did burn incense [12 2KI 18 04](#) # He removed the high places, and brake the images, and cut down the groves, and brake in pieces the brazen serpent that Moses had made: for unto those days the children of Israel did burn incense to it: and he called it Nehushtan.

did burn with [05 DEU 05 23](#) # And it came to pass, when ye heard the voice out of the midst of the darkness, [for the mountain did burn with fire,] that ye came near unto me, [even] all the heads of your tribes, and your elders;

did but taste [09 ISA 14 43](#) # Then Saul said to Jonathan, Tell me what thou hast done. And Jonathan told him, and said, I did but taste a little honey with the end of the rod that [was] in mine hand, [and], lo, I must die.

did by him [44 ACT 02 22](#) # Ye men of Israel, hear these words; Jesus of Nazareth, a man approved of God among you by miracles and wonders and signs, which God did by him in the midst of you, as ye yourselves also know:

did by the [58 HEB 07 19](#) # For the law made nothing perfect, but the bringing in of a better hope [did]; by the which we draw nigh unto God.

did came unto [41 MAR 03 08](#) # And from Jerusalem, and from Idumaea, and [from] beyond Jordan; and they about Tyre and Sidon, a great multitude, when they had heard what great things he did, came unto him.

did carry away [12 2KI 18 11](#) # And the king of Assyria did carry away Israel unto Assyria, and put them in Halah and in Habor [by] the river of Gozan, and in the cities of the Medes:

did cast away [14 2CH 29 19](#) # Moreover all the vessels, which king Ahaz in his reign did cast away in his transgression, have we prepared and sanctified, and, behold, they [are] before the altar of the LORD.

Now when Simon Peter heard that it was the Lord, he girt [his] fisher's coat [unto him], [for he was naked,] and did cast himself into the sea.

did cast in [41 MAR 12 44](#) # For all [they] did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, [even] all her living.

did cast in [41 MAR 12 44](#) # For all [they] did cast in of their abundance; but she of her want did cast in all that she had, [even] all her living.

did chide with [07 JUD 08 01](#) # And the men of Ephraim said unto him, Why hast thou served us thus, that thou calledst us not, when thou wentest to fight with the Midianites? And they did chide with him sharply.

did choose And [10 2SA 21 06](#) # Let seven men of his sons be delivered unto us, and we will hang them up unto the LORD in Gibeah of Saul, [whom] the LORD did choose. And the king said, I will give [them].

did choose out [11 1KI 14 21](#) # And Rehoboam the son of Solomon reigned in Judah. Rehoboam [was] forty and one years old when he began to reign, and he reigned seventeen years in Jerusalem, the city which the LORD did choose out of all the tribes of Israel, to put his name there. And his mother's name [was] Naamah an Ammonitess.

did choose that [23 ISA 65 12](#) # Therefore will I number you to the sword, and ye shall all bow down to the slaughter: because when I called, ye did not answer; when I spake, ye did not hear; but did evil before mine eyes, and did choose [that] wherein I delighted not.

did circumcise All [06 JOS 05 04](#) # And this [is] the cause why Joshua did circumcise: All the people that came out of Egypt, [that were] males, [even] all the men of war, died in the wilderness by the way, after they came out of Egypt.

did cleanse it [26 EZE 43 22](#) # And on the second day thou shalt offer a kid of the goats without blemish for a sin offering; and they shall cleanse the altar, as they did cleanse [it] with the bullock.

did cleave unto [05 DEU 04 04](#) # But ye that did cleave unto the LORD your God [are] alive every one of you this day.

did command before [01 GEN 50 16](#) # And they sent a messenger unto Joseph, saying, Thy father did command before he died, saying,

did commit things [42 LUK 12 48](#) # But he that knew not, and did commit things worthy of stripes, shall be beaten with few [stripes]. For unto whomsoever much is given, of him shall be much required: and to whom men have committed much, of him they will ask the more.

did communicate with [50 PHP 04 14](#) # Notwithstanding ye have well done, that ye did communicate with my affliction.

did compass either [11 1KI 07 15](#) # For he cast two pillars of brass, of eighteen cubits high apiece: and a line of twelve cubits did compass either of them about.

did compass it [11 1KI 07 23](#) # And he made a molten sea, ten cubits from the one brim to the other: [it was] round all about, and his height [was] five cubits: and a line of thirty cubits did compass it round about.

did continually eat [24 JER 52 33](#) # And changed his prison garments: and he did continually eat bread before him all the days of his life.

did corrupt the [66 REV 19 02](#) # For true and righteous [are] his judgments: for he hath judged the great whore, which did corrupt the earth with her fornication, and hath avenged the blood of his servants at her hand.

did cry there [24 JER 46 17](#) # They did cry there, Pharaoh king of Egypt [is but] a noise; he hath passed the time appointed.

did Cyrus king [15 EZR 01 08](#) # Even those did Cyrus king of Persia bring forth by the hand of Mithredath the treasurer, and numbered them unto Sheshbazzar, the prince of Judah.

did Cyrus the [15 EZR 05 14](#) # And the vessels also of gold and silver of the house of God, which Nebuchadnezzar took out of the temple that [was] in Jerusalem, and brought them into the temple of Babylon, those did Cyrus the king take out of the temple of Babylon, and they were delivered unto [one],

whose name [was] Sheshbazzar, whom he had made governor;

did Dan remain [07\\_JUD\\_05\\_17](#) # Gilead abode beyond Jordan: and why did Dan remain in ships? Asher continued on the sea shore, and abode in his breaches.

did David and [09\\_ISA\\_27\\_11](#) # And David saved neither man nor woman alive, to bring [tidings] to Gath, saying, Lest they should tell on us, saying, So did David, and so [will be] his manner all the while he dwelleth in the country of the Philistines.

did David bring [10\\_2SA\\_02\\_03](#) # And his men that [were] with him did David bring up, every man with his household: and they dwelt in the cities of Hebron.

did David his [11\\_1KI\\_11\\_06](#) # And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as [did] David his father.

did David his [11\\_1KI\\_11\\_33](#) # Because that they have forsaken me, and have worshipped Ashtoreth the goddess of the Zidonians, Chemosh the god of the Moabites, and Milcom the god of the children of Ammon, and have not walked in my ways, to do [that which is] right in mine eyes, and [to keep] my statutes and my judgments, as [did] David his father.

did David his [11\\_1KI\\_15\\_11](#) # And Asa did [that which was] right in the eyes of the LORD, as [did] David his father.

did day by [14\\_2CH\\_24\\_11](#) # Now it came to pass, that at what time the chest was brought unto the king's office by the hand of the Levites, and when they saw that [there was] much money, the king's scribe and the high priest's officer came and emptied the chest, and took it, and carried it to his place again. did diligently observe [11\\_1KI\\_20\\_33](#) # Now the men did diligently observe whether [any thing would come] from him, and did hastily catch [it]: and they said, Thy brother Benhadad. Then he said, Go ye, bring him. Then Benhadad came forth to him; and he caused him to come up into the chariot.

did displeased the [01\\_GEN\\_38\\_10](#) # And the thing which he did displeased the LORD: wherefore he slew him also.

did distribute for [06\\_JOS\\_13\\_32](#) # These [are the countries] which Moses did distribute for inheritance in the plains of Moab, on the other side Jordan, by Jericho, eastward.

did drink did [38\\_ZEC\\_07\\_06](#) # And when ye did eat, and when ye did drink, did not ye eat [for yourselves], and drink [for yourselves]?

did drive them [24\\_JER\\_46\\_15](#) # Why are thy valiant [men] swept away? they stood not, because the LORD did drive them.

did eat and [13\\_1CH\\_29\\_22](#) # And did eat and drink before the LORD on that day with great gladness. And they made Solomon the son of David king the second time, and anointed [him] unto the LORD [to be] the

chief governor, and Zadok [to be] priest.

did eat and [11 1KI 19 06](#) # And he looked, and, behold, [there was] a cake baken on the coals, and a cruse of water at his head. And he did eat and drink, and laid him down again.

did eat and [11 1KI 19 08](#) # And he arose, and did eat and drink, and went in the strength of that meat forty days and forty nights unto Horeb the mount of God.

**did eat their [44 ACT 02 46](#) # And they, continuing daily with one accord in the temple, and breaking bread from house to house, did eat their meat with gladness and singleness of heart,**

**did eat their [01 GEN 47 22](#) # Only the land of the priests bought he not; for the priests had a portion [assigned them] of Pharaoh, and did eat their portion which Pharaoh gave them: wherefore they sold not their lands.**

**did eat Then [11 1KI 19 21](#) # And he returned back from him, and took a yoke of oxen, and slew them, and boiled their flesh with the instruments of the oxen, and gave unto the people, and they did eat. Then he arose, and went after Elijah, and ministered unto him.**

**did eat Then [09 ISA 28 25](#) # And she brought [it] before Saul, and before his servants; and they did eat. Then they rose up, and went away that night.**

**did eat there [01 GEN 31 46](#) # And Jacob said unto his brethren, Gather stones; and they took stones, and made an heap: and they did eat there upon the heap.**

**did eat they [42 LUK 17 27](#) # They did eat, they drank, they married wives, they were given in marriage, until the day that Noe entered into the ark, and the flood came, and destroyed them all.**

**did eat they [42 LUK 17 28](#) # Likewise also as it was in the days of Lot; they did eat, they drank, they bought, they sold, they planted, they builded;**

**did eat throughout [14 2CH 30 22](#) # And Hezekiah spake comfortably unto all the Levites that taught the good knowledge of the LORD: and they did eat throughout the feast seven days, offering peace offerings, and making confession to the LORD God of their fathers.**

did eat up [30 AMO 07 04](#) # Thus hath the Lord GOD showed unto me: and, behold, the Lord GOD called to contend by fire, and it devoured the great deep, and did eat up a part.

did eat up [01 GEN 41 04](#) # And the ill favoured and leanfleshed kine did eat up the seven well favoured and fat kine. So Pharaoh awoke.

did eat up [01 GEN 41 20](#) # And the lean and the ill favoured kine did eat up the first seven fat kine:

did eat up [19 PSA 105 35](#) # And did eat up all the herbs in their land, and devoured the fruit of their ground.

did eat were [40 MAT 15 38](#) # And they that did eat were four thousand men, beside women and children.

did eat with [09 ISA 09 24](#) # And the cook took up the shoulder, and [that] which [was] upon it, and set [it] before Saul. And [Samuel] said, Behold that which is left! set [it] before thee, [and] eat: for unto this time hath it been kept for thee since I said, I have invited the people. So Saul did eat with Samuel that day.

did eat with [48 GAL 02 12](#) # For before that certain came from James, he did eat with the Gentiles: but when they were come, he withdrew and separated himself, fearing them which were of the circumcision.

did eat with [01 GEN 43 32](#) # And they set on for him by himself, and for them by themselves, and for the Egyptians, which did eat with him, by themselves: because the Egyptians might not eat bread with the Hebrews; for that [is] an abomination unto the Egyptians.

did eat [10 2SA 12 20](#) # Then David arose from the earth, and washed, and anointed [himself], and changed his apparel, and came into the house of the LORD, and worshipped: then he came to his own house; and when he required, they set bread before him, and he did eat.

did eat [15 EZR 06 21](#) # And the children of Israel, which were come again out of captivity, and all such as had separated themselves unto them from the filthiness of the heathen of the land, to seek the LORD God of Israel, did eat,

did eat [01 GEN 03 06](#) # And when the woman saw that the tree [was] good for food, and that it [was] pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make [one] wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

did eat [01 GEN 03 12](#) # And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest [to be] with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.

did eat [01 GEN 03 13](#) # And the LORD God said unto the woman, What [is] this [that] thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.

did Ephraim drive [07 JUD 01 29](#) # Neither did Ephraim drive out the Canaanites that dwelt in Gezer; but the Canaanites dwelt in Gezer among them.

did Esaias prophesy [40 MAT 15 07](#) # [Ye] hypocrites, well did Esaias prophesy of you, saying,

did escape neither [31 OBA 01 14](#) # Neither shouldst thou have stood in the crossway, to cut off those of his that did escape; neither shouldst thou have delivered up those of his that did remain in the day of distress.

did esteem him [23 ISA 53 04](#) # Surely he hath borne our griefs, and carried our sorrows: yet we did esteem him stricken, smitten of God, and afflicted.

