dwelt add ye <u>23\_ISA\_29\_01</u># Woe to Ariel, to Ariel, the city [where] David dwelt! add ye year to year; let them kill sacrifices.

dwelt all great <u>26\_EZE\_31\_06</u># All the fowls of heaven made their nests in his boughs, and under his branches did all the beasts of the field bring forth their young, and under his shadow dwelt all great nations.

dwelt among plants <u>13\_1CH\_04\_23</u> # These [were] the potters, and those that dwelt among plants and hedges: there they dwelt with the king for his work.

dwelt among the <u>01\_GEN\_23\_10</u># And Ephron dwelt among the children of Heth: and Ephron the Hittite answered Abraham in the audience of the children of Heth, [even] of all that went in at the gate of his city, saying,

dwelt among the <u>24\_JER\_39\_14</u> # Even they sent, and took Jeremiah out of the court of the prison, and committed him unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan, that he should carry him home: so he dwelt among the people.

dwelt among the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_16</u> # And the children of the Kenite, Moses' father in law, went up out of the city of palm trees with the children of Judah into the wilderness of Judah, which [lieth] in the south of Arad; and they went and dwelt among the people.

dwelt among the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_32</u># But the Asherites dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: for they did not drive them out.

dwelt among the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_33</u> # Neither did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Bethshemesh, nor the inhabitants of Bethanath; but he dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: nevertheless the inhabitants of Bethshemesh and of Bethanath became tributaries unto them.

dwelt among the <u>07\_JUD\_03\_05</u> # And the children of Israel dwelt among the Canaanites, Hittites, and Amorites, and Perizzites, and Hivites, and Jebusites:

dwelt among them <u>06\_JOS\_09\_16</u># And it came to pass at the end of three days after they had made a league with them, that they heard that they [were] their neighbours, and [that] they dwelt among them.

dwelt among them <u>07\_JUD\_01\_30</u> # Neither did Zebulun drive out the inhabitants of Kitron, nor the inhabitants of Nahalol; but the Canaanites dwelt among them, and became tributaries.

dwelt among us <u>43\_JOH\_01\_14</u> # And the Word was made flesh, and dwelt among us, [and we beheld his glory, the glory as of the only begotten of the Father,] full of grace and truth.

dwelt an old <u>11\_1KI\_13\_11</u># Now there dwelt an old prophet in Bethel; and his sons came and told him all the works that the man of God had done that day in Bethel: the words which he had spoken unto the king, them they told also to their father.

dwelt and abode <u>43\_JOH\_01\_39</u> # He saith unto them, Come and see. They came and saw where he dwelt, and abode with him that day: for it was about the tenth hour.

dwelt and all <u>04\_NUM\_31\_10</u> # And they burnt all their cities wherein they dwelt, and all their goodly castles, with fire.

dwelt and they <u>26\_EZE\_37\_25</u> # And they shall dwell in the land that I have given unto Jacob my servant, wherein your fathers have dwelt; and they shall dwell therein, [even] they, and their children, and their children's children for ever: and my servant David [shall be] their prince for ever.

dwelt and upon <u>27\_DAN\_04\_21</u> # Whose leaves [were] fair, and the fruit thereof much, and in it [was] meat for all; under which the beasts of the field dwelt, and upon whose branches the fowls of the heaven had their habitation:

dwelt as a <u>18\_JOB\_29\_25</u># I chose out their way, and sat chief, and dwelt as a king in the army, as one [that] comforteth the mourners.

dwelt as strangers <u>44\_ACT\_13\_17</u># The God of this people of Israel chose our fathers, and exalted the people when they dwelt as strangers in the land of Egypt, and with an high arm brought he them out of it.

dwelt at Arumah <u>07\_JUD\_09\_41</u> # And Abimelech dwelt at Arumah: and Zebul thrust out Gaal and his brethren, that they should not dwell in Shechem.

dwelt at Ashtaroth <u>06\_JOS\_12\_04</u> # And the coast of Og king of Bashan, [which was] of the remnant of the giants, that dwelt at Ashtaroth and at Edrei,

dwelt at Astaroth <u>05\_DEU\_01\_04</u> # After he had slain Sihon the king of the Amorites, which dwelt in Heshbon, and Og the king of Bashan, which dwelt at Astaroth in Edrei:

dwelt at Beersheba 13\_1CH\_04\_28 # And they dwelt at Beersheba, and Moladah, and Hazarshual,

dwelt at Beersheba <u>01\_GEN\_22\_19</u># So Abraham returned unto his young men, and they rose up and went together to Beersheba; and Abraham dwelt at Beersheba.

dwelt at Damascus <u>11\_1KI\_15\_18</u># Then Asa took all the silver and the gold [that were] left in the treasures of the house of the LORD, and the treasures of the king's house, and delivered them into the hand of his servants: and king Asa sent them to Benhadad, the son of Tabrimon, the son of Hezion, king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

dwelt at Damascus <u>14\_2CH\_16\_02</u> # Then Asa brought out silver and gold out of the treasures of the house of the LORD and of the king's house, and sent to Benhadad king of Syria, that dwelt at Damascus, saying,

dwelt at Damascus <u>44\_ACT\_09\_22</u> # But Saul increased the more in strength, and confounded the Jews which dwelt at Damascus, proving that this is very Christ.

dwelt at Heshbon <u>05\_DEU\_03\_02</u> # And the LORD said unto me, Fear him not: for I will deliver him, and all his people, and his land, into thy hand; and thou shalt do unto him as thou didst unto Sihon king of the Amorites, which dwelt at Heshbon.

