**Bethanath and Bethshemesh [06 JOS 19 38](#) # And Iron, and Migdalel, Horem, and Bethanath, and Bethshemesh; nineteen cities with their villages.**

**Bethanath became tributaries [07 JUD 01 33](#) # Neither did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Bethshemesh, nor the inhabitants of Bethanath; but he dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: nevertheless the inhabitants of Bethshemesh and of Bethanath became tributaries unto them.**

**Bethanath but he [07 JUD 01 33](#) # Neither did Naphtali drive out the inhabitants of Bethshemesh, nor the inhabitants of Bethanath; but he dwelt among the Canaanites, the inhabitants of the land: nevertheless the inhabitants of Bethshemesh and of Bethanath became tributaries unto them.**

**Bethanoth and Eltekon [06 JOS 15 59](#) # And Maarath, and Bethanoth, and Eltekon; six cities with their villages:**

**Bethany and he [42 LUK 24 50](#) # And he led them out as far as to Bethany, and he lifted up his hands, and blessed them.**

**Bethany and he [40 MAT 21 17](#) # And he left them, and went out of the city into Bethany; and he lodged there.**

**Bethany at the [42 LUK 19 29](#) # And it came to pass, when he was come nigh to Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount called [the mount] of Olives, he sent two of his disciples,**

**Bethany at the [41 MAR 11 01](#) # And when they came nigh to Jerusalem, unto Bethphage and Bethany, at the mount of Olives, he sendeth forth two of his disciples,**

**Bethany he was [41 MAR 11 12](#) # And on the morrow, when they were come from Bethany, he was hungry:**

**Bethany in the [41 MAR 14 03](#) # And being in Bethany in the house of Simon the leper, as he sat at meat, there came a woman having an alabaster box of ointment of spikenard very precious; and she brake the box, and poured [it] on his head.**

**Bethany in the [40 MAT 26 06](#) # Now when Jesus was in Bethany, in the house of Simon the leper,**

**Bethany the town [43 JOH 11 01](#) # Now a certain [man] was sick, [named] Lazarus, of Bethany, the town of Mary and her sister Martha.**

**Bethany was nigh [43 JOH 11 18](#) # Now Bethany was nigh unto Jerusalem, about fifteen furlongs off:**

**Bethany where Lazarus [43 JOH 12 01](#) # Then Jesus six days before the passover came to Bethany, where Lazarus was which had been dead, whom he raised from the dead.**

**Bethany with the [41 MAR 11 11](#) # And Jesus entered into Jerusalem, and into the temple: and when he had looked round about upon all things, and now the eventide was come, he went out unto Bethany with the twelve.**

**Ethan and Heman [13 1CH 02 06](#) # And the sons of Zerah; Zimri, and Ethan, and Heman, and Calcol, and**

**Dara: five of them in all.**

**Ethan Azariah [13 1CH 02 08](#) # And the sons of Ethan; Azariah.**

**Ethan the Ezrahite [11 1KI 04 31](#) # For he was wiser than all men; than Ethan the Ezrahite, and Heman, and Chalcol, and Darda, the sons of Mahol: and his fame was in all nations round about.**

**Ethan the Ezrahite [19 PSA 89 01](#) # Maschil of Ethan the Ezrahite. I will sing of the mercies of the LORD for ever: with my mouth will I make known thy faithfulness to all generations.**

**Ethan the son [13 1CH 06 42](#) # The son of Ethan, the son of Zimmah, the son of Shimei,**

**Ethan the son [13 1CH 06 44](#) # And their brethren the sons of Merari [stood] on the left hand: Ethan the son of Kishi, the son of Abdi, the son of Malluch,**

**Ethan the son [13 1CH 15 17](#) # So the Levites appointed Heman the son of Joel; and of his brethren, Asaph the son of Berechiah; and of the sons of Merari their brethren, Ethan the son of Kushaiah;**

**Ethan were appointed [13 1CH 15 19](#) # So the singers, Heman, Asaph, and Ethan, [were appointed] to sound with cymbals of brass;**

**Ethan which is [11 1KI 08 02](#) # And all the men of Israel assembled themselves unto king Solomon at the feast in the month Ethan, which [is] the seventh month.**