Did ever people [05 DEU 04 33](#) # Did [ever] people hear the voice of God speaking out of the midst of the fire, as thou hast heard, and live?

did evil again [07 JUD 03 12](#) # And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD: and the LORD strengthened Eglon the king of Moab against Israel, because they had done evil in the sight of the LORD.

did evil again [07 JUD 10 06](#) # And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD, and served Baalim, and Ashtaroth, and the gods of Syria, and the gods of Zidon, and the gods of Moab, and the gods of the children of Ammon, and the gods of the Philistines, and forsook the LORD, and served not him.

did evil again [07 JUD 13 01](#) # And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD; and the LORD delivered them into the hand of the Philistines forty years.

did evil again [16 NEH 09 28](#) # But after they had rest, they did evil again before thee: therefore leftest thou them in the hand of their enemies, so that they had the dominion over them: yet when they returned, and cried unto thee, thou heardest [them] from heaven; and many times didst thou deliver them according to thy mercies;

did evil because [14 2CH 12 14](#) # And he did evil, because he prepared not his heart to seek the LORD.

did evil before [23 ISA 65 12](#) # Therefore will I number you to the sword, and ye shall all bow down to the slaughter: because when I called, ye did not answer; when I spake, ye did not hear; but did evil before mine eyes, and did choose [that] wherein I delighted not.

did evil in [11 1KI 11 06](#) # And Solomon did evil in the sight of the LORD, and went not fully after the LORD, as [did] David his father.

did evil in [11 1KI 14 22](#) # And Judah did evil in the sight of the LORD, and they provoked him to jealousy with their sins which they had committed, above all that their fathers had done.

did evil in [11 1KI 15 26](#) # And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of his father, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin.

did evil in [11 1KI 15 34](#) # And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of Jeroboam, and in his sin wherewith he made Israel to sin.

did evil in [11 1KI 16 30](#) # And Ahab the son of Omri did evil in the sight of the LORD above all that [were] before him.

did evil in [11 1KI 22 52](#) # And he did evil in the sight of the LORD, and walked in the way of his father, and in the way of his mother, and in the way of Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who made Israel to sin:

did evil in [14\\_2CH\\_22\\_04](#) # Wherefore he did evil in the sight of the LORD like the house of Ahab: for they were his counsellors after the death of his father to his destruction.

did evil in [12\\_2KI\\_08\\_18](#) # And he walked in the way of the kings of Israel, as did the house of Ahab: for the daughter of Ahab was his wife: and he did evil in the sight of the LORD.

did evil in [12\\_2KI\\_08\\_27](#) # And he walked in the way of the house of Ahab, and did evil in the sight of the LORD, as [did] the house of Ahab: for he [was] the son in law of the house of Ahab.

did evil in [07\\_JUD\\_02\\_11](#) # And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and served Baalim:

did evil in [07\\_JUD\\_03\\_07](#) # And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD, and forgat the LORD their God, and served Baalim and the groves.

did evil in [07\\_JUD\\_04\\_01](#) # And the children of Israel again did evil in the sight of the LORD, when Ehud was dead.

did evil in [07\\_JUD\\_06\\_01](#) # And the children of Israel did evil in the sight of the LORD: and the LORD delivered them into the hand of Midian seven years.

did excel them [23\\_ISA\\_10\\_10](#) # As my hand hath found the kingdoms of the idols, and whose graven images did excel them of Jerusalem and of Samaria:

did fail because [24\\_JER\\_14\\_06](#) # And the wild asses did stand in the high places, they snuffed up the wind like dragons; their eyes did fail, because [there was] no grass.

did fear before [37\\_HAG\\_01\\_12](#) # Then Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, and Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, with all the remnant of the people, obeyed the voice of the LORD their God, and the words of Haggai the prophet, as the LORD their God had sent him, and the people did fear before the LORD.

did fear the [12\\_2KI\\_04\\_01](#) # Now there cried a certain woman of the wives of the sons of the prophets unto Elisha, saying, Thy servant my husband is dead; and thou knowest that thy servant did fear the LORD: and the creditor is come to take unto him my two sons to be bondmen.

did feed delicately [25\\_LAM\\_04\\_05](#) # They that did feed delicately are desolate in the streets: they that were brought up in scarlet embrace dunghills.

did fight knew [10\\_2SA\\_11\\_20](#) # And if so be that the king's wrath arise, and he say unto thee, Wherefore approached ye so nigh unto the city when ye did fight? knew ye not that they would shoot from the wall?

did flatter him [19\\_PSA\\_78\\_36](#) # Nevertheless they did flatter him with their mouth, and they lied unto him with their tongues.

did flee apace [19\\_PSA\\_68\\_12](#) # Kings of armies did flee apace: and she that tarried at home divided the spoil.

did flee from [30\\_AMO\\_05\\_19](#) # As if a man did flee from a lion, and a bear met him; or went into the house, and leaned his hand on the wall, and a serpent bit him.

did fly and [10\\_2SA\\_22\\_11](#) # And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: and he was seen upon the wings of the wind.

did fly upon [19\\_PSA\\_18\\_10](#) # And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.

did fly yea [19 PSA 18 10](#) # And he rode upon a cherub, and did fly: yea, he did fly upon the wings of the wind.

did fly [23 ISA 06 02](#) # Above it stood the seraphims: each one had six wings; with twain he covered his face, and with twain he covered his feet, and with twain he did fly.

did for Israel [07 JUD 02 07](#) # And the people served the LORD all the days of Joshua, and all the days of the elders that outlived Joshua, who had seen all the great works of the LORD, that he did for Israel.

did for Tobiah [16 NEH 13 07](#) # And I came to Jerusalem, and understood of the evil that Eliashib did for Tobiah, in preparing him a chamber in the courts of the house of God.

did for you [05 DEU 01 30](#) # The LORD your God which goeth before you, he shall fight for you, according to all that he did for you in Egypt before your eyes;

did for you [05 DEU 04 34](#) # Or hath God assayed to go [and] take him a nation from the midst of [another] nation, by temptations, by signs, and by wonders, and by war, and by a mighty hand, and by a stretched out arm, and by great terrors, according to all that the LORD your God did for you in Egypt before your eyes?

did foreknow he [45 ROM 08 29](#) # For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate [to be] conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

did from his [58 HEB 04 10](#) # For he that is entered into his rest, he also hath ceased from his own works, as God [did] from his.

did gird it [07 JUD 03 16](#) # But Ehud made him a dagger which had two edges, of a cubit length; and he did gird it under his raiment upon his right thigh.

did give to [14 2CH 30 24](#) # For Hezekiah king of Judah did give to the congregation a thousand bullocks and seven thousand sheep; and the princes gave to the congregation a thousand bullocks and ten thousand sheep: and a great number of priests sanctified themselves.

did God appear [14 2CH 01 07](#) # In that night did God appear unto Solomon, and said unto him, Ask what I shall give thee.

did God render [07 JUD 09 57](#) # And all the evil of the men of Shechem did God render upon their heads: and upon them came the curse of Jotham the son of Jerubbaal.

did God send [44 ACT 07 35](#) # This Moses whom they refused, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge? the same did God send [to be] a ruler and a deliverer by the hand of the angel which appeared to him in the bush.

did good and [44 ACT 14 17](#) # Nevertheless he left not himself without witness, in that he did good, and gave us rain from heaven, and fruitful seasons, filling our hearts with food and gladness.

did great wonders [44 ACT 06 08](#) # And Stephen, full of faith and power, did great wonders and miracles among the people.

did grind in [07 JUD 16 21](#) # But the Philistines took him, and put out his eyes, and brought him down to Gaza, and bound him with fetters of brass; and he did grind in the prison house.

did he make [02\\_EXO\\_36\\_22](#) # One board had two tenons, equally distant one from another: thus did he make for all the boards of the tabernacle.

did he not [24\\_JER\\_26\\_19](#) # Did Hezekiah king of Judah and all Judah put him at all to death? did he not fear the LORD, and besought the LORD, and the LORD repented him of the evil which he had pronounced against them? Thus might we procure great evil against our souls.

did he put [11\\_1KI\\_07\\_51](#) # So was ended all the work that king Solomon made for the house of the LORD. And Solomon brought in the things which David his father had dedicated; [even] the silver, and the gold, and the vessels, did he put among the treasures of the house of the LORD.

did he put [03\\_LEV\\_08\\_09](#) # And he put the mitre upon his head; also upon the mitre, [even] upon his forefront, did he put the golden plate, the holy crown; as the LORD commanded Moses.

did he testify [44\\_ACT\\_02\\_40](#) # And with many other words did he testify and exhort, saying, Save yourselves from this untoward generation.

did he to [43\\_JOH\\_09\\_26](#) # Then said they to him again, What did he to thee? how opened he thine eyes?

did he trespass [14\\_2CH\\_28\\_22](#) # And in the time of his distress did he trespass yet more against the LORD: this [is that] king Ahaz.

did he unto [10\\_2SA\\_12\\_31](#) # And he brought forth the people that [were] therein, and put [them] under saws, and under harrows of iron, and under axes of iron, and made them pass through the brickkiln: and thus did he unto all the cities of the children of Ammon. So David and all the people returned unto Jerusalem.

did he unto [01\\_GEN\\_42\\_25](#) # Then Joseph commanded to fill their sacks with corn, and to restore every man's money into his sack, and to give them provision for the way: and thus did he unto them.

did he unto [06\\_JOS\\_09\\_26](#) # And so did he unto them, and delivered them out of the hand of the children of Israel, that they slew them not.

did he [02\\_EXO\\_40\\_16](#) # Thus did Moses: according to all that the LORD commanded him, so did he.

did he [01\\_GEN\\_06\\_22](#) # Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he.

did he [04\\_NUM\\_17\\_11](#) # And Moses did [so]: as the LORD commanded him, so did he.

did hear my [10\\_2SA\\_22\\_07](#) # In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried to my God: and he did hear my voice out of his temple, and my cry [did enter] into his ears.

did hearken unto [24\\_JER\\_37\\_02](#) # But neither he, nor his servants, nor the people of the land, did hearken unto the words of the LORD, which he spake by the prophet Jeremiah.

did help her [25\\_LAM\\_01\\_07](#) # Jerusalem remembered in the days of her affliction and of her miseries all her pleasant things that she had in the days of old, when her people fell into the hand of the enemy, and

none did help her: the adversaries saw her, [and] did mock at her sabbaths.

did Hezekiah throughout [14\\_2CH\\_31\\_20](#) # And thus did Hezekiah throughout all Judah, and wrought [that which was] good and right and truth before the LORD his God.

did hide himself [43\\_JOH\\_12\\_36](#) # While ye have light, believe in the light, that ye may be the children of light. These things spake Jesus, and departed, and did hide himself from them.

did hide themselves [09\\_ISA\\_13\\_06](#) # When the men of Israel saw that they were in a strait, [for the people were distressed,] then the people did hide themselves in caves, and in thickets, and in rocks, and in high places, and in pits.

did Hiel the [11\\_1KI\\_16\\_34](#) # In his days did Hiel the Bethelite build Jericho: he laid the foundation thereof in Abiram his firstborn, and set up the gates thereof in his youngest [son] Segub, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake by Joshua the son of Nun.

did him honour [14\\_2CH\\_32\\_33](#) # And Hezekiah slept with his fathers, and they buried him in the chiefest of the sepulchres of the sons of David: and all Judah and the inhabitants of Jerusalem did him honour at his death. And Manasseh his son reigned in his stead.

did him reverence [17\\_EST\\_03\\_02](#) # And all the king's servants, that [were] in the king's gate, bowed, and revered Haman: for the king had so commanded concerning him. But Mordecai bowed not, nor did [him] reverence.

did him reverence [17\\_EST\\_03\\_05](#) # And when Haman saw that Mordecai bowed not, nor did him reverence, then was Haman full of wrath.

did hinder you [48\\_GAL\\_05\\_07](#) # Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth?

did his brethren [43\\_JOH\\_07\\_05](#) # For neither did his brethren believe in him.

did his disciples [40\\_MAT\\_09\\_19](#) # And Jesus arose, and followed him, and [so did] his disciples.

did his neighbour [44\\_ACT\\_07\\_27](#) # But he that did his neighbour wrong thrust him away, saying, Who made thee a ruler and a judge over us?



did howbeit he [14 2CH 27 02](#) # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Uzziah did: howbeit he entered not into the temple of the LORD. And the people did yet corruptly.

did Hiram his [14 2CH 04 16](#) # The pots also, and the shovels, and the fleshhooks, and all their instruments, did Hiram his father make to king Solomon for the house of the LORD of bright brass.

did I anoint [27 DAN 10 03](#) # I ate no pleasant bread, neither came flesh nor wine in my mouth, neither did I anoint myself at all, till three whole weeks were fulfilled.

did I beat [10 2SA 22 43](#) # Then did I beat them as small as the dust of the earth, I did stamp them as the mire of the street, [and] did spread them abroad.

did I beat [19 PSA 18 42](#) # Then did I beat them small as the dust before the wind: I did cast them out as the dirt in the streets.

did I chatter [23 ISA 38 14](#) # Like a crane [or] a swallow, so did I chatter: I did mourn as a dove: mine eyes fail [with looking] upward: O LORD, I am oppressed; undertake for me.

did I choose [09 ISA 02 28](#) # And did I choose him out of all the tribes of Israel [to be] my priest, to offer upon mine altar, to burn incense, to wear an ephod before me? and did I give unto the house of thy father all the offerings made by fire of the children of Israel?

Did I desire [12 2KI 04 28](#) # Then she said, Did I desire a son of my lord? did I not say, Do not deceive me?

did I eat [26 EZE 03 03](#) # And he said unto me, Son of man, cause thy belly to eat, and fill thy bowels with this roll that I give thee. Then did I eat [it]; and it was in my mouth as honey for sweetness.

