

# KJV Bible linked to Three Phrase Concordance

Edom a deputy <u>11\_1KI\_22\_47</u> # [There was] then no king in Edom: a deputy [was] king.

Edom according to <u>26\_EZE\_25\_14</u># And I will lay my vengeance upon Edom by the hand of my people Israel: and they shall do in Edom according to mine anger and according to my fury; and they shall know my vengeance, saith the Lord GOD.

Edom according to <u>01\_GEN\_36\_43</u> # Duke Magdiel, duke Iram: these [be] the dukes of Edom, according to their habitations in the land of their possession: he [is] Esau the father of the Edomites.

Edom and against <u>09\_1SA\_14\_47</u># So Saul took the kingdom over Israel, and fought against all his enemies on every side, against Moab, and against the children of Ammon, and against Edom, and against the kings of Zobah, and against the Philistines: and whithersoever he turned himself, he vexed [them].

Edom and all <u>13\_1CH\_18\_13</u> # And he put garrisons in Edom; and all the Edomites became David's servants. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

Edom and for <u>30\_AMO\_01\_11</u># Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Edom, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because he did pursue his brother with the sword, and did cast off all pity, and his anger did tear perpetually, and he kept his wrath for ever:

Edom and from <u>13\_1CH\_18\_11</u># Them also king David dedicated unto the LORD, with the silver and the gold that he brought from all [these] nations; from Edom, and from Moab, and from the children of Ammon, and from the Philistines, and from Amalek.

Edom and his <u>24\_JER\_49\_20</u> # Therefore hear the counsel of the LORD, that he hath taken against Edom; and his purposes, that he hath purposed against the inhabitants of Teman: Surely the least of the flock shall draw them out: surely he shall make their habitations desolate with them.

Edom and Joab <u>11\_1KI\_11\_15</u># For it came to pass, when David was in Edom, and Joab the captain of the host was gone up to bury the slain, after he had smitten every male in Edom;

Edom and Moab <u>27\_DAN\_11\_41</u># He shall enter also into the glorious land, and many [countries] shall be overthrown: but these shall escape out of his hand, [even] Edom, and Moab, and the chief of the children of Ammon.

Edom and Moab <u>23\_ISA\_11\_14</u># But they shall fly upon the shoulders of the Philistines toward the west; they shall spoil them of the east together: they shall lay their hand upon Edom and Moab; and the children of Ammon shall obey them.

Edom and Moab <u>24\_JER\_25\_21</u> # Edom, and Moab, and the children of Ammon,

Edom and of <u>30\_AMO\_09\_12</u># That they may possess the remnant of Edom, and of all the heathen, which are called by my name, saith the LORD that doeth this.

Edom and remembered <u>30\_AMO\_01\_09</u># Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Tyrus, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they delivered up the whole captivity to Edom, and remembered not the brotherly covenant:

Edom and that <u>24\_JER\_40\_11</u># Likewise when all the Jews that [were] in Moab, and among the Ammonites, and in Edom, and that [were] in all the countries, heard that the king of Babylon had left a remnant of Judah, and that he had set over them Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan;

Edom and the <u>12\_2KI\_03\_20</u> # And it came to pass in the morning, when the meat offering was offered, that, behold, there came water by the way of Edom, and the country was filled with water.

Edom and the <u>01\_GEN\_36\_32</u># And Bela the son of Beor reigned in Edom: and the name of his city [was] Dinhabah.

Edom and the <u>24\_JER\_09\_26</u># Egypt, and Judah, and Edom, and the children of Ammon, and Moab, and all [that are] in the utmost corners, that dwell in the wilderness: for all [these] nations [are] uncircumcised, and all the house of Israel [are] uncircumcised in the heart.

Edom and the <u>07\_JUD\_11\_18</u># Then they went along through the wilderness, and compassed the land of Edom, and the land of Moab, and came by the east side of the land of Moab, and pitched on the other side of Arnon, but came not within the border of Moab: for Arnon [was] the border of Moab.

