clearly seen being <u>45\_ROM\_01\_20</u> # For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, [even] his eternal power and Godhead; so that they are without excuse:

clearly to cast <u>40\_MAT\_07\_05</u># Thou hypocrite, first cast out the beam out of thine own eye; and then shalt thou see clearly to cast out the mote out of thy brother's eye.

clearly to pull <u>42\_LUK\_06\_42</u> # Either how canst thou say to thy brother, Brother, let me pull out the mote that is in thine eye, when thou thyself beholdest not the beam that is in thine own eye? Thou hypocrite, cast out first the beam out of thine own eye, and then shalt thou see clearly to pull out the mote that is in thy brother's eye.

clearly <u>18\_JOB\_33\_03</u> # My words [shall be of] the uprightness of my heart: and my lips shall utter knowledge clearly.

clearly <u>41\_MAR\_08\_25</u> # After that he put [his] hands again upon his eyes, and made him look up: and he was restored, and saw every man clearly.

dearly beloved and <u>57\_PHM\_01\_01</u># Paul, a prisoner of Jesus Christ, and Timothy [our] brother, unto Philemon our dearly beloved, and fellowlabourer,

dearly beloved and <u>50\_PHP\_04\_01</u># Therefore, my brethren, dearly beloved and longed for, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, [my] dearly beloved.

Dearly beloved avenge <u>45\_ROM\_12\_19</u> # Dearly beloved, avenge not yourselves, but [rather] give place unto wrath: for it is written, Vengeance [is] mine; I will repay, saith the Lord.

dearly beloved flee <u>46\_1CO\_10\_14</u> # Wherefore, my dearly beloved, flee from idolatry.

dearly beloved for <u>47\_2CO\_12\_19</u> # Again, think ye that we excuse ourselves unto you? we speak before God in Christ: but [we do] all things, dearly beloved, for your edifying.

Dearly beloved I <u>60\_1PE\_02\_11</u> # Dearly beloved, I beseech [you] as strangers and pilgrims, abstain from fleshly lusts, which war against the soul;

dearly beloved let <u>47\_2CO\_07\_01</u> # Having therefore these promises, dearly beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all filthiness of the flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.

dearly beloved of <u>24\_JER\_12\_07</u> # I have forsaken mine house, I have left mine heritage; I have given the dearly beloved of my soul into the hand of her enemies.

dearly beloved son <u>55\_2TI\_01\_02</u> # To Timothy, [my] dearly beloved son: Grace, mercy, [and] peace, from God the Father and Christ Jesus our Lord.

dearly beloved <u>50\_PHP\_04\_01</u># Therefore, my brethren, dearly beloved and longed for, my joy and crown, so stand fast in the Lord, [my] dearly beloved.

early about the <u>06\_JOS\_06\_15</u># And it came to pass on the seventh day, that they rose early about the

dawning of the day, and compassed the city after the same manner seven times: only on that day they compassed the city seven times.

early after God <u>19\_PSA\_78\_34</u># When he slew them, then they sought him: and they returned and inquired early after God.

early and built <u>07\_JUD\_21\_04</u> # And it came to pass on the morrow, that the people rose early, and built there an altar, and offered burnt offerings and peace offerings.

early and corrupted <u>36\_ZEP\_03\_07</u># I said, Surely thou wilt fear me, thou wilt receive instruction; so their dwelling should not be cut off, howsoever I punished them: but they rose early, [and] corrupted all their doings.

early and gathered <u>14\_2CH\_29\_20</u># Then Hezekiah the king rose early, and gathered the rulers of the city, and went up to the house of the LORD.

early and go <u>01\_GEN\_19\_02</u> # And he said, Behold now, my lords, turn in, I pray you, into your servant's house, and tarry all night, and wash your feet, and ye shall rise up early, and go on your ways. And they said, Nay; but we will abide in the street all night.

early and gone <u>12\_2KI\_06\_15</u> # And when the servant of the man of God was risen early, and gone forth, behold, an host compassed the city both with horses and chariots. And his servant said unto him, Alas, my master! how shall we do?

