debtor both to <u>45\_ROM\_01\_14</u> # I am debtor both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians; both to the wise, and to the unwise.

debtor his pledge <u>26\_EZE\_18\_07</u># And hath not oppressed any, [but] hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by violence, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment;

debtor to do <u>48\_GAL\_05\_03</u># For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.

debtor <u>40\_MAT\_23\_16</u># Woe unto you, [ye] blind guides, which say, Whosoever shall swear by the temple, it is nothing; but whosoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor!

debtors not to 45\_ROM\_08\_12 # Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

debtors the one <u>42\_LUK\_07\_41</u> # There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty.

debtors they are <u>45\_ROM\_15\_27</u># It hath pleased them verily; and their debtors they are. For if the Gentiles have been made partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister unto them in carnal things.

debtors unto him <u>42\_LUK\_16\_05</u> # So he called every one of his lord's debtors [unto him], and said unto the first, How much owest thou unto my lord?

debtors 40\_MAT\_06\_12 # And forgive us our debts, as we forgive our debtors.