Edom and the <u>04\_NUM\_21\_04</u> # And they journeyed from mount Hor by the way of the Red sea, to compass the land of Edom: and the soul of the people was much discouraged because of the way.

Edom and the <u>19\_PSA\_83\_06</u># The tabernacles of Edom, and the Ishmaelites; of Moab, and the Hagarenes;

Edom and these <u>01\_GEN\_36\_19</u># These [are] the sons of Esau, who [is] Edom, and these [are] their dukes.

Edom and they <u>12\_2KI\_03\_09</u> # So the king of Israel went, and the king of Judah, and the king of Edom: and they fetched a compass of seven days' journey: and there was no water for the host, and for the cattle that followed them.

Edom and thine <u>12\_2KI\_14\_10</u># Thou hast indeed smitten Edom, and thine heart hath lifted thee up: glory [of this], and tarry at home: for why shouldest thou meddle to [thy] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

Edom and to 24\_JER\_27\_03 # And send them to the king of Edom, and to the king of Moab, and to the king of the Ammonites, and to the king of Tyrus, and to the king of Zidon, by the hand of the messengers which come to Jerusalem unto Zedekiah king of Judah;

Edom and understanding <u>31\_OBA\_01\_08</u> # Shall I not in that day, saith the LORD, even destroy the wise [men] out of Edom, and understanding out of the mount of Esau?

Edom and will <u>26\_EZE\_25\_13</u># Therefore thus saith the Lord GOD; I will also stretch out mine hand upon Edom, and will cut off man and beast from it; and I will make it desolate from Teman; and they of Dedan shall fall by the sword.

Edom and your <u>04\_NUM\_34\_03</u># Then your south quarter shall be from the wilderness of Zin along by the coast of Edom, and your south border shall be the outmost coast of the salt sea eastward:

Edom be as <u>24\_JER\_49\_22</u># Behold, he shall come up and fly as the eagle, and spread his wings over Bozrah: and at that day shall the heart of the mighty men of Edom be as the heart of a woman in her pangs.

Edom became David's <u>10\_2SA\_08\_14</u> # And he put garrisons in Edom; throughout all Edom put he garrisons, and all they of Edom became David's servants. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

Edom before any <u>13\_1CH\_01\_43</u> # Now these [are] the kings that reigned in the land of Edom before [any] king reigned over the children of Israel; Bela the son of Beor: and the name of his city [was] Dinhabah.

Edom before there <u>01\_GEN\_36\_31</u> # And these [are] the kings that reigned in the land of Edom, before there reigned any king over the children of Israel.

Edom but they <u>12\_2KI\_03\_26</u># And when the king of Moab saw that the battle was too sore for him, he took with him seven hundred men that drew swords, to break through [even] unto the king of Edom: but they could not.

Edom by the <u>26\_EZE\_25\_14</u># And I will lay my vengeance upon Edom by the hand of my people Israel: and they shall do in Edom according to mine anger and according to my fury; and they shall know my vengeance, saith the Lord GOD.

Edom came out <u>04\_NUM\_20\_20</u># And he said, Thou shalt not go through. And Edom came out against him with much people, and with a strong hand.

Edom hath dealt <u>26\_EZE\_25\_12</u># Thus saith the Lord GOD; Because that Edom hath dealt against the house of Judah by taking vengeance, and hath greatly offended, and revenged himself upon them;

Edom he will <u>25\_LAM\_04\_22</u> # The punishment of thine iniquity is accomplished, O daughter of Zion; he will no more carry thee away into captivity: he will visit thine iniquity, O daughter of Edom; he will discover thy sins.

Edom her kings <u>26\_EZE\_32\_29</u> # There [is] Edom, her kings, and all her princes, which with their might are laid by [them that were] slain by the sword: they shall lie with the uncircumcised, and with them that go down to the pit.

Edom in the <u>12\_2KI\_14\_07</u># He slew of Edom in the valley of salt ten thousand, and took Selah by war, and called the name of it Joktheel unto this day.