**Nethaneel and Amasai [13 1CH 15 24](#) # And Shebaniah, and Jehoshaphat, and Nethaneel, and Amasai, and Zechariah, and Benaiah, and Eliezer, the priests, did blow with the trumpets before the ark of God: and Obededom and Jehiah [were] doorkeepers for the ark.**

**Nethaneel and Judah [16 NEH 12 36](#) # And his brethren, Shemaiah, and Azarael, Milalai, Gilalai, Maai, Nethaneel, and Judah, Hanani, with the musical instruments of David the man of God, and Ezra the scribe before them.**

**Nethaneel and to [14 2CH 17 07](#) # Also in the third year of his reign he sent to his princes, [even] to Benhail, and to Obadiah, and to Zechariah, and to Nethaneel, and to Michaiah, to teach in the cities of Judah.**

**Nethaneel his brethren [14 2CH 35 09](#) # Conaniah also, and Shemaiah and Nethaneel, his brethren, and Hashabiah and Jeiel and Jozabad, chief of the Levites, gave unto the Levites for passover offerings five thousand [small cattle], and five hundred oxen.**

**Nethaneel Jozabad and [15 EZR 10 22](#) # And of the sons of Pashur; Elioenai, Maaseiah, Ishmael, Nethaneel, Jozabad, and Elasah.**

**Nethaneel the fifth [13 1CH 26 04](#) # Moreover the sons of Obededom [were], Shemaiah the firstborn, Jehozabad the second, Joah the third, and Sacar the fourth, and Nethaneel the fifth,**

**Nethaneel the fourth [13 1CH 02 14](#) # Nethaneel the fourth, Raddai the fifth,**

**Nethaneel the scribe [13 1CH 24 06](#) # And Shemaiah the son of Nethaneel the scribe, [one] of the Levites, wrote them before the king, and the princes, and Zadok the priest, and Ahimelech the son of Abiathar, and [before] the chief of the fathers of the priests and Levites: one principal household being taken for Eleazar, and [one] taken for Ithamar.**

**Nethaneel the son [04 NUM 01 08](#) # Of Issachar; Nethaneel the son of Zuar.**

Nethaneel the son [04\\_NUM\\_02\\_05](#) # And those that do pitch next unto him [shall be] the tribe of Issachar: and Nethaneel the son of Zuar [shall be] captain of the children of Issachar.

Nethaneel the son [04\\_NUM\\_07\\_18](#) # On the second day Nethaneel the son of Zuar, prince of Issachar, did offer:

Nethaneel the son [04\\_NUM\\_07\\_23](#) # And for a sacrifice of peace offerings, two oxen, five rams, five he goats, five lambs of the first year: this [was] the offering of Nethaneel the son of Zuar.

Nethaneel the son [04\\_NUM\\_10\\_15](#) # And over the host of the tribe of the children of Issachar [was] Nethaneel the son of Zuar.

Nethaneel [16\\_NEH\\_12\\_21](#) # Of Hilkiah, Hashabiah; of Jedaiah, Nethaneel.

Nethaniah and Asarelah [13\\_1CH\\_25\\_02](#) # Of the sons of Asaph; Zaccur, and Joseph, and Nethaniah, and Asarelah, the sons of Asaph under the hands of Asaph, which prophesied according to the order of the king.

Nethaniah and found [24\\_JER\\_41\\_12](#) # Then they took all the men, and went to fight with Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and found him by the great waters that [are] in Gibeon.

Nethaniah and Johanan [12\\_2KI\\_25\\_23](#) # And when all the captains of the armies, they and their men, heard that the king of Babylon had made Gedaliah governor, there came to Gedaliah to Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and Johanan the son of Careah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth the Netophathite, and Jaazaniah the son of a Maachathite, they and their men.

Nethaniah and Johanan [24\\_JER\\_40\\_08](#) # Then they came to Gedaliah to Mizpah, even Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and Johanan and Jonathan the sons of Kareah, and Seraiah the son of Tanhumeth, and the sons of Ephai the Netophathite, and Jezaniah the son of a Maachathite, they and their men.

Nethaniah and no [24\\_JER\\_40\\_15](#) # Then Johanan the son of Kareah spake to Gedaliah in Mizpah secretly, saying, Let me go, I pray thee, and I will slay Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and no man shall know [it]: wherefore should he slay thee, that all the Jews which are gathered unto thee should be scattered, and the remnant in Judah perish?

