dispersed abroad he [47_2CO_09_09](#) # [As it is written, He hath dispersed abroad; he hath given to the poor: his righteousness remaineth for ever.

dispersed among the [17_EST_03_08](#) # And Haman said unto king Ahasuerus, There is a certain people scattered abroad and dispersed among the people in all the provinces of thy kingdom; and their laws [are] diverse from all people; neither keep they the king's laws: therefore it [is] not for the king's profit to suffer them.
