destitute afflicted tormented <u>58 HEB 11 37</u> # They were stoned, they were sawn asunder, were tempted, were slain with the sword: they wandered about in sheepskins and goatskins; being destitute, afflicted, tormented;

destitute and not <u>19\_PSA\_102\_17</u> # He will regard the prayer of the destitute, and not despise their prayer.

destitute my master <u>01\_GEN\_24\_27</u> # And he said, Blessed [be] the LORD God of my master Abraham, who hath not left destitute my master of his mercy and his truth: I [being] in the way, the LORD led me to the house of my master's brethren.

destitute of daily <u>59\_JAM\_02\_15</u> # If a brother or sister be naked, and destitute of daily food,

destitute of that <u>26\_EZE\_32\_15</u> # When I shall make the land of Egypt desolate, and the country shall be destitute of that whereof it was full, when I shall smite all them that dwell therein, then shall they know that I [am] the LORD.

destitute of the <u>54\_1TI\_06\_05</u> # Perverse disputings of men of corrupt minds, and destitute of the truth, supposing that gain is godliness: from such withdraw thyself.

destitute of wisdom <u>20\_PRO\_15\_21</u> # Folly [is] joy to [him that is] destitute of wisdom: but a man of understanding walketh uprightly.

destitute <u>19\_PSA\_141\_08</u> # But mine eyes [are] unto thee, O GOD the Lord: in thee is my trust; leave not my soul destitute.
