confidence in the <u>53_2TH_03_04</u> # And we have confidence in the Lord touching you, that ye both do and will do the things which we command you.

confidence in the <u>50_PHP_03_03</u># For we are the circumcision, which worship God in the spirit, and rejoice in Christ Jesus, and have no confidence in the flesh.

denied the Holy 44_ACT_03_14 # But ye denied the Holy One and the Just, and desired a murderer to be granted unto you;

denied with an 40_MAT_26_72 # And again he denied with an oath, I do not know the man.

denieth me before 42_LUK_12_09 # But he that denieth me before men shall be denied before the angels of God.

denieth that Jesus 62_1JO_02_22 # Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.

denieth the Father <u>62_1JO_02_22</u> # Who is a liar but he that denieth that Jesus is the Christ? He is antichrist, that denieth the Father and the Son.

denieth the Son <u>62_1JO_02_23</u> # Whosoever denieth the Son, the same hath not the Father: [@but@ he that acknowledgeth the Son hath the Father also].

handmaiden for behold <u>42_LUK_01_48</u> # For he hath regarded the low estate of his handmaiden: for, behold, from henceforth all generations shall call me blessed.

handmaidens came near <u>01_GEN_33_06</u># Then the handmaidens came near, they and their children, and they bowed themselves.

handmaidens I will <u>44_ACT_02_18</u> # And on my servants and on my handmaidens I will pour out in those days of my Spirit; and they shall prophesy:

handmaidens <u>08_RUT_02_13</u># Then she said, Let me find favour in thy sight, my lord; for that thou hast comforted me, and for that thou hast spoken friendly unto thine handmaid, though I be not like unto one of thine handmaidens.

harden his heart <u>02_EXO_04_21</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, When thou goest to return into Egypt, see that thou do all those wonders before Pharaoh, which I have put in thine hand: but I will harden his heart, that he shall not let the people go.

harden myself in <u>18_JOB_06_10</u> # Then should I yet have comfort; yea, I would harden myself in sorrow: let him not spare; for I have not concealed the words of the Holy One.

hardeneth his neck <u>20_PRO_29_01</u># He, that being often reproved hardeneth [his] neck, shall suddenly be destroyed, and that without remedy.

hardeneth <u>45_ROM_09_18</u> # Therefore hath he mercy on whom he will [have mercy], and whom he will he hardeneth.

hidden from him <u>44_ACT_26_26</u> # For the king knoweth of these things, before whom also I speak freely: for I am persuaded that none of these things are hidden from him; for this thing was not done in a corner.

hidden from him <u>03_LEV_05_02</u># Or if a soul touch any unclean thing, whether [it be] a carcase of an unclean beast, or a carcase of unclean cattle, or the carcase of unclean creeping things, and [if] it be hidden from him; he also shall be unclean, and guilty.

hidden 20_PRO_28_12 # When righteous [men] do rejoice, [there is] great glory: but when the wicked rise, a man is hidden.

holden in cords 18_JOB_36_08 # And if [they be] bound in fetters, [and] be holden in cords of affliction;

holden me by 19_PSA_73_23 # Nevertheless I [am] continually with thee: thou hast holden [me] by my right hand.

holden me up 19_PSA_18_35 # Thou hast also given me the shield of thy salvation: and thy right hand hath holden me up, and thy gentleness hath made me great.

holden my peace 23_ISA_42_14 # I have long time holden my peace; I have been still, [and] refrained myself: [now] will I cry like a travailing woman; I will destroy and devour at once.

holden of it <u>44_ACT_02_24</u># Whom God hath raised up, having loosed the pains of death: because it was not possible that he should be holden of it.

holden such a 12_2KI_23_22 # Surely there was not holden such a passover from the days of the judges that judged Israel, nor in all the days of the kings of Israel, nor of the kings of Judah;

holden that they 42 LUK 24 16 # But their eyes were holden that they should not know him.

holden to subdue 23_ISA_45_01 # Thus saith the LORD to his anointed, to Cyrus, whose right hand I have holden, to subdue nations before him; and I will loose the loins of kings, to open before him the two leaved gates; and the gates shall not be shut;

holden to the 12_2KI_23_23 # But in the eighteenth year of king Josiah, [wherein] this passover was holden to the LORD in Jerusalem.

laden with sins <u>55_2TI_03_06</u> # For of this sort are they which creep into houses, and lead captive silly women laden with sins, led away with divers lusts,

laden with the <u>01_GEN_45_23</u> # And to his father he sent after this [manner]; ten asses laden with the good things of Egypt, and ten she asses laden with corn and bread and meat for his father by the way.
