deceiveth himself <u>48_GAL_06_03</u> # For if a man think himself to be something, when he is nothing, he deceiveth himself.

deceiveth his neighbour 20_PRO_26_19 # So [is] the man [that] deceiveth his neighbour, and saith, Am not I in sport?

deceiveth his own <u>59_JAM_01_26</u># If any man among you seem to be religious, and bridleth not his tongue, but deceiveth his own heart, this man's religion [is] vain.

deceiveth the people <u>43_JOH_07_12</u># And there was much murmuring among the people concerning him: for some said, He is a good man: others said, Nay; but he deceiveth the people.

deceiveth the whole 66_REV_12_09 # And the great dragon was cast out, that old serpent, called the Devil, and Satan, which deceiveth the whole world: he was cast out into the earth, and his angels were cast out with him.

deceiveth them that <u>66_REV_13_14</u> # And deceiveth them that dwell on the earth by [the means of] those miracles which he had power to do in the sight of the beast; saying to them that dwell on the earth, that they should make an image to the beast, which had the wound by a sword, and did live.