Did I fear [18 JOB 31 34](#) # Did I fear a great multitude, or did the contempt of families terrify me, that I kept silence, [and] went not out of the door?

did I give [09 ISA 02 28](#) # And did I choose him out of all the tribes of Israel [to be] my priest, to offer upon mine altar, to burn incense, to wear an ephod before me? and did I give unto the house of thy father all the offerings made by fire of the children of Israel?

Did I make [47 2CO 12 17](#) # Did I make a gain of you by any of them whom I sent unto you?

did I make [26 EZE 20 17](#) # Nevertheless mine eye spared them from destroying them, neither did I make an end of them in the wilderness.

did I make [19 PSA 142 01](#) # Maschil of David; A Prayer when he was in the cave. I cried unto the LORD with my voice; with my voice unto the LORD did I make my supplication.

Did I not [11 1KI 02 42](#) # And the king sent and called for Shimei, and said unto him, Did I not make thee to swear by the LORD, and protested unto thee, saying, Know for a certain, on the day thou goest out, and walkest abroad any whither, that thou shalt surely die? and thou saidst unto me, The word [that] I have heard [is] good.

Did I not [11 1KI 22 18](#) # And the king of Israel said unto Jehoshaphat, Did I not tell thee that he would prophesy no good concerning me, but evil?

Did I not [14 2CH 18 17](#) # And the king of Israel said to Jehoshaphat, Did I not tell thee [that] he would not prophesy good unto me, but evil?

Did I not [12 2KI 02 18](#) # And when they came again to him, [for he tarried at Jericho,] he said unto them,

**Did I not say unto you, Go not?**

**did I not [12\\_2KI\\_04\\_28](#) # Then she said, Did I desire a son of my lord? did I not say, Do not deceive me?**

**did I not [18\\_JOB\\_03\\_11](#) # Why died I not from the womb? [why] did I [not] give up the ghost when I came out of the belly?**

**Did I not [04\\_NUM\\_22\\_37](#) # And Balak said unto Balaam, Did I not earnestly send unto thee to call thee? wherefore camest thou not unto me? am I not able indeed to promote thee to honour?**

**Did I plainly [09\\_ISA\\_02\\_27](#) # And there came a man of God unto Eli, and said unto him, Thus saith the LORD, Did I plainly appear unto the house of thy father, when they were in Egypt in Pharaoh's house?**

**Did I say [18\\_JOB\\_06\\_22](#) # Did I say, Bring unto me? or, Give a reward for me of your substance?**

**did I shut [44\\_ACT\\_26\\_10](#) # Which thing I also did in Jerusalem: and many of the saints did I shut up in prison, having received authority from the chief priests; and when they were put to death, I gave my voice against [them].**

**Did I then [09\\_ISA\\_22\\_15](#) # Did I then begin to inquire of God for him? be it far from me: let not the king impute [any] thing unto his servant, [nor] to all the house of my father: for thy servant knew nothing of all this, less or more.**

**did I turn [19\\_PSA\\_18\\_37](#) # I have pursued mine enemies, and overtaken them: neither did I turn again till they were consumed.**

**did I use [47\\_2CO\\_01\\_17](#) # When I therefore was thus minded, did I use lightness? or the things that I purpose, do I purpose according to the flesh, that with me there should be yea yea, and nay nay?**

**did I write [47\\_2CO\\_02\\_09](#) # For to this end also did I write, that I might know the proof of you, whether ye be obedient in all things.**

**did in Egypt [06\\_JOS\\_09\\_09](#) # And they said unto him, From a very far country thy servants are come because of the name of the LORD thy God: for we have heard the fame of him, and all that he did in Egypt,**

**did in Jerusalem [24\\_JER\\_15\\_04](#) # And I will cause them to be removed into all kingdoms of the earth, because of Manasseh the son of Hezekiah king of Judah, for [that] which he did in Jerusalem.**

**did in like [02\\_EXO\\_07\\_11](#) # Then Pharaoh also called the wise men and the sorcerers: now the magicians of Egypt, they also did in like manner with their enchantments.**

**did in Shiloh [09\\_ISA\\_02\\_14](#) # And he struck [it] into the pan, or kettle, or caldron, or pot; all that the fleshhook brought up the priest took for himself. So they did in Shiloh, unto all the Israelites that came thither.**

**did in the [11\\_1KI\\_16\\_07](#) # And also by the hand of the prophet Jehu the son of Hanani came the word of the LORD against Baasha, and against his house, even for all the evil that he did in the sight of the LORD,**

in provoking him to anger with the work of his hands, in being like the house of Jeroboam; and because he killed him.

did in the [05 DEU 11 03](#) # And his miracles, and his acts, which he did in the midst of Egypt unto Pharaoh the king of Egypt, and unto all his land;

did in the [26 EZE 24 18](#) # So I spake unto the people in the morning: and at even my wife died; and I did in the morning as I was commanded.

did in the [04 NUM 21 14](#) # Wherefore it is said in the book of the wars of the LORD, What he did in the Red sea, and in the brooks of Arnon,

did interpret [01 GEN 41 12](#) # And [there was] there with us a young man, an Hebrew, servant to the captain of the guard; and we told him, and he interpreted to us our dreams; to each man according to his dream he did interpret.

did is not [43 JOH 04 29](#) # Come, see a man, which told me all things that ever I did: is not this the Christ?

did Isaiah the [14 2CH 26 22](#) # Now the rest of the acts of Uzziah, first and last, did Isaiah the prophet, the son of Amoz, write.

did Israel deliver [09 ISA 07 14](#) # And the cities which the Philistines had taken from Israel were restored to Israel, from Ekron even unto Gath; and the coasts thereof did Israel deliver out of the hands of the Philistines. And there was peace between Israel and the Amorites.

did it as [44 ACT 03 17](#) # And now, brethren, I wot that through ignorance ye did [it], as [did] also your rulers.

did Jesus in [43 JOH 02 11](#) # This beginning of miracles did Jesus in Cana of Galilee, and manifested forth his glory; and his disciples believed on him.

did Jesus in [43 JOH 20 30](#) # And many other signs truly did Jesus in the presence of his disciples, which are not written in this book:

did Joab remain [11 1KI 11 16](#) # [For six months did Joab remain there with all Israel, until he had cut off every male in Edom:]

did Joash beat [12 2KI 13 25](#) # And Jehoash the son of Jehoahaz took again out of the hand of Benhadad the son of Hazael the cities, which he had taken out of the hand of Jehoahaz his father by war. Three times did Joash beat him, and recovered the cities of Israel.

did Job continually [18 JOB 01 05](#) # And it was so, when the days of [their] feasting were gone about, that Job sent and sanctified them, and rose up early in the morning, and offered burnt offerings [according] to the number of them all: for Job said, It may be that my sons have sinned, and cursed God in their hearts. Thus did Job continually.

did Joshua burn [06 JOS 11 13](#) # But [as for] the cities that stood still in their strength, Israel burned none of them, save Hazor only; [that] did Joshua burn.

did Joshua he [06 JOS 11 15](#) # As the LORD commanded Moses his servant, so did Moses command Joshua, and so did Joshua; he left nothing undone of all that the LORD commanded Moses.

did Joshua pitch [06 JOS 04 20](#) # And those twelve stones, which they took out of Jordan, did Joshua pitch in Gilgal.

did Joshua take [06 JOS 10 42](#) # And all these kings and their land did Joshua take at one time, because the LORD God of Israel fought for Israel.

did Joshua take [06 JOS 11 12](#) # And all the cities of those kings, and all the kings of them, did Joshua take, and smote them with the edge of the sword, [and] he utterly destroyed them, as Moses the servant of the LORD commanded.

did Josiah put [12 2KI 23 24](#) # Moreover the [workers with] familiar spirits, and the wizards, and the images, and the idols, and all the abominations that were spied in the land of Judah and in Jerusalem, did Josiah put away, that he might perform the words of the law which were written in the book that Hilkiah the priest found in the house of the LORD.

did keep it [07 JUD 02 22](#) # That through them I may prove Israel, whether they will keep the way of the LORD to walk therein, as their fathers did keep [it], or not.

did king Ahasuerus [17 EST 03 01](#) # After these things did king Ahasuerus promote Haman the son of Hammedatha the Agagite, and advanced him, and set his seat above all the princes that [were] with him.

did king Ahaz [14 2CH 28 16](#) # At that time did king Ahaz send unto the kings of Assyria to help him.

did know thee [28 HOS 13 05](#) # I did know thee in the wilderness, in the land of great drought.

did lade you [11 1KI 12 11](#) # And now whereas my father did lade you with a heavy yoke, I will add to your yoke: my father hath chastised you with whips, but I will chastise you with scorpions.

did lead him [05 DEU 32 12](#) # [So] the LORD alone did lead him, and [there was] no strange god with him.

did let no [17 EST 05 12](#) # Haman said moreover, Yea, Esther the queen did let no man come in with the king unto the banquet that she had prepared but myself; and to morrow am I invited unto her also with the king.

did let none [09 1SA 03 19](#) # And Samuel grew, and the LORD was with him, and did let none of his words fall to the ground.

did Libnah revolt [14 2CH 21 10](#) # So the Edomites revolted from under the hand of Judah unto this day. The same time [also] did Libnah revolt from under his hand; because he had forsaken the LORD God of his fathers.

did lift up [12 2KI 25 27](#) # And it came to pass in the seven and thirtieth year of the captivity of Jehoiachin king of Judah, in the twelfth month, on the seven and twentieth [day] of the month, [that] Evilmerodach king of Babylon in the year that he began to reign did lift up the head of Jehoiachin king of Judah out of prison;

did lift up [38 ZEC 01 21](#) # Then said I, What come these to do? did make heretofore [02\\_EXO\\_05\\_08](#) # And the tale of the bricks, which they did make heretofore, ye shall lay upon them; ye shall not diminish [ought] thereof: for they [be] idle; therefore they cry, saying, Let us go [and] sacrifice to our God.

did Manasseh drive [07\\_JUD\\_01\\_27](#) # Neither did Manasseh drive out [the inhabitants of] Bethshean and her towns, nor Taanach and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Dor and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Ibleam and her towns, nor the inhabitants of Megiddo and her towns: but the Canaanites would dwell in that land.

did Manasseh his [14\\_2CH\\_33\\_22](#) # But he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD, as did Manasseh his father: for Amon sacrificed unto all the carved images which Manasseh his father had made, and served them;

did many things [41\\_MAR\\_06\\_20](#) # For Herod feared John, knowing that he was a just man and an holy, and observed him; and when he heard him, he did many things, and heard him gladly.

did marvel [41\\_MAR\\_05\\_20](#) # And he departed, and began to publish in Decapolis how great things Jesus had done for him: and all [men] did marvel.

did me much [55\\_2TI\\_04\\_14](#) # Alexander the coppersmith did me much evil: the Lord reward him according to his works:

did meditate in [19\\_PSA\\_119\\_23](#) # Princes also did sit [and] speak against me: [but] thy servant did meditate in thy statutes.

did melt neither [06\\_JOS\\_02\\_11](#) # And as soon as we had heard [these things], our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the LORD your God, he [is] God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

did mete it [02\\_EXO\\_16\\_18](#) # And when they did mete [it] with an omer, he that gathered much had nothing over, and he that gathered little had no lack; they gathered every man according to his eating.

did minister the [60\\_1PE\\_01\\_12](#) # Unto whom it was revealed, that not unto themselves, but unto us they did minister the things, which are now reported unto you by them that have preached the gospel unto you with the Holy Ghost sent down from heaven; which things the angels desire to look into.

did minister unto [09\\_ISA\\_02\\_11](#) # And Elkanah went to Ramah to his house. And the child did minister unto the LORD before Eli the priest.

did mock at [25\\_LAM\\_01\\_07](#) # Jerusalem remembered in the days of her affliction and of her miseries all her pleasant things that she had in the days of old, when her people fell into the hand of the enemy, and none did help her: the adversaries saw her, [and] did mock at her sabbaths.

did more grievously [23\\_ISA\\_09\\_01](#) # Nevertheless the dimness [shall] not [be] such as [was] in her vexation, when at the first he lightly afflicted the land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, and afterward did more grievously afflict [her by] the way of the sea, beyond Jordan, in Galilee of the nations.

did more to [11\\_1KI\\_16\\_33](#) # And Ahab made a grove; and Ahab did more to provoke the LORD God of Israel to anger than all the kings of Israel that were before him.

did Moses according [02\\_EXO\\_40\\_16](#) # Thus did Moses: according to all that the LORD commanded him, so did he.

did Moses command [06 JOS 11 15](#) # As the LORD commanded Moses his servant, so did Moses command Joshua, and so did Joshua; he left nothing undone of all that the LORD commanded Moses.

did Moses command [41 MAR 10 03](#) # And he answered and said unto them, What did Moses command you?

did Moses smite [06 JOS 13 12](#) # All the kingdom of Og in Bashan, which reigned in Ashtaroth and in Edrei, who remained of the remnant of the giants: for these did Moses smite, and cast them out.

