>40_MAT_14_11</u># And his head was brought in a charger, and given to the damsel: and she brought [it] to her mother.

damsel and spake <u>01_GEN_34_03</u> # And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel, and spake kindly unto the damsel.

damsel and the <u>41_MAR_06_28</u># And brought his head in a charger, and gave it to the damsel: and the damsel gave it to her mother.

damsel and them <u>41_MAR_05_40</u> # And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying.

damsel arose and <u>41_MAR_05_42</u> # And straightway the damsel arose, and walked; for she was [of the age] of twelve years. And they were astonished with a great astonishment.

damsel Ask of <u>41_MAR_06_22</u># And when the daughter of the said Herodias came in, and danced, and pleased Herod and them that sat with him, the king said unto the damsel, Ask of me whatsoever thou wilt, and I will give [it] thee.

damsel because he <u>05_DEU_22_19</u> # And they shall amerce him in an hundred [shekels] of silver, and give [them] unto the father of the damsel, because he hath brought up an evil name upon a virgin of Israel: and

she shall be his wife; he may not put her away all his days.

damsel because she <u>05_DEU_22_24</u># Then ye shall bring them both out unto the gate of that city, and ye shall stone them with stones that they die; the damsel, because she cried not, [being] in the city; and the man, because he hath humbled his neighbour's wife: so thou shalt put away evil from among you.

damsel by the <u>41_MAR_05_41</u> # And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

damsel came to 44_ACT_12_13 # And as Peter knocked at the door of the gate, a damsel came to hearken, named Rhoda.

damsel came unto 40_MAT_26_69 # Now Peter sat without in the palace: and a damsel came unto him, saying, Thou also wast with Jesus of Galilee.

damsel cried and <u>05_DEU_22_27</u># For he found her in the field, [and] the betrothed damsel cried, and [there was] none to save her.

damsel gave it <u>41_MAR_06_28</u># And brought his head in a charger, and gave it to the damsel: and the damsel gave it to her mother.

Damsel I say <u>41_MAR_05_41</u># And he took the damsel by the hand, and said unto her, Talitha cumi; which is, being interpreted, Damsel, I say unto thee, arise.

damsel in the <u>05_DEU_22_25</u># But if a man find a betrothed damsel in the field, and the man force her, and lie with her: then the man only that lay with her shall die:

damsel is not <u>41_MAR_05_39</u> # And when he was come in, he saith unto them, Why make ye this ado, and weep? the damsel is not dead, but sleepeth.

damsel is this <u>08_RUT_02_05</u> # Then said Boaz unto his servant that was set over the reapers, Whose damsel [is] this?

damsel no sin <u>05_DEU_22_26</u> # But unto the damsel thou shalt do nothing; [there is] in the damsel no sin [worthy] of death: for as when a man riseth against his neighbour, and slayeth him, even so [is] this matter:

damsel or two <u>07_JUD_05_30</u> # Have they not sped? have they [not] divided the prey; to every man a damsel [or] two; to Sisera a prey of divers colours, a prey of divers colours of needlework, of divers colours of needlework on both sides, [meet] for the necks of [them that take] the spoil?

damsel possessed with <u>44_ACT_16_16</u># And it came to pass, as we went to prayer, a certain damsel possessed with a spirit of divination met us, which brought her masters much gain by soothsaying:

damsel ran and 01_GEN_24_28 # And the damsel ran, and told [them of] her mother's house these things.

damsel saw him <u>07_JUD_19_03</u># And her husband arose, and went after her, to speak friendly unto her, [and] to bring her again, having his servant with him, and a couple of asses: and she brought him into her father's house: and when the father of the damsel saw him, he rejoiced to meet him.

damsel that came <u>08_RUT_02_06</u> # And the servant that was set over the reapers answered and said, It [is] the Moabitish damsel that came back with Naomi out of the country of Moab:

damsel that is <u>05_DEU_22_23</u> # If a damsel [that is] a virgin be betrothed unto an husband, and a man find her in the city, and lie with her;

damsel that is <u>05_DEU_22_28</u> # If a man find a damsel [that is] a virgin, which is not betrothed, and lay hold on her, and lie with her, and they be found;

damsel that kept 43_JOH_18_17_# Then saith the damsel that kept the door unto Peter, Art not thou also [one] of this man's disciples? He saith, I am not.

damsel thou shalt <u>05_DEU_22_26</u># But unto the damsel thou shalt do nothing; [there is] in the damsel no sin [worthy] of death: for as when a man riseth against his neighbour, and slayeth him, even so [is] this matter:

damsel throughout all <u>11_1KI_01_03</u># So they sought for a fair damsel throughout all the coasts of Israel, and found Abishag a Shunammite, and brought her to the king.