dwelt at Heshbon <u>05\_DEU\_04\_46</u> # On this side Jordan, in the valley over against Bethpeor, in the land of Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt at Heshbon, whom Moses and the children of Israel smote, after they were come forth out of Egypt:

dwelt at Heshbon <u>04\_NUM\_21\_34</u># And the LORD said unto Moses, Fear him not: for I have delivered him into thy hand, and all his people, and his land; and thou shalt do to him as thou didst unto Sihon king of the Amorites, which dwelt at Heshbon.

dwelt at Jabez <u>13\_1CH\_02\_55</u># And the families of the scribes which dwelt at Jabez; the Tirathites, the

Shimeathites, [and] Suchathites. These [are] the Kenites that came of Hemath, the father of the house of Rechab.

dwelt at Jerusalem <u>13\_1CH\_09\_34</u> # These chief fathers of the Levites [were] chief throughout their generations; these dwelt at Jerusalem.

dwelt at Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_19\_04</u># And Jehoshaphat dwelt at Jerusalem: and he went out again through the people from Beersheba to mount Ephraim, and brought them back unto the LORD God of their fathers.

dwelt at Jerusalem <u>16\_NEH\_11\_01</u># And the rulers of the people dwelt at Jerusalem: the rest of the people also cast lots, to bring one of ten to dwell in Jerusalem the holy city, and nine parts [to dwell] in [other] cities.

dwelt at Jerusalem <u>16\_NEH\_11\_06</u># All the sons of Perez that dwelt at Jerusalem [were] four hundred threescore and eight valiant men.

dwelt at Kirjatharba <u>16\_NEH\_11\_25</u># And for the villages, with their fields, [some] of the children of Judah dwelt at Kirjatharba, and [in] the villages thereof, and at Dibon, and [in] the villages thereof, and at Jekabzeel, and [in] the villages thereof,

dwelt at Lydda <u>44\_ACT\_09\_32</u># And it came to pass, as Peter passed throughout all [quarters], he came down also to the saints which dwelt at Lydda.

dwelt at Lydda <u>44\_ACT\_09\_35</u> # And all that dwelt at Lydda and Saron saw him, and turned to the Lord.

dwelt at Michmash <u>16 NEH\_11\_31</u># The children also of Benjamin from Geba [dwelt] at Michmash, and Aija, and Bethel, and [in] their villages,

dwelt at Nineveh <u>12\_2KI\_19\_36</u># So Sennacherib king of Assyria departed, and went and returned, and dwelt at Nineveh.

dwelt at Nineveh <u>23\_ISA\_37\_37</u># So Sennacherib king of Assyria departed, and went and returned, and dwelt at Nineveh.

dwelt by the <u>11\_1KI\_17\_05</u># So he went and did according unto the word of the LORD: for he went and dwelt by the brook Cherith, that [is] before Jordan.

dwelt by the <u>26\_EZE\_03\_15</u># Then I came to them of the captivity at Telabib, that dwelt by the river of Chebar, and I sat where they sat, and remained there astonished among them seven days.

dwelt by the <u>01\_GEN\_25\_11</u># And it came to pass after the death of Abraham, that God blessed his son Isaac; and Isaac dwelt by the well Lahairoi.

dwelt by them <u>16\_NEH\_04\_12</u> # And it came to pass, that when the Jews which dwelt by them came, they said unto us ten times, From all places whence ye shall return unto us [they will be upon you].

dwelt careless after <u>07\_JUD\_18\_07</u># Then the five men departed, and came to Laish, and saw the people that [were] therein, how they dwelt careless, after the manner of the Zidonians, quiet and secure; and [there was] no magistrate in the land, that might put [them] to shame in [any] thing; and they [were] far from the Zidonians, and had no business with [any] man.

dwelt carelessly that <u>36\_ZEP\_02\_15</u># This [is] the rejoicing city that dwelt carelessly, that said in her heart, I [am], and [there is] none beside me: how is she become a desolation, a place for beasts to lie down in! every one that passeth by her shall hiss, [and] wag his hand.

dwelt certain of <u>16\_NEH\_11\_04</u># And at Jerusalem dwelt [certain] of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin. Of the children of Judah; Athaiah the son of Uzziah, the son of Zechariah, the son of Amariah, the son of Shephatiah, the son of Mahalaleel, of the children of Perez;

dwelt Esau in 01\_GEN\_36\_08 # Thus dwelt Esau in mount Seir: Esau [is] Edom.

dwelt every one <u>16\_NEH\_11\_03</u># Now these [are] the chief of the province that dwelt in Jerusalem: but in the cities of Judah dwelt every one in his possession in their cities, [to wit], Israel, the priests, and the Levites, and the Nethinims, and the children of Solomon's servants.

dwelt first in <u>55\_2TI\_01\_05</u> # When I call to remembrance the unfeigned faith that is in thee, which dwelt first in thy grandmother Lois, and thy mother Eunice; and I am persuaded that in thee also.

dwelt from Beersheba <u>16\_NEH\_11\_30</u># Zanoah, Adullam, and [in] their villages, at Lachish, and the fields thereof, at Azekah, and [in] the villages thereof. And they dwelt from Beersheba unto the valley of Hinnom.

dwelt from Havilah <u>01\_GEN\_25\_18</u># And they dwelt from Havilah unto Shur, that [is] before Egypt, as thou goest toward Assyria: [and] he died in the presence of all his brethren.

dwelt had another <u>11\_1KI\_07\_08</u># And his house where he dwelt [had] another court within the porch, [which] was of the like work. Solomon made also an house for Pharaoh's daughter, whom he had taken [to wife], like unto this porch.