early and it <u>09\_1SA\_09\_26</u># And they arose early: and it came to pass about the spring of the day, that Samuel called Saul to the top of the house, saying, Up, that I may send thee away. And Saul arose, and they went out both of them, he and Samuel, abroad.

early and latter <u>59\_JAM\_05\_07</u># Be patient therefore, brethren, unto the coming of the Lord. Behold, the husbandman waiteth for the precious fruit of the earth, and hath long patience for it, until he receive the early and latter rain.

early and pitched <u>07\_JUD\_07\_01</u> # Then Jerubbaal, who [is] Gideon, and all the people that [were] with him, rose up early, and pitched beside the well of Harod: so that the host of the Midianites were on the north side of them, by the hill of Moreh, in the valley.

early and protesting <u>24\_JER\_11\_07</u> # For I earnestly protested unto your fathers in the day [that] I brought them up out of the land of Egypt, [even] unto this day, rising early and protesting, saying, Obey my voice.

early and sending <u>24\_JER\_07\_25</u># Since the day that your fathers came forth out of the land of Egypt unto this day I have even sent unto you all my servants the prophets, daily rising up early and sending [them]:

early and sending <u>24\_JER\_25\_04</u> # And the LORD hath sent unto you all his servants the prophets, rising early and sending [them]; but ye have not hearkened, nor inclined your ear to hear.

early and sending <u>24\_JER\_26\_05</u> # To hearken to the words of my servants the prophets, whom I sent unto you, both rising up early, and sending [them], but ye have not hearkened;

early and sending <u>24\_JER\_29\_19</u># Because they have not hearkened to my words, saith the LORD, which I sent unto them by my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending [them]; but ye would not hear, saith the LORD.

early and sending <u>24\_JER\_35\_15</u> # I have sent also unto you all my servants the prophets, rising up early and sending [them], saying, Return ye now every man from his evil way, and amend your doings, and go not after other gods to serve them, and ye shall dwell in the land which I have given to you and to your

fathers: but ye have not inclined your ear, nor hearkened unto me.

early and sending <u>24\_JER\_44\_04</u> # Howbeit I sent unto you all my servants the prophets, rising early and sending [them], saying, Oh, do not this abominable thing that I hate.

early and set <u>07\_JUD\_09\_33</u> # And it shall be, [that] in the morning, as soon as the sun is up, thou shalt rise early, and set upon the city: and, behold, [when] he and the people that [is] with him come out against thee, then mayest thou do to them as thou shalt find occasion.

early and speaking <u>24\_JER\_07\_13</u> # And now, because ye have done all these works, saith the LORD, and I spake unto you, rising up early and speaking, but ye heard not; and I called you, but ye answered not;

early and speaking <u>24\_JER\_25\_03</u># From the thirteenth year of Josiah the son of Amon king of Judah, even unto this day, that [is] the three and twentieth year, the word of the LORD hath come unto me, and I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but ye have not hearkened.

early and speaking <u>24\_JER\_35\_14</u> # The words of Jonadab the son of Rechab, that he commanded his sons not to drink wine, are performed; for unto this day they drink none, but obey their father's commandment: notwithstanding I have spoken unto you, rising early and speaking; but ye hearkened not unto me.

early and stood <u>10\_2SA\_15\_02</u> # And Absalom rose up early, and stood beside the way of the gate: and it was [so], that when any man that had a controversy came to the king for judgment, then Absalom called unto him, and said, Of what city [art] thou? And he said, Thy servant [is] of one of the tribes of Israel.

early and teaching <u>24\_JER\_32\_33</u> # And they have turned unto me the back, and not the face: though I taught them, rising up early and teaching [them], yet they have not hearkened to receive instruction.

early and the <u>06\_JOS\_08\_14</u> # And it came to pass, when the king of Ai saw [it], that they hasted and rose up early, and the men of the city went out against Israel to battle, he and all his people, at a time appointed, before the plain; but he wist not that [there were] liers in ambush against him behind the city.