Nethaniah and the [24\\_JER\\_41\\_02](#) # Then arose Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, and the ten men that were with him, and smote Gedaliah the son of Ahikam the son of Shaphan with the sword, and slew him, whom the king of Babylon had made governor over the land.

Nethaniah and Zebadiah [14\\_2CH\\_17\\_08](#) # And with them [he sent] Levites, [even] Shemaiah, and Nethaniah, and Zebadiah, and Asahel, and Shemiramoth, and Jehonathan, and Adonijah, and Tobijah, and Tobadonijah, Levites; and with them Elishama and Jehoram, priests.

Nethaniah carried them [24\\_JER\\_41\\_10](#) # Then Ishmael carried away captive all the residue of the people that [were] in Mizpah, [even] the king's daughters, and all the people that remained in Mizpah, whom Nebuzaradan the captain of the guard had committed to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam: and Ishmael the son of Nethaniah carried them away captive, and departed to go over to the Ammonites.

Nethaniah escaped from [24\\_JER\\_41\\_15](#) # But Ishmael the son of Nethaniah escaped from Johanan with eight men, and went to the Ammonites.

Nethaniah filled it [24\\_JER\\_41\\_09](#) # Now the pit wherein Ishmael had cast all the dead bodies of the men, whom he had slain because of Gedaliah, [was] it which Asa the king had made for fear of Baasha king of Israel: [and] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah filled it with [them that were] slain.

Nethaniah from Mizpah [24\\_JER\\_41\\_16](#) # Then took Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the

forces that [were] with him, all the remnant of the people whom he had recovered from Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, from Mizpah, after [that] he had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, [even] mighty men of war, and the women, and the children, and the eunuchs, whom he had brought again from Gibeon:

Nethaniah had done [24 JER 41 11](#) # But when Johanan the son of Kareah, and all the captains of the forces that [were] with him, heard of all the evil that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had done,

Nethaniah had slain [24 JER 41 18](#) # Because of the Chaldeans: for they were afraid of them, because Ishmael the son of Nethaniah had slain Gedaliah the son of Ahikam, whom the king of Babylon made governor in the land.

Nethaniah he his [13 1CH 25 12](#) # The fifth to Nethaniah, [he], his sons, and his brethren, [were] twelve:

Nethaniah slew them [24 JER 41 07](#) # And it was [so], when they came into the midst of the city, that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah slew them, [and cast them] into the midst of the pit, he, and the men that [were] with him.

Nethaniah the son [12 2KI 25 25](#) # But it came to pass in the seventh month, that Ishmael the son of Nethaniah, the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, came, and ten men with him, and smote Gedaliah, that he died, and the Jews and the Chaldees that were with him at Mizpah.

Nethaniah the son [24 JER 36 14](#) # Therefore all the princes sent Jehudi the son of Nethaniah, the son of Shelemiah, the son of Cushi, unto Baruch, saying, Take in thine hand the roll wherein thou hast read in the ears of the people, and come. So Baruch the son of Neriah took the roll in his hand, and came unto them.

Nethaniah the son [24 JER 41 01](#) # Now it came to pass in the seventh month, [that] Ishmael the son of Nethaniah the son of Elishama, of the seed royal, and the princes of the king, even ten men with him, came unto Gedaliah the son of Ahikam to Mizpah; and there they did eat bread together in Mizpah.

Nethaniah to slay [24 JER 40 14](#) # And said unto him, Dost thou certainly know that Baalis the king of the Ammonites hath sent Ishmael the son of Nethaniah to slay thee? But Gedaliah the son of Ahikam believed them not.

Nethaniah went forth [24 JER 41 06](#) # And Ishmael the son of Nethaniah went forth from Mizpah to meet them, weeping all along as he went: and it came to pass, as he met them, he said unto them, Come to Gedaliah the son of Ahikam.

Zethan and Tharshish [13 1CH 07 10](#) # The sons also of Jediahel; Bilhan: and the sons of Bilhan; Jeush, and Benjamin, and Ehud, and Chenaanah, and Zethan, and Tharshish, and Ahishahar.