dwelt in a <u>14\_2CH\_26\_21</u> # And Uzziah the king was a leper unto the day of his death, and dwelt in a several house, [being] a leper; for he was cut off from the house of the LORD: and Jotham his son [was] over the king's house, judging the people of the land.

dwelt in a <u>12\_2KI\_15\_05</u># And the LORD smote the king, so that he was a leper unto the day of his death, and dwelt in a several house. And Jotham the king's son [was] over the house, judging the people of the land.

dwelt in a <u>01\_GEN\_19\_30</u># And Lot went up out of Zoar, and dwelt in the mountain, and his two daughters with him; for he feared to dwell in Zoar: and he dwelt in a cave, he and his two daughters.

dwelt in a <u>40\_MAT\_02\_23</u># And he came and dwelt in a city called Nazareth: that it might be fulfilled which was spoken by the prophets, He shall be called a Nazarene.

dwelt in all <u>04\_NUM\_21\_25</u># And Israel took all these cities: and Israel dwelt in all the cities of the Amorites, in Heshbon, and in all the villages thereof.

dwelt in an <u>13\_1CH\_17\_05</u># For I have not dwelt in an house since the day that I brought up Israel unto this day; but have gone from tent to tent, and from [one] tabernacle [to another].

dwelt in any <u>10\_2SA\_07\_06</u> # Whereas I have not dwelt in [any] house since the time that I brought up the children of Israel out of Egypt, even to this day, but have walked in a tent and in a tabernacle.

dwelt in Aroer <u>13\_1CH\_05\_08</u> # And Bela the son of Azaz, the son of Shema, the son of Joel, who dwelt in Aroer, even unto Nebo and Baalmeon:

dwelt in Asia <u>44\_ACT\_19\_10</u> # And this continued by the space of two years; so that all they which dwelt in Asia heard the word of the Lord Jesus, both Jews and Greeks.

dwelt in Bethel <u>12\_2KI\_17\_28</u># Then one of the priests whom they had carried away from Samaria came and dwelt in Bethel, and taught them how they should fear the LORD.

dwelt in Capernaum <u>40\_MAT\_04\_13</u># And leaving Nazareth, he came and dwelt in Capernaum, which is upon the sea coast, in the borders of Zabulon and Nephthalim:

dwelt in Charran <u>44\_ACT\_07\_02</u> # And he said, Men, brethren, and fathers, hearken; The God of glory appeared unto our father Abraham, when he was in Mesopotamia, before he dwelt in Charran,

dwelt in Charran <u>44\_ACT\_07\_04</u> # Then came he out of the land of the Chaldaeans, and dwelt in Charran: and from thence, when his father was dead, he removed him into this land, wherein ye now dwell.

dwelt in Egypt <u>11\_1KI\_12\_02</u># And it came to pass, when Jeroboam the son of Nebat, who was yet in Egypt, heard [of it], [for he was fled from the presence of king Solomon, and Jeroboam dwelt in Egypt;]

dwelt in Egypt <u>02\_EXO\_12\_40</u> # Now the sojourning of the children of Israel, who dwelt in Egypt, [was] four hundred and thirty years.

dwelt in Egypt <u>01\_GEN\_50\_22</u># And Joseph dwelt in Egypt, he, and his father's house: and Joseph lived an hundred and ten years.

dwelt in Egypt <u>04\_NUM\_20\_15</u># How our fathers went down into Egypt, and we have dwelt in Egypt a long time; and the Egyptians vexed us, and our fathers:

dwelt in from <u>23\_ISA\_13\_20</u> # It shall never be inhabited, neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation: neither shall the Arabian pitch tent there; neither shall the shepherds make their fold there.

dwelt in from <u>24\_JER\_50\_39</u># Therefore the wild beasts of the desert with the wild beasts of the islands shall dwell [there], and the owls shall dwell therein: and it shall be no more inhabited for ever; neither shall it be dwelt in from generation to generation.

dwelt in Gerar <u>01\_GEN\_26\_06</u># And Isaac dwelt in Gerar:

dwelt in Gezer <u>06\_JOS\_16\_10</u># And they drave not out the Canaanites that dwelt in Gezer: but the Canaanites dwell among the Ephraimites unto this day, and serve under tribute.

dwelt in Gezer <u>07\_JUD\_01\_29</u># Neither did Ephraim drive out the Canaanites that dwelt in Gezer; but the Canaanites dwelt in Gezer among them.

dwelt in Gezer <u>07\_JUD\_01\_29</u># Neither did Ephraim drive out the Canaanites that dwelt in Gezer; but the Canaanites dwelt in Gezer among them.

dwelt in Gilead <u>13\_1CH\_05\_16</u># And they dwelt in Gilead in Bashan, and in her towns, and in all the suburbs of Sharon, upon their borders.

dwelt in Gurbaal <u>14\_2CH\_26\_07</u># And God helped him against the Philistines, and against the Arabians that dwelt in Gurbaal, and the Mehunims.

dwelt in Harosheth <u>07\_JUD\_04\_02</u> # And the LORD sold them into the hand of Jabin king of Canaan, that reigned in Hazor; the captain of whose host [was] Sisera, which dwelt in Harosheth of the Gentiles.

dwelt in Hazerim <u>05\_DEU\_02\_23</u> # And the Avims which dwelt in Hazerim, [even] unto Azzah, the Caphtorims, which came forth out of Caphtor, destroyed them, and dwelt in their stead.]

dwelt in Hazezontamar <u>01\_GEN\_14\_07</u> # And they returned, and came to Enmishpat, which [is] Kadesh, and smote all the country of the Amalekites, and also the Amorites, that dwelt in Hazezontamar.

