deep and cause <u>26\_EZE\_32\_14</u># Then will I make their waters deep, and cause their rivers to run like oil, saith the Lord GOD.

deep and did 30 AMO 07 04 # Thus hath the Lord GOD showed unto me: and, behold, the Lord GOD called to contend by fire, and it devoured the great deep, and did eat up a part.

deep and laid <u>42\_LUK\_06\_48</u># He is like a man which built an house, and digged deep, and laid the foundation on a rock: and when the flood arose, the stream beat vehemently upon that house, and could not shake it: for it was founded upon a rock.

deep and large <u>26\_EZE\_23\_32</u> # Thus saith the Lord GOD; Thou shalt drink of thy sister's cup deep and large: thou shalt be laughed to scorn and had in derision; it containeth much.

deep and large <u>23\_ISA\_30\_33</u># For Tophet [is] ordained of old; yea, for the king it is prepared; he hath made [it] deep [and] large: the pile thereof [is] fire and much wood; the breath of the LORD, like a stream of brimstone, doth kindle it.

deep and let <u>42\_LUK\_05\_04</u># Now when he had left speaking, he said unto Simon, Launch out into the deep, and let down your nets for a draught.

deep and secret <u>27\_DAN\_02\_22</u> # He revealeth the deep and secret things: he knoweth what [is] in the darkness, and the light dwelleth with him.

deep And the <u>01\_GEN\_01\_02</u># And the earth was without form, and void; and darkness [was] upon the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God moved upon the face of the waters.

deep and the <u>01\_GEN\_08\_02</u> # The fountains also of the deep and the windows of heaven were stopped, and the rain from heaven was restrained;

deep as an <u>23\_ISA\_63\_13</u># That led them through the deep, as an horse in the wilderness, [that] they should not stumble?

deep as with 19\_PSA\_104\_06 # Thou coveredst it with the deep as [with] a garment: the waters stood above the mountains.

deep at the 19\_PSA\_42\_07\_# Deep calleth unto deep at the noise of thy waterspouts: all thy waves and thy billows are gone over me.

deep Be dry 23\_ISA\_44\_27 # That saith to the deep, Be dry, and I will dry up thy rivers:

deep broken up <u>01\_GEN\_07\_11</u># In the six hundredth year of Noah's life, in the second month, the seventeenth day of the month, the same day were all the fountains of the great deep broken up, and the windows of heaven were opened.

Deep calleth unto 19\_PSA\_42\_07 # Deep calleth unto deep at the noise of thy waterspouts: all thy waves and thy billows are gone over me.

deep ditch and 20\_PRO\_23\_27 # For a whore [is] a deep ditch; and a strange woman [is] a narrow pit.

deep for him <u>26\_EZE\_31\_15</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; In the day when he went down to the grave I caused a mourning: I covered the deep for him, and I restrained the floods thereof, and the great waters were stayed: and I caused Lebanon to mourn for him, and all the trees of the field fainted for him.

deep from whence 43\_JOH\_04\_11# The woman saith unto him, Sir, thou hast nothing to draw with, and the well is deep: from whence then hast thou that living water?

deep in the <u>32\_JON\_02\_03</u># For thou hadst cast me into the deep, in the midst of the seas; and the floods compassed me about: all thy billows and thy waves passed over me.

deep is frozen 18\_JOB\_38\_30 # The waters are hid as [with] a stone, and the face of the deep is frozen.

deep mire where 19\_PSA\_69\_02 # I sink in deep mire, where [there is] no standing: I am come into deep waters, where the floods overflow me.

deep O inhabitants 24\_JER\_49\_08 # Flee ye, turn back, dwell deep, O inhabitants of Dedan; for I will bring the calamity of Esau upon him, the time [that] I will visit him.

deep O LORD <u>19\_PSA\_36\_06</u> # Thy righteousness [is] like the great mountains; thy judgments [are] a great deep: O LORD, thou preservest man and beast.

deep O ye 24 JER 49 30 # Flee, get you far off, dwell deep, O ye inhabitants of Hazor, saith the LORD; for Nebuchadrezzar king of Babylon hath taken counsel against you, and hath conceived a purpose against you.

deep pit he <u>20\_PRO\_22\_14</u># The mouth of strange women [is] a deep pit: he that is abhorred of the LORD shall fall therein.

deep pits that <u>19\_PSA\_140\_10</u> # Let burning coals fall upon them: let them be cast into the fire; into deep pits, that they rise not up again.

deep places of 19\_PSA\_95\_04 # In his hand [are] the deep places of the earth: the strength of the hills [is] his also.

deep places 19\_PSA\_135\_06 # Whatsoever the LORD pleased, [that] did he in heaven, and in earth, in the seas, and all deep places.