Edom in the <u>19\_PSA\_137\_07</u># Remember, O LORD, the children of Edom in the day of Jerusalem; who said, Raze [it], raze [it, even] to the foundation thereof.

Edom in the <u>19\_PSA\_60\_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Joab returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.

Edom into lime <u>30\_AMO\_02\_01</u> # Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Moab, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because he burned the bones of the king of Edom into lime:

Edom put he <u>10\_2SA\_08\_14</u># And he put garrisons in Edom; throughout all Edom put he garrisons, and all they of Edom became David's servants. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

Edom refused to <u>04\_NUM\_20\_21</u># Thus Edom refused to give Israel passage through his border: wherefore Israel turned away from him.

Edom revolted from <u>12\_2KI\_08\_20</u> # In his days Edom revolted from under the hand of Judah, and made a king over themselves.

Edom revolted from <u>12\_2KI\_08\_22</u> # Yet Edom revolted from under the hand of Judah unto this day. Then Libnah revolted at the same time.

Edom said unto <u>04\_NUM\_20\_18</u> # And Edom said unto him, Thou shalt not pass by me, lest I come out

against thee with the sword.

Edom saith We <u>39\_MAL\_01\_04</u># Whereas Edom saith, We are impoverished, but we will return and build the desolate places; thus saith the LORD of hosts, They shall build, but I will throw down; and they shall call them, The border of wickedness, and, The people against whom the LORD hath indignation for ever.

Edom saying Let <u>07\_JUD\_11\_17</u># Then Israel sent messengers unto the king of Edom, saying, Let me, I pray thee, pass through thy land: but the king of Edom would not hearken [thereto]. And in like manner they sent unto the king of Moab: but he would not [consent]: and Israel abode in Kadesh.

Edom saying <u>04\_NUM\_20\_23</u># And the LORD spake unto Moses and Aaron in mount Hor, by the coast of the land of Edom, saying,

Edom shall be <u>02\_EXO\_15\_15</u># Then the dukes of Edom shall be amazed; the mighty men of Moab, trembling shall take hold upon them; all the inhabitants of Canaan shall melt away.

Edom shall be <u>24\_JER\_49\_17</u># Also Edom shall be a desolation: every one that goeth by it shall be astonished, and shall hiss at all the plagues thereof.

Edom shall be <u>29\_JOE\_03\_19</u># Egypt shall be a desolation, and Edom shall be a desolate wilderness, for the violence [against] the children of Judah, because they have shed innocent blood in their land.

Edom shall be <u>04\_NUM\_24\_18</u># And Edom shall be a possession, Seir also shall be a possession for his enemies; and Israel shall do valiantly.

Edom southward were <u>06\_JOS\_15\_21</u> # And the uttermost cities of the tribe of the children of Judah toward the coast of Edom southward were Kabzeel, and Eder, and Jagur,

Edom that dwellest <u>25\_LAM\_04\_21</u># Rejoice and be glad, O daughter of Edom, that dwellest in the land of Uz; the cup also shall pass through unto thee: thou shalt be drunken, and shalt make thyself naked.

Edom the earth <u>07\_JUD\_05\_04</u> # LORD, when thou wentest out of Seir, when thou marchedst out of the field of Edom, the earth trembled, and the heavens dropped, the clouds also dropped water.

Edom the wilderness <u>06\_JOS\_15\_01</u># [This] then was the lot of the tribe of the children of Judah by their families; [even] to the border of Edom the wilderness of Zin southward [was] the uttermost part of the south coast.

Edom these are <u>01\_GEN\_36\_17</u> # And these [are] the sons of Reuel Esau's son; duke Nahath, duke Zerah, duke Shammah, duke Mizzah: these [are] the dukes [that came] of Reuel in the land of Edom; these [are] the sons of Bashemath Esau's wife.

Edom these were <u>01\_GEN\_36\_16</u> # Duke Korah, duke Gatam, [and] duke Amalek: these [are] the dukes [that came] of Eliphaz in the land of Edom; these [were] the sons of Adah.

