dishonour by evil <u>47_2CO_06_08</u> # By honour and dishonour, by evil report and good report: as deceivers, and [yet] true;

dishonour it is <u>46_1CO_15_43</u> # It is sown in dishonour; it is raised in glory: it is sown in weakness; it is raised in power:

dishonour me <u>43_JOH_08_49</u> # Jesus answered, I have not a devil; but I honour my Father, and ye do dishonour me.

dishonour mine adversaries 19_PSA_69_19 # Thou hast known my reproach, and my shame, and my dishonour: mine adversaries [are] all before thee.

dishonour shall he <u>20_PRO_06_33</u># A wound and dishonour shall he get; and his reproach shall not be wiped away.

dishonour that magnify 19_PSA_35_26 # Let them be ashamed and brought to confusion together that rejoice at mine hurt: let them be clothed with shame and dishonour that magnify [themselves] against me.

dishonour that seek 19_PSA_71_13 # Let them be confounded [and] consumed that are adversaries to my soul; let them be covered [with] reproach and dishonour that seek my hurt.

dishonour their own <u>45_ROM_01_24</u> # Wherefore God also gave them up to uncleanness through the lusts of their own hearts, to dishonour their own bodies between themselves:

dishonour therefore have <u>15_EZR_04_14</u> # Now because we have maintenance from [the king's] palace, and it was not meet for us to see the king's dishonour, therefore have we sent and certified the king;

dishonour <u>55_2TI_02_20</u> # But in a great house there are not only vessels of gold and of silver, but also of wood and of earth; and some to honour, and some to dishonour.

dishonour <u>45_ROM_09_21</u># Hath not the potter power over the clay, of the same lump to make one vessel unto honour, and another unto dishonour?

dishonourest thou God <u>45_ROM_02_23</u> # Thou that makest thy boast of the law, through breaking the law dishonourest thou God?

dishonoureth her head <u>46_1CO_11_05</u># But every woman that prayeth or prophesieth with [her] head uncovered dishonoureth her head: for that is even all one as if she were shaven.

dishonoureth his head <u>46_1CO_11_04</u># Every man praying or prophesying, having [his] head covered, dishonoureth his head.

dishonoureth the father <u>33_MIC_07_06</u># For the son dishonoureth the father, the daughter riseth up against her mother, the daughter in law against her mother in law; a man's enemies [are] the men of his own house.
