dishonour by evil [47_2CO_06_08](#) # By honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and [yet] true;

dishonour it is [46_1CO_15_43](#) # It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

dishonour me [43_JOH_08_49](#) # Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.

dishonour mine adversaries [19_PSA_69_19](#) # Thou hast known my reproach, and my shame, and my dishonour: mine adversaries [are] all before thee.

dishonour shall he [20_PRO_06_33](#) # A wound and dishonour shall he get; and his reproach shall not be wiped away.

dishonour that magnify [19_PSA_35_26](#) # Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonour that magnify [themselves] against me.
