brandish my sword <u>26_EZE_32_10</u> # Yea, I will make many people amazed at thee, and their kings shall be horribly afraid for thee, when I shall brandish my sword before them; and they shall tremble at [every] moment, every man for his own life, in the day of thy fall.

childish things 46_1CO_13_11# When I was a child, I spake as a child, I understood as a child, I thought as a child: but when I became a man, I put away childish things.

dish the same 40_MAT_26_23# And he answered and said, He that dippeth [his] hand with me in the dish, the same shall betray me.

dish wiping it 12_2KI_21_13 # And I will stretch over Jerusalem the line of Samaria, and the plummet of the house of Ahab: and I will wipe Jerusalem as [a man] wipeth a dish, wiping [it], and turning [it] upside down.

dish <u>07_JUD_05_25</u> # He asked water, [and] she gave [him] milk; she brought forth butter in a lordly dish.

dish <u>41_MAR_14_20</u># And he answered and said unto them, [It is] one of the twelve, that dippeth with me in the dish.

Dishan are these <u>01_GEN_36_28</u> # The children of Dishan [are] these; Uz, and Aran.

Dishan these are <u>01_GEN_36_21</u># And Dishon, and Ezer, and Dishan: these [are] the dukes of the Horites, the children of Seir in the land of Edom.

Dishan these are <u>01_GEN_36_30</u># Duke Dishon, duke Ezer, duke Dishan: these [are] the dukes [that came] of Hori, among their dukes in the land of Seir.

Dishan Uz and 13_1CH_01_42 # The sons of Ezer; Bilhan, and Zavan, [and] Jakan. The sons of Dishan; Uz, and Aran.

Dishan <u>13_1CH_01_38</u># And the sons of Seir; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah, and Dishon, and Ezar, and Dishan.

dishes and his <u>02_EXO_37_16</u># And he made the vessels which [were] upon the table, his dishes, and his spoons, and his bowls, and his covers to cover withal, [of] pure gold.

dishes and the <u>04_NUM_04_07</u># And upon the table of showbread they shall spread a cloth of blue, and put thereon the dishes, and the spoons, and the bowls, and covers to cover withal: and the continual bread shall be thereon:

dishes thereof and <u>02_EXO_25_29</u> # And thou shalt make the dishes thereof, and spoons thereof, and covers thereof, and bowls thereof, to cover withal: [of] pure gold shalt thou make them.

Dishon Amram and 13_1CH_01_41 # The sons of Anah; Dishon. And the sons of Dishon; Amram, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.

Dishon and Aholibamah <u>01_GEN_36_25</u># And the children of Anah [were] these; Dishon, and Aholibamah the daughter of Anah.

Dishon and Ezar 13_1CH_01_38 # And the sons of Seir; Lotan, and Shobal, and Zibeon, and Anah, and Dishon, and Ezar, and Dishan.

Dishon and Ezer <u>01_GEN_36_21</u> # And Dishon, and Ezer, and Dishan: these [are] the dukes of the Horites, the children of Seir in the land of Edom.

Dishon And the 13_1CH_01_41 # The sons of Anah; Dishon. And the sons of Dishon; Amram, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.

Dishon duke Ezer <u>01_GEN_36_30</u> # Duke Dishon, duke Ezer, duke Dishan: these [are] the dukes [that came] of Hori, among their dukes in the land of Seir.

