

## KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

dove and it <u>43\_JOH\_01\_32</u># And John bare record, saying, I saw the Spirit descending from heaven like a dove, and it abode upon him.

dove and lighting 40\_MAT\_03\_16# And Jesus, when he was baptized, went up straightway out of the water: and, lo, the heavens were opened unto him, and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove, and lighting upon him:

dove came in <u>01\_GEN\_08\_11</u># And the dove came in to him in the evening; and, lo, in her mouth [was] an olive leaf plucked off: so Noah knew that the waters were abated from off the earth.

dove covered with 19 PSA 68 13 # Though ye have lien among the pots, [yet shall ye be as] the wings of a dove covered with silver, and her feathers with yellow gold.

dove descending upon 41\_MAR\_01\_10 # And straightway coming up out of the water, he saw the heavens opened, and the Spirit like a dove descending upon him:

dove for then 19\_PSA\_55\_06 # And I said, Oh that I had wings like a dove! [for then] would I fly away, and be at rest.

dove found no <u>01\_GEN\_08\_09</u># But the dove found no rest for the sole of her foot, and she returned unto him into the ark, for the waters [were] on the face of the whole earth: then he put forth his hand, and took her, and pulled her in unto him into the ark.

dove from him <u>01\_GEN\_08\_08</u># Also he sent forth a dove from him, to see if the waters were abated from off the face of the ground;

dove mine eyes 23\_ISA\_38\_14 # Like a crane [or] a swallow, so did I chatter: I did mourn as a dove: mine eyes fail [with looking] upward: O LORD, I am oppressed; undertake for me.

dove my undefiled 22\_SON\_05\_02\_# I sleep, but my heart waketh: [it is] the voice of my beloved that knocketh, [saying], Open to me, my sister, my love, my dove, my undefiled: for my head is filled with dew, [and] my locks with the drops of the night.

dove my undefiled <u>22\_SON\_06\_09</u> # My dove, my undefiled is [but] one; she [is] the [only] one of her mother, she [is] the choice [one] of her that bare her. The daughters saw her, and blessed her; [yea], the queens and the concubines, and they praised her.

dove out of <u>01\_GEN\_08\_10</u> # And he stayed yet other seven days; and again he sent forth the dove out of the ark;

dove that art 22\_SON\_02\_14 # O my dove, [that art] in the clefts of the rock, in the secret [places] of the stairs, let me see thy countenance, let me hear thy voice; for sweet [is] thy voice, and thy countenance [is]

comely.

dove that maketh <u>24\_JER\_48\_28</u> # O ye that dwell in Moab, leave the cities, and dwell in the rock, and be like the dove [that] maketh her nest in the sides of the hole's mouth.

dove upon him <u>42\_LUK\_03\_22</u> # And the Holy Ghost descended in a bodily shape like a dove upon him, and a voice came from heaven, which said, Thou art my beloved Son; in thee I am well pleased.

dove which returned <u>01\_GEN\_08\_12</u> # And he stayed yet other seven days; and sent forth the dove; which returned not again unto him any more.

dove without heart <u>28\_HOS\_07\_11</u># Ephraim also is like a silly dove without heart: they call to Egypt, they go to Assyria.

dove's dung for 12\_2KI\_06\_25\_# And there was a great famine in Samaria: and, behold, they besieged it, until an ass's head was [sold] for fourscore [pieces] of silver, and the fourth part of a cab of dove's dung for five [pieces] of silver.

doves and the <u>43\_JOH\_02\_14</u># And found in the temple those that sold oxen and sheep and doves, and the changers of money sitting:

doves by the <u>22\_SON\_05\_12</u> # His eyes [are] as [the eyes] of doves by the rivers of waters, washed with milk, [and] fitly set.

doves eyes within 22\_SON\_04\_01 # Behold, thou [art] fair, my love; behold, thou [art] fair; thou [hast] doves' eyes within thy locks: thy hair [is] as a flock of goats, that appear from mount Gilead.

doves eyes 22\_SON\_01\_15 # Behold, thou [art] fair, my love; behold, thou [art] fair; thou [hast] doves' eyes.

doves of the <u>26\_EZE\_07\_16</u># But they that escape of them shall escape, and shall be on the mountains like doves of the valleys, all of them mourning, every one for his iniquity.

doves tabering upon 34\_NAH\_02\_07 # And Huzzab shall be led away captive, she shall be brought up, and her maids shall lead [her] as with the voice of doves, tabering upon their breasts.

doves Take these <u>43\_JOH\_02\_16</u># And said unto them that sold doves, Take these things hence; make not my Father's house an house of merchandise.

doves to their 23\_ISA\_60\_08 # Who [are] these [that] fly as a cloud, and as the doves to their windows?

doves we look <u>23\_ISA\_59\_11</u> # We roar all like bears, and mourn sore like doves: we look for judgment, but [there is] none; for salvation, [but] it is far off from us.

doves <u>41\_MAR\_11\_15</u># And they come to Jerusalem: and Jesus went into the temple, and began to cast out them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves;

doves <u>40\_MAT\_10\_16</u># Behold, I send you forth as sheep in the midst of wolves: be ye therefore wise as serpents, and harmless as doves.

doves <u>40\_MAT\_21\_12</u># And Jesus went into the temple of God, and cast out all them that sold and bought in the temple, and overthrew the tables of the moneychangers, and the seats of them that sold doves,

turtledove and a <u>01\_GEN\_15\_09</u># And he said unto him, Take me an heifer of three years old, and a she goat of three years old, and a ram of three years old, and a turtledove, and a young pigeon.

turtledove for a <u>03\_LEV\_12\_06</u># And when the days of her purifying are fulfilled, for a son, or for a daughter, she shall bring a lamb of the first year for a burnt offering, and a young pigeon, or a turtledove, for a sin offering, unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, unto the priest:

turtledove unto the <u>19\_PSA\_74\_19</u> # O deliver not the soul of thy turtledove unto the multitude [of the wicked]: forget not the congregation of thy poor for ever.

turtledoves or of <u>03\_LEV\_01\_14</u># And if the burnt sacrifice for his offering to the LORD [be] of fowls, then he shall bring his offering of turtledoves, or of young pigeons.

turtledoves or of <u>03\_LEV\_14\_30</u># And he shall offer the one of the turtledoves, or of the young pigeons, such as he can get;

turtledoves or two <u>03\_LEV\_05\_07</u> # And if he be not able to bring a lamb, then he shall bring for his trespass, which he hath committed, two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, unto the LORD; one for a sin offering, and the other for a burnt offering.

turtledoves or two <u>03 LEV\_05\_11</u># But if he be not able to bring two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, then he that sinned shall bring for his offering the tenth part of an ephah of fine flour for a sin offering; he shall put no oil upon it, neither shall he put [any] frankincense thereon: for it [is] a sin offering.

turtledoves or two <u>03\_LEV\_14\_22</u># And two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, such as he is able to get; and the one shall be a sin offering, and the other a burnt offering.

turtledoves or two <u>03\_LEV\_15\_14</u># And on the eighth day he shall take to him two turtledoves, or two young pigeons, and come before the LORD unto the door of the tabernacle of the congregation, and give them unto the priest:

turtledoves or two <u>42\_LUK\_02\_24</u># And to offer a sacrifice according to that which is said in the law of the Lord, A pair of turtledoves, or two young pigeons.
