appease him with <u>01\_GEN\_32\_20</u># And say ye moreover, Behold, thy servant Jacob [is] behind us. For he said, I will appease him with the present that goeth before me, and afterward I will see his face; peradventure he will accept of me.

appeased he remembered <u>17\_EST\_02\_01</u># After these things, when the wrath of king Ahasuerus was appeased, he remembered Vashti, and what she had done, and what was decreed against her.

appeased the people <u>44\_ACT\_19\_35</u> # And when the townclerk had appeased the people, he said, [Ye] men of Ephesus, what man is there that knoweth not how that the city of the Ephesians is a worshipper of the great goddess Diana, and of the [image] which fell down from Jupiter?

ceased unto the <u>15\_EZR\_04\_24</u> # Then ceased the work of the house of God which [is] at Jerusalem. So it ceased unto the second year of the reign of Darius king of Persia.

ceased <u>09\_1SA\_25\_09</u># And when David's young men came, they spake to Nabal according to all those words in the name of David, and ceased.

ceaseth from raising <u>28\_HOS\_07\_04</u> # They [are] all adulterers, as an oven heated by the baker, [who] ceaseth from raising after he hath kneaded the dough, until it be leavened.

ceaseth he hath <u>23\_ISA\_33\_08</u># The highways lie waste, the wayfaring man ceaseth: he hath broken the covenant, he hath despised the cities, he regardeth no man.

ceaseth not to <u>44\_ACT\_06\_13</u> # And set up false witnesses, which said, This man ceaseth not to speak blasphemous words against this holy place, and the law:

ceaseth not without 25\_LAM\_03\_49 # Mine eye trickleth down, and ceaseth not, without any intermission,

ceaseth the noise 23\_ISA\_24\_08 # The mirth of tabrets ceaseth, the noise of them that rejoice endeth, the joy of the harp ceaseth.

ceaseth the oppressors 23\_ISA\_16\_04 # Let mine outcasts dwell with thee, Moab; be thou a covert to them from the face of the spoiler: for the extortioner is at an end, the spoiler ceaseth, the oppressors are consumed out of the land.

decease to have <u>61\_2PE\_01\_15</u> # Moreover I will endeavour that ye may be able after my decease to have these things always in remembrance.

decease which he <u>42\_LUK\_09\_31</u># Who appeared in glory, and spake of his decease which he should accomplish at Jerusalem.

deceased and having <u>40\_MAT\_22\_25</u> # Now there were with us seven brethren: and the first, when he had married a wife, deceased, and, having no issue, left his wife unto his brother:

disease he had <u>43\_JOH\_05\_04</u> # For an angel went down at a certain season into the pool, and troubled the water: whosoever then first after the troubling of the water stepped in was made whole of whatsoever disease he had.

disease <u>12\_2KI\_08\_09</u> # So Hazael went to meet him, and took a present with him, even of every good thing of Damascus, forty camels' burden, and came and stood before him, and said, Thy son Benhadad king of Syria hath sent me to thee, saying, Shall I recover of this disease?

disease 21\_ECC\_06\_02 # A man to whom God hath given riches, wealth, and honour, so that he wanteth nothing for his soul of all that he desireth, yet God giveth him not power to eat thereof, but a stranger eateth it: this [is] vanity, and it [is] an evil disease.

disease <u>40\_MAT\_10\_01</u># And when he had called unto [him] his twelve disciples, he gave them power [against] unclean spirits, to cast them out, and to heal all manner of sickness and all manner of disease.

diseased and them <u>41\_MAR\_01\_32</u> # And at even, when the sun did set, they brought unto him all that were diseased, and them that were possessed with devils.

diseased have ye <u>26\_EZE\_34\_04</u> # The diseased have ye not strengthened, neither have ye healed that which was sick, neither have ye bound up [that which was] broken, neither have ye brought again that which was driven away, neither have ye sought that which was lost; but with force and with cruelty have ye ruled them.

diseased in his <u>11\_1KI\_15\_23</u># The rest of all the acts of Asa, and all his might, and all that he did, and the cities which he built, [are] they not written in the book of the chronicles of the kings of Judah? Nevertheless in the time of his old age he was diseased in his feet.

diseased <u>40\_MAT\_14\_35</u># And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto him all that were diseased;

diseases and cast <u>41\_MAR\_01\_34</u> # And he healed many that were sick of divers diseases, and cast out many devils; and suffered not the devils to speak, because they knew him.