early and they <u>43\_JOH\_18\_28</u> # Then led they Jesus from Caiaphas unto the hall of judgment: and it was early; and they themselves went not into the judgment hall, lest they should be defiled; but that they might eat the passover.

early and worshipped <u>09\_1SA\_01\_19</u> # And they rose up in the morning early, and worshipped before the LORD, and returned, and came to their house to Ramah: and Elkanah knew Hannah his wife; and the LORD remembered her.

early but they <u>20\_PRO\_01\_28</u># Then shall they call upon me, but I will not answer; they shall seek me early, but they shall not find me:

early destroy all <u>19\_PSA\_101\_08</u> # I will early destroy all the wicked of the land; that I may cut off all wicked doers from the city of the LORD.

early dew it <u>28\_HOS\_06\_04</u> # O Ephraim, what shall I do unto thee? O Judah, what shall I do unto thee? for your goodness [is] as a morning cloud, and as the early dew it goeth away.

early dew that <u>28\_HOS\_13\_03</u> # Therefore they shall be as the morning cloud, and as the early dew that passeth away, as the chaff [that] is driven with the whirlwind out of the floor, and as the smoke out of the chimney.

early for when <u>23\_ISA\_26\_09</u># With my soul have I desired thee in the night; yea, with my spirit within me will I seek thee early: for when thy judgments [are] in the earth, the inhabitants of the world will learn righteousness.

early from mount <u>07\_JUD\_07\_03</u> # Now therefore go to, proclaim in the ears of the people, saying, Whosoever [is] fearful and afraid, let him return and depart early from mount Gilead. And there returned of the people twenty and two thousand; and there remained ten thousand.

early in the <u>09\_1SA\_17\_20</u># And David rose up early in the morning, and left the sheep with a keeper, and took, and went, as Jesse had commanded him; and he came to the trench, as the host was going forth to the fight, and shouted for the battle.

early in the <u>09\_1SA\_29\_10</u># Wherefore now rise up early in the morning with thy master's servants that are come with thee: and as soon as ye be up early in the morning, and have light, depart.

early in the <u>01\_GEN\_31\_55</u> # And early in the morning Laban rose up, and kissed his sons and his daughters, and blessed them: and Laban departed, and returned unto his place.

early in the <u>23\_ISA\_05\_11</u># Woe unto them that rise up early in the morning, [that] they may follow strong drink; that continue until night, [till] wine inflame them!

early in the <u>23\_ISA\_37\_36</u> # Then the angel of the LORD went forth, and smote in the camp of the Assyrians a hundred and fourscore and five thousand: and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they [were] all dead corpses.

early in the <u>40\_MAT\_20\_01</u># For the kingdom of heaven is like unto a man [that is] an householder, which went out early in the morning to hire labourers into his vineyard.

early in the <u>04\_NUM\_14\_40</u># And they rose up early in the morning, and gat them up into the top of the mountain, saying, Lo, we [be here], and will go up unto the place which the LORD hath promised: for we have sinned.

early in the <u>20\_PRO\_27\_14</u># He that blesseth his friend with a loud voice, rising early in the morning, it shall be counted a curse to him.

early on the <u>09\_1SA\_05\_03</u> # And when they of Ashdod arose early on the morrow, behold, Dagon [was] fallen upon his face to the earth before the ark of the LORD. And they took Dagon, and set him in his place again.

early on the <u>07\_JUD\_06\_38</u> # And it was so: for he rose up early on the morrow, and thrust the fleece together, and wringed the dew out of the fleece, a bowl full of water.

early on your <u>07\_JUD\_19\_09</u> # And when the man rose up to depart, he, and his concubine, and his servant, his father in law, the damsel's father, said unto him, Behold, now the day draweth toward evening, I pray you tarry all night: behold, the day groweth to an end, lodge here, that thine heart may be merry; and to morrow get you early on your way, that thou mayest go home.