dwelt in Hebron <u>07\_JUD\_01\_10</u># And Judah went against the Canaanites that dwelt in Hebron: [now the name of Hebron before [was] Kirjatharba:] and they slew Sheshai, and Ahiman, and Talmai.

dwelt in her <u>01\_GEN\_38\_11</u># Then said Judah to Tamar his daughter in law, Remain a widow at thy father's house, till Shelah my son be grown: for he said, Lest peradventure he die also, as his brethren [did]. And Tamar went and dwelt in her father's house.

dwelt in Heshbon <u>05\_DEU\_01\_04</u> # After he had slain Sihon the king of the Amorites, which dwelt in Heshbon, and Og the king of Bashan, which dwelt at Astaroth in Edrei:

dwelt in Heshbon <u>06\_JOS\_12\_02</u># Sihon king of the Amorites, who dwelt in Heshbon, [and] ruled from Aroer, which [is] upon the bank of the river Arnon, and from the middle of the river, and from half Gilead, even unto the river Jabbok, [which is] the border of the children of Ammon;

dwelt in Heshbon <u>07\_JUD\_11\_26</u># While Israel dwelt in Heshbon and her towns, and in Aroer and her towns, and in all the cities that [be] along by the coasts of Arnon, three hundred years? why therefore did ye not recover [them] within that time?

dwelt in his <u>07\_JUD\_08\_29</u> # And Jerubbaal the son of Joash went and dwelt in his own house.

dwelt in it <u>18\_JOB\_22\_08</u># But [as for] the mighty man, he had the earth; and the honourable man dwelt in it.

dwelt in Jerusalem <u>13\_1CH\_08\_28</u># These [were] heads of the fathers, by their generations, chief [men]. These dwelt in Jerusalem.

dwelt in Jerusalem <u>11\_1KI\_02\_38</u># And Shimei said unto the king, The saying [is] good: as my lord the king hath said, so will thy servant do. And Shimei dwelt in Jerusalem many days.

dwelt in Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_11\_05</u># And Rehoboam dwelt in Jerusalem, and built cities for defence in Judah.

dwelt in Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_31\_04</u> # Moreover he commanded the people that dwelt in Jerusalem to give the portion of the priests and the Levites, that they might be encouraged in the law of the LORD.

dwelt in Jerusalem <u>14\_2CH\_34\_22</u> # And Hilkiah, and [they] that the king [had appointed], went to Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvath, the son of Hasrah, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college:] and they spake to her to that [effect].

dwelt in Jerusalem <u>12\_2KI\_22\_14</u># So Hilkiah the priest, and Ahikam, and Achbor, and Shaphan, and Asahiah, went unto Huldah the prophetess, the wife of Shallum the son of Tikvah, the son of Harhas, keeper of the wardrobe; [now she dwelt in Jerusalem in the college;] and they communed with her.

dwelt in Jerusalem <u>10\_2SA\_09\_13</u> # So Mephibosheth dwelt in Jerusalem: for he did eat continually at the king's table; and was lame on both his feet.

dwelt in Jerusalem <u>42\_LUK\_13\_04</u> # Or those eighteen, upon whom the tower in Siloam fell, and slew them, think ye that they were sinners above all men that dwelt in Jerusalem?

dwelt in Jerusalem <u>16\_NEH\_11\_03</u># Now these [are] the chief of the province that dwelt in Jerusalem: but in the cities of Judah dwelt every one in his possession in their cities, [to wit], Israel, the priests, and the Levites, and the Nethinims, and the children of Solomon's servants.

dwelt in Judaea <u>44\_ACT\_11\_29</u># Then the disciples, every man according to his ability, determined to send relief unto the brethren which dwelt in Judaea:

dwelt in Judah <u>14\_2CH\_30\_25</u> # And all the congregation of Judah, with the priests and the Levites, and all the congregation that came out of Israel, and the strangers that came out of the land of Israel, and that dwelt in Judah, rejoiced.

dwelt in mount <u>07\_JUD\_03\_03</u># [Namely], five lords of the Philistines, and all the Canaanites, and the Sidonians, and the Hivites that dwelt in mount Lebanon, from mount Baalhermon unto the entering in of Hamath.

dwelt in Naioth <u>09\_1SA\_19\_18</u># So David fled, and escaped, and came to Samuel to Ramah, and told him all that Saul had done to him. And he and Samuel went and dwelt in Naioth.

dwelt in Ophel <u>16\_NEH\_03\_26</u># Moreover the Nethinims dwelt in Ophel, unto [the place] over against the water gate toward the east, and the tower that lieth out.

dwelt in Ophel <u>16\_NEH\_11\_21</u># But the Nethinims dwelt in Ophel: and Ziha and Gispa [were] over the Nethinims.

dwelt in Seir <u>05\_DEU\_02\_08</u> # And when we passed by from our brethren the children of Esau, which dwelt in Seir, through the way of the plain from Elath, and from Eziongaber, we turned and passed by the way of the wilderness of Moab.

dwelt in Seir <u>05\_DEU\_02\_12</u># The Horims also dwelt in Seir beforetime; but the children of Esau succeeded them, when they had destroyed them from before them, and dwelt in their stead; as Israel did unto the land of his possession, which the LORD gave unto them.

dwelt in Seir <u>05\_DEU\_02\_22</u> # As he did to the children of Esau, which dwelt in Seir, when he destroyed the Horims from before them; and they succeeded them, and dwelt in their stead even unto this day:

dwelt in Shamir <u>07\_JUD\_10\_01</u> # And after Abimelech there arose to defend Israel Tola the son of Puah the son of Dodo, a man of Issachar, and he dwelt in Shamir in mount Ephraim.

