Eglon and all <u>06_JOS_10_34</u> # And from Lachish Joshua passed unto Eglon, and all Israel with him; and they encamped against it, and fought against it:

Eglon and all <u>06_JOS_10_36</u># And Joshua went up from Eglon, and all Israel with him, unto Hebron; and they fought against it:

Eglon but destroyed <u>06_JOS_10_37</u># And they took it, and smote it with the edge of the sword, and the king thereof, and all the cities thereof, and all the souls that [were] therein; he left none remaining, according to all that he had done to Eglon; but destroyed it utterly, and all the souls that [were] therein.

Eglon gathered themselves <u>06_JOS_10_05</u> # Therefore the five kings of the Amorites, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, the king of Eglon, gathered themselves together, and went up, they and all their hosts, and encamped before Gibeon, and made war against it.

Eglon king of <u>07_JUD_03_17</u># And he brought the present unto Eglon king of Moab: and Eglon [was] a very fat man.

Eglon one the 06_JOS_12_12 # The king of Eglon, one; the king of Gezer, one;

Eglon saying <u>06_JOS_10_03</u> # Wherefore Adonizedek king of Jerusalem sent unto Hoham king of Hebron, and unto Piram king of Jarmuth, and unto Japhia king of Lachish, and unto Debir king of Eglon, saying,

Eglon the king <u>07_JUD_03_12</u># And the children of Israel did evil again in the sight of the LORD: and the LORD strengthened Eglon the king of Moab against Israel, because they had done evil in the sight of the LORD.

Eglon the king <u>07_JUD_03_14</u> # So the children of Israel served Eglon the king of Moab eighteen years.

Eglon the king <u>07_JUD_03_15</u># But when the children of Israel cried unto the LORD, the LORD raised them up a deliverer, Ehud the son of Gera, a Benjamite, a man lefthanded: and by him the children of Israel sent a present unto Eglon the king of Moab.

Eglon was a <u>07_JUD_03_17</u># And he brought the present unto Eglon king of Moab: and Eglon [was] a very fat man.

Eglon <u>06_JOS_10_23</u># And they did so, and brought forth those five kings unto him out of the cave, the king of Jerusalem, the king of Hebron, the king of Jarmuth, the king of Lachish, [and] the king of Eglon.
