drunk and at <u>10\_2SA\_11\_13</u># And when David had called him, he did eat and drink before him; and he made him drunk: and at even he went out to lie on his bed with the servants of his lord, but went not down to his house.

drunk and his <u>08\_RUT\_03\_07</u> # And when Boaz had eaten and drunk, and his heart was merry, he went to lie down at the end of the heap of corn: and she came softly, and uncovered his feet, and laid her down.

drunk any water <u>09\_1SA\_30\_12</u> # And they gave him a piece of a cake of figs, and two clusters of raisins: and when he had eaten, his spirit came again to him: for he had eaten no bread, nor drunk [any] water, three days and three nights.

drunk at the <u>23\_ISA\_51\_17</u># Awake, awake, stand up, O Jerusalem, which hast drunk at the hand of the LORD the cup of his fury; thou hast drunken the dregs of the cup of trembling, [and] wrung [them] out.

drunk he sent <u>12\_2KI\_06\_23</u># And he prepared great provision for them: and when they had eaten and drunk, he sent them away, and they went to their master. So the bands of Syria came no more into the land of Israel.

drunk her princes 24\_JER\_51\_57 # And I will make drunk her princes, and her wise [men], her captains, and her rulers, and her mighty men: and they shall sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, saith the King, whose name [is] the LORD of hosts.

drunk his spirit <u>07\_JUD\_15\_19</u> # But God clave an hollow place that [was] in the jaw, and there came water thereout; and when he had drunk, his spirit came again, and he revived: wherefore he called the name thereof Enhakkore, which [is] in Lehi unto this day.

drunk in every <u>03\_LEV\_11\_34</u># Of all meat which may be eaten, [that] on which [such] water cometh shall be unclean: and all drink that may be drunk in every [such] vessel shall be unclean.

drunk in my <u>23\_ISA\_63\_06</u> # And I will tread down the people in mine anger, and make them drunk in my fury, and I will bring down their strength to the earth.

drunk in the <u>11\_1KI\_16\_09</u># And his servant Zimri, captain of half [his] chariots, conspired against him, as he was in Tirzah, drinking himself drunk in the house of Arza steward of [his] house in Tirzah.

drunk in the <u>11\_1KI\_20\_16</u># And they went out at noon. But Benhadad [was] drinking himself drunk in the pavilions, he and the kings, the thirty and two kings that helped him.

drunk in thy <u>42\_LUK\_13\_26</u># Then shall ye begin to say, We have eaten and drunk in thy presence, and thou hast taught in our streets.

drunk my wine <u>22\_SON\_05\_01</u># I am come into my garden, my sister, [my] spouse: I have gathered my myrrh with my spice; I have eaten my honeycomb with my honey; I have drunk my wine with my milk: eat, O friends; drink, yea, drink abundantly, O beloved.

drunk neither wine <u>09\_1SA\_01\_15</u> # And Hannah answered and said, No, my lord, I [am] a woman of a sorrowful spirit: I have drunk neither wine nor strong drink, but have poured out my soul before the LORD.

drunk Now Eli <u>09\_1SA\_01\_09</u># So Hannah rose up after they had eaten in Shiloh, and after they had drunk. Now Eli the priest sat upon a seat by a post of the temple of the LORD.

drunk of the <u>26\_EZE\_34\_18</u> # [Seemeth it] a small thing unto you to have eaten up the good pasture, but ye must tread down with your feet the residue of your pastures? and to have drunk of the deep waters, but ye must foul the residue with your feet?

drunk that he <u>11\_1KI\_13\_23</u># And it came to pass, after he had eaten bread, and after he had drunk, that he saddled for him the ass, [to wit], for the prophet whom he had brought back.

drunk then that <u>43\_JOH\_02\_10</u> # And saith unto him, Every man at the beginning doth set forth good wine; and when men have well drunk, then that which is worse: [but] thou hast kept the good wine until now.

drunk upon my <u>31\_OBA\_01\_16</u># For as ye have drunk upon my holy mountain, [so] shall all the heathen drink continually, yea, they shall drink, and they shall swallow down, and they shall be as though they had not been.

drunk with the <u>66\_REV\_17\_02</u> # With whom the kings of the earth have committed fornication, and the inhabitants of the earth have been made drunk with the wine of her fornication.

drunk with their <u>24\_JER\_46\_10</u> # For this [is] the day of the Lord GOD of hosts, a day of vengeance, that he may avenge him of his adversaries: and the sword shall devour, and it shall be satiate and made drunk with their blood: for the Lord GOD of hosts hath a sacrifice in the north country by the river Euphrates.