Edom throughout all <u>10\_2SA\_08\_14</u> # And he put garrisons in Edom; throughout all Edom put he garrisons, and all they of Edom became David's servants. And the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

Edom thus saith <u>24\_JER\_49\_07</u># Concerning Edom, thus saith the LORD of hosts; [Is] wisdom no more in Teman? is counsel perished from the prudent? is their wisdom vanished?

Edom Thus saith <u>04\_NUM\_20\_14</u> # And Moses sent messengers from Kadesh unto the king of Edom, Thus saith thy brother Israel, Thou knowest all the travail that hath befallen us:

Edom We have <u>31\_OBA\_01\_01</u># The vision of Obadiah. Thus saith the Lord GOD concerning Edom; We have heard a rumour from the LORD, and an ambassador is sent among the heathen, Arise ye, and let us rise up against her in battle.

Edom went down <u>12\_2KI\_03\_12</u># And Jehoshaphat said, The word of the LORD is with him. So the king of Israel and Jehoshaphat and the king of Edom went down to him.

Edom were duke <u>13\_1CH\_01\_51</u># Hadad died also. And the dukes of Edom were; duke Timnah, duke Aliah, duke Jetheth,

Edom will I <u>19\_PSA\_108\_09</u> # Moab [is] my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe; over Philistia will I triumph.

Edom will I <u>19\_PSA\_60\_08</u> # Moab [is] my washpot; over Edom will I cast out my shoe: Philistia, triumph thou because of me.

Edom with dyed <u>23\_ISA\_63\_01</u> # Who [is] this that cometh from Edom, with dyed garments from Bozrah? this [that is] glorious in his apparel, travelling in the greatness of his strength? I that speak in righteousness, mighty to save.

Edom would not <u>07\_JUD\_11\_17</u># Then Israel sent messengers unto the king of Edom, saying, Let me, I pray thee, pass through thy land: but the king of Edom would not hearken [thereto]. And in like manner they sent unto the king of Moab: but he would not [consent]: and Israel abode in Kadesh.

Edom <u>13\_1CH\_01\_54</u># Duke Magdiel, duke Iram. These [are] the dukes of Edom.

Edom <u>11\_1KI\_09\_26</u># And king Solomon made a navy of ships in Eziongeber, which [is] beside Eloth, on the shore of the Red sea, in the land of Edom.

Edom <u>11\_1KI\_11\_14</u># And the LORD stirred up an adversary unto Solomon, Hadad the Edomite: he [was] of the king's seed in Edom.

Edom <u>11\_1KI\_11\_15</u># For it came to pass, when David was in Edom, and Joab the captain of the host was gone up to bury the slain, after he had smitten every male in Edom;

Edom <u>11\_1KI\_11\_16</u># [For six months did Joab remain there with all Israel, until he had cut off every male in Edom:]

Edom <u>14\_2CH\_08\_17</u># Then went Solomon to Eziongeber, and to Eloth, at the sea side in the land of Edom.

Edom <u>14\_2CH\_25\_20</u> # But Amaziah would not hear; for it [came] of God, that he might deliver them into the hand [of their enemies], because they sought after the gods of Edom.

Edom <u>12\_2KI\_03\_08</u># And he said, Which way shall we go up? And he answered, The way through the wilderness of Edom.

Edom <u>30\_AMO\_01\_06</u># Thus saith the LORD; For three transgressions of Gaza, and for four, I will not turn away [the punishment] thereof; because they carried away captive the whole captivity, to deliver [them] up to Edom:

Edom <u>01\_GEN\_25\_30</u> # And Esau said to Jacob, Feed me, I pray thee, with that same red [pottage]; for I [am] faint: therefore was his name called Edom.

Edom <u>01\_GEN\_32\_03</u> # And Jacob sent messengers before him to Esau his brother unto the land of Seir,

Edom <u>01\_GEN\_36\_01</u> # Now these [are] the generations of Esau, who [is] Edom.

Edom <u>01\_GEN\_36\_08</u> # Thus dwelt Esau in mount Seir: Esau [is] Edom.