did Moses the [06 JOS 12 06](#) # Them did Moses the servant of the LORD and the children of Israel smite: and Moses the servant of the LORD gave it [for] a possession unto the Reubenites, and the Gadites, and the half tribe of Manasseh.

did Moses then [40 MAT 19 07](#) # They say unto him, Why did Moses then command to give a writing of divorcement, and to put her away?

did mourn as [23 ISA 38 14](#) # Like a crane [or] a swallow, so did I chatter: I did mourn as a dove: mine eyes fail [with looking] upward: O LORD, I am oppressed; undertake for me.

did much more [45 ROM 05 20](#) # Moreover the law entered, that the offence might abound. But where sin abounded, grace did much more abound:

did my heart [44 ACT 02 26](#) # Therefore did my heart rejoice, and my tongue was glad; moreover also my flesh shall rest in hope:

did my mother [19 PSA 51 05](#) # Behold, I was shapen in iniquity, and in sin did my mother conceive me.

did my shepherds [26 EZE 34 08](#) # [As] I live, saith the Lord GOD, surely because my flock became a prey, and my flock became meat to every beast of the field, because [there was] no shepherd, neither did my shepherds search for my flock, but the shepherds fed themselves, and fed not my flock;

did Naphtali drive [07 JUD 01 33](#) # Neither did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Bethshemesh, nor the inhabitants of Bethanath; but he dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: nevertheless the inhabitants of Bethshemesh and of Bethanath became tributaries unto them.

did Nathan speak [13 1CH 17 15](#) # According to all these words, and according to all this vision, so did Nathan speak unto David.

did Nathan speak [10 2SA 07 17](#) # According to all these words, and according to all this vision, so did Nathan speak unto David.

did Nebuzaradan the [12 2KI 25 11](#) # Now the rest of the people [that were] left in the city, and the fugitives that fell away to the king of Babylon, with the remnant of the multitude, did Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard carry away.

did neither eat [05 DEU 09 18](#) # And I fell down before the LORD, as at the first, forty days and forty nights: I did neither eat bread, nor drink water, because of all your sins which ye sinned, in doing wickedly in the sight of the LORD, to provoke him to anger.

did neither eat [02 EXO 34 28](#) # And he was there with the LORD forty days and forty nights; he did neither eat bread, nor drink water. And he wrote upon the tables the words of the covenant, the ten commandments.

did neither had [16 NEH 02 16](#) # And the rulers knew not whither I went, or what I did; neither had I as yet told [it] to the Jews, nor to the priests, nor to the nobles, nor to the rulers, nor to the rest that did the

did no miracle [43 JOH 10 41](#) # And many resorted unto him, and said, John did no miracle: but all things that John spake of this man were true.

did no more [07 JUD 13 21](#) # But the angel of the LORD did no more appear to Manoah and to his wife. Then Manoah knew that he [was] an angel of the LORD.

did no sin [60 1PE 02 22](#) # Who did no sin, neither was guile found in his mouth:

did Noah according [01 GEN 06 22](#) # Thus did Noah; according to all that God commanded him, so did he.

did not a [10 2SA 11 21](#) # Who smote Abimelech the son of Jerubbesheth? did not a woman cast a piece of a millstone upon him from the wall, that he died in Thebez? why went ye nigh the wall? then say thou, Thy servant Uriah the Hittite is dead also.

did not Abraham [43 JOH 08 40](#) # But now ye seek to kill me, a man that hath told you the truth, which I have heard of God: this did not Abraham.

Did not Achan [06 JOS 22 20](#) # Did not Achan the son of Zerah commit a trespass in the accursed thing, and wrath fell on all the congregation of Israel? and that man perished not alone in his iniquity.

did not answer [23 ISA 65 12](#) # Therefore will I number you to the sword, and ye shall all bow down to the slaughter: because when I called, ye did not answer; when I spake, ye did not hear; but did evil before mine eyes, and did choose [that] wherein I delighted not.

did not as [47 2CO 08 05](#) # And [this they did], not as we hoped, but first gave their own selves to the Lord, and unto us by the will of God.

did not as [02 EXO 01 17](#) # But the midwives feared God, and did not as the king of Egypt commanded them, but saved the men children alive.

did not believe [12 2KI 17 14](#) # Notwithstanding they would not hear, but hardened their necks, like to the neck of their fathers, that did not believe in the LORD their God.

did not believe [05 DEU 01 32](#) # Yet in this thing ye did not believe the LORD your God,

did not believe [43 JOH 09 18](#) # But the Jews did not believe concerning him, that he had been blind, and received his sight, until they called the parents of him that had received his sight.

did not believe [45 ROM 03 03](#) # For what if some did not believe? shall their unbelief make the faith of God without effect?

did not burden [47 2CO 12 16](#) # But be it so, I did not burden you: nevertheless, being crafty, I caught you with guile.

did not cease [04 NUM 11 25](#) # And the LORD came down in a cloud, and spake unto him, and took of the spirit that [was] upon him, and gave [it] unto the seventy elders: and it came to pass, [that], when the spirit rested upon them, they prophesied, and did not cease.

did not choose [20 PRO 01 29](#) # For that they hated knowledge, and did not choose the fear of the LORD:

did not commit [43 JOH 02 24](#) # But Jesus did not commit himself unto them, because he knew all [men],

did not confess [43 JOH 12 42](#) # Nevertheless among the chief rulers also many believed on him; but



because of the Pharisees they did not confess [him], lest they should be put out of the synagogue:

did not depart [10 2SA 22 23](#) # For all his judgments [were] before me: and [as for] his statutes, I did not depart from them.

did not destroy [19 PSA 106 34](#) # They did not destroy the nations, concerning whom the LORD commanded them:

did not drive [07 JUD 01 21](#) # And the children of Benjamin did not drive out the Jebusites that inhabited Jerusalem; but the Jebusites dwell with the children of Benjamin in Jerusalem unto this day.

did not drive [07 JUD 01 32](#) # But the Asherites dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: for they did not drive them out.

did not eat [09 ISA 01 07](#) # And [as] he did so year by year, when she went up to the house of the LORD, so she provoked her; therefore she wept, and did not eat.

did not every [26 EZE 20 08](#) # But they rebelled against me, and would not hearken unto me: they did not every man cast away the abominations of their eyes, neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt: then I said, I will pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.

did not he [39 MAL 02 15](#) # And did not he make one? Yet had he the residue of the spirit. And wherefore one? That he might seek a godly seed. Therefore take heed to your spirit, and let none deal treacherously against the wife of his youth.

did not hear [23 ISA 65 12](#) # Therefore will I number you to the sword, and ye shall all bow down to the slaughter: because when I called, ye did not answer; when I spake, ye did not hear; but did evil before mine eyes, and did choose [that] wherein I delighted not.

did not hear [23 ISA 66 04](#) # I also will choose their delusions, and will bring their fears upon them; because when I called, none did answer; when I spake, they did not hear: but they did evil before mine eyes, and chose [that] in which I delighted not.

did not hear [43 JOH 09 27](#) # He answered them, I have told you already, and ye did not hear: wherefore would ye hear [it] again? will ye also be his disciples?

did not hear [43 JOH 10 08](#) # All that ever came before me are thieves and robbers: but the sheep did not hear them.

did not hear [38 ZEC 01 04](#) # Be ye not as your fathers, unto whom the former prophets have cried, saying, Thus saith the LORD of hosts; Turn ye now from your evil ways, and [from] your evil doings: but they did not hear, nor hearken unto me, saith the LORD.

did not hearken [12 2KI 17 40](#) # Howbeit they did not hearken, but they did after their former manner.

did not hearken [28 HOS 09 17](#) # My God will cast them away, because they did not hearken unto him: and they shall be wanderers among the nations.

did not I [01 GEN 29 25](#) # And it came to pass, that in the morning, behold, it [was] Leah: and he said to Laban, What [is] this thou hast done unto me? did not I serve with thee for Rachel? wherefore then hast thou beguiled me?

Did not I [18 JOB 30 25](#) # Did not I weep for him that was in trouble? was [not] my soul grieved for the poor?

Did not I [43 JOH 18 26](#) # One of the servants of the high priest, being [his] kinsman whose ear Peter cut off, saith, Did not I see thee in the garden with him?

Did not I [07 JUD 10 11](#) # And the LORD said unto the children of Israel, [Did] not [I deliver you] from the Egyptians, and from the Amorites, from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines?

did not I [16 NEH 05 15](#) # But the former governors that [had been] before me were chargeable unto the people, and had taken of them bread and wine, beside forty shekels of silver; yea, even their servants bare rule over the people: but so did not I, because of the fear of God.

did not intend [06 JOS 22 33](#) # And the thing pleased the children of Israel; and the children of Israel blessed God, and did not intend to go up against them in battle, to destroy the land wherein the children of Reuben and Gad dwelt.

Did not Israel [45 ROM 10 19](#) # But I say, Did not Israel know? First Moses saith, I will provoke you to jealousy by [them that are] no people, [and] by a foolish nation I will anger you.

did not Job [18 JOB 02 10](#) # But he said unto her, Thou speakest as one of the foolish women speaketh. What? shall we receive good at the hand of God, and shall we not receive evil? In all this did not Job sin with his lips.

did not know [28 HOS 02 08](#) # For she did not know that I gave her corn, and wine, and oil, and multiplied her silver and gold, [which] they prepared for Baal.

did not labour [06 JOS 24 13](#) # And I have given you a land for which ye did not labour, and cities which ye built not, and ye dwell in them; of the vineyards and oliveyards which ye planted not do ye eat.

did not let [02 EXO 09 07](#) # And Pharaoh sent, and, behold, there was not one of the cattle of the Israelites dead. And the heart of Pharaoh was hardened, and he did not let the people go.

did not like [45 ROM 01 28](#) # And even as they did not like to retain God in [their] knowledge, God gave them over to a reprobate mind, to do those things which are not convenient;

did not lodge [18 JOB 31 32](#) # The stranger did not lodge in the street: [but] I opened my doors to the traveller.

did not make [27 DAN 04 07](#) # Then came in the magicians, the astrologers, the Chaldeans, and the soothsayers: and I told the dream before them; but they did not make known unto me the interpretation thereof.

did not many [40 MAT 13 58](#) # And he did not many mighty works there because of their unbelief.

did not minister [40 MAT 25 44](#) # Then shall they also answer him, saying, Lord, when saw we thee an hungered, or athirst, or a stranger, or naked, or sick, or in prison, and did not minister unto thee?

Did not Moses [43 JOH 07 19](#) # Did not Moses give you the law, and [yet] none of you keepeth the law? Why go ye about to kill me?

did not one [18 JOB 31 15](#) # Did not he that made me in the womb make him? and did not one fashion us in the womb?

Did not our [42 LUK 24 32](#) # And they said one to another, Did not our heart burn within us, while he talked with us by the way, and while he opened to us the scriptures?

did not our [16 NEH 13 18](#) # Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? yet ye bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the sabbath.

did not overtake [28 HOS 10 09](#) # O Israel, thou hast sinned from the days of Gibeah: there they stood: the battle in Gibeah against the children of iniquity did not overtake them.

did not profit [58 HEB 04 02](#) # For unto us was the gospel preached, as well as unto them: but the word preached did not profit them, not being mixed with faith in them that heard [it].

did not pursue [01 GEN 35 05](#) # And they journeyed: and the terror of God was upon the cities that [were] round about them, and they did not pursue after the sons of Jacob.

did not put [19 PSA 18 22](#) # For all his judgments [were] before me, and I did not put away his statutes from me.

did not receive [42 LUK 09 53](#) # And they did not receive him, because his face was as though he would go to Jerusalem.

did not rest [03 LEV 26 35](#) # As long as it lieth desolate it shall rest; because it did not rest in your sabbaths, when ye dwelt upon it.

did not set [05 DEU 07 07](#) # The LORD did not set his love upon you, nor choose you, because ye were more in number than any people; for ye [were] the fewest of all people:

did not show [09 ISA 22 17](#) # And the king said unto the footmen that stood about him, Turn, and slay the priests of the LORD; because their hand also [is] with David, and because they knew when he fled, and did not show it to me. But the servants of the king would not put forth their hand to fall upon the priests of the LORD.

did not slip [10 2SA 22 37](#) # Thou hast enlarged my steps under me; so that my feet did not slip.

did not slip [19 PSA 18 36](#) # Thou hast enlarged my steps under me, that my feet did not slip.

did not so [07 JUD 02 17](#) # And yet they would not hearken unto their judges, but they went a whoring after other gods, and bowed themselves unto them: they turned quickly out of the way which their fathers walked in, obeying the commandments of the LORD; [but] they did not so.