dwelt in silence <u>19\_PSA\_94\_17</u> # Unless the LORD [had been] my help, my soul had almost dwelt in silence.

dwelt in Sodom <u>01\_GEN\_14\_12</u># And they took Lot, Abram's brother's son, who dwelt in Sodom, and his goods, and departed.

dwelt in strong 09\_1SA\_23\_29 # And David went up from thence, and dwelt in strong holds at Engedi.

dwelt in tents <u>24\_JER\_35\_10</u># But we have dwelt in tents, and have obeyed, and done according to all that Jonadab our father commanded us.

dwelt in tents <u>07\_JUD\_08\_11</u># And Gideon went up by the way of them that dwelt in tents on the east of Nobah and Jogbehah, and smote the host: for the host was secure.

dwelt in that <u>05\_DEU\_01\_44</u># And the Amorites, which dwelt in that mountain, came out against you, and chased you, as bees do, and destroyed you in Seir, [even] unto Hormah.

dwelt in that <u>01\_GEN\_35\_22</u> # And it came to pass, when Israel dwelt in that land, that Reuben went and lay with Bilhah his father's concubine: and Israel heard [it]. Now the sons of Jacob were twelve:

dwelt in that <u>04\_NUM\_14\_45</u># Then the Amalekites came down, and the Canaanites which dwelt in that hill, and smote them, and discomfited them, [even] unto Hormah.

dwelt in the <u>13\_1CH\_05\_23</u> # And the children of the half tribe of Manasseh dwelt in the land: they

increased from Bashan unto Baalhermon and Senir, and unto mount Hermon.

dwelt in the <u>13\_1CH\_09\_16</u># And Obadiah the son of Shemaiah, the son of Galal, the son of Jeduthun, and Berechiah the son of Asa, the son of Elkanah, that dwelt in the villages of the Netophathites.

dwelt in the <u>13\_1CH\_11\_07</u># And David dwelt in the castle; therefore they called it the city of David.

dwelt in the <u>11\_1KI\_09\_16</u># [For] Pharaoh king of Egypt had gone up, and taken Gezer, and burnt it with fire, and slain the Canaanites that dwelt in the city, and given it [for] a present unto his daughter, Solomon's wife.

dwelt in the <u>11\_1KI\_12\_17</u># But [as for] the children of Israel which dwelt in the cities of Judah, Rehoboam reigned over them.

dwelt in the <u>09\_18A\_27\_07</u># And the time that David dwelt in the country of the Philistines was a full year and four months.

dwelt in the <u>14\_2CH\_10\_17</u># But [as for] the children of Israel that dwelt in the cities of Judah, Rehoboam reigned over them.

dwelt in the <u>14\_2CH\_31\_06</u> # And [concerning] the children of Israel and Judah, that dwelt in the cities of Judah, they also brought in the tithe of oxen and sheep, and the tithe of holy things which were consecrated unto the LORD their God, and laid [them] by heaps.

dwelt in the <u>12\_2KI\_17\_24</u># And the king of Assyria brought [men] from Babylon, and from Cuthah, and from Ava, and from Hamath, and from Sepharvaim, and placed [them] in the cities of Samaria instead of the children of Israel: and they possessed Samaria, and dwelt in the cities thereof.

dwelt in the <u>10\_2SA\_02\_03</u> # And his men that [were] with him did David bring up, every man with his household: and they dwelt in the cities of Hebron.

dwelt in the <u>10\_2SA\_05\_09</u># So David dwelt in the fort, and called it the city of David. And David built round about from Millo and inward.

dwelt in the <u>10\_2SA\_09\_12</u> # And Mephibosheth had a young son, whose name [was] Micha. And all that dwelt in the house of Ziba [were] servants unto Mephibosheth.

dwelt in the <u>27\_DAN\_04\_12</u># The leaves thereof [were] fair, and the fruit thereof much, and in it [was] meat for all: the beasts of the field had shadow under it, and the fowls of the heaven dwelt in the boughs thereof, and all flesh was fed of it.

dwelt in the <u>05\_DEU\_29\_16</u># [For ye know how we have dwelt in the land of Egypt; and how we came through the nations which ye passed by;

dwelt in the <u>05\_DEU\_33\_16</u> # And for the precious things of the earth and fulness thereof, and [for] the good will of him that dwelt in the bush: let [the blessing] come upon the head of Joseph, and upon the top of the head of him [that was] separated from his brethren.

dwelt in the <u>17\_EST\_09\_19</u> # Therefore the Jews of the villages, that dwelt in the unwalled towns, made the fourteenth day of the month Adar [a day of] gladness and feasting, and a good day, and of sending portions one to another.

dwelt in the <u>02\_EXO\_02\_15</u># Now when Pharaoh heard this thing, he sought to slay Moses. But Moses fled from the face of Pharaoh, and dwelt in the land of Midian: and he sat down by a well.

dwelt in the <u>01\_GEN\_04\_16</u># And Cain went out from the presence of the LORD, and dwelt in the land of Nod, on the east of Eden.

dwelt in the <u>01\_GEN\_13\_18</u># Then Abram removed [his] tent, and came and dwelt in the plain of Mamre, which [is] in Hebron, and built there an altar unto the LORD.

dwelt in the <u>01\_GEN\_14\_13</u># And there came one that had escaped, and told Abram the Hebrew; for he dwelt in the plain of Mamre the Amorite, brother of Eshcol, and brother of Aner: and these [were] confederate with Abram.

