eagle against the <u>28_HOS_08_01</u> # [Set] the trumpet to thy mouth. [He shall come] as an eagle against the house of the LORD, because they have transgressed my covenant, and trespassed against my law.

eagle and shall <u>24_JER_48_40</u># For thus saith the LORD; Behold, he shall fly as an eagle, and shall spread his wings over Moab.

eagle and spread 24_JER_49_22 # Behold, he shall come up and fly as the eagle, and spread his wings over Bozrah: and at that day shall the heart of the mighty men of Edom be as the heart of a woman in her pangs.

eagle and the <u>05_DEU_14_12</u># But these [are they] of which ye shall not eat: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the osprey,

eagle and the 05_DEU_14_17 # And the pelican, and the gier eagle, and the cormorant,

eagle and the <u>03_LEV_11_13</u># And these [are they which] ye shall have in abomination among the fowls; they shall not be eaten, they [are] an abomination: the eagle, and the ossifrage, and the osprey,

eagle and though <u>31_OBA_01_04</u># Though thou exalt [thyself] as the eagle, and though thou set thy nest among the stars, thence will I bring thee down, saith the LORD.

eagle flieth a <u>05_DEU_28_49</u> # The LORD shall bring a nation against thee from far, from the end of the earth, [as swift] as the eagle flieth; a nation whose tongue thou shalt not understand;

eagle for they <u>33_MIC_01_16</u># Make thee bald, and poll thee for thy delicate children; enlarge thy baldness as the eagle; for they are gone into captivity from thee.

eagle I will <u>24_JER_49_16</u> # Thy terribleness hath deceived thee, [and] the pride of thine heart, O thou that dwellest in the clefts of the rock, that holdest the height of the hill: though thou shouldest make thy nest as high as the eagle, I will bring thee down from thence, saith the LORD.

eagle in the 20_PRO_30_19 # The way of an eagle in the air; the way of a serpent upon a rock; the way of a ship in the midst of the sea; and the way of a man with a maid.

eagle mount up 18_JOB_39_27 # Doth the eagle mount up at thy command, and make her nest on high?

eagle stirreth up <u>05_DEU_32_11</u># As an eagle stirreth up her nest, fluttereth over her young, spreadeth abroad her wings, taketh them, beareth them on her wings:

eagle that hasteth <u>35_HAB_01_08</u> # Their horses also are swifter than the leopards, and are more fierce than the evening wolves: and their horsemen shall spread themselves, and their horsemen shall come from far; they shall fly as the eagle [that] hasteth to eat.

eagle that hasteth <u>18_JOB_09_26</u># They are passed away as the swift ships: as the eagle [that] hasteth to the prey.

eagle that she <u>66_REV_12_14</u># And to the woman were given two wings of a great eagle, that she might fly into the wilderness, into her place, where she is nourished for a time, and times, and half a time, from the face of the serpent.

eagle toward heaven <u>20_PRO_23_05</u> # Wilt thou set thine eyes upon that which is not? for [riches] certainly make themselves wings; they fly away as an eagle toward heaven.

eagle with great <u>26 EZE 17_03</u> # And say, Thus saith the Lord GOD; A great eagle with great wings, longwinged, full of feathers, which had divers colours, came unto Lebanon, and took the highest branch of the cedar:

eagle with great <u>26_EZE_17_07</u># There was also another great eagle with great wings and many feathers: and, behold, this vine did bend her roots toward him, and shot forth her branches toward him, that he might water it by the furrows of her plantation.

eagle <u>26_EZE_01_10</u># As for the likeness of their faces, they four had the face of a man, and the face of a lion, on the right side: and they four had the face of an ox on the left side; they four also had the face of an eagle.

eagle <u>26_EZE_10_14</u># And every one had four faces: the first face [was] the face of a cherub, and the second face [was] the face of a man, and the third the face of a lion, and the fourth the face of an eagle.

eagle 03_LEV_11_18 # And the swan, and the pelican, and the gier eagle,

eagle <u>66_REV_04_07</u># And the first beast [was] like a lion, and the second beast like a calf, and the third beast had a face as a man, and the fourth beast [was] like a flying eagle.

eagle's wings I <u>27_DAN_07_04</u># The first [was] like a lion, and had eagle's wings: I beheld till the wings thereof were plucked, and it was lifted up from the earth, and made stand upon the feet as a man, and a man's heart was given to it.

eagle's <u>19_PSA_103_05</u># Who satisfieth thy mouth with good [things; so that] thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.

eagles be gathered <u>42_LUK_17_37</u># And they answered and said unto him, Where, Lord? And he said unto them, Wheresoever the body [is], thither will the eagles be gathered together.

eagles be gathered $\underline{40_MAT_24_28}$ # For wheresoever the carcase is, there will the eagles be gathered together.

eagles feathers and <u>27_DAN_04_33</u> # The same hour was the thing fulfilled upon Nebuchadnezzar: and he was driven from men, and did eat grass as oxen, and his body was wet with the dew of heaven, till his hairs were grown like eagles' [feathers], and his nails like birds' [claws].

eagles of the <u>25_LAM_04_19</u># Our persecutors are swifter than the eagles of the heaven: they pursued us upon the mountains, they laid wait for us in the wilderness.

eagles shall eat 20_PRO_30_17 # The eye [that] mocketh at [his] father, and despiseth to obey [his] mother, the ravens of the valley shall pick it out, and the young eagles shall eat it.

eagles they shall 23_ISA_40_31 # But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew [their] strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; [and] they shall walk, and not faint.

eagles they were 10_2SA_01_23 # Saul and Jonathan [were] lovely and pleasant in their lives, and in their death they were not divided: they were swifter than eagles, they were stronger than lions.

eagles wings and <u>02_EXO_19_04</u># Ye have seen what I did unto the Egyptians, and [how] I bare you on eagles' wings, and brought you unto myself.

eagles Woe unto <u>24_JER_04_13</u> # Behold, he shall come up as clouds, and his chariots [shall be] as a whirlwind: his horses are swifter than eagles. Woe unto us! for we are spoiled.