Did not Solomon [16 NEH 13 26](#) # Did not Solomon king of Israel sin by these things? yet among many nations was there no king like him, who was beloved of his God, and God made him king over all Israel: nevertheless even him did outlandish women cause to sin.

did not sow [42 LUK 19 22](#) # And he saith unto him, Out of thine own mouth will I judge thee, [thou] wicked servant. Thou knewest that I was an austere man, taking up that I laid not down, and reaping that I did not sow:

did not stand [24 JER 46 21](#) # Also her hired men [are] in the midst of her like fatted bullocks; for they

also are turned back, [and] are fled away together: they did not stand, because the day of their calamity was come upon them, [and] the time of their visitation.

did not stink [02\\_EXO\\_16\\_24](#) # And they laid it up till the morning, as Moses bade: and it did not stink, neither was there any worm therein.

did not stir [19\\_PSA\\_78\\_38](#) # But he, [being] full of compassion, forgave [their] iniquity, and destroyed [them] not: yea, many a time turned he his anger away, and did not stir up all his wrath.

did not that [14\\_2CH\\_28\\_01](#) # Ahaz [was] twenty years old when he began to reign, and he reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem: but he did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, like David his father:

did not that [12\\_2KI\\_16\\_02](#) # Twenty years old [was] Ahaz when he began to reign, and reigned sixteen years in Jerusalem, and did not [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD his God, like David his father.

did not the [01\\_GEN\\_40\\_23](#) # Yet did not the chief butler remember Joseph, but forgat him.

did not the [23\\_ISA\\_42\\_24](#) # Who gave Jacob for a spoil, and Israel to the robbers? did not the LORD, he against whom we have sinned? for they would not walk in his ways, neither were they obedient unto his law.

did not the [24\\_JER\\_44\\_21](#) # The incense that ye burned in the cities of Judah, and in the streets of Jerusalem, ye, and your fathers, your kings, and your princes, and the people of the land, did not the LORD remember them, and came it [not] into his mind?

Did not the [07\\_JUD\\_06\\_13](#) # And Gideon said unto him, Oh my Lord, if the LORD be with us, why then is all this befallen us? and where [be] all his miracles which our fathers told us of, saying, Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt? but now the LORD hath forsaken us, and delivered us into the hands of the Midianites.

Did not the [07\\_JUD\\_06\\_13](#) # And Gideon said unto him, Oh my Lord, if the LORD be with us, why then is all this befallen us? and where [be] all his miracles which our fathers told us of, saying, Did not the LORD bring us up from Egypt? but now the LORD hath forsaken us, and delivered us into the hands of the Midianites.

did not utterly [07\\_JUD\\_01\\_28](#) # And it came to pass, when Israel was strong, that they put the Canaanites to tribute, and did not utterly drive them out.

Did not we [44\\_ACT\\_05\\_28](#) # Saying, Did not we straitly command you that ye should not teach in this name? and, behold, ye have filled Jerusalem with your doctrine, and intend to bring this man's blood upon us.

Did not we [27\\_DAN\\_03\\_24](#) # Then Nebuchadnezzar the king was astonished, and rose up in haste, [and] spake, and said unto his counsellors, Did not we cast three men bound into the midst of the fire? They answered and said unto the king, True, O king.

Did not ye [07 JUD 11 07](#) # And Jephthah said unto the elders of Gilead, Did not ye hate me, and expel me out of my father's house? and why are ye come unto me now when ye are in distress?

did not ye [38 ZEC 07 06](#) # And when ye did eat, and when ye did drink, did not ye eat [for yourselves], and drink [for yourselves]?

did not yet [09 ISA 03 07](#) # Now Samuel did not yet know the LORD, neither was the word of the LORD yet revealed unto him.

Did not your [16 NEH 13 18](#) # Did not your fathers thus, and did not our God bring all this evil upon us, and upon this city? yet ye bring more wrath upon Israel by profaning the sabbath.

did number according [04 NUM 04 37](#) # These [were] they that were numbered of the families of the Kohathites, all that might do service in the tabernacle of the congregation, which Moses and Aaron did number according to the commandment of the LORD by the hand of Moses.

did number according [04 NUM 04 41](#) # These [are] they that were numbered of the families of the sons of Gershon, of all that might do service in the tabernacle of the congregation, whom Moses and Aaron did number according to the commandment of the LORD.

did obeisance and [10 2SA 14 04](#) # And when the woman of Tekoah spake to the king, she fell on her face to the ground, and did obeisance, and said, Help, O king.

did obeisance and [02 EXO 18 07](#) # And Moses went out to meet his father in law, and did obeisance, and kissed him; and they asked each other of [their] welfare; and they came into the tent.

did obeisance unto [11 1KI 01 16](#) # And Bathsheba bowed, and did obeisance unto the king. And the king said, What wouldest thou?

did obeisance [10 2SA 01 02](#) # It came even to pass on the third day, that, behold, a man came out of the camp from Saul with his clothes rent, and earth upon his head: and [so] it was, when he came to David, that he fell to the earth, and did obeisance.

did offer an [02 EXO 35 24](#) # Every one that did offer an offering of silver and brass brought the LORD's offering: and every man, with whom was found shittim wood for any work of the service, brought [it].

did offer sweet [26 EZE 06 13](#) # Then shall ye know that I [am] the LORD, when their slain [men] shall be among their idols round about their altars, upon every high hill, in all the tops of the mountains, and under every green tree, and under every thick oak, the place where they did offer sweet savour to all their idols.

did offer [04 NUM 07 18](#) # On the second day Nethaneel the son of Zuar, prince of Issachar, did offer:

did offer [04 NUM 07 24](#) # On the third day Eliab the son of Helon, prince of the children of Zebulun, [did offer]:

did offer [04 NUM 07 30](#) # On the fourth day Elizur the son of Shedeur, prince of the children of Reuben, [did offer]:

did offer [04 NUM 07 36](#) # On the fifth day Shelumiel the son of Zurishaddai, prince of the children of Simeon, [did offer]:

did on the [26 EZE 46 12](#) # Now when the prince shall prepare a voluntary burnt offering or peace offerings voluntarily unto the LORD, [one] shall then open him the gate that looketh toward the east, and he shall prepare his burnt offering and his peace offerings, as he did on the sabbath day: then he shall go

forth; and after his going forth [one] shall shut the gate.

did on them [43 JOH 06 02](#) # And a great multitude followed him, because they saw his miracles which he did on them that were diseased.

did once when [58 HEB 07 27](#) # Who needeth not daily, as those high priests, to offer up sacrifice, first for his own sins, and then for the people's: for this he did once, when he offered up himself.

did oppress you [07 JUD 10 12](#) # The Zidonians also, and the Amalekites, and the Maonites, did oppress you; and ye cried to me, and I delivered you out of their hand.

did ordain in [13 1CH 09 22](#) # All these [which were] chosen to be porters in the gates [were] two hundred and twelve. These were reckoned by their genealogy in their villages, whom David and Samuel the seer did ordain in their set office.

did others tell [43 JOH 18 34](#) # Jesus answered him, Sayest thou this thing of thyself, or did others tell it thee of me?

did outlandish women [16 NEH 13 26](#) # Did not Solomon king of Israel sin by these things? yet among many nations was there no king like him, who was beloved of his God, and God made him king over all Israel: nevertheless even him did outlandish women cause to sin.

did outrun Peter [43 JOH 20 04](#) # So they ran both together: and the other disciple did outrun Peter, and came first to the sepulchre.

did perversely the [10 2SA 19 19](#) # And said unto the king, Let not my lord impute iniquity unto me, neither do thou remember that which thy servant did perversely the day that my lord the king went out of Jerusalem, that the king should take it to his heart.

did pleased all [10 2SA 03 36](#) # And all the people took notice [of it], and it pleased them: as whatsoever the king did pleased all the people.

did predestinate them [45 ROM 08 30](#) # Moreover whom he did predestinate, them he also called: and whom he called, them he also justified: and whom he justified, them he also glorified.

did predestinate to [45 ROM 08 29](#) # For whom he did foreknow, he also did predestinate [to be] conformed to the image of his Son, that he might be the firstborn among many brethren.

did prophesy [44 ACT 21 09](#) # And the same man had four daughters, virgins, which did prophesy.

did provide [14 2CH 02 07](#) # Send me now therefore a man cunning to work in gold, and in silver, and in brass, and in iron, and in purple, and crimson, and blue, and that can skill to grave with the cunning men that [are] with me in Judah and in Jerusalem, whom David my father did provide.

did provoke howbeit [58 HEB 03 16](#) # For some, when they had heard, did provoke: howbeit not all that came out of Egypt by Moses.

did pursue his [30 AMO 01 11](#) # Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Edom, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because he did pursue his brother with the sword, and did cast off all pity, and his anger did tear perpetually, and he kept his wrath for ever:

did put all [46 1CO 15 27](#) # For he hath put all things under his feet. But when he saith all things are put under [him, it is] manifest that he is excepted, which did put all things under him.

did put away [09 1SA 07 04](#) # Then the children of Israel did put away Baalim and Ashtaroth, and served

the LORD only.

did put his [09 ISA 19 05](#) # For he did put his life in his hand, and slew the Philistine, and the LORD wrought a great salvation for all Israel: thou sawest [it], and didst rejoice: wherefore then wilt thou sin against innocent blood, to slay David without a cause?

did put on [02 EXO 33 04](#) # And when the people heard these evil tidings, they mourned: and no man did put on him his ornaments.

did put upon [11 1KI 12 09](#) # And he said unto them, What counsel give ye that we may answer this people, who have spoken to me, saying, Make the yoke which thy father did put upon us lighter?

did put upon [14 2CH 10 09](#) # And he said unto them, What advice give ye that we may return answer to this people, which have spoken to me, saying, Ease somewhat the yoke that thy father did put upon us?

did quake and [40 MAT 27 51](#) # And, behold, the veil of the temple was rent in twain from the top to the bottom; and the earth did quake, and the rocks rent;

did reign in [40 MAT 02 22](#) # But when he heard that Archelaus did reign in Judaea in the room of his father Herod, he was afraid to go thither: notwithstanding, being warned of God in a dream, he turned aside into the parts of Galilee:

did reign over [12 2KI 11 03](#) # And he was with her hid in the house of the LORD six years. And Athaliah did reign over the land.

did reign that [46 1CO 04 08](#) # Now ye are full, now ye are rich, ye have reigned as kings without us: and I would to God ye did reign, that we also might reign with you.

did remain in [31 OBA 01 14](#) # Neither shouldest thou have stood in the crossway, to cut off those of his that did escape; neither shouldest thou have delivered up those of his that did remain in the day of distress.

did repent for [47 2CO 07 08](#) # For though I made you sorry with a letter, I do not repent, though I did repent: for I perceive that the same epistle hath made you sorry, though [it were] but for a season.

did rest the [58 HEB 04 04](#) # For he spake in a certain place of the seventh [day] on this wise, And God did rest the seventh day from all his works.

did reverence And [10 2SA 09 06](#) # Now when Mephibosheth, the son of Jonathan, the son of Saul, was come unto David, he fell on his face, and did reverence. And David said, Mephibosheth. And he answered, Behold thy servant!

did reverence to [11 1KI 01 31](#) # Then Bathsheba bowed with [her] face to the earth, and did reverence to the king, and said, Let my lord king David live for ever.

did righteousness and [23 ISA 58 02](#) # Yet they seek me daily, and delight to know my ways, as a nation that did righteousness, and forsook not the ordinance of their God: they ask of me the ordinances of justice; they take delight in approaching to God.

did rise up [19 PSA 35 11](#) # False witnesses did rise up; they laid to my charge [things] that I knew not.

did run to [40 MAT 28 08](#) # And they departed quickly from the sepulchre with fear and great joy; and did run to bring his disciples word.

did run well [48 GAL 05 07](#) # Ye did run well; who did hinder you that ye should not obey the truth?

did sacrifice and [12\\_2KI\\_14\\_04](#) # Howbeit the high places were not taken away: as yet the people did sacrifice and burnt incense on the high places.

did sacrifice still [14\\_2CH\\_33\\_17](#) # Nevertheless the people did sacrifice still in the high places, [yet] unto the LORD their God only.

did said This [43\\_JOH\\_06\\_14](#) # Then those men, when they had seen the miracle that Jesus did, said, This is of a truth that prophet that should come into the world.

did Sarah laugh [01\\_GEN\\_18\\_13](#) # And the LORD said unto Abraham, Wherefore did Sarah laugh, saying, Shall I of a surety bear a child, which am old?

did say should [44\\_ACT\\_26\\_22](#) # Having therefore obtained help of God, I continue unto this day, witnessing both to small and great, saying none other things than those which the prophets and Moses did say should come:

did say to [11\\_1KI\\_13\\_22](#) # But camest back, and hast eaten bread and drunk water in the place, of the which [the LORD] did say to thee, Eat no bread, and drink no water; thy carcase shall not come unto the sepulchre of thy fathers.

did search or [26\\_EZE\\_34\\_06](#) # My sheep wandered through all the mountains, and upon every high hill: yea, my flock was scattered upon all the face of the earth, and none did search or seek [after them].

did secretly those [12\\_2KI\\_17\\_09](#) # And the children of Israel did secretly [those] things that [were] not right against the LORD their God, and they built them high places in all their cities, from the tower of the watchmen to the fenced city.