dwelt in the <u>01\_GEN\_19\_30</u># And Lot went up out of Zoar, and dwelt in the mountain, and his two daughters with him; for he feared to dwell in Zoar: and he dwelt in a cave, he and his two daughters.

dwelt in the <u>01\_GEN\_21\_20</u># And God was with the lad; and he grew, and dwelt in the wilderness, and became an archer.

dwelt in the <u>01\_GEN\_21\_21</u># And he dwelt in the wilderness of Paran: and his mother took him a wife out of the land of Egypt.

dwelt in the <u>01\_GEN\_24\_62</u> # And Isaac came from the way of the well Lahairoi; for he dwelt in the south country.

dwelt in the <u>01\_GEN\_37\_01</u># And Jacob dwelt in the land wherein his father was a stranger, in the land of Canaan.

dwelt in the <u>01\_GEN\_47\_27</u># And Israel dwelt in the land of Egypt, in the country of Goshen; and they had possessions therein, and grew, and multiplied exceedingly.

dwelt in the <u>24\_JER\_41\_17</u> # And they departed, and dwelt in the habitation of Chimham, which is by Bethlehem, to go to enter into Egypt,

dwelt in the <u>24\_JER\_44\_15</u> # Then all the men which knew that their wives had burned incense unto other gods, and all the women that stood by, a great multitude, even all the people that dwelt in the land of Egypt, in Pathros, answered Jeremiah, saying,

dwelt in the <u>06\_JOS\_24\_07</u> # And when they cried unto the LORD, he put darkness between you and the Egyptians, and brought the sea upon them, and covered them; and your eyes have seen what I have done in Egypt: and ye dwelt in the wilderness a long season.

dwelt in the <u>06\_JOS\_24\_18</u># And the LORD drave out from before us all the people, even the Amorites which dwelt in the land: [therefore] will we also serve the LORD; for he [is] our God.

dwelt in the <u>07\_JUD\_01\_09</u> # And afterward the children of Judah went down to fight against the Canaanites, that dwelt in the mountain, and in the south, and in the valley.

dwelt in the <u>07\_JUD\_11\_03</u># Then Jephthah fled from his brethren, and dwelt in the land of Tob: and there were gathered vain men to Jephthah, and went out with him.

dwelt in the <u>07\_JUD\_15\_08</u> # And he smote them hip and thigh with a great slaughter: and he went down and dwelt in the top of the rock Etam.

dwelt in the <u>04\_NUM\_14\_25</u> # [Now the Amalekites and the Canaanites dwelt in the valley.] To morrow turn you, and get you into the wilderness by the way of the Red sea.

dwelt in the <u>04\_NUM\_21\_01</u> # And [when] king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south, heard tell

that Israel came by the way of the spies; then he fought against Israel, and took [some] of them prisoners.

dwelt in the <u>04\_NUM\_21\_31</u> # Thus Israel dwelt in the land of the Amorites.

dwelt in the <u>04\_NUM\_33\_40</u> # And king Arad the Canaanite, which dwelt in the south in the land of Canaan, heard of the coming of the children of Israel.

dwelt in their <u>13\_1CH\_04\_41</u> # And these written by name came in the days of Hezekiah king of Judah, and smote their tents, and the habitations that were found there, and destroyed them utterly unto this day, and dwelt in their rooms: because [there was] pasture there for their flocks.

dwelt in their <u>13\_1CH\_05\_10</u> # And in the days of Saul they made war with the Hagarites, who fell by their hand: and they dwelt in their tents throughout all the east [land] of Gilead.

dwelt in their <u>13\_1CH\_05\_22</u># For there fell down many slain, because the war [was] of God. And they dwelt in their steads until the captivity.

dwelt in their <u>13\_1CH\_09\_02</u> # Now the first inhabitants that [dwelt] in their possessions in their cities [were], the Israelites, the priests, Levites, and the Nethinims.

dwelt in their <u>12\_2KI\_13\_05</u># [And the LORD gave Israel a saviour, so that they went out from under the hand of the Syrians: and the children of Israel dwelt in their tents, as beforetime.

dwelt in their <u>05\_DEU\_02\_12</u># The Horims also dwelt in Seir beforetime; but the children of Esau succeeded them, when they had destroyed them from before them, and dwelt in their stead; as Israel did unto the land of his possession, which the LORD gave unto them.

dwelt in their <u>05\_DEU\_02\_23</u># And the Avims which dwelt in Hazerim, [even] unto Azzah, the Caphtorims, which came forth out of Caphtor, destroyed them, and dwelt in their stead.]

dwelt in their <u>26\_EZE\_36\_17</u> # Son of man, when the house of Israel dwelt in their own land, they defiled it by their own way and by their doings: their way was before me as the uncleanness of a removed woman.

dwelt in their <u>15\_EZR\_02\_70</u># So the priests, and the Levites, and [some] of the people, and the singers, and the porters, and the Nethinims, dwelt in their cities, and all Israel in their cities.

dwelt in their <u>16\_NEH\_07\_73</u># So the priests, and the Levites, and the porters, and the singers, and [some] of the people, and the Nethinims, and all Israel, dwelt in their cities; and when the seventh month came, the children of Israel [were] in their cities.

dwelt in them <u>13\_1CH\_10\_07</u> # And when all the men of Israel that [were] in the valley saw that they fled, and that Saul and his sons were dead, then they forsook their cities, and fled: and the Philistines came and dwelt in them.

dwelt in them <u>09\_18A\_31\_07</u> # And when the men of Israel that [were] on the other side of the valley, and [they] that [were] on the other side Jordan, saw that the men of Israel fled, and that Saul and his sons were dead, they forsook the cities, and fled; and the Philistines came and dwelt in them.

