brandish my sword [26 EZE 32 10](#) # Yea, I will make many people amazed at thee, and their kings shall be horribly afraid for thee, when I shall brandish my sword before them; and they shall tremble at [every] moment, every man for his own life, in the day of thy fall.

childish things [46 1CO 13 11](#) # When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.

dish the same [40 MAT 26 23](#) # And he answered and said, He that dippeth [his] hand with me in the dish, the same shall betray me.

dish wiping it [12 2KI 21 13](#) # And I will stretch over Jerusalem the line of Samaria, and the plummet of the house of Ahab: and I will wipe Jerusalem as [a man] wipeth a dish, wiping [it], and turning [it] upside down.

dish [07 JUD 05 25](#) # He asked water, [and] she gave [him] milk; she brought forth butter in a lordly dish.

dish [41 MAR 14 20](#) # And he answered and said unto them, [It is] one of the twelve, that dippeth with me in the dish.

Dishan are these [01 GEN 36 28](#) # The children of Dishan [are] these; Uz, and Aran.

Dishan these are [01 GEN 36 21](#) # And Dishon, and Ezer, and Dishan: these [are] the dukes of the Horites, the children of Seir in the land of Edom.

Dishan these are [01 GEN 36 30](#) # Duke Dishon, duke Ezer, duke Dishan: these [are] the dukes [that came] of Hori, among their dukes in the land of Seir.

Dishan Uz and [13 1CH 01 42](#) # The sons of Ezer; Bilhan, and Zavan, [and] Jakan. The sons of Dishan; Uz, and Aran.

Dishan [13 1CH 01 38](#) # And the sons of Seir; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah, and Dishon, and Ezar, and Dishan.

dishes and his [02 EXO 37 16](#) # And he made the vessels which [were] upon the table, his dishes, and his spoons, and his bowls, and his covers to cover withal, [of] pure gold.

dishes and the [04 NUM 04 07](#) # And upon the table of showbread they shall spread a cloth of blue, and put thereon the dishes, and the spoons, and the bowls, and covers to cover withal: and the continual bread shall be thereon:

dishes thereof and [02 EXO 25 29](#) # And thou shalt make the dishes thereof, and spoons thereof, and covers thereof, and bowls thereof, to cover withal: [of] pure gold shalt thou make them.

Dishon Amram and [13 1CH 01 41](#) # The sons of Anah; Dishon. And the sons of Dishon; Amram, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.

Dishon and Aholibamah [01 GEN 36 25](#) # And the children of Anah [were] these; Dishon, and Aholibamah the daughter of Anah.

Dishon and Ezar [13 1CH 01 38](#) # And the sons of Seir; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah, and Dishon, and Ezar, and Dishan.

Dishon and Ezer [01 GEN 36 21](#) # And Dishon, and Ezer, and Dishan: these [are] the dukes of the Horites, the children of Seir in the land of Edom.

Dishon And the [13 1CH 01 41](#) # The sons of Anah; Dishon. And the sons of Dishon; Amram, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.

Dishon duke Ezer [01 GEN 36 30](#) # Duke Dishon, duke Ezer, duke Dishan: these [are] the dukes [that came] of Hori, among their dukes in the land of Seir.

Dishon Hemdan and [01 GEN 36 26](#) # And these [are] the children of Dishon; Hemdan, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.

dishonest gain which [26 EZE 22 13](#) # Behold, therefore I have smitten mine hand at thy dishonest gain which thou hast made, and at thy blood which hath been in the midst of thee.

dishonest gain [26 EZE 22 27](#) # Her princes in the midst thereof [are] like wolves ravening the prey, to shed blood, [and] to destroy souls, to get dishonest gain.

dishonesty not walking [47 2CO 04 02](#) # But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

dishonour by evil [47 2CO 06 08](#) # By honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and [yet] true;

dishonour it is [46 1CO 15 43](#) # It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

dishonour me [43 JOH 08 49](#) # Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.

dishonour mine adversaries [19 PSA 69 19](#) # Thou hast known my reproach, and my shame, and my dishonour: mine adversaries [are] all before thee.

dishonour shall he [20 PRO 06 33](#) # A wound and dishonour shall he get; and his reproach shall not be wiped away.

dishonour that magnify [19 PSA 35 26](#) # Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonour that magnify [themselves] against me.

dishonour that seek [19 PSA 71 13](#) # Let them be confounded [and] consumed that are adversaries to my soul; let them be covered [with] reproach and dishonour that seek my hurt.

dishonour their own [45 ROM 01 24](#) # Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:

dishonour therefore have [15 EZR 04 14](#) # Now because we have maintenance from [the king's] palace, and it was not meet for us to see the king's dishonour, therefore have we sent and certified the king;

dishonour [55 2TI 02 20](#) # But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.

dishonour [45 ROM 09 21](#) # Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

dishonourest thou God [45 ROM 02 23](#) # Thou that makest thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonourest thou God?

dishonoureth her head [46 1CO 11 05](#) # But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with [her] head uncovered dishonoureth her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven.

dishonoureth his head [46 1CO 11 04](#) # Every man praying or prophesying, having [his] head covered, dishonoureth his head.

dishonoureth the father [33 MIC 07 06](#) # For the son dishonoureth the father, the daughter riseth up against her mother, the daughter in law against her mother in law; a man's enemies [are] the men of his own house.

outlandish women cause [16 NEH 13 26](#) # Did not Solomon king of Israel sin by these things? yet among many nations was there no king like him, who was beloved of his God, and God made him king over all Israel: nevertheless even him did outlandish women cause to sin.

reddish and it [03 LEV 13 19](#) # And in the place of the boil there be a white rising, or a bright spot, white, and somewhat reddish, and it be showed to the priest;

reddish in his [03 LEV 13 43](#) # Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, [if] the rising of the sore [be] white reddish in his bald head, or in his bald forehead, as the leprosy appeareth in the skin of the flesh;

reddish in the [03 LEV 13 49](#) # And if the plague be greenish or reddish in the garment, or in the skin, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in any thing of skin; it [is] a plague of leprosy, and shall be showed unto the priest:

reddish or white [03 LEV 13 24](#) # Or if there be [any] flesh, in the skin whereof [there is] a hot burning, and the quick [flesh] that burneth have a white bright spot, somewhat reddish, or white;

reddish sore it [03 LEV 13 42](#) # And if there be in the bald head, or bald forehead, a white reddish sore; it [is] a leprosy sprung up in his bald head, or his bald forehead.

reddish which in [03 LEV 14 37](#) # And he shall look on the plague, and, behold, [if] the plague [be] in the walls of the house with hollow streaks, greenish or reddish, which in sight [are] lower than the wall;

snuffdishes and all [04 NUM 04 09](#) # And they shall take a cloth of blue, and cover the candlestick of the light, and his lamps, and his tongs, and his snuffdishes, and all the oil vessels thereof, wherewith they minister unto it:

snuffdishes of pure [02 EXO 37 23](#) # And he made his seven lamps, and his snuffers, and his snuffdishes, [of] pure gold.

snuffdishes thereof shall [02 EXO 25 38](#) # And the tongs thereof, and the snuffdishes thereof, [shall be of] pure gold.