Dishon Hemdan and <u>01_GEN_36_26</u># And these [are] the children of Dishon; Hemdan, and Eshban, and Ithran, and Cheran.

dishonest gain which <u>26_EZE_22_13</u># Behold, therefore I have smitten mine hand at thy dishonest gain which thou hast made, and at thy blood which hath been in the midst of thee.

dishonest gain <u>26_EZE_22_27</u> # Her princes in the midst thereof [are] like wolves ravening the prey, to shed blood, [and] to destroy souls, to get dishonest gain.

dishonesty not walking <u>47_2CO_04_02</u> # But have renounced the hidden things of dishonesty, not walking in craftiness, nor handling the word of God deceitfully; but by manifestation of the truth commending ourselves to every man's conscience in the sight of God.

dishonour by evil <u>47_2CO_06_08</u> # By honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and [yet] true;

dishonour it is <u>46_1CO_15_43</u># It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

dishonour me <u>43_JOH_08_49</u> # Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.

dishonour mine adversaries 19_PSA_69_19 # Thou hast known my reproach, and my shame, and my dishonour: mine adversaries [are] all before thee.

dishonour shall he <u>20_PRO_06_33</u># A wound and dishonour shall he get; and his reproach shall not be wiped away.

dishonour that magnify 19_PSA_35_26 # Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonour that magnify [themselves] against me.

dishonour that seek <u>19_PSA_71_13</u> # Let them be confounded [and] consumed that are adversaries to my soul; let them be covered [with] reproach and dishonour that seek my hurt.

dishonour their own <u>45_ROM_01_24</u> # Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:

dishonour therefore have <u>15_EZR_04_14</u># Now because we have maintenance from [the king's] palace, and it was not meet for us to see the king's dishonour, therefore have we sent and certified the king;

dishonour <u>55_2TI_02_20</u> # But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.

dishonour <u>45_ROM_09_21</u># Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

dishonourest thou God <u>45_ROM_02_23</u> # Thou that makest thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonourest thou God?

dishonoureth her head <u>46_1CO_11_05</u># But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with [her] head uncovered dishonoureth her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven.

dishonoureth his head <u>46_1CO_11_04</u># Every man praying or prophesying, having [his] head covered, dishonoureth his head.

dishonoureth the father <u>33_MIC_07_06</u># For the son dishonoureth the father, the daughter riseth up against her mother, the daughter in law against her mother in law; a man's enemies [are] the men of his own house.

outlandish women cause <u>16_NEH_13_26</u># Did not Solomon king of Israel sin by these things? yet among many nations was there no king like him, who was beloved of his God, and God made him king over all Israel: nevertheless even him did outlandish women cause to sin.

reddish and it <u>03_LEV_13_19</u># And in the place of the boil there be a white rising, or a bright spot, white, and somewhat reddish, and it be showed to the priest;

reddish in his <u>03_LEV_13_43</u># Then the priest shall look upon it: and, behold, [if] the rising of the sore [be] white reddish in his bald head, or in his bald forehead, as the leprosy appeareth in the skin of the flesh;

reddish in the <u>03_LEV_13_49</u># And if the plague be greenish or reddish in the garment, or in the skin, either in the warp, or in the woof, or in any thing of skin; it [is] a plague of leprosy, and shall be showed unto the priest:

reddish or white <u>03_LEV_13_24</u> # Or if there be [any] flesh, in the skin whereof [there is] a hot burning, and the quick [flesh] that burneth have a white bright spot, somewhat reddish, or white;

reddish sore it <u>03_LEV_13_42</u> # And if there be in the bald head, or bald forehead, a white reddish sore; it [is] a leprosy sprung up in his bald head, or his bald forehead.

reddish which in <u>03_LEV_14_37</u> # And he shall look on the plague, and, behold, [if] the plague [be] in the walls of the house with hollow streaks, greenish or reddish, which in sight [are] lower than the wall;

snuffdishes and all <u>04_NUM_04_09</u># And they shall take a cloth of blue, and cover the candlestick of the light, and his lamps, and his tongs, and his snuffdishes, and all the oil vessels thereof, wherewith they minister unto it:

snuffdishes of pure <u>02_EXO_37_23</u># And he made his seven lamps, and his snuffers, and his snuffdishes, [of] pure gold.

snuffdishes thereof shall <u>02_EXO_25_38</u> # And the tongs thereof, and the snuffdishes thereof, [shall be of] pure gold.