damsel to the <u>05_DEU_22_21</u># Then they shall bring out the damsel to the door of her father's house, and the men of her city shall stone her with stones that she die: because she hath wrought folly in Israel, to play the whore in her father's house: so shalt thou put evil away from among you.

damsel to whom <u>01_GEN_24_14</u># And let it come to pass, that the damsel to whom I shall say, Let down thy pitcher, I pray thee, that I may drink; and she shall say, Drink, and I will give thy camels drink also: [let the same be] she [that] thou hast appointed for thy servant Isaac; and thereby shall I know that thou hast showed kindness unto my master.

damsel to wife <u>01_GEN_34_04</u># And Shechem spake unto his father Hamor, saying, Get me this damsel to wife.

damsel to wife <u>01_GEN_34_12</u> # Ask me never so much dowry and gift, and I will give according as ye shall say unto me: but give me the damsel to wife.

damsel was lying <u>41_MAR_05_40</u># And they laughed him to scorn. But when he had put them all out, he taketh the father and the mother of the damsel, and them that were with him, and entereth in where the damsel was lying.

damsel was very <u>11_1KI_01_04</u># And the damsel [was] very fair, and cherished the king, and ministered to him: but the king knew her not.

damsel was very <u>01_GEN_24_16</u># And the damsel [was] very fair to look upon, a virgin, neither had any man known her: and she went down to the well, and filled her pitcher, and came up.

damsel <u>05_DEU_22_20</u> # But if this thing be true, [and the tokens of] virginity be not found for the damsel:

damsel <u>01_GEN_34_03</u># And his soul clave unto Dinah the daughter of Jacob, and he loved the damsel, and spake kindly unto the damsel.

damsel's father fifty <u>05 DEU 22 29 #</u> Then the man that lay with her shall give unto the damsel's father fifty [shekels] of silver, and she shall be his wife; because he hath humbled her, he may not put her away all his days.

damsel's father had <u>07_JUD_19_06</u># And they sat down, and did eat and drink both of them together: for the damsel's father had said unto the man, Be content, I pray thee, and tarry all night, and let thine heart be merry.

damsel's father retained <u>07_JUD_19_04</u> # And his father in law, the damsel's father, retained him; and he abode with him three days: so they did eat and drink, and lodged there.

damsel's father said 07_JUD_19_05 # And it came to pass on the fourth day, when they arose early in the

morning, that he rose up to depart: and the damsel's father said unto his son in law, Comfort thine heart with a morsel of bread, and afterward go your way.

damsel's father said <u>07_JUD_19_08</u># And he arose early in the morning on the fifth day to depart: and the damsel's father said, Comfort thine heart, I pray thee. And they tarried until afternoon, and they did eat both of them.

damsel's father said <u>07_JUD_19_09</u># And when the man rose up to depart, he, and his concubine, and his servant, his father in law, the damsel's father, said unto him, Behold, now the day draweth toward evening, I pray you tarry all night: behold, the day groweth to an end, lodge here, that thine heart may be merry; and to morrow get you early on your way, that thou mayest go home.

damsel's father shall <u>05_DEU_22_16</u># And the damsel's father shall say unto the elders, I gave my daughter unto this man to wife, and he hateth her;

damsel's virginity unto <u>05_DEU_22_15</u># Then shall the father of the damsel, and her mother, take and bring forth [the tokens of] the damsel's virginity unto the elders of the city in the gate:

damsels and they <u>01_GEN_24_61</u># And Rebekah arose, and her damsels, and they rode upon the camels, and followed the man: and the servant took Rebekah, and went his way.

damsels of hers <u>09_1SA_25_42</u> # And Abigail hasted, and arose, and rode upon an ass, with five damsels of hers that went after her; and she went after the messengers of David, and became his wife.

damsels playing with 19_PSA_68_25_# The singers went before, the players on instruments [followed] after; among [them were] the damsels playing with timbrels.

Elmodam which was 42_LUK_03_28 # Which was [the son] of Melchi, which was [the son] of Addi, which was [the son] of Cosam, which was [the son] of Elmodam, which was [the son] of Er,

endamage the revenue <u>15_EZR_04_13</u> # Be it known now unto the king, that, if this city be builded, and the walls set up [again, then] will they not pay toll, tribute, and custom, and [so] thou shalt endamage the revenue of the kings.

Ephesdammin <u>09_1SA_17_01</u># Now the Philistines gathered together their armies to battle, and were gathered together at Shochoh, which [belongeth] to Judah, and pitched between Shochoh and Azekah, in Ephesdammin.

Pasdammim and there <u>13_1CH_11_13</u># He was with David at Pasdammim, and there the Philistines were gathered together to battle, where was a parcel of ground full of barley; and the people fled from before the Philistines.

Syriadamascus and the <u>13_1CH_18_06</u># Then David put [garrisons] in Syriadamascus; and the Syrians became David's servants, [and] brought gifts. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.