deep poverty abounded <u>47\_2CO\_08\_02</u># How that in a great trial of affliction the abundance of their joy and their deep poverty abounded unto the riches of their liberality.

deep root and 19\_PSA\_80\_09 # Thou preparedst [room] before it, and didst cause it to take deep root, and it filled the land.

deep set him <u>26\_EZE\_31\_04</u># The waters made him great, the deep set him up on high with her rivers running round about his plants, and sent out her little rivers unto all the trees of the field.

deep that coucheth <u>05\_DEU\_33\_13</u> # And of Joseph he said, Blessed of the LORD [be] his land, for the precious things of heaven, for the dew, and for the deep that coucheth beneath,

deep that hath <u>23\_ISA\_51\_10</u> # [Art] thou not it which hath dried the sea, the waters of the great deep; that hath made the depths of the sea a way for the ransomed to pass over?

deep that is <u>45\_ROM\_10\_07</u> # Or, Who shall descend into the deep? [that is, to bring up Christ again from the dead.]

deep that lieth <u>01\_GEN\_49\_25</u> # [Even] by the God of thy father, who shall help thee; and by the Almighty, who shall bless thee with blessings of heaven above, blessings of the deep that lieth under, blessings of the breasts, and of the womb:

deep things of <u>46\_1CO\_02\_10</u> # But God hath revealed [them] unto us by his Spirit: for the Spirit searcheth all things, yea, the deep things of God.

deep things out <u>18\_JOB\_12\_22</u># He discovereth deep things out of darkness, and bringeth out to light the shadow of death.

deep to be 18\_JOB\_41\_32 # He maketh a path to shine after him; [one] would think the deep [to be] hoary.

deep to boil 18\_JOB\_41\_31 # He maketh the deep to boil like a pot: he maketh the sea like a pot of ointment.

deep to hide <u>23\_ISA\_29\_15</u># Woe unto them that seek deep to hide their counsel from the LORD, and their works are in the dark, and they say, Who seeth us? and who knoweth us?

deep upon thee <u>26\_EZE\_26\_19</u># For thus saith the Lord GOD; When I shall make thee a desolate city, like the cities that are not inhabited; when I shall bring up the deep upon thee, and great waters shall cover

thee;

deep uttered his <u>35\_HAB\_03\_10</u># The mountains saw thee, [and] they trembled: the overflowing of the water passed by: the deep uttered his voice, [and] lifted up his hands on high.

deep water but 20\_PRO\_20\_05 # Counsel in the heart of man [is like] deep water; but a man of understanding will draw it out.

deep waters and 20\_PRO\_18\_04 # The words of a man's mouth [are as] deep waters, [and] the wellspring of wisdom [as] a flowing brook.

deep waters but <u>26\_EZE\_34\_18</u># [Seemeth it] a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but ye must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? and to have drunk of the deep waters, but ye must foul the residue with your feet?

deep waters where 19\_PSA\_69\_02 # I sink in deep mire, where [there is] no standing: I am come into deep waters, where the floods overflow me.

deep waters 19\_PSA\_69\_14 # Deliver me out of the mire, and let me not sink: let me be delivered from them that hate me, and out of the deep waters.

deep who can 21\_ECC\_07\_24 # That which is far off, and exceeding deep, who can find it out?

deep <u>47\_2CO\_11\_25</u># Thrice was I beaten with rods, once was I stoned, thrice I suffered shipwreck, a night and a day I have been in the deep;

deep 42\_LUK\_08\_31 # And they be sought him that he would not command them to go out into the deep.

deep <u>20\_PRO\_08\_28</u># When he established the clouds above: when he strengthened the fountains of the deep:

deep 19 PSA 107 24 # These see the works of the LORD, and his wonders in the deep.

deep <u>19\_PSA\_64\_06</u> # They search out iniquities; they accomplish a diligent search: both the inward [thought] of every one [of them], and the heart, [is] deep.

deep 19\_PSA\_92\_05 # O LORD, how great are thy works! [and] thy thoughts are very deep.

deeper than hell <u>18\_JOB\_11\_08</u># [It is] as high as heaven; what canst thou do? deeper than hell; what canst thou know?

deeper than the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_03</u># And the priest shall look on the plague in the skin of the flesh: and [when] the hair in the plague is turned white, and the plague in sight [be] deeper than the skin of his flesh, it [is] a plague of leprosy: and the priest shall look on him, and pronounce him unclean.

deeper than the <u>03\_LEV\_13\_04</u># If the bright spot [be] white in the skin of his flesh, and in sight [be] not deeper than the skin, and the hair thereof be not turned white; then the priest shall shut up [him that hath] the plague seven days:
