distress a day <u>36_ZEP_01_15</u># That day [is] a day of wrath, a day of trouble and distress, a day of wasteness and desolation, a day of darkness and gloominess, a day of clouds and thick darkness,

distress a refuge 23_ISA_25_04 # For thou hast been a strength to the poor, a strength to the needy in his distress, a refuge from the storm, a shadow from the heat, when the blast of the terrible ones [is] as a storm [against] the wall.

distress and anguish <u>20_PRO_01_27</u> # When your fear cometh as desolation, and your destruction cometh as a whirlwind; when distress and anguish cometh upon you.

distress and every <u>09_1SA_22_02</u># And every one [that was] in distress, and every one that [was] in debt, and every one [that was] discontented, gathered themselves unto him; and he became a captain over them: and there were with him about four hundred men.

distress and was <u>01_GEN_35_03</u># And let us arise, and go up to Bethel; and I will make there an altar unto God, who answered me in the day of my distress, and was with me in the way which I went.

distress Ariel and 23_ISA_29_02 # Yet I will distress Ariel, and there shall be heaviness and sorrow: and it shall be unto me as Ariel.

distress by your <u>52_1TH_03_07</u># Therefore, brethren, we were comforted over you in all our affliction and distress by your faith:

distress come upon $01_{GEN_42_21}$ # And they said one to another, We [are] verily guilty concerning our brother, in that we saw the anguish of his soul, when he besought us, and we would not hear; therefore is this distress come upon us.

distress did he <u>14_2CH_28_22</u> # And in the time of his distress did he trespass yet more against the LORD: this [is that] king Ahaz.

distress have mercy 19_PSA_04_01 # To the chief Musician on Neginoth, A Psalm of David. Hear me when I call, O God of my righteousness: thou hast enlarged me [when I was] in distress; have mercy upon me, and hear my prayer.

distress her shall <u>23_ISA_29_07</u> # And the multitude of all the nations that fight against Ariel, even all that fight against her and her munition, and that distress her, shall be as a dream of a night vision.

distress I called <u>10_2SA_22_07</u> # In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried to my God: and he did hear my voice out of his temple, and my cry [did enter] into his ears.

distress I called <u>19_PSA_18_06</u># In my distress I called upon the LORD, and cried unto my God: he heard my voice out of his temple, and my cry came before him, [even] into his ears.

distress I cried 19_PSA_120_01 # A Song of degrees. In my distress I cried unto the LORD, and he heard me.

distress I say <u>46_1CO_07_26</u> # I suppose therefore that this is good for the present distress, [I say], that [it is] good for a man so to be.

distress in the <u>42_LUK_21_23</u> # But woe unto them that are with child, and to them that give suck, in those days! for there shall be great distress in the land, and wrath upon this people.

distress my bowels <u>25_LAM_01_20</u># Behold, O LORD; for I [am] in distress: my bowels are troubled; mine heart is turned within me; for I have grievously rebelled: abroad the sword bereaveth, at home [there is] as death.

Distress not the <u>05_DEU_02_09</u> # And the LORD said unto me, Distress not the Moabites, neither contend with them in battle: for I will not give thee of their land [for] a possession; because I have given Ar unto the children of Lot [for] a possession.

distress of nations 42 LUK 21 25 # And there shall be signs in the sun, and in the moon, and in the stars; and upon the earth distress of nations, with perplexity; the sea and the waves roaring;

distress or persecution 45_ROM_08_35 # Who shall separate us from the love of Christ? [shall] tribulation, or distress, or persecution, or famine, or nakedness, or peril, or sword?

distress that we <u>16_NEH_02_17</u> # Then said I unto them, Ye see the distress that we [are] in, how Jerusalem [lieth] waste, and the gates thereof are burned with fire: come, and let us build up the wall of Jerusalem, that we be no more a reproach.

distress the LORD 19_PSA_118_05 # I called upon the LORD in distress: the LORD answered me, [and set me] in a large place.

distress thee in <u>05_DEU_28_55</u># So that he will not give to any of them of the flesh of his children whom he shall eat: because he hath nothing left him in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee in all thy gates.

distress thee in <u>05_DEU_28_57</u># And toward her young one that cometh out from between her feet, and toward her children which she shall bear: for she shall eat them for want of all [things] secretly in the siege and straitness, wherewith thine enemy shall distress thee in thy gates.

distress thee <u>05_DEU_28_53</u># And thou shalt eat the fruit of thine own body, the flesh of thy sons and of thy daughters, which the LORD thy God hath given thee, in the siege, and in the straitness, wherewith thine enemies shall distress thee:

distress them not <u>05 DEU 02_19</u> # And [when] thou comest nigh over against the children of Ammon, distress them not, nor meddle with them: for I will not give thee of the land of the children of Ammon [any] possession; because I have given it unto the children of Lot [for] a possession.

distress them that 24_JER_10_18 # For thus saith the LORD, Behold, I will sling out the inhabitants of the land at this once, and will distress them, that they may find [it so].

distress upon men <u>36_ZEP_01_17</u># And I will bring distress upon men, that they shall walk like blind men, because they have sinned against the LORD: and their blood shall be poured out as dust, and their flesh as the dung.

distress 11_1KI_01_29 # And the king sware, and said, [As] the LORD liveth, that hath redeemed my soul out of all distress,

distress <u>07_JUD_11_07</u> # And Jephthah said unto the elders of Gilead, Did not ye hate me, and expel me out of my father's house? and why are ye come unto me now when ye are in distress?

distress 16_NEH_09_37 # And it yieldeth much increase unto the kings whom thou hast set over us because

of our sins: also they have dominion over our bodies, and over our cattle, at their pleasure, and we [are] in great distress.

distress 31_OBA_01_12 # But thou shouldest not have looked on the day of thy brother in the day that he became a stranger; neither shouldest thou have rejoiced over the children of Judah in the day of their destruction; neither shouldest thou have spoken proudly in the day of distress.

distress 31_OBA_01_14 # Neither shouldest thou have stood in the crossway, to cut off those of his that did escape; neither shouldest thou have delivered up those of his that did remain in the day of distress.

distressed and he <u>01_GEN_32_07</u># Then Jacob was greatly afraid and distressed: and he divided the people that [was] with him, and the flocks, and herds, and the camels, into two bands;

distressed because of <u>04_NUM_22_03</u># And Moab was sore afraid of the people, because they [were] many: and Moab was distressed because of the children of Israel.

distressed for the <u>09_1SA_28_15</u># And Samuel said to Saul, Why hast thou disquieted me, to bring me up? And Saul answered, I am sore distressed; for the Philistines make war against me, and God is departed from me, and answereth me no more, neither by prophets, nor by dreams: therefore I have called thee, that thou mayest make known unto me what I shall do.

distressed for the <u>09_1SA_30_06</u># And David was greatly distressed; for the people spake of stoning him, because the soul of all the people was grieved, every man for his sons and for his daughters: but David encouraged himself in the LORD his God.

distressed for thee <u>10_2SA_01_26</u> # I am distressed for thee, my brother Jonathan: very pleasant hast thou been unto me: thy love to me was wonderful, passing the love of women.

distressed him but $\underline{14_2CH_28_20}$ # And Tilgathpilneser king of Assyria came unto him, and distressed him, but strengthened him not.

distressed that day <u>09_1SA_14_24</u># And the men of Israel were distressed that day: for Saul had adjured the people, saying, Cursed [be] the man that eateth [any] food until evening, that I may be avenged on mine enemies. So none of the people tasted [any] food.

distressed then the <u>09_1SA_13_06</u># When the men of Israel saw that they were in a strait, [for the people were distressed,] then the people did hide themselves in caves, and in thickets, and in rocks, and in high places, and in pits.

distressed we are <u>47_2CO_04_08</u> # [We are] troubled on every side, yet not distressed; [we are] perplexed, but not in despair;

distressed <u>07_JUD_02_15</u> # Whithersoever they went out, the hand of the LORD was against them for evil, as the LORD had said, and as the LORD had sworn unto them: and they were greatly distressed.

distressed <u>07_JUD_10_09</u> # Moreover the children of Ammon passed over Jordan to fight also against Judah, and against Benjamin, and against the house of Ephraim; so that Israel was sore distressed.

distresses daily <u>26_EZE_30_16</u> # And I will set fire in Egypt: Sin shall have great pain, and No shall be rent asunder, and Noph [shall have] distresses daily.

distresses for Christ's <u>47_2CO_12_10</u> # Therefore I take pleasure in infirmities, in reproaches, in necessities, in persecutions, in distresses for Christ's sake: for when I am weak, then am I strong.

distresses 47_2CO_06_04 # But in all [things] approving ourselves as the ministers of God, in much

patience, in afflictions, in necessities, in distresses,

distresses 19_PSA_107_06 # Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, [and] he delivered them out of their distresses.

distresses 19_PSA_107_13 # Then they cried unto the LORD in their trouble, [and] he saved them out of their distresses.

distresses 19_PSA_107_19 # Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, [and] he saveth them out of their distresses.

distresses 19_PSA_107_28 # Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he bringeth them out of their distresses.

distresses 19_PSA_25_17 # The troubles of my heart are enlarged: [O] bring thou me out of my distresses.