Edom <u>01\_GEN\_36\_21</u> # And Dishon, and Ezer, and Dishan: these [are] the dukes of the Horites, the children of Seir in the land of Edom.

Edom <u>04\_NUM\_33\_37</u> # And they removed from Kadesh, and pitched in mount Hor, in the edge of the land of Edom.

Edom <u>19\_PSA\_108\_10</u># Who will bring me into the strong city? who will lead me into Edom?

Edom <u>19\_PSA\_60\_09</u># Who will bring me [into] the strong city? who will lead me into Edom?

Edomite came and <u>19\_PSA\_52\_01</u># To the chief Musician, Maschil, [A Psalm] of David, when Doeg the Edomite came and told Saul, and said unto him, David is come to the house of Ahimelech. Why boastest thou thyself in mischief, O mighty man? the goodness of God [endureth] continually.

Edomite for he <u>05\_DEU\_23\_07</u># Thou shalt not abhor an Edomite; for he [is] thy brother: thou shalt not abhor an Egyptian; because thou wast a stranger in his land.

Edomite he was <u>11\_1KI\_11\_14</u># And the LORD stirred up an adversary unto Solomon, Hadad the Edomite: he [was] of the king's seed in Edom.

Edomite the chiefest <u>09\_1SA\_21\_07</u> # Now a certain man of the servants of Saul [was] there that day, detained before the LORD; and his name [was] Doeg, an Edomite, the chiefest of the herdmen that [belonged] to Saul.

Edomite turned and <u>09\_1SA\_22\_18</u> # And the king said to Doeg, Turn thou, and fall upon the priests. And Doeg the Edomite turned, and he fell upon the priests, and slew on that day fourscore and five persons that did wear a linen ephod.

Edomite was there <u>09\_1SA\_22\_22</u># And David said unto Abiathar, I knew [it] that day, when Doeg the Edomite [was] there, that he would surely tell Saul: I have occasioned [the death] of all the persons of thy father's house.

Edomite which was <u>09\_1SA\_22\_09</u># Then answered Doeg the Edomite, which was set over the servants of Saul, and said, I saw the son of Jesse coming to Nob, to Ahimelech the son of Ahitub.

Edomites and thine <u>14\_2CH\_25\_19</u> # Thou sayest, Lo, thou hast smitten the Edomites; and thine heart lifteth thee up to boast: abide now at home; why shouldest thou meddle to [thine] hurt, that thou shouldest fall, [even] thou, and Judah with thee?

Edomites became David's <u>13\_1CH\_18\_13</u> # And he put garrisons in Edom; and all the Edomites became David's servants. Thus the LORD preserved David whithersoever he went.

Edomites had come <u>14\_2CH\_28\_17</u># For again the Edomites had come and smitten Judah, and carried away captives.

Edomites in mount <u>01\_GEN\_36\_09</u> # And these [are] the generations of Esau the father of the Edomites in mount Seir:

Edomites in the <u>13\_1CH\_18\_12</u> # Moreover Abishai the son of Zeruiah slew of the Edomites in the valley of

salt eighteen thousand.

Edomites revolted from <u>14\_2CH\_21\_08</u># In his days the Edomites revolted from under the dominion of Judah, and made themselves a king.

Edomites revolted from <u>14\_2CH\_21\_10</u> # So the Edomites revolted from under the hand of Judah unto this day. The same time [also] did Libnah revolt from under his hand; because he had forsaken the LORD God of his fathers.

Edomites that he <u>14\_2CH\_25\_14</u># Now it came to pass, after that Amaziah was come from the slaughter of the Edomites, that he brought the gods of the children of Seir, and set them up [to be] his gods, and bowed down himself before them, and burned incense unto them.

Edomites which compassed <u>14\_2CH\_21\_09</u># Then Jehoram went forth with his princes, and all his chariots with him: and he rose up by night, and smote the Edomites which compassed him in, and the captains of the chariots.

Edomites which compassed <u>12\_2KI\_08\_21</u># So Joram went over to Zair, and all the chariots with him: and he rose by night, and smote the Edomites which compassed him about, and the captains of the chariots: and the people fled into their tents.

