dew and for <u>05 DEU 33_13</u> # And of Joseph he said, Blessed of the LORD [be] his land, for the precious things of heaven, for the dew, and for the deep that coucheth beneath,

dew and I <u>38_ZEC_08_12</u> # For the seed [shall be] prosperous; the vine shall give her fruit, and the ground shall give her increase, and the heavens shall give their dew; and I will cause the remnant of this people to possess all these [things].

dew and my <u>22_SON_05_02</u> # I sleep, but my heart waketh: [it is] the voice of my beloved that knocketh, [saying], Open to me, my sister, my love, my dove, my undefiled: for my head is filled with dew, [and] my locks with the drops of the night.

dew and the <u>37_HAG_01_10</u># Therefore the heaven over you is stayed from dew, and the earth is stayed [from] her fruit.

dew as the <u>05_DEU_32_02</u> # My doctrine shall drop as the rain, my speech shall distil as the dew, as the small rain upon the tender herb, and as the showers upon the grass:

dew be on <u>07_JUD_06_37</u># Behold, I will put a fleece of wool in the floor; [and] if the dew be on the fleece only, and [it be] dry upon all the earth [beside], then shall I know that thou wilt save Israel by mine hand, as thou hast said.

dew falleth on 10_2SA_17_12# So shall we come upon him in some place where he shall be found, and we will light upon him as the dew falleth on the ground: and of him and of all the men that [are] with him there shall not be left so much as one.

dew fell upon 04_NUM_11_09 # And when the dew fell upon the camp in the night, the manna fell upon it.

dew from the <u>33_MIC_05_07</u> # And the remnant of Jacob shall be in the midst of many people as a dew from the LORD, as the showers upon the grass, that tarrieth not for man, nor waiteth for the sons of men.

dew in the <u>23_ISA_18_04</u># For so the LORD said unto me, I will take my rest, and I will consider in my dwelling place like a clear heat upon herbs, [and] like a cloud of dew in the heat of harvest.

dew is as 23_ISA_26_19 # Thy dead [men] shall live, [together with] my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew [is as] the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.

dew it goeth <u>28_HOS_06_04</u> # O Ephraim, what shall I do unto thee? O Judah, what shall I do unto thee? for your goodness [is] as a morning cloud, and as the early dew it goeth away.

dew lay all <u>18_JOB_29_19</u> # My root [was] spread out by the waters, and the dew lay all night upon my branch.

dew lay round <u>02_EXO_16_13</u># And it came to pass, that at even the quails came up, and covered the camp: and in the morning the dew lay round about the host.

dew neither let <u>10_2SA_01_21</u> # Ye mountains of Gilboa, [let there be] no dew, neither [let there be] rain, upon you, nor fields of offerings: for there the shield of the mighty is vilely cast away, the shield of Saul, [as though he had] not [been] anointed with oil.

dew nor rain 11 1KI 17 01 # And Elijah the Tishbite, [who was] of the inhabitants of Gilead, said unto Ahab, [As] the LORD God of Israel liveth, before whom I stand, there shall not be dew nor rain these years, but according to my word.

dew of heaven 27_DAN_04_15 # Nevertheless leave the stump of his roots in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and [let] his portion [be] with the beasts in the grass of the earth:

dew of heaven 27_DAN_04_23 # And whereas the king saw a watcher and an holy one coming down from heaven, and saying, Hew the tree down, and destroy it; yet leave the stump of the roots thereof in the earth, even with a band of iron and brass, in the tender grass of the field; and let it be wet with the dew of heaven, and [let] his portion [be] with the beasts of the field, till seven times pass over him;

dew of heaven <u>27_DAN_04_25</u># That they shall drive thee from men, and thy dwelling shall be with the beasts of the field, and they shall make thee to eat grass as oxen, and they shall wet thee with the dew of heaven, and seven times shall pass over thee, till thou know that the most High ruleth in the kingdom of men, and giveth it to whomsoever he will.

dew of heaven 27_DAN_04_33 # The same hour was the thing fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar: and he was driven from men, and did eat grass as oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till his hairs were grown like eagles' [feathers], and his nails like birds' [claws].

