discern between good 11 1KI 03 09# Give therefore thy servant an understanding heart to judge thy people, that I may discern between good and bad: for who is able to judge this thy so great a people?

discern between good 10 2SA 19 35 # I [am] this day fourscore years old: [and] can I discern between good and evil? can thy servant taste what I eat or what I drink? can I hear any more the voice of singing men and singing women? wherefore then should thy servant be yet a burden unto my lord the king?

discern between the 26 EZE 44 23 # And they shall teach my people [the difference] between the holy and profane, and cause them to discern between the unclean and the clean.

discern between the 39 MAL 03 18 # Then shall ye return, and discern between the righteous and the wicked, between him that serveth God and him that serveth him not.

discern between their <u>32_JON_04_11</u># And should not I spare Nineveh, that great city, wherein are more than sixscore thousand persons that cannot discern between their right hand and their left hand; and [also] much cattle?

discern both good 58 HEB 05 14 # But strong meat belongeth to them that are of full age, [even] those who by reason of use have their senses exercised to discern both good and evil.

discern good and 10 2SA 14 17 # Then thine handmaid said, The word of my lord the king shall now be comfortable: for as an angel of God, so [is] my lord the king to discern good and bad: therefore the LORD thy God will be with thee.

Discern I pray 01 GEN 38 25 # When she [was] brought forth, she sent to her father in law, saying, By the man, whose these [are, am] I with child: and she said, Discern, I pray thee, whose [are] these, the signet, and bracelets, and staff.

discern judgment 11 1KI 03 11# And God said unto him, Because thou hast asked this thing, and hast not asked for thyself long life; neither hast asked riches for thyself, nor hast asked the life of thine enemies; but hast asked for thyself understanding to discern judgment;

discern perverse things 18 JOB 06 30 # Is there iniquity in my tongue? cannot my taste discern perverse things?

discern the face 42 LUK 12 56# [Ye] hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky and of the earth; but how is it that ye do not discern this time?

discern the face 40 MAT 16 03# And in the morning, [It will be] foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowering. O [ye] hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not [discern] the signs of the times?

discern the form 18 JOB 04 16 # It stood still, but I could not discern the form thereof: an image [was] before mine eyes, [there was] silence, and I heard a voice, [saying],

discern the noise 15 EZR 03 13 # So that the people could not discern the noise of the shout of joy from the noise of the weeping of the people: for the people shouted with a loud shout, and the noise was heard afar off.

discern the signs 40 MAT 16 03 # And in the morning, [It will be] foul weather to day: for the sky is red and lowering. O [ye] hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky; but can ye not [discern] the signs of the times?

discern this time 42 LUK 12 56 # [Ye] hypocrites, ye can discern the face of the sky and of the earth; but how is it that ye do not discern this time?

discern thou what 01 GEN 31 32 # With whomsoever thou findest thy gods, let him not live: before our brethren discern thou what [is] thine with me, and take [it] to thee. For Jacob knew not that Rachel had stolen them.

discerned among the 20 PRO 07 07 # And beheld among the simple ones, I discerned among the youths, a young man void of understanding,

discerned him not 01 GEN 27 23 # And he discerned him not, because his hands were hairy, as his brother Esau's hands: so he blessed him.

discerned him that 11 1KI 20 41 # And he hasted, and took the ashes away from his face; and the king of Israel discerned him that he [was] of the prophets.

discerned 46 1CO 02 14 # But the natural man receiveth not the things of the Spirit of God: for they are foolishness unto him: neither can he know [them], because they are spiritually discerned.

discerner of the 58 HEB 04 12 # For the word of God [is] quick, and powerful, and sharper than any twoedged sword, piercing even to the dividing asunder of soul and spirit, and of the joints and marrow, and [is] a discerner of the thoughts and intents of the heart.

discerneth both time 21 ECC 08 05 # Whoso keepeth the commandment shall feel no evil thing: and a wise man's heart discerneth both time and judgment.

discerning of spirits 46 1CO 12 10 # To another the working of miracles; to another prophecy; to another discerning of spirits; to another [divers] kinds of tongues; to another the interpretation of tongues:

discerning the Lord's 46 1CO 11 29 # For he that eateth and drinketh unworthily, eateth and drinketh damnation to himself, not discerning the Lord's body.