Edomites Zidonians and <u>11\_1KI\_11\_01</u># But king Solomon loved many strange women, together with the daughter of Pharaoh, women of the Moabites, Ammonites, Edomites, Zidonians, [and] Hittites;

Edomites <u>01\_GEN\_36\_43</u># Duke Magdiel, duke Iram: these [be] the dukes of Edom, according to their habitations in the land of their possession: he [is] Esau the father of the Edomites.

freedom And Paul <u>44\_ACT\_22\_28</u> # And the chief captain answered, With a great sum obtained I this freedom. And Paul said, But I was [free] born.

freedom given her <u>03\_LEV\_19\_20</u> # And whosoever lieth carnally with a woman, that [is] a bondmaid, betrothed to an husband, and not at all redeemed, nor freedom given her; she shall be scourged; they shall not be put to death, because she was not free.

Obededom also the <u>13\_1CH\_16\_38</u># And Obededom with their brethren, threescore and eight; Obededom also the son of Jeduthun and Hosah [to be] porters:

Obededom and all <u>13\_1CH\_13\_14</u> # And the ark of God remained with the family of Obededom in his house three months. And the LORD blessed the house of Obededom, and all that he had.

Obededom and all <u>10\_2SA\_06\_11</u> # And the ark of the LORD continued in the house of Obededom the Gittite three months: and the LORD blessed Obededom, and all his household.

Obededom and Jeiel <u>13\_1CH\_15\_18</u># And with them their brethren of the second [degree], Zechariah,

Ben, and Jaaziel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Unni, Eliab, and Benaiah, and Maaseiah, and Mattithiah, and Elipheleh, and Mikneiah, and Obededom, and Jeiel, the porters.

Obededom and Jeiel <u>13\_1CH\_15\_21</u> # And Mattithiah, and Elipheleh, and Mikneiah, and Obededom, and Jeiel, and Azaziah, with harps on the Sheminith to excel.

Obededom and Jeiel <u>13\_1CH\_16\_05</u># Asaph the chief, and next to him Zechariah, Jeiel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehiel, and Mattithiah, and Eliab, and Benaiah, and Obededom: and Jeiel with psalteries and with harps; but Asaph made a sound with cymbals;

Obededom and the <u>14\_2CH\_25\_24</u> # And [he took] all the gold and the silver, and all the vessels that were found in the house of God with Obededom, and the treasures of the king's house, the hostages also, and returned to Samaria.

Obededom in his <u>13\_1CH\_13\_14</u># And the ark of God remained with the family of Obededom in his house three months. And the LORD blessed the house of Obededom, and all that he had.

Obededom into the <u>10\_2SA\_06\_12</u> # And it was told king David, saying, The LORD hath blessed the house of Obededom, and all that [pertaineth] unto him, because of the ark of God. So David went and brought up the ark of God from the house of Obededom into the city of David with gladness.

Obededom southward and <u>13\_1CH\_26\_15</u># To Obededom southward; and to his sons the house of Asuppim.

Obededom the Gittite <u>13\_1CH\_13\_13</u> # So David brought not the ark [home] to himself to the city of David, but carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite.

Obededom the Gittite <u>10\_2SA\_06\_10</u> # So David would not remove the ark of the LORD unto him into the city of David: but David carried it aside into the house of Obededom the Gittite.

Obededom the Gittite <u>10\_2SA\_06\_11</u># And the ark of the LORD continued in the house of Obededom the Gittite three months: and the LORD blessed Obededom, and all his household.

Obededom they and <u>13\_1CH\_26\_08</u># All these of the sons of Obededom: they and their sons and their brethren, able men for strength for the service, [were] threescore and two of Obededom.

Obededom were Shemaiah <u>13\_1CH\_26\_04</u> # Moreover the sons of Obededom [were], Shemaiah the firstborn, Jehozabad the second, Joah the third, and Sacar the fourth, and Nethaneel the fifth,