did see all [14\\_2CH\\_18\\_16](#) # Then he said, I did see all Israel scattered upon the mountains, as sheep that have no shepherd: and the LORD said, These have no master; let them return [therefore] every man to his house in peace.

did see corruption [44\\_ACT\\_02\\_31](#) # He seeing this before spake of the resurrection of Christ, that his soul was not left in hell, neither his flesh did see corruption.

did see me [19\\_PSA\\_31\\_11](#) # I was a reproach among all mine enemies, but especially among my neighbours, and a fear to mine acquaintance: they that did see me without fled from me.

did see my [19\\_PSA\\_139\\_16](#) # Thine eyes did see my substance, yet being unperfect; and in thy book all [my members] were written, [which] in continuance were fashioned, when [as yet there was] none of them.

did see that [02\\_EXO\\_05\\_19](#) # And the officers of the children of Israel did see [that] they [were] in evil [case], after it was said, Ye shall not minish [ought] from your bricks of your daily task.

did see [35\\_HAB\\_01\\_01](#) # The burden which Habakkuk the prophet did see.

did see [23\\_ISA\\_13\\_01](#) # The burden of Babylon, which Isaiah the son of Amoz did see.

did seek God [19\\_PSA\\_53\\_02](#) # God looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were [any] that did understand, that did seek God.

did sell himself [11\\_1KI\\_21\\_25](#) # But there was none like unto Ahab, which did sell himself to work wickedness in the sight of the LORD, whom Jezebel his wife stirred up.

did send me [01\\_GEN\\_45\\_05](#) # Now therefore be not grieved, nor angry with yourselves, that ye sold me hither: for God did send me before you to preserve life.



did Sennacherib king [14 2CH 32 09](#) # After this did Sennacherib king of Assyria send his servants to Jerusalem, [but he [himself laid siege] against Lachish, and all his power with him,] unto Hezekiah king of Judah, and unto all Judah that [were] at Jerusalem, saying,

did Sennacherib king [12 2KI 18 13](#) # Now in the fourteenth year of king Hezekiah did Sennacherib king of Assyria come up against all the fenced cities of Judah, and took them.

did separate the [01 GEN 30 40](#) # And Jacob did separate the lambs, and set the faces of the flocks toward the ringstreaked, and all the brown in the flock of Laban; and he put his own flocks by themselves, and put them not unto Laban's cattle.

did service unto [48 GAL 04 08](#) # Howbeit then, when ye knew not God, ye did service unto them which by nature are no gods.

did set over [02 EXO 01 11](#) # Therefore they did set over them taskmasters to afflict them with their burdens. And they built for Pharaoh treasure cities, Pithom and Raamses.

did set them [41 MAR 08 06](#) # And he commanded the people to sit down on the ground: and he took the seven loaves, and gave thanks, and brake, and gave to his disciples to set before [them]; and they did set [them] before the people.

did set they [41 MAR 01 32](#) # And at even, when the sun did set, they brought unto him all that were diseased, and them that were possessed with devils.

did set up [04 NUM 10 21](#) # And the Kohathites set forward, bearing the sanctuary: and [the other] did set up the tabernacle against they came.

did shake and [40 MAT 28 04](#) # And for fear of him the keepers did shake, and became as dead [men].

did shake kingdoms [23 ISA 14 16](#) # They that see thee shall narrowly look upon thee, [and] consider thee, [saying, Is] this the man that made the earth to tremble, that did shake kingdoms;

did she many [44 ACT 16 18](#) # And this did she many days. But Paul, being grieved, turned and said to the spirit, I command thee in the name of Jesus Christ to come out of her. And he came out the same hour.

did she regard [09 ISA 04 20](#) # And about the time of her death the women that stood by her said unto her, Fear not; for thou hast borne a son. But she answered not, neither did she regard [it].

did she strengthen [26 EZE 16 49](#) # Behold, this was the iniquity of thy sister Sodom, pride, fulness of bread, and abundance of idleness was in her and in her daughters, neither did she strengthen the hand of the poor and needy.

did shear his [09 ISA 25 04](#) # And David heard in the wilderness that Nabal did shear his sheep.

did Sheshbazzar bring [15 EZR 01 11](#) # All the vessels of gold and of silver [were] five thousand and four hundred. All [these] did Sheshbazzar bring up with [them of] the captivity that were brought up from Babylon unto Jerusalem.

did shine as [40 MAT 17 02](#) # And was transfigured before them: and his face did shine as the sun, and his raiment was white as the light.

did signify when [60 1PE 01 11](#) # Searching what, or what manner of time the Spirit of Christ which was in them did signify, when it testified beforehand the sufferings of Christ, and the glory that should follow.

did sin and [11 1KI 14 16](#) # And he shall give Israel up because of the sins of Jeroboam, who did sin, and who made Israel to sin.

did sin this [43 JOH 09 02](#) # And his disciples asked him, saying, Master, who did sin, this man, or his parents, that he was born blind?

did sing of [26 EZE 27 25](#) # The ships of Tarshish did sing of thee in thy market: and thou wast replenished, and made very glorious in the midst of the seas.

did sit and [19 PSA 119 23](#) # Princes also did sit [and] speak against me: [but] thy servant did meditate in thy statutes.

did sit whose [27 DAN 07 09](#) # I beheld till the thrones were cast down, and the Ancient of days did sit, whose garment [was] white as snow, and the hair of his head like the pure wool: his throne [was like] the fiery flame, [and] his wheels [as] burning fire.

did six days [06 JOS 06 14](#) # And the second day they compassed the city once, and returned into the camp: so they did six days.

did so and [11 1KI 14 04](#) # And Jeroboam's wife did so, and arose, and went to Shiloh, and came to the house of Ahijah. But Ahijah could not see; for his eyes were set by reason of his age.

did the priest [12\\_2KI\\_11\\_10](#) # And to the captains over hundreds did the priest give king David's spears and shields, that [were] in the temple of the LORD.

did the priests [11\\_1KI\\_08\\_04](#) # And they brought up the ark of the LORD, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and all the holy vessels that [were] in the tabernacle, even those did the priests and the Levites bring up.

did the priests [14\\_2CH\\_05\\_05](#) # And they brought up the ark, and the tabernacle of the congregation, and all the holy vessels that [were] in the tabernacle, these did the priests [and] the Levites bring up.

did the service [58\\_HEB\\_09\\_09](#) # Which [was] a figure for the time then present, in which were offered both gifts and sacrifices, that could not make him that did the service perfect, as pertaining to the conscience;

did the signs [02\\_EXO\\_04\\_30](#) # And Aaron spake all the words which the LORD had spoken unto Moses, and did the signs in the sight of the people.

did the sons [16\\_NEH\\_03\\_03](#) # But the fish gate did the sons of Hassenaah build, who [also] laid the beams thereof, and set up the doors thereof, the locks thereof, and the bars thereof.

did the things [42\\_LUK\\_17\\_09](#) # Doth he thank that servant because he did the things that were commanded

him? I trow not.

did the waters [01\\_GEN\\_07\\_20](#) # Fifteen cubits upward did the waters prevail; and the mountains were covered.

did the which [43\\_JOH\\_21\\_25](#) # And there are also many other things which Jesus did, the which, if they should be written every one, I suppose that even the world itself could not contain the books that should be written. Amen.

did the will [40\\_MAT\\_21\\_31](#) # Whether of them twain did the will of [his] father? They say unto him, The first. Jesus saith unto them, Verily I say unto you, That the publicans and the harlots go into the kingdom of God before you.

did the work [13\\_1CH\\_23\\_24](#) # These [were] the sons of Levi after the house of their fathers; [even] the chief of the fathers, as they were counted by number of names by their polls, that did the work for the service of the house of the LORD, from the age of twenty years and upward.

did the work [13\\_1CH\\_27\\_26](#) # And over them that did the work of the field for tillage of the ground [was] Ezri the son of Chelub:

did the work [14\\_2CH\\_24\\_12](#) # And the king and Jehoiada gave it to such as did the work of the service of the house of the LORD, and hired masons and carpenters to repair the house of the LORD, and also such as wrought iron and brass to mend the house of the LORD.

did the work [14\\_2CH\\_34\\_12](#) # And the men did the work faithfully: and the overseers of them [were] Jahath and Obadiah, the Levites, of the sons of Merari; and Zechariah and Meshullam, of the sons of the Kohathites, to set [it] forward; and [other of] the Levites, all that could skill of instruments of music.

did the work [12\\_2KI\\_12\\_11](#) # And they gave the money, being told, into the hands of them that did the work, that had the oversight of the house of the LORD: and they laid it out to the carpenters and builders, that wrought upon the house of the LORD,

did the work [16\\_NEH\\_02\\_16](#) # And the rulers knew not whither I went, or what I did; neither had I as yet told [it] to the Jews, nor to the priests, nor to the nobles, nor to the rulers, nor to the rest that did the work.

did the work [16\\_NEH\\_11\\_12](#) # And their brethren that did the work of the house [were] eight hundred twenty and two: and Adaiah the son of Jeroham, the son of Pelaliah, the son of Amzi, the son of Zechariah, the son of Pashur, the son of Malchiah,

did the work [16\\_NEH\\_13\\_10](#) # And I perceived that the portions of the Levites had not been given [them]: for the Levites and the singers, that did the work, were fled every one to his field.

did the wrong [02\\_EXO\\_02\\_13](#) # And when he went out the second day, behold, two men of the Hebrews strove together: and he said to him that did the wrong, Wherefore smitest thou thy fellow?

did their fathers [12\\_2KI\\_17\\_41](#) # So these nations feared the LORD, and served their graven images, both their children, and their children's children: as did their fathers, so do they unto this day.

did their fathers [42\\_LUK\\_06\\_23](#) # Rejoice ye in that day, and leap for joy: for, behold, your reward [is] great in heaven: for in the like manner did their fathers unto the prophets.

did their fathers [42\\_LUK\\_06\\_26](#) # Woe unto you, when all men shall speak well of you! for so did their fathers to the false prophets.

did their own [19\\_PSA\\_44\\_03](#) # For they got not the land in possession by their own sword, neither did their

own arm save them: but thy right hand, and thine arm, and the light of thy countenance, because thou hadst a favour unto them.

did their witness [41 MAR 14 59](#) # But neither so did their witness agree together.

did them not [24 JER 11 08](#) # Yet they obeyed not, nor inclined their ear, but walked every one in the imagination of their evil heart: therefore I will bring upon them all the words of this covenant, which I commanded [them] to do; but they did [them] not.

did them suddenly [23 ISA 48 03](#) # I have declared the former things from the beginning; and they went forth out of my mouth, and I showed them; I did [them] suddenly, and they came to pass.

did there confound [01 GEN 11 09](#) # Therefore is the name of it called Babel; because the LORD did there confound the language of all the earth: and from thence did the LORD scatter them abroad upon the face of all the earth.

did there he [01 GEN 39 22](#) # And the keeper of the prison committed to Joseph's hand all the prisoners that [were] in the prison; and whatsoever they did there, he was the doer [of it].

did there remain [06 JOS 02 11](#) # And as soon as we had heard [these things], our hearts did melt, neither did there remain any more courage in any man, because of you: for the LORD your God, he [is] God in heaven above, and in earth beneath.

did these nations [05 DEU 12 30](#) # Take heed to thyself that thou be not snared by following them, after that they be destroyed from before thee; and that thou inquire not after their gods, saying, How did these nations serve their gods? even so will I do likewise.

did these three [13 1CH 11 19](#) # And said, My God forbid it me, that I should do this thing: shall I drink the blood of these men that have put their lives in jeopardy? for with [the jeopardy of] their lives they brought it. Therefore he would not drink it. These things did these three mightiest.

did these three [10 2SA 23 17](#) # And he said, Be it far from me, O LORD, that I should do this: [is not this] the blood of the men that went in jeopardy of their lives? therefore he would not drink it. These things did these three mighty men.

did they bestow [14 2CH 24 07](#) # For the sons of Athaliah, that wicked woman, had broken up the house of God; and also all the dedicated things of the house of the LORD did they bestow upon Baalim.

did they bring [11 1KI 10 29](#) # And a chariot came up and went out of Egypt for six hundred [shekels] of silver, and an horse for an hundred and fifty: and so for all the kings of the Hittites, and for the kings of Syria, did they bring [them] out by their means.

did they cast [40 MAT 27 35](#) # And they crucified him, and parted his garments, casting lots: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophet, They parted my garments among them, and upon my vesture did they cast lots.

did they dedicate [13 1CH 26 27](#) # Out of the spoils won in battles did they dedicate to maintain the house of the LORD.

did they departed [12 2KI 17 22](#) # For the children of Israel walked in all the sins of Jeroboam which he did; they departed not from them;

did they eat [14 2CH 30 18](#) # For a multitude of the people, [even] many of Ephraim, and Manasseh, Issachar, and Zebulun, had not cleansed themselves, yet did they eat the passover otherwise than it was written. But Hezekiah prayed for them, saying, The good LORD pardon every one

did they forsake [26 EZE 20 08](#) # But they rebelled against me, and would not hearken unto me: they did not every man cast away the abominations of their eyes, neither did they forsake the idols of Egypt: then I said, I will pour out my fury upon them, to accomplish my anger against them in the midst of the land of Egypt.