drunken man and <u>19\_PSA\_107\_27</u> # They reel to and fro, and stagger like a drunken man, and are at their wit's end.

drunken man staggereth <u>23\_ISA\_19\_14</u> # The LORD hath mingled a perverse spirit in the midst thereof: and they have caused Egypt to err in every work thereof, as a drunken [man] staggereth in his vomit.

drunken man <u>18\_JOB\_12\_25</u># They grope in the dark without light, and he maketh them to stagger like [a] drunken [man].

drunken of her <u>24\_JER\_51\_07</u> # Babylon [hath been] a golden cup in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad.

drunken of my <u>26\_EZE\_39\_19</u># And ye shall eat fat till ye be full, and drink blood till ye be drunken, of my sacrifice which I have sacrificed for you.

drunken our water 25\_LAM\_05\_04 # We have drunken our water for money; our wood is sold unto us.

drunken put away <u>09\_1SA\_01\_14</u># And Eli said unto her, How long wilt thou be drunken? put away thy wine from thee.

drunken that they <u>24\_JER\_51\_39</u># In their heat I will make their feasts, and I will make them drunken, that they may rejoice, and sleep a perpetual sleep, and not wake, saith the LORD.

drunken the dregs 23\_ISA\_51\_17 # Awake, awake, stand up, O Jerusalem, which hast drunk at the hand of

the LORD the cup of his fury; thou hast drunken the dregs of the cup of trembling, [and] wrung [them] out.

drunken the nations <u>24\_JER\_51\_07</u># Babylon [hath been] a golden cup in the LORD'S hand, that made all the earth drunken: the nations have drunken of her wine; therefore the nations are mad.

drunken thou shalt <u>34\_NAH\_03\_11</u># Thou also shalt be drunken: thou shalt be hid, thou also shalt seek strength because of the enemy.

drunken wherefore she <u>09\_1SA\_25\_36</u> # And Abigail came to Nabal; and, behold, he held a feast in his house, like the feast of a king; and Nabal's heart [was] merry within him, for he [was] very drunken: wherefore she told him nothing, less or more, until the morning light.

drunken with the <u>66\_REV\_17\_06</u> # And I saw the woman drunken with the blood of the saints, and with the blood of the martyrs of Jesus: and when I saw her, I wondered with great admiration.

drunken with their 23\_ISA\_49\_26 # And I will feed them that oppress thee with their own flesh; and they shall be drunken with their own blood, as with sweet wine: and all flesh shall know that I the LORD [am] thy Saviour and thy Redeemer, the mighty One of Jacob.

drunken with wormwood <u>25\_LAM\_03\_15</u># He hath filled me with bitterness, he hath made me drunken with wormwood.

drunken <u>46\_1CO\_11\_21</u># For in eating every one taketh before [other] his own supper: and one is hungry, and another is drunken.

drunken <u>09\_1SA\_01\_13</u># Now Hannah, she spake in her heart; only her lips moved, but her voice was not heard: therefore Eli thought she had been drunken.

drunken <u>42\_LUK\_12\_45</u> # But and if that servant say in his heart, My lord delayeth his coming; and shall begin to beat the menservants and maidens, and to eat and drink, and to be drunken;

drunken <u>40\_MAT\_24\_49</u># And shall begin to smite [his] fellowservants, and to eat and drink with the drunken;

drunkenness and cares <u>42\_LUK\_21\_34</u> # And take heed to yourselves, lest at any time your hearts be overcharged with surfeiting, and drunkenness, and cares of this life, and [so] that day come upon you unawares.

drunkenness and sorrow <u>26\_EZE\_23\_33</u> # Thou shalt be filled with drunkenness and sorrow, with the cup of astonishment and desolation, with the cup of thy sister Samaria.

drunkenness not in <u>45\_ROM\_13\_13</u> # Let us walk honestly, as in the day; not in rioting and drunkenness, not in chambering and wantonness, not in strife and envying.

drunkenness revellings and <u>48\_GAL\_05\_21</u># Envyings, murders, drunkenness, revellings, and such like: of the which I tell you before, as I have also told [you] in time past, that they which do such things shall not inherit the kingdom of God.

drunkenness to thirst <u>05\_DEU\_29\_19</u> # And it come to pass, when he heareth the words of this curse, that he bless himself in his heart, saying, I shall have peace, though I walk in the imagination of mine heart, to add drunkenness to thirst:

drunkenness <u>21\_ECC\_10\_17</u># Blessed [art] thou, O land, when thy king [is] the son of nobles, and thy princes eat in due season, for strength, and not for drunkenness!
