disquiet the inhabitants <u>24_JER_50_34</u># Their Redeemer [is] strong; the LORD of hosts [is] his name: he shall thoroughly plead their cause, that he may give rest to the land, and disquiet the inhabitants of Babylon.

disquieted and for <u>20_PRO_30_21</u># For three [things] the earth is disquieted, and for four [which] it cannot bear:

disquieted in me <u>19_PSA_42_05</u># Why art thou cast down, O my soul? and [why] art thou disquieted in me? hope thou in God: for I shall yet praise him [for] the help of his countenance.
