decay with thee <u>03_LEV_25_35</u># And if thy brother be waxen poor, and fallen in decay with thee; then thou shalt relieve him: [yea, though he be] a stranger, or a sojourner; that he may live with thee.

decayed and there <u>16_NEH_04_10</u> # And Judah said, The strength of the bearers of burdens is decayed, and [there is] much rubbish; so that we are not able to build the wall.

decayed places thereof <u>23_ISA_44_26</u># That confirmeth the word of his servant, and performeth the counsel of his messengers; that saith to Jerusalem, Thou shalt be inhabited; and to the cities of Judah, Ye shall be built, and I will raise up the decayed places thereof:

decayeth and drieth <u>18_JOB_14_11</u># [As] the waters fail from the sea, and the flood decayeth and drieth up:

decayeth and through <u>21_ECC_10_18</u># By much slothfulness the building decayeth; and through idleness of the hands the house droppeth through.

decayeth and waxeth <u>58_HEB_08_13</u># In that he saith, A new [covenant], he hath made the first old. Now that which decayeth and waxeth old [is] ready to vanish away.
