demand by the <u>27_DAN_04_17</u> # This matter [is] by the decree of the watchers, and the demand by the word of the holy ones: to the intent that the living may know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will, and setteth up over it the basest of men.

demand of thee <u>18_JOB_38_03</u># Gird up now thy loins like a man; for I will demand of thee, and answer thou me.

demand of thee <u>18_JOB_40_07</u># Gird up thy loins now like a man: I will demand of thee, and declare thou unto me.

demand of thee <u>18_JOB_42_04</u> # Hear, I beseech thee, and I will speak: I will demand of thee, and declare thou unto me.

demanded cannot the <u>27_DAN_02_27</u> # Daniel answered in the presence of the king, and said, The secret which the king hath demanded cannot the wise [men], the astrologers, the magicians, the soothsayers, show unto the king;

demanded of him <u>10_2SA_11_07</u># And when Uriah was come unto him, David demanded [of him] how Joab did, and how the people did, and how the war prospered.

demanded of him <u>42_LUK_03_14</u># And the soldiers likewise demanded of him, saying, And what shall we do? And he said unto them, Do violence to no man, neither accuse [any] falsely; and be content with your wages.

demanded of the <u>42_LUK_17_20</u> # And when he was demanded of the Pharisees, when the kingdom of God should come, he answered them and said, The kingdom of God cometh not with observation:

demanded of them <u>40_MAT_02_04</u># And when he had gathered all the chief priests and scribes of the people together, he demanded of them where Christ should be born.

demanded Wherefore have <u>02_EXO_05_14</u> # And the officers of the children of Israel, which Pharaoh's taskmasters had set over them, were beaten, [and] demanded, Wherefore have ye not fulfilled your task in making brick both yesterday and to day, as heretofore?

demanded who he <u>44_ACT_21_33</u> # Then the chief captain came near, and took him, and commanded [him] to be bound with two chains; and demanded who he was, and what he had done.