dwelt in them 07\_JUD\_21\_23 # And the children of Benjamin did so, and took [them] wives, according to

their number, of them that danced, whom they caught: and they went and returned unto their inheritance, and repaired the cities, and dwelt in them.

dwelt in Tirzah <u>11\_1KI\_15\_21</u># And it came to pass, when Baasha heard [thereof], that he left off building of Ramah, and dwelt in Tirzah.

dwelt long enough <u>05\_DEU\_01\_06</u># The LORD our God spake unto us in Horeb, saying, Ye have dwelt long enough in this mount:

dwelt men of <u>16\_NEH\_13\_16</u># There dwelt men of Tyre also therein, which brought fish, and all manner of ware, and sold on the sabbath unto the children of Judah, and in Jerusalem.

dwelt of the <u>13\_1CH\_09\_03</u># And in Jerusalem dwelt of the children of Judah, and of the children of Benjamin, and of the children of Ephraim, and Manasseh;

dwelt on the <u>06\_JOS\_07\_07</u># And Joshua said, Alas, O Lord GOD, wherefore hast thou at all brought this people over Jordan, to deliver us into the hand of the Amorites, to destroy us? would to God we had been content, and dwelt on the other side Jordan!

dwelt on the <u>06\_JOS\_24\_02</u> # And Joshua said unto all the people, Thus saith the LORD God of Israel, Your fathers dwelt on the other side of the flood in old time, [even] Terah, the father of Abraham, and the father of Nachor: and they served other gods.

dwelt on the <u>06\_JOS\_24\_08</u># And I brought you into the land of the Amorites, which dwelt on the other side Jordan; and they fought with you: and I gave them into your hand, that ye might possess their land; and I destroyed them from before you.

dwelt on the <u>66\_REV\_11\_10</u># And they that dwell upon the earth shall rejoice over them, and make merry, and shall send gifts one to another; because these two prophets tormented them that dwelt on the earth.

dwelt over against <u>13\_1CH\_05\_11</u># And the children of Gad dwelt over against them, in the land of Bashan unto Salcah:

dwelt round about <u>42\_LUK\_01\_65</u> # And fear came on all that dwelt round about them: and all these sayings were noised abroad throughout all the hill country of Judaea.

dwelt safely every <u>11\_1KI\_04\_25</u># And Judah and Israel dwelt safely, every man under his vine and under his fig tree, from Dan even to Beersheba, all the days of Solomon.

dwelt safely in <u>26\_EZE\_39\_26</u># After that they have borne their shame, and all their trespasses whereby they have trespassed against me, when they dwelt safely in their land, and none made [them] afraid.

dwelt shall ye <u>03\_LEV\_18\_03</u> # After the doings of the land of Egypt, wherein ye dwelt, shall ye not do: and after the doings of the land of Canaan, whither I bring you, shall ye not do: neither shall ye walk in their ordinances.

dwelt ten years <u>01\_GEN\_16\_03</u> # And Sarai Abram's wife took Hagar her maid the Egyptian, after Abram had dwelt ten years in the land of Canaan, and gave her to her husband Abram to be his wife.

dwelt the children <u>13\_1CH\_07\_29</u> # And by the borders of the children of Manasseh, Bethshean and her towns, Taanach and her towns, Megiddo and her towns, Dor and her towns. In these dwelt the children of Joseph the son of Israel.

dwelt the father <u>13\_1CH\_08\_29</u> # And at Gibeon dwelt the father of Gibeon; whose wife's name [was] Maachah:

dwelt the father <u>13\_1CH\_09\_35</u># And in Gibeon dwelt the father of Gibeon, Jehiel, whose wife's name [was] Maachah:

dwelt there for <u>07\_JUD\_09\_21</u># And Jotham ran away, and fled, and went to Beer, and dwelt there, for fear of Abimelech his brother.

dwelt there of <u>13\_1CH\_04\_40</u> # And they found fat pasture and good, and the land [was] wide, and quiet, and peaceable; for [they] of Ham had dwelt there of old.

dwelt there unto <u>13\_1CH\_04\_43</u># And they smote the rest of the Amalekites that were escaped, and dwelt there unto this day.

dwelt there unto <u>12\_2KI\_16\_06</u># At that time Rezin king of Syria recovered Elath to Syria, and drave the Jews from Elath: and the Syrians came to Elath, and dwelt there unto this day.

dwelt there <u>14\_2CH\_28\_18</u># The Philistines also had invaded the cities of the low country, and of the south of Judah, and had taken Bethshemesh, and Ajalon, and Gederoth, and Shocho with the villages thereof, and Timnah with the villages thereof, Gimzo also and the villages thereof: and they dwelt there.

dwelt there <u>44\_ACT\_22\_12</u> # And one Ananias, a devout man according to the law, having a good report of all the Jews which dwelt [there],

dwelt there <u>01\_GEN\_11\_02</u># And it came to pass, as they journeyed from the east, that they found a plain in the land of Shinar; and they dwelt there.

dwelt there <u>01\_GEN\_11\_31</u> # And Terah took Abram his son, and Lot the son of Haran his son's son, and Sarai his daughter in law, his son Abram's wife; and they went forth with them from Ur of the Chaldees, to go into the land of Canaan; and they came unto Haran, and dwelt there.

dwelt there <u>01\_GEN\_26\_17</u># And Isaac departed thence, and pitched his tent in the valley of Gerar, and dwelt there.

dwelt therein and <u>11\_1KI\_11\_24</u># And he gathered men unto him, and became captain over a band, when David slew them [of Zobah]: and they went to Damascus, and dwelt therein, and reigned in Damascus.