did they had [43 JOH 15 24](#) # If I had not done among them the works which none other man did, they had not had sin: but now have they both seen and hated both me and my Father.

did they not [09 ISA 06 06](#) # Wherefore then do ye harden your hearts, as the Egyptians and Pharaoh hardened their hearts? when he had wrought wonderfully among them, did they not let the people go, and they departed?

did they not [09 ISA 21 11](#) # And the servants of Achish said unto him, [Is] not this David the king of the land? did they not sing one to another of him in dances, saying, Saul hath slain his thousands, and David his ten thousands?

did they not [38 ZEC 01 06](#) # But my words and my statutes, which I commanded my servants the prophets, did they not take hold of your fathers? and they returned and said, Like as the LORD of hosts thought to do unto us, according to our ways, and according to our doings, so hath he dealt with us.

did they provoke [19 PSA 78 40](#) # How oft did they provoke him in the wilderness, [and] grieve him in the desert!

did they spit [40 MAT 26 67](#) # Then did they spit in his face, and buffeted him; and others smote [him] with the palms of their hands,

did they unto [04 NUM 08 22](#) # And after that went the Levites in to do their service in the tabernacle of the congregation before Aaron, and before his sons: as the LORD had commanded Moses concerning the Levites, so did they unto them.

did they with [14 2CH 35 12](#) # And they removed the burnt offerings, that they might give according to the divisions of the families of the people, to offer unto the LORD, as [it is] written in the book of Moses. And so [did they] with the oxen.

did they [02 EXO 07 06](#) # And Moses and Aaron did as the LORD commanded them, so did they.

did they [02 EXO 12 28](#) # And the children of Israel went away, and did as the LORD had commanded Moses and Aaron, so did they.

did they [02 EXO 12 50](#) # Thus did all the children of Israel; as the LORD commanded Moses and Aaron, so did they.

did they [02 EXO 39 32](#) # Thus was all the work of the tabernacle of the tent of the congregation finished: and the children of Israel did according to all that the LORD commanded Moses, so did they.

did they [04 NUM 01 54](#) # And the children of Israel did according to all that the LORD commanded Moses, so did they.

did this people [02 EXO 32 21](#) # And Moses said unto Aaron, What did this people unto thee, that thou hast brought so great a sin upon them?

did this thing [10 2SA 12 06](#) # And he shall restore the lamb fourfold, because he did this thing, and because he had no pity.

did those great [06 JOS 24 17](#) # For the LORD our God, he [it is] that brought us up and our fathers out of the land of Egypt, from the house of bondage, and which did those great signs in our sight, and preserved us in all the way wherein we went, and among all the people through whom we passed:

did thy fathers [05 DEU 08 03](#) # And he humbled thee, and suffered thee to hunger, and fed thee with manna, which thou knewest not, neither did thy fathers know; that he might make thee know that man doth not live by bread only, but by every [word] that proceedeth out of the mouth of the LORD doth man live.

did thy foot [05 DEU 08 04](#) # Thy raiment waxed not old upon thee, neither did thy foot swell, these forty years.

did thy servant [01 GEN 39 19](#) # And it came to pass, when his master heard the words of his wife, which she spake unto him, saying, After this manner did thy servant to me; that his wrath was kindled.

Did Titus make [47 2CO 12 18](#) # I desired Titus, and with [him] I sent a brother. Did Titus make a gain of you? walked we not in the same spirit? [walked we] not in the same steps?

did to both [02 EXO 36 29](#) # And they were coupled beneath, and coupled together at the head thereof, to one ring: thus he did to both of them in both the corners.

did to Debir [06 JOS 10 39](#) # And he took it, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof; and they smote them with the edge of the sword, and utterly destroyed all the souls that [were] therein; he left none remaining: as he had done to Hebron, so he did to Debir, and to the king thereof; as he had done also to Libnah, and to her king.

did to Israel [09 ISA 15 02](#) # Thus saith the LORD of hosts, I remember [that] which Amalek did to Israel, how he laid [wait] for him in the way, when he came up from Egypt.

did to it [24 JER 07 12](#) # But go ye now unto my place which [was] in Shiloh, where I set my name at the first, and see what I did to it for the wickedness of my people Israel.

did to make [11 1KI 16 19](#) # For his sins which he sinned in doing evil in the sight of the LORD, in walking in the way of Jeroboam, and in his sin which he did, to make Israel to sin.

did to me [11 1KI 02 05](#) # Moreover thou knowest also what Joab the son of Zeruiah did to me, [and] what he did to the two captains of the hosts of Israel, unto Abner the son of Ner, and unto Amasa the son of Jether, whom he slew, and shed the blood of war in peace, and put the blood of war upon his girdle that [was] about his loins, and in his shoes that [were] on his feet.

did to prosper [01 GEN 39 03](#) # And his master saw that the LORD [was] with him, and that the LORD made all that he did to prosper in his hand.

did to Sihon [05 DEU 31 04](#) # And the LORD shall do unto them as he did to Sihon and to Og, kings of the Amorites, and unto the land of them, whom he destroyed.

did to the [11 1KI 02 05](#) # Moreover thou knowest also what Joab the son of Zeruiah did to me, [and] what he did to the two captains of the hosts of Israel, unto Abner the son of Ner, and unto Amasa the son of Jether, whom he slew, and shed the blood of war in peace, and put the blood of war upon his girdle that [was] about his loins, and in his shoes that [were] on his feet.

did to the [05 DEU 02 22](#) # As he did to the children of Esau, which dwelt in Seir, when he destroyed the Horims from before them; and they succeeded them, and dwelt in their stead even unto this day:

did to the [02 EXO 18 14](#) # And when Moses' father in law saw all that he did to the people, he said, What

**[is] this thing that thou doest to the people? why sittest thou thyself alone, and all the people stand by thee from morning unto even?**

**did to the [06 JOS 04 23](#) # For the LORD your God dried up the waters of Jordan from before you, until ye were passed over, as the LORD your God did to the Red sea, which he dried up from before us, until we were gone over:**

**did to the [06 JOS 09 10](#) # And all that he did to the two kings of the Amorites, that [were] beyond Jordan, to Sihon king of Heshbon, and to Og king of Bashan, which [was] at Ashtaroth.**

**did to the [06 JOS 10 28](#) # And that day Joshua took Makkedah, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof he utterly destroyed, them, and all the souls that [were] therein; he let none remain: and he did to the king of Makkedah as he did unto the king of Jericho.**

**did to the [04 NUM 08 20](#) # And Moses, and Aaron, and all the congregation of the children of Israel, did to the Levites according unto all that the LORD commanded Moses concerning the Levites, so did the children of Israel unto them.**

**did to them [12 2KI 23 19](#) # And all the houses also of the high places that [were] in the cities of Samaria, which the kings of Israel had made to provoke [the LORD] to anger, Josiah took away, and did to them according to all the acts that he had done in Bethel.**

**did to you [09 ISA 12 07](#) # Now therefore stand still, that I may reason with you before the LORD of all the righteous acts of the LORD, which he did to you and to your fathers.**

**did tremble and [23 ISA 05 25](#) # Therefore is the anger of the LORD kindled against his people, and he hath stretched forth his hand against them, and hath smitten them: and the hills did tremble, and their carcasses [were] torn in the midst of the streets. For all this his anger is not turned away, but his hand [is] stretched out still.**

**did tremble [35 HAB 03 07](#) # I saw the tents of Cushan in affliction: [and] the curtains of the land of Midian did tremble.**

**did turn away [14 2CH 25 27](#) # Now after the time that Amaziah did turn away from following the LORD they made a conspiracy against him in Jerusalem; and he fled to Lachish: but they sent to Lachish after him, and slew him there.**

**did turn many [39 MAL 02 06](#) # The law of truth was in his mouth, and iniquity was not found in his lips: he walked with me in peace and equity, and did turn many away from iniquity.**

**did turn unto [14 2CH 15 04](#) # But when they in their trouble did turn unto the LORD God of Israel, and sought him, he was found of them.**

**did understand and [19 PSA 14 02](#) # The LORD looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were any that did understand, [and] seek God.**

**did understand that [19 PSA 53 02](#) # God looked down from heaven upon the children of men, to see if there were [any] that did understand, that did seek God.**

**did unto all [09 ISA 02 22](#) # Now Eli was very old, and heard all that his sons did unto all Israel; and how they lay with the women that assembled [at] the door of the tabernacle of the congregation.**

**did unto Amnon [10 2SA 13 29](#) # And the servants of Absalom did unto Amnon as Absalom had commanded. Then all the king's sons arose, and every man gat him up upon his mule, and fled.**

did unto Dathan [05\\_DEU\\_11\\_06](#) # And what he did unto Dathan and Abiram, the sons of Eliab, the son of Reuben: how the earth opened her mouth, and swallowed them up, and their households, and their tents, and all the substance that [was] in their possession, in the midst of all Israel:

did unto him [01\\_GEN\\_50\\_12](#) # And his sons did unto him according as he commanded them:

did unto him [01\\_GEN\\_50\\_15](#) # And when Joseph's brethren saw that their father was dead, they said, Joseph will peradventure hate us, and will certainly requite us all the evil which we did unto him.

did unto his [07\\_JUD\\_09\\_56](#) # Thus God rendered the wickedness of Abimelech, which he did unto his father, in slaying his seventy brethren:

did unto me [05\\_DEU\\_02\\_29](#) # [As the children of Esau which dwell in Seir, and the Moabites which dwell in Ar, did unto me;] until I shall pass over Jordan into the land which the LORD our God giveth us.

did unto me [02\\_EXO\\_13\\_08](#) # And thou shalt show thy son in that day, saying, [This is done] because of that [which] the LORD did unto me when I came forth out of Egypt.

did unto me [07\\_JUD\\_15\\_11](#) # Then three thousand men of Judah went to the top of the rock Etam, and said to Samson, Knowest thou not that the Philistines [are] rulers over us? what [is] this [that] thou hast done unto us? And he said unto them, As they did unto me, so have I done unto them.

did unto Miriam [05\\_DEU\\_24\\_09](#) # Remember what the LORD thy God did unto Miriam by the way, after that ye were come forth out of Egypt.

did unto Pharaoh [05\\_DEU\\_07\\_18](#) # Thou shalt not be afraid of them: [but] shalt well remember what the LORD thy God did unto Pharaoh, and unto all Egypt;

did unto Sarah [01\\_GEN\\_21\\_01](#) # And the LORD visited Sarah as he had said, and the LORD did unto Sarah as he had spoken.

did unto Sihon [05\\_DEU\\_03\\_06](#) # And we utterly destroyed them, as we did unto Sihon king of Heshbon, utterly destroying the men, women, and children, of every city.

did unto the [05\\_DEU\\_02\\_12](#) # The Horims also dwelt in Seir beforetime; but the children of Esau succeeded them, when they had destroyed them from before them, and dwelt in their stead; as Israel did unto the land of his possession, which the LORD gave unto them.

did unto the [05\\_DEU\\_11\\_04](#) # And what he did unto the army of Egypt, unto their horses, and to their chariots; how he made the water of the Red sea to overflow them as they pursued after you, and [how] the LORD hath destroyed them unto this day;

did unto the [02\\_EXO\\_19\\_04](#) # Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and [how] I bare you on eagles' wings, and brought you unto myself.

did unto the [06\\_JOS\\_02\\_10](#) # For we have heard how the LORD dried up the water of the Red sea for you, when ye came out of Egypt; and what ye did unto the two kings of the Amorites, that [were] on the other side Jordan, Sihon and Og, whom ye utterly destroyed.

did unto the [06\\_JOS\\_10\\_28](#) # And that day Joshua took Makkedah, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof he utterly destroyed, them, and all the souls that [were] therein; he let none remain: and he did to the king of Makkedah as he did unto the king of Jericho.

did unto thee [05 DEU 25 17](#) # Remember what Amalek did unto thee by the way, when ye were come forth out of Egypt;

did unto thee [01 GEN 50 17](#) # So shall ye say unto Joseph, Forgive, I pray thee now, the trespass of thy brethren, and their sin; for they did unto thee evil: and now, we pray thee, forgive the trespass of the servants of the God of thy father. And Joseph wept when they spake unto him.

did unto them [06 JOS 11 09](#) # And Joshua did unto them as the LORD bade him: he hocked their horses, and burnt their chariots with fire.

did unto them [40 MAT 21 36](#) # Again, he sent other servants more than the first: and they did unto them likewise.

did unto us [44 ACT 11 17](#) # Forasmuch then as God gave them the like gift as [he did] unto us, who believed on the Lord Jesus Christ; what was I, that I could withstand God?