dew of heaven <u>27_DAN_05_21</u> # And he was driven from the sons of men; and his heart was made like the beasts, and his dwelling [was] with the wild asses: they fed him with grass like oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven; till he knew that the most high God ruled in the kingdom of men, and [that] he appointeth over it whomsoever he will.

dew of heaven <u>01_GEN_27_28</u> # Therefore God give thee of the dew of heaven, and the fatness of the earth, and plenty of corn and wine:

dew of heaven <u>01_GEN_27_39</u> # And Isaac his father answered and said unto him, Behold, thy dwelling shall be the fatness of the earth, and of the dew of heaven from above;

dew of herbs <u>23_ISA_26_19</u># Thy dead [men] shall live, [together with] my dead body shall they arise. Awake and sing, ye that dwell in dust: for thy dew [is as] the dew of herbs, and the earth shall cast out the dead.

dew of Hermon 19_PSA_133_03 # As the dew of Hermon, [and as the dew] that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, [even] life for evermore.

dew of thy 19_PSA_110_03 # Thy people [shall be] willing in the day of thy power, in the beauties of holiness from the womb of the morning: thou hast the dew of thy youth.

dew on all <u>07_JUD_06_40</u> # And God did so that night: for it was dry upon the fleece only, and there was dew on all the ground.

dew out of <u>07_JUD_06_38</u># And it was so: for he rose up early on the morrow, and thrust the fleece together, and wringed the dew out of the fleece, a bowl full of water.

dew that descended 19_PSA_133_03 # As the dew of Hermon, [and as the dew] that descended upon the mountains of Zion: for there the LORD commanded the blessing, [even] life for evermore.

dew that lay <u>02_EXO_16_14</u># And when the dew that lay was gone up, behold, upon the face of the wilderness [there lay] a small round thing, [as] small as the hoar frost on the ground.

dew that passeth <u>28_HOS_13_03</u> # Therefore they shall be as the morning cloud, and as the early dew that passeth away, as the chaff [that] is driven with the whirlwind out of the floor, and as the smoke out of the chimney.

dew unto Israel <u>28_HOS_14_05</u># I will be as the dew unto Israel: he shall grow as the lily, and cast forth his roots as Lebanon.

dew upon the <u>20_PRO_19_12</u># The king's wrath [is] as the roaring of a lion; but his favour [is] as dew upon the grass.

dew <u>05_DEU_33_28</u># Israel then shall dwell in safety alone: the fountain of Jacob [shall be] upon a land of corn and wine; also his heavens shall drop down dew.

dew 18_JOB_38_28 # Hath the rain a father? or who hath begotten the drops of dew?

dew <u>07_JUD_06_39</u># And Gideon said unto God, Let not thine anger be hot against me, and I will speak but this once: let me prove, I pray thee, but this once with the fleece; let it now be dry only upon the fleece, and upon all the ground let there be dew.

dew 20_PRO_03_20 # By his knowledge the depths are broken up, and the clouds drop down the dew.

mildew and they <u>05_DEU_28_22</u> # The LORD shall smite thee with a consumption, and with a fever, and with an inflammation, and with an extreme burning, and with the sword, and with blasting, and with mildew; and they shall pursue thee until thou perish.

mildew and with <u>37_HAG_02_17</u> # I smote you with blasting and with mildew and with hail in all the labours of your hands; yet ye [turned] not to me, saith the LORD.

mildew locust or 11_1KI_08_37 # If there be in the land famine, if there be pestilence, blasting, mildew, locust, [or] if there be caterpillar; if their enemy besiege them in the land of their cities; whatsoever plague, whatsoever sickness [there be];

mildew locusts or 14_2CH_06_28 # If there be dearth in the land, if there be pestilence, if there be blasting, or mildew, locusts, or caterpillars; if their enemies besiege them in the cities of their land; whatsoever sore or whatsoever sickness [there be]:

mildew when your <u>30_AMO_04_09</u># I have smitten you with blasting and mildew: when your gardens and your vineyards and your fig trees and your olive trees increased, the palmerworm devoured [them]: yet have ye not returned unto me, saith the LORD.
