demand by the [27 DAN 04 17](#) # This matter [is] by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.

demand of thee [18 JOB 38 03](#) # Gird up now thy loins like a man; for I will demand of thee, and answer thou me.

demand of thee [18 JOB 40 07](#) # Gird up thy loins now like a man: I will demand of thee, and declare thou unto me.

demand of thee [18 JOB 42 04](#) # Hear, I beseech thee, and I will speak: I will demand of thee, and declare thou unto me.