early shall find 20\_PRO\_08\_17 # I love them that love me; and those that seek me early shall find me.

early the first <u>41\_MAR\_16\_09</u># Now when [Jesus] was risen early the first [day] of the week, he appeared first to Mary Magdalene, out of whom he had cast seven devils.

early to depart <u>09\_18A\_29\_11</u># So David and his men rose up early to depart in the morning, to return into the land of the Philistines. And the Philistines went up to Jezreel.

early to meet <u>09\_1SA\_15\_12</u> # And when Samuel rose early to meet Saul in the morning, it was told Samuel, saying, Saul came to Carmel, and, behold, he set him up a place, and is gone about, and passed on, and gone down to Gilgal.

early to sit <u>19\_PSA\_127\_02</u># [It is] vain for you to rise up early, to sit up late, to eat the bread of sorrows: [for] so he giveth his beloved sleep.

early to the <u>22\_SON\_07\_12</u> # Let us get up early to the vineyards; let us see if the vine flourish, [whether]

the tender grape appear, [and] the pomegranates bud forth: there will I give thee my loves.

early when it <u>43\_JOH\_20\_01</u> # The first [day] of the week cometh Mary Magdalene early, when it was yet dark, unto the sepulchre, and seeth the stone taken away from the sepulchre.

early will I <u>19\_PSA\_63\_01</u> # A Psalm of David, when he was in the wilderness of Judah. O God, thou [art] my God; early will I seek thee: my soul thirsteth for thee, my flesh longeth for thee in a dry and thirsty land, where no water is;

early with thy <u>19\_PSA\_90\_14</u> # O satisfy us early with thy mercy; that we may rejoice and be glad all our days.

early <u>28\_HOS\_05\_15</u> # I will go [and] return to my place, till they acknowledge their offence, and seek my face: in their affliction they will seek me early.

early <u>19\_PSA\_108\_02</u># Awake, psaltery and harp: I [myself] will awake early.

early <u>19\_PSA\_46\_05</u> # God [is] in the midst of her; she shall not be moved: God shall help her, [and that] right early.

early <u>19\_PSA\_57\_08</u># Awake up, my glory; awake, psaltery and harp: I [myself] will awake early.

yearly hired servant <u>03\_LEV\_25\_53</u> # [And] as a yearly hired servant shall he be with him: [and the other] shall not rule with rigour over him in thy sight.

yearly in a <u>07\_JUD\_21\_19</u># Then they said, Behold, [there is] a feast of the LORD in Shiloh yearly [in a place] which [is] on the north side of Bethel, on the east side of the highway that goeth up from Bethel to Shechem, and on the south of Lebonah.

yearly sacrifice and <u>09\_1SA\_01\_21</u> # And the man Elkanah, and all his house, went up to offer unto the LORD the yearly sacrifice, and his vow.

yearly sacrifice there <u>09\_1SA\_20\_06</u># If thy father at all miss me, then say, David earnestly asked [leave] of me that he might run to Bethlehem his city: for [there is] a yearly sacrifice there for all the family.

yearly sacrifice <u>09\_1SA\_02\_19</u># Moreover his mother made him a little coat, and brought [it] to him from year to year, when she came up with her husband to offer the yearly sacrifice.

yearly to lament <u>07\_JUD\_11\_40</u># [That] the daughters of Israel went yearly to lament the daughter of Jephthah the Gileadite four days in a year.

yearly to worship <u>09\_1SA\_01\_03</u># And this man went up out of his city yearly to worship and to sacrifice unto the LORD of hosts in Shiloh. And the two sons of Eli, Hophni and Phinehas, the priests of the LORD, [were] there.

yearly with the <u>16\_NEH\_10\_32</u> # Also we made ordinances for us, to charge ourselves yearly with the third part of a shekel for the service of the house of our God;

yearly <u>17\_EST\_09\_21</u> # To stablish [this] among them, that they should keep the fourteenth day of the month Adar, and the fifteenth day of the same, yearly,
