debtor both to [45 ROM 01 14](#) # I am debtor both to the Greeks, and to the Barbarians; both to the wise, and to the unwise.

debtor his pledge [26 EZE 18 07](#) # And hath not oppressed any, [but] hath restored to the debtor his pledge, hath spoiled none by violence, hath given his bread to the hungry, and hath covered the naked with a garment;

debtor to do [48 GAL 05 03](#) # For I testify again to every man that is circumcised, that he is a debtor to do the whole law.

debtor [40 MAT 23 16](#) # Woe unto you, [ye] blind guides, which say, Whosoever shall swear by the temple, it is nothing; but whosoever shall swear by the gold of the temple, he is a debtor!

debtors not to [45 ROM 08 12](#) # Therefore, brethren, we are debtors, not to the flesh, to live after the flesh.

debtors the one [42 LUK 07 41](#) # There was a certain creditor which had two debtors: the one owed five hundred pence, and the other fifty.

debtors they are [45 ROM 15 27](#) # It hath pleased them verily; and their debtors they are. For if the Gentiles have been made partakers of their spiritual things, their duty is also to minister unto them in carnal things.
