Ethiopians afraid and <u>26_EZE_30_09</u># In that day shall messengers go forth from me in ships to make the careless Ethiopians afraid, and great pain shall come upon them, as in the day of Egypt: for, lo, it cometh.

Ethiopians also ye 36_ZEP_02_12 # Ye Ethiopians also, ye [shall be] slain by my sword.

Ethiopians and the 14_2CH_16_08# Were not the Ethiopians and the Lubims a huge host, with very many chariots and horsemen? yet, because thou didst rely on the LORD, he delivered them into thine hand.

Ethiopians and the 24_JER_46_09 # Come up, ye horses; and rage, ye chariots; and let the mighty men come forth; the Ethiopians and the Libyans, that handle the shield; and the Lydians, that handle [and] bend the bow.

Ethiopians before Asa <u>14_2CH_14_12</u># So the LORD smote the Ethiopians before Asa, and before Judah; and the Ethiopians fled.

Ethiopians captives young <u>23_ISA_20_04</u># So shall the king of Assyria lead away the Egyptians prisoners, and the Ethiopians captives, young and old, naked and barefoot, even with [their] buttocks uncovered, to the shame of Egypt.

Ethiopians fled 14_2CH_14_12 # So the LORD smote the Ethiopians before Asa, and before Judah; and the Ethiopians fled.

Ethiopians shall be <u>27_DAN_11_43</u># But he shall have power over the treasures of gold and of silver, and over all the precious things of Egypt: and the Libyans and the Ethiopians [shall be] at his steps.

Ethiopians unto me <u>30_AMO_09_07</u> # [Are] ye not as children of the Ethiopians unto me, O children of Israel? saith the LORD. Have not I brought up Israel out of the land of Egypt? and the Philistines from Caphtor, and the Syrians from Kir?

Ethiopians were overthrown 14 2CH 14 13 # And Asa and the people that [were] with him pursued them unto Gerar: and the Ethiopians were overthrown, that they could not recover themselves; for they were destroyed before the LORD, and before his host; and they carried away very much spoil.