diseases And his <u>14\_2CH\_21\_19</u># And it came to pass, that in process of time, after the end of two years, his bowels fell out by reason of his sickness: so he died of sore diseases. And his people made no burning for him, like the burning of his fathers.

diseases and torments <u>40\_MAT\_04\_24</u># And his fame went throughout all Syria: and they brought unto

diseases <u>42\_LUK\_06\_17</u> # And he came down with them, and stood in the plain, and the company of his disciples, and a great multitude of people out of all Judaea and Jerusalem, and from the sea coast of Tyre and Sidon, which came to hear him, and to be healed of their diseases;

diseases <u>42\_LUK\_09\_01</u> # Then he called his twelve disciples together, and gave them power and authority over all devils, and to cure diseases.

diseases <u>19\_PSA\_103\_03</u># Who forgive h all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases;

displease him and <u>20\_PRO\_24\_18</u># Lest the LORD see [it], and it displease him, and he turn away his wrath from him.

displease my lord <u>01\_GEN\_31\_35</u> # And she said to her father, Let it not displease my lord that I cannot rise up before thee; for the custom of women [is] upon me. And he searched, but found not the images.

displease not the <u>09\_1SA\_29\_07</u># Wherefore now return, and go in peace, that thou displease not the lords of the Philistines.

displease thee for <u>10\_2SA\_11\_25</u># Then David said unto the messenger, Thus shalt thou say unto Joab, Let not this thing displease thee, for the sword devoureth one as well as another: make thy battle more strong against the city, and overthrow it: and encourage thou him.

displease thee I <u>04\_NUM\_22\_34</u> # And Balaam said unto the angel of the LORD, I have sinned; for I knew not that thou stoodest in the way against me: now therefore, if it displease thee, I will get me back again.

displeased against the <u>35\_HAB\_03\_08</u># Was the LORD displeased against the rivers? [was] thine anger

against the rivers? [was] thy wrath against the sea, that thou didst ride upon thine horses [and] thy chariots of salvation?

displeased and came <u>11\_1KI\_20\_43</u># And the king of Israel went to his house heavy and displeased, and came to Samaria.

displeased and said <u>41\_MAR\_10\_14</u> # But when Jesus saw [it], he was much displeased, and said unto them, Suffer the little children to come unto me, and forbid them not: for of such is the kingdom of God.

displeased and they <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_15</u> # And I am very sore displeased with the heathen [that are] at ease: for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

displeased because of <u>11\_1KI\_21\_04</u># And Ahab came into his house heavy and displeased because of the word which Naboth the Jezreelite had spoken to him: for he had said, I will not give thee the inheritance of my fathers. And he laid him down upon his bed, and turned away his face, and would eat no bread.

displeased because the <u>13\_1CH\_13\_11</u># And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzza: wherefore that place is called Perezuzza to this day.

displeased because the <u>10\_2SA\_06\_08</u> # And David was displeased, because the LORD had made a breach upon Uzzah: and he called the name of the place Perezuzzah to this day.

displeased him and <u>09\_1SA\_18\_08</u># And Saul was very wroth, and the saying displeased him; and he said, They have ascribed unto David ten thousands, and to me they have ascribed [but] thousands: and [what] can he have more but the kingdom?

displeased him and <u>01\_GEN\_48\_17</u># And when Joseph saw that his father laid his right hand upon the head of Ephraim, it displeased him: and he held up his father's hand, to remove it from Ephraim's head unto Manasseh's head.

displeased him at <u>11\_1KI\_01\_06</u># And his father had not displeased him at any time in saying, Why hast thou done so? and he also [was a] very goodly [man]; and [his mother] bare him after Absalom.

displeased him that <u>23\_ISA\_59\_15</u> # Yea, truth faileth; and he [that] departeth from evil maketh himself a prey: and the LORD saw [it], and it displeased him that [there was] no judgment.

displeased Jonah exceedingly <u>32\_JON\_04\_01</u> # But it displeased Jonah exceedingly, and he was very angry.

displeased O turn <u>19\_PSA\_60\_01</u> # To the chief Musician upon Shushaneduth, Michtam of David, to teach; when he strove with Aramnaharaim and with Aramzobah, when Joab returned, and smote of Edom in the valley of salt twelve thousand. O God, thou hast cast us off, thou hast scattered us, thou hast been displeased; O turn thyself to us again.

displeased Samuel when <u>09\_1SA\_08\_06</u># But the thing displeased Samuel, when they said, Give us a king to judge us. And Samuel prayed unto the LORD.

displeased the LORD <u>10\_2SA\_11\_27</u> # And when the mourning was past, David sent and fetched her to his house, and she became his wife, and bare him a son. But the thing that David had done displeased the LORD.