dwelt therein and <u>11\_1KI\_12\_25</u># Then Jeroboam built Shechem in mount Ephraim, and dwelt therein; and went out from thence, and built Penuel.

dwelt therein and <u>14\_2CH\_20\_08</u> # And they dwelt therein, and have built thee a sanctuary therein for thy name, saying,

dwelt therein and <u>06\_JOS\_19\_47</u> # And the coast of the children of Dan went out [too little] for them: therefore the children of Dan went up to fight against Leshem, and took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and possessed it, and dwelt therein, and called Leshem, Dan, after the name of Dan their father.

dwelt therein in <u>05\_DEU\_02\_10</u># The Emims dwelt therein in times past, a people great, and many, and tall, as the Anakims;

dwelt therein in <u>05\_DEU\_02\_20</u># [That also was accounted a land of giants: giants dwelt therein in old time; and the Ammonites call them Zamzummims;

dwelt therein thou <u>19\_PSA\_68\_10</u># Thy congregation hath dwelt therein: thou, O God, hast prepared of thy goodness for the poor.

dwelt therein <u>05\_DEU\_08\_12</u> # Lest [when] thou hast eaten and art full, and hast built goodly houses, and dwelt [therein];

dwelt therein <u>06\_JOS\_19\_50</u> # According to the word of the LORD they gave him the city which he asked, [even] Timnathserah in mount Ephraim: and he built the city, and dwelt therein.

dwelt therein <u>06\_JOS\_21\_43</u> # And the LORD gave unto Israel all the land which he sware to give unto their fathers; and they possessed it, and dwelt therein.

dwelt therein <u>07\_JUD\_18\_28</u># And [there was] no deliverer, because it [was] far from Zidon, and they had no business with [any] man; and it was in the valley that [lieth] by Bethrehob. And they built a city, and dwelt therein.

dwelt therein <u>04\_NUM\_32\_40</u> # And Moses gave Gilead unto Machir the son of Manasseh; and he dwelt therein.

dwelt two full <u>10\_2SA\_14\_28</u># So Absalom dwelt two full years in Jerusalem, and saw not the king's face.

dwelt two whole <u>44\_ACT\_28\_30</u> # And Paul dwelt two whole years in his own hired house, and received all that came in unto him,

dwelt under his <u>26\_EZE\_31\_17</u> # They also went down into hell with him unto [them that be] slain with the sword; and [they that were] his arm, [that] dwelt under his shadow in the midst of the heathen.

dwelt under the <u>07\_JUD\_04\_05</u> # And she dwelt under the palm tree of Deborah between Ramah and Bethel in mount Ephraim: and the children of Israel came up to her for judgment.

dwelt upon it <u>03\_LEV\_26\_35</u> # As long as it lieth desolate it shall rest; because it did not rest in your sabbaths, when ye dwelt upon it.

dwelt upon the <u>06\_JOS\_02\_15</u># Then she let them down by a cord through the window: for her house [was] upon the town wall, and she dwelt upon the wall.

dwelt with Achish <u>09\_1SA\_27\_03</u> # And David dwelt with Achish at Gath, he and his men, every man with his household, [even] David with his two wives, Ahinoam the Jezreelitess, and Abigail the Carmelitess, Nabal's wife.

dwelt with her <u>08\_RUT\_02\_23</u># So she kept fast by the maidens of Boaz to glean unto the end of barley harvest and of wheat harvest; and dwelt with her mother in law.

dwelt with him <u>09\_18A\_22\_04</u># And he brought them before the king of Moab: and they dwelt with him all the while that David was in the hold.

dwelt with him <u>24\_JER\_40\_06</u># Then went Jeremiah unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam to Mizpah; and dwelt with him among the people that were left in the land.

dwelt with him <u>19\_PSA\_120\_06</u># My soul hath long dwelt with him that hateth peace.

dwelt with the <u>13\_1CH\_04\_23</u># These [were] the potters, and those that dwelt among plants and hedges: there they dwelt with the king for his work.

dwelt with their <u>13\_1CH\_08\_32</u># And Mikloth begat Shimeah. And these also dwelt with their brethren in Jerusalem, over against them.

dwelt with their 13\_1CH\_09\_38 # And Mikloth begat Shimeam. And they also dwelt with their brethren at

Jerusalem, over against their brethren.

dwelt <u>11\_1KI\_13\_25</u># And, behold, men passed by, and saw the carcase cast in the way, and the lion standing by the carcase: and they came and told [it] in the city where the old prophet dwelt.

dwelt <u>12\_2KI\_17\_29</u> # Howbeit every nation made gods of their own, and put [them] in the houses of the high places which the Samaritans had made, every nation in their cities wherein they dwelt.

dwelt <u>01\_GEN\_19\_29</u># And it came to pass, when God destroyed the cities of the plain, that God remembered Abraham, and sent Lot out of the midst of the overthrow, when he overthrew the cities in the which Lot dwelt.

dwelt <u>24\_JER\_02\_06</u> # Neither said they, Where [is] the LORD that brought us up out of the land of Egypt, that led us through the wilderness, through a land of deserts and of pits, through a land of drought, and of the shadow of death, through a land that no man passed through, and where no man dwelt?

dwelt <u>06\_JOS\_22\_33</u># And the thing pleased the children of Israel; and the children of Israel blessed God, and did not intend to go up against them in battle, to destroy the land wherein the children of Reuben and Gad dwelt.

dwelt <u>19\_PSA\_74\_02</u> # Remember thy congregation, [which] thou hast purchased of old; the rod of thine inheritance, [which] thou hast redeemed; this mount Zion, wherein thou hast dwelt.
