Egyptian whose name <u>01_GEN_16_01</u># Now Sarai Abram's wife bare him no children: and she had an handmaid, an Egyptian, whose name [was] Hagar.

Egyptian women for <u>02_EXO_01_19</u># And the midwives said unto Pharaoh, Because the Hebrew women [are] not as the Egyptian women; for they [are] lively, and are delivered ere the midwives come in unto them.

Egyptian yesterday <u>44_ACT_07_28</u> # Wilt thou kill me, as thou diddest the Egyptian yesterday?

Egyptian <u>44_ACT_07_24</u> # And seeing one [of them] suffer wrong, he defended [him], and avenged him that was oppressed, and smote the Egyptian:

Egyptians buried all <u>04_NUM_33_04</u> # For the Egyptians buried all [their] firstborn, which the LORD had smitten among them: upon their gods also the LORD executed judgments.

Egyptians came unto <u>01_GEN_47_15</u> # And when money failed in the land of Egypt, and in the land of

Canaan, all the Egyptians came unto Joseph, and said, Give us bread: for why should we die in thy presence? for the money faileth.

Egyptians could not <u>02_EXO_07_21</u> # And the fish that [was] in the river died; and the river stank, and the Egyptians could not drink of the water of the river; and there was blood throughout all the land of Egypt.

Egyptians dead upon <u>02_EXO_14_30</u># Thus the LORD saved Israel that day out of the hand of the Egyptians; and Israel saw the Egyptians dead upon the sea shore.

Egyptians digged round <u>02_EXO_07_24</u> # And all the Egyptians digged round about the river for water to drink; for they could not drink of the water of the river.

Egyptians evil entreated <u>05_DEU_26_06</u># And the Egyptians evil entreated us, and afflicted us, and laid upon us hard bondage:

Egyptians fled against <u>02_EXO_14_27</u> # And Moses stretched forth his hand over the sea, and the sea returned to his strength when the morning appeared; and the Egyptians fled against it; and the LORD overthrew the Egyptians in the midst of the sea.

Egyptians for I <u>02_EXO_15_26</u> # And said, If thou wilt diligently hearken to the voice of the LORD thy God, and wilt do that which is right in his sight, and wilt give ear to his commandments, and keep all his statutes, I will put none of these diseases upon thee, which I have brought upon the Egyptians: for I [am] the LORD that healeth thee.

Egyptians for Israel's <u>02_EXO_18_08</u># And Moses told his father in law all that the LORD had done unto Pharaoh and to the Egyptians for Israel's sake, [and] all the travail that had come upon them by the way, and [how] the LORD delivered them.

Egyptians For it <u>02_EXO_14_12</u> # [Is] not this the word that we did tell thee in Egypt, saying, Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians? For [it had been] better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness.

Egyptians for the <u>26_EZE_23_21</u> # Thus thou calledst to remembrance the lewdness of thy youth, in bruising thy teats by the Egyptians for the paps of thy youth.

Egyptians jewels of <u>02_EXO_12_35</u> # And the children of Israel did according to the word of Moses; and they borrowed of the Egyptians jewels of silver, and jewels of gold, and raiment:

Egyptians keep in <u>02_EXO_06_05</u># And I have also heard the groaning of the children of Israel, whom the Egyptians keep in bondage; and I have remembered my covenant.

Egyptians made the <u>02_EXO_01_13</u># And the Egyptians made the children of Israel to serve with rigour:

Egyptians marched after <u>02_EXO_14_10</u> # And when Pharaoh drew nigh, the children of Israel lifted up their eyes, and, behold, the Egyptians marched after them; and they were sore afraid: and the children of

Egyptians may know <u>02_EXO_14_04</u> # And I will harden Pharaoh's heart, that he shall follow after them; and I will be honoured upon Pharaoh, and upon all his host; that the Egyptians may know that I [am] the LORD. And they did so.

Egyptians might not <u>01_GEN_43_32</u> # And they set on for him by himself, and for them by themselves, and for the Egyptians, which did eat with him, by themselves: because the Egyptians might not eat bread with the Hebrews; for that [is] an abomination unto the Egyptians.

Egyptians Moreover the <u>02_EXO_11_03</u># And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians. Moreover the man Moses [was] very great in the land of Egypt, in the sight of Pharaoh's servants, and in the sight of the people.

Egyptians mourned for <u>01_GEN_50_03</u># And forty days were fulfilled for him; for so are fulfilled the days of those which are embalmed: and the Egyptians mourned for him threescore and ten days.

Egyptians oppress them <u>02_EXO_03_09</u> # Now therefore, behold, the cry of the children of Israel is come unto me: and I have also seen the oppression wherewith the Egyptians oppress them.

Egyptians prisoners and <u>23_ISA_20_04</u> # So shall the king of Assyria lead away the Egyptians prisoners, and the Ethiopians captives, young and old, naked and barefoot, even with [their] buttocks uncovered, to the shame of Egypt.

Egyptians pursued after <u>02_EXO_14_09</u> # But the Egyptians pursued after them, all the horses [and] chariots of Pharaoh, and his horsemen, and his army, and overtook them encamping by the sea, beside Pihahiroth, before Baalzephon.

