

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

devoureth before them <u>29\_JOE\_02\_03</u># A fire devoureth before them; and behind them a flame burneth: the land [is] as the garden of Eden before them, and behind them a desolate wilderness; yea, and nothing shall escape them.

devoureth both the <u>26\_EZE\_15\_04</u> # Behold, it is cast into the fire for fuel; the fire devoureth both the ends of it, and the midst of it is burned. Is it meet for [any] work?

devoureth iniquity <u>20\_PRO\_19\_28</u># An ungodly witness scorneth judgment: and the mouth of the wicked devoureth iniquity.

devoureth one as <u>10\_2SA\_11\_25</u># Then David said unto the messenger, Thus shalt thou say unto Joab, Let not this thing displease thee, for the sword devoureth one as well as another: make thy battle more strong against the city, and overthrow it: and encourage thou him.

devoureth round about <u>25\_LAM\_02\_03</u> # He hath cut off in [his] fierce anger all the horn of Israel: he hath drawn back his right hand from before the enemy, and he burned against Jacob like a flaming fire, [which] devoureth round about.

devoureth that which <u>20\_PRO\_20\_25</u> # [It is] a snare to the man [who] devoureth [that which is] holy, and after vows to make inquiry.

devoureth the man <u>35\_HAB\_01\_13</u># [Thou art] of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity: wherefore lookest thou upon them that deal treacherously, [and] holdest thy tongue when the wicked devoureth [the man that is] more righteous than he?

devoureth the stubble 23\_ISA\_05\_24 # Therefore as the fire devoureth the stubble, and the flame consumeth the chaff, [so] their root shall be as rottenness, and their blossom shall go up as dust: because they have cast away the law of the LORD of hosts, and despised the word of the Holy One of Israel.

devoureth the stubble <u>29\_JOE\_02\_05</u># Like the noise of chariots on the tops of mountains shall they leap, like the noise of a flame of fire that devoureth the stubble, as a strong people set in battle array.

devoureth their enemies <u>66\_REV\_11\_05</u> # And if any man will hurt them, fire proceedeth out of their mouth, and devoureth their enemies: and if any man will hurt them, he must in this manner be killed.