did unto us [44 ACT 15 08](#) # And God, which knoweth the hearts, bare them witness, giving them the Holy Ghost, even as [he did] unto us;

did unto you [05 DEU 11 05](#) # And what he did unto you in the wilderness, until ye came into this place;

did upbraid me [07 JUD 08 15](#) # And he came unto the men of Succoth, and said, Behold Zebah and Zalmunna with whom ye did upbraid me, saying, [Are] the hands of Zebah and Zalmunna now in thine hand, that we should give bread unto thy men [that are] weary?

did upon the [02 EXO 14 31](#) # And Israel saw that great work which the LORD did upon the Egyptians: and the people feared the LORD, and believed the LORD, and his servant Moses.

did Urijah the [12 2KI 16 16](#) # Thus did Urijah the priest, according to all that king Ahaz commanded.

did value [40 MAT 27 09](#) # Then was fulfilled that which was spoken by Jeremy the prophet, saying, And they took the thirty pieces of silver, the price of him that was valued, whom they of the children of Israel did value;

did very abominably [11 1KI 21 26](#) # And he did very abominably in following idols, according to all [things] as did the Amorites, whom the LORD cast out before the children of Israel.

did very wickedly [14 2CH 20 35](#) # And after this did Jehoshaphat king of Judah join himself with Ahaziah king of Israel, who did very wickedly:

did vex them [14 2CH 15 06](#) # And nation was destroyed of nation, and city of city: for God did vex them with all adversity.

did visit the [44 ACT 15 14](#) # Simeon hath declared how God at the first did visit the Gentiles, to take out of them a people for his name.

did walk the [01 GEN 48 15](#) # And he blessed Joseph, and said, God, before whom my fathers Abraham and Isaac did walk, the God which fed me all my life long unto this day,

did walk then [11 1KI 03 14](#) # And if thou wilt walk in my ways, to keep my statutes and my commandments, as thy father David did walk, then I will lengthen thy days.

did wash the [03 LEV 09 14](#) # And he did wash the inwards and the legs, and burnt [them] upon the burnt offering on the altar.

did we eat [53 2TH 03 08](#) # Neither did we eat any man's bread for nought; but wrought with labour and travail night and day, that we might not be chargeable to any of you:

did we make [24 JER 44 19](#) # And when we burned incense to the queen of heaven, and poured out drink offerings unto her, did we make her cakes to worship her, and pour out drink offerings unto her, without our men?

did we rejoice [19 PSA 66 06](#) # He turned the sea into dry [land]: they went through the flood on foot: there did we rejoice in him.

did wear a [09 ISA 22 18](#) # And the king said to Doeg, Turn thou, and fall upon the priests. And Doeg the Edomite turned, and he fell upon the priests, and slew on that day fourscore and five persons that did wear a linen ephod.

did what they [17 EST 09 05](#) # Thus the Jews smote all their enemies with the stroke of the sword, and slaughter, and destruction, and did what they would unto those that hated them.

did when he [43 JOH 04 54](#) # This [is] again the second miracle [that] Jesus did, when he was come out of Judaea into Galilee.

did when he [41 MAR 02 25](#) # And he said unto them, Have ye never read what David did, when he had need, and was an hungred, he, and they that were with him?

did when he [40 MAT 12 03](#) # But he said unto them, Have ye not read what David did, when he was an hungred, and they that were with him;

did when himself [42 LUK 06 03](#) # And Jesus answering them said, Have ye not read so much as this, what David did, when himself was an hungered, and they which were with him;

did when Jezebel [11 1KI 18 13](#) # Was it not told my lord what I did when Jezebel slew the prophets of the LORD, how I hid an hundred men of the LORD's prophets by fifty in a cave, and fed them with bread and water?

did which were [12 2KI 21 11](#) # Because Manasseh king of Judah hath done these abominations, [and] hath done wickedly above all that the Amorites did, which [were] before him, and hath made Judah also to sin with his idols:

did wipe them [42 LUK 07 38](#) # And stood at his feet behind [him] weeping, and began to wash his feet with tears, and did wipe [them] with the hairs of her head, and kissed his feet, and anointed [them] with the ointment.

did with her [07 JUD 11 39](#) # And it came to pass at the end of two months, that she returned unto her father, who did with her [according] to his vow which he had vowed: and she knew no man. And it was a custom in Israel,

did with the [03 LEV 04 20](#) # And he shall do with the bullock as he did with the bullock for a sin offering, so shall he do with this: and the priest shall make an atonement for them, and it shall be forgiven them.

did with the [03 LEV 16 15](#) # Then shall he kill the goat of the sin offering, that [is] for the people, and

bring his blood within the veil, and do with that blood as he did with the blood of the bullock, and sprinkle it upon the mercy seat, and before the mercy seat:

did wonderously and [07\\_JUD\\_13\\_19](#) # So Manoah took a kid with a meat offering, and offered [it] upon a rock unto the LORD: and [the angel] did wonderously; and Manoah and his wife looked on.

did work in [37\\_HAG\\_01\\_14](#) # And the LORD stirred up the spirit of Zerubbabel the son of Shealtiel, governor of Judah, and the spirit of Joshua the son of Josedech, the high priest, and the spirit of all the remnant of the people; and they came and did work in the house of the LORD of hosts, their God,

did work in [45\\_ROM\\_07\\_05](#) # For when we were in the flesh, the motions of sins, which were by the law, did work in our members to bring forth fruit unto death.

did work wilily [06\\_JOS\\_09\\_04](#) # They did work wilily, and went and made as if they had been ambassadors, and took old sacks upon their asses, and wine bottles, old, and rent, and bound up;

did worse than [11\\_1KI\\_16\\_25](#) # But Omri wrought evil in the eyes of the LORD, and did worse than all that [were] before him.

did worse than [24\\_JER\\_07\\_26](#) # Yet they hearkened not unto me, nor inclined their ear, but hardened their neck: they did worse than their fathers.

did worship and [06\\_JOS\\_05\\_14](#) # And he said, Nay; but [as] captain of the host of the LORD am I now come. And Joshua fell on his face to the earth, and did worship, and said unto him, What saith my lord unto his servant?

did write Jesus [43\\_JOH\\_01\\_45](#) # Philip findeth Nathanael, and saith unto him, We have found him, of whom Moses in the law, and the prophets, did write, Jesus of Nazareth, the son of Joseph.

did ye at [38\\_ZEC\\_07\\_05](#) # Speak unto all the people of the land, and to the priests, saying, When ye fasted and mourned in the fifth and seventh [month], even those seventy years, did ye at all fast unto me, [even] to me?

did ye despise [10\\_2SA\\_19\\_43](#) # And the men of Israel answered the men of Judah, and said, We have ten parts in the king, and we have also more [right] in David than ye: why then did ye despise us, that our advice should not be first had in bringing back our king? And the words of the men of Judah were fiercer than the words of the men of Israel.

Did ye never [40\\_MAT\\_21\\_42](#) # Jesus saith unto them, Did ye never read in the scriptures, The stone which the builders rejected, the same is become the head of the corner: this is the Lord's doing, and it is marvellous in our eyes?

did ye not [07\\_JUD\\_11\\_26](#) # While Israel dwelt in Heshbon and her towns, and in Aroer and her towns, and in all the cities that [be] along by the coasts of Arnon, three hundred years? why therefore did ye not recover [them] within that time?

did ye not [41\\_MAR\\_11\\_31](#) # And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say, Why then did ye not believe him?

did ye not [40\\_MAT\\_21\\_25](#) # The baptism of John, whence was it? from heaven, or of men? And they reasoned with themselves, saying, If we shall say, From heaven; he will say unto us, Why did ye not then believe him?

did yearn upon [01\\_GEN\\_43\\_30](#) # And Joseph made haste; for his bowels did yearn upon his brother: and he sought [where] to weep; and he entered into [his] chamber, and wept there.

did yet corruptly [14 2CH 27 02](#) # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Uzziah did: howbeit he entered not into the temple of the LORD. And the people did yet corruptly.

did yield fruit [41 MAR 04 08](#) # And other fell on good ground, and did yield fruit that sprang up and increased; and brought forth, some thirty, and some sixty, and some an hundred.

did your fathers [04 NUM 32 08](#) # Thus did your fathers, when I sent them from Kadeshbarnea to see the land.

did Zachariah the [12 2KI 15 08](#) # In the thirty and eighth year of Azariah king of Judah did Zachariah the son of Jeroboam reign over Israel in Samaria six months.

did Zebulun drive [07 JUD 01 30](#) # Neither did Zebulun drive out the inhabitants of Kitron, nor the inhabitants of Nahalol; but the Canaanites dwelt among them, and became tributaries.

did Zimri destroy [11 1KI 16 12](#) # Thus did Zimri destroy all the house of Baasha, according to the word of the LORD, which he spake against Baasha by Jehu the prophet,

did Zimri reign [11 1KI 16 15](#) # In the twenty and seventh year of Asa king of Judah did Zimri reign seven days in Tirzah. And the people [were] encamped against Gibbethon, which [belonged] to the Philistines.

did [14 2CH 26 04](#) # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that his father Amaziah did.

did [12 2KI 14 03](#) # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, yet not like David his father: he did according to all things as Joash his father did.

did [12 2KI 18 03](#) # And he did [that which was] right in the sight of the LORD, according to all that David his father did.

did [12 2KI 21 20](#) # And he did [that which was] evil in the sight of the LORD, as his father Manasseh did.

did [12 2KI 24 03](#) # Surely at the commandment of the LORD came [this] upon Judah, to remove [them] out of his sight, for the sins of Manasseh, according to all that he did;

did [44 ACT 08 06](#) # And the people with one accord gave heed unto those things which Philip spake, hearing and seeing the miracles which he did.

didst thou forbear [16 NEH 09 30](#) # Yet many years didst thou forbear them, and testifiedst against them by thy spirit in thy prophets: yet would they not give ear: therefore gavest thou them into the hand of the

people of the lands.

didst thou get [16 NEH 09 10](#) # And showedst signs and wonders upon Pharaoh, and on all his servants, and on all the people of his land: for thou knewest that they dealt proudly against them. So didst thou get thee a name, as [it is] this day.

didst thou lead [23 ISA 63 14](#) # As a beast goeth down into the valley, the Spirit of the LORD caused him to rest: so didst thou lead thy people, to make thyself a glorious name.

didst thou make [13 1CH 17 22](#) # For thy people Israel didst thou make thine own people for ever; and thou, LORD, becamest their God.

didst thou marvel [66 REV 17 07](#) # And the angel said unto me, Wherefore didst thou marvel? I will tell thee the mystery of the woman, and of the beast that carrieth her, which hath the seven heads and ten horns.

didst thou not [09 ISA 15 19](#) # Wherefore then didst thou not obey the voice of the LORD, but didst fly upon the spoil, and didst evil in the sight of the LORD?

didst thou require [01 GEN 31 39](#) # That which was torn [of beasts] I brought not unto thee; I bare the loss of it; of my hand didst thou require it, [whether] stolen by day, or stolen by night.

didst thou set [10 2SA 19 28](#) # For all [of] my father's house were but dead men before my lord the king: yet didst thou set thy servant among them that did eat at thine own table. What right therefore have I yet to cry any more unto the king?

didst trust in [26 EZE 16 15](#) # But thou didst trust in thine own beauty, and playedst the harlot because of thy renown, and pouredst out thy fornications on every one that passed by; his it was.

didst trust in [28 HOS 10 13](#) # Ye have plowed wickedness, ye have reaped iniquity; ye have eaten the fruit of lies: because thou didst trust in thy way, in the multitude of thy mighty men.

didst unto Jericho [06 JOS 08 02](#) # And thou shalt do to Ai and her king as thou didst unto Jericho and her king: only the spoil thereof, and the cattle thereof, shall ye take for a prey unto yourselves: lay thee an ambush for the city behind it.

didst unto me [10 2SA 13 16](#) # And she said unto him, [There is] no cause: this evil in sending me away [is] greater than the other that thou didst unto me. But he would not hearken unto her.

didst unto Sihon [05 DEU 03 02](#) # And the LORD said unto me, Fear him not: for I will deliver him, and all his people, and his land, into thy hand; and thou shalt do unto him as thou didst unto Sihon king of the Amorites, which dwelt at Heshbon.

didst weaken the [23 ISA 14 12](#) # How art thou fallen from heaven, O Lucifer, son of the morning! [how] art thou cut down to the ground, which didst weaken the nations!

didst well in [14 2CH 06 08](#) # But the LORD said to David my father, Forasmuch as it was in thine heart to build an house for my name, thou didst well in that it was in thine heart:

Hadid and Ono [16 NEH 07 37](#) # The children of Lod, Hadid, and Ono, seven hundred twenty and one.

Hadid Zeboim Neballat [16 NEH 11 34](#) # Hadid, Zeboim, Neballat,

Jedidah the daughter [12 2KI 22 01](#) # Josiah [was] eight years old when he began to reign, and he reigned thirty and one years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name [was] Jedidah, the daughter of Adaiah of Boscath.

Jedidiah because of [10 2SA 12 25](#) # And he sent by the hand of Nathan the prophet; and he called his

**name Jedidiah, because of the LORD.**