Egyptians pursued after <u>06_JOS_24_06</u># And I brought your fathers out of Egypt: and ye came unto the sea; and the Egyptians pursued after your fathers with chariots and horsemen unto the Red sea.

Egyptians pursued and <u>02_EXO_14_23</u># And the Egyptians pursued, and went in after them to the midst of the sea, [even] all Pharaoh's horses, his chariots, and his horsemen.

Egyptians said Let <u>02_EXO_14_25</u> # And took off their chariot wheels, that they drave them heavily: so that the Egyptians said, Let us flee from the face of Israel; for the LORD fighteth for them against the Egyptians.

Egyptians shall be <u>02_EXO_08_21</u> # Else, if thou wilt not let my people go, behold, I will send swarms [of flies] upon thee, and upon thy servants, and upon thy people, and into thy houses: and the houses of the Egyptians shall be full of swarms [of flies], and also the ground whereon they [are].

Egyptians shall he <u>24_JER_43_13</u># He shall break also the images of Bethshemesh, that [is] in the land of Egypt; and the houses of the gods of the Egyptians shall he burn with fire.

Egyptians shall hear <u>04_NUM_14_13</u># And Moses said unto the LORD, Then the Egyptians shall hear [it], [for thou broughtest up this people in thy might from among them;]

Egyptians shall help <u>23_ISA_30_07</u># For the Egyptians shall help in vain, and to no purpose: therefore have I cried concerning this, Their strength [is] to sit still.

Egyptians shall know <u>02_EXO_07_05</u> # And the Egyptians shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I stretch forth mine hand upon Egypt, and bring out the children of Israel from among them.

Egyptians shall know <u>02_EXO_14_18</u> # And the Egyptians shall know that I [am] the LORD, when I have

gotten me honour upon Pharaoh, upon his chariots, and upon his horsemen.

Egyptians shall know 23_ISA_19_21 # And the LORD shall be known to Egypt, and the Egyptians shall know the LORD in that day, and shall do sacrifice and oblation; yea, they shall vow a vow unto the LORD, and perform [it].

Egyptians shall loathe <u>02_EXO_07_18</u># And the fish that [is] in the river shall die, and the river shall stink; and the Egyptians shall loathe to drink of the water of the river.

Egyptians shall see <u>01_GEN_12_12</u># Therefore it shall come to pass, when the Egyptians shall see thee, that they shall say, This [is] his wife: and they will kill me, but they will save thee alive.

Egyptians shall serve 23_ISA_19_23 # In that day shall there be a highway out of Egypt to Assyria, and the Assyrian shall come into Egypt, and the Egyptian into Assyria, and the Egyptians shall serve with the Assyrians.

Egyptians so that <u>02_EXO_12_36</u># And the LORD gave the people favour in the sight of the Egyptians, so that they lent unto them [such things as they required]. And they spoiled the Egyptians.

Egyptians sold every <u>01_GEN_47_20</u> # And Joseph bought all the land of Egypt for Pharaoh; for the Egyptians sold every man his field, because the famine prevailed over them: so the land became Pharaoh's.

Egyptians speak and <u>02_EXO_32_12</u># Wherefore should the Egyptians speak, and say, For mischief did he bring them out, to slay them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth? Turn from thy fierce wrath, and repent of this evil against thy people.

Egyptians than that <u>02_EXO_14_12</u># [Is] not this the word that we did tell thee in Egypt, saying, Let us alone, that we may serve the Egyptians? For [it had been] better for us to serve the Egyptians, than that we should die in the wilderness.

Egyptians upon their <u>02_EXO_14_26</u> # And the LORD said unto Moses, Stretch out thine hand over the sea, that the waters may come again upon the Egyptians, upon their chariots, and upon their horsemen.

Egyptians vexed us <u>04_NUM_20_15</u> # How our fathers went down into Egypt, and we have dwelt in Egypt a long time; and the Egyptians vexed us, and our fathers:

Egyptians were urgent <u>02_EXO_12_33</u> # And the Egyptians were urgent upon the people, that they might send them out of the land in haste; for they said, We [be] all dead [men].

Egyptians wherefore the <u>01_GEN_50_11</u> # And when the inhabitants of the land, the Canaanites, saw the mourning in the floor of Atad, they said, This [is] a grievous mourning to the Egyptians: wherefore the name of it was called Abelmizraim, which [is] beyond Jordan.

Egyptians which did 01_GEN_43_32 # And they set on for him by himself, and for them by themselves, and

Egyptians <u>01_GEN_43_32</u> # And they set on for him by himself, and for them by themselves, and for the Egyptians, which did eat with him, by themselves: because the Egyptians might not eat bread with the Hebrews; for that [is] an abomination unto the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>01_GEN_46_34</u> # That ye shall say, Thy servants' trade hath been about cattle from our youth even until now, both we, [and] also our fathers: that ye may dwell in the land of Goshen; for every shepherd [is] an abomination unto the Egyptians.

Egyptians <u>04_NUM_33_03</u> # And they departed from Rameses in the first month, on the fifteenth day of the first month; on the morrow after the passover the children of Israel went out with an high hand in the sight of all the Egyptians.