displeased the LORD <u>01\_GEN\_38\_10</u># And the thing which he did displeased the LORD: wherefore he slew him also.

displeased the LORD <u>04\_NUM\_11\_01</u># And [when] the people complained, it displeased the LORD: and the LORD heard [it]; and his anger was kindled; and the fire of the LORD burnt among them, and

consumed [them that were] in the uttermost parts of the camp.

displeased with himself <u>27\_DAN\_06\_14</u> # Then the king, when he heard [these] words, was sore displeased with himself, and set [his] heart on Daniel to deliver him: and he laboured till the going down of the sun to deliver him.

displeased with James <u>41\_MAR\_10\_41</u> # And when the ten heard [it], they began to be much displeased with James and John.

displeased with the <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_15</u># And I am very sore displeased with the heathen [that are] at ease: for I was but a little displeased, and they helped forward the affliction.

displeased with them <u>44\_ACT\_12\_20</u># And Herod was highly displeased with them of Tyre and Sidon: but they came with one accord to him, and, having made Blastus the king's chamberlain their friend, desired peace; because their country was nourished by the king's [country].

displeased with this <u>13\_1CH\_21\_07</u> # And God was displeased with this thing; therefore he smote Israel.

displeased with your <u>38\_ZEC\_01\_02</u> # The LORD hath been sore displeased with your fathers.

displeased <u>04\_NUM\_11\_10</u># Then Moses heard the people weep throughout their families, every man in the door of his tent: and the anger of the LORD was kindled greatly; Moses also was displeased.

ease and his <u>19\_PSA\_25\_13</u># His soul shall dwell at ease; and his seed shall inherit the earth.

ease and none 24\_JER\_46\_27 # But fear not thou, O my servant Jacob, and be not dismayed, O Israel: for, behold, I will save thee from afar off, and thy seed from the land of their captivity; and Jacob shall return, and be in rest and at ease, and none shall make [him] afraid.

ease and quiet <u>18\_JOB\_21\_23</u># One dieth in his full strength, being wholly at ease and quiet.

ease but he <u>18\_JOB\_16\_12</u># I was at ease, but he hath broken me asunder: he hath also taken [me] by my neck, and shaken me to pieces, and set me up for his mark.

grease but I <u>19\_PSA\_119\_70</u># Their heart is as fat as grease; [but] I delight in thy law.

increase all that <u>24\_JER\_02\_03</u># Israel [was] holiness unto the LORD, [and] the firstfruits of his increase: all that devour him shall offend; evil shall come upon them, saith the LORD.

increase and abound <u>52\_1TH\_03\_12</u># And the Lord make you to increase and abound in love one toward another, and toward all [men], even as we [do] toward you:

pleased for his <u>23\_ISA\_42\_21</u># The LORD is well pleased for his righteousness' sake; he will magnify the law, and make [it] honourable.

pleased for they <u>46\_1CO\_10\_05</u> # But with many of them God was not well pleased: for they were overthrown in the wilderness.

pleased God by <u>46\_1CO\_01\_21</u> # For after that in the wisdom of God the world by wisdom knew not God, it pleased God by the foolishness of preaching to save them that believe.

pleased God who <u>48\_GAL\_01\_15</u># But when it pleased God, who separated me from my mother's womb, and called [me] by his grace,

pleased God <u>58\_HEB\_11\_05</u># By faith Enoch was translated that he should not see death; and was not found, because God had translated him: for before his translation he had this testimony, that he pleased God.

pleased Haman and <u>17\_EST\_05\_14</u># Then said Zeresh his wife and all his friends unto him, Let a gallows be made of fifty cubits high, and to morrow speak thou unto the king that Mordecai may be hanged thereon: then go thou in merrily with the king unto the banquet. And the thing pleased Haman; and he caused the gallows to be made.

pleased Hamor and <u>01\_GEN\_34\_18</u># And their words pleased Hamor, and Shechem Hamor's son.

pleased hear ye <u>40\_MAT\_17\_05</u># While he yet spake, behold, a bright cloud overshadowed them: and behold a voice out of the cloud, which said, This is my beloved Son, in whom I am well pleased; hear ye him.

pleased Herod and <u>41\_MAR\_06\_22</u> # And when the daughter of the said Herodias came in, and danced, and pleased Herod and them that sat with him, the king said unto the damsel, Ask of me whatsoever thou

pleased him and <u>46\_1CO\_15\_38</u># But God giveth it a body as it hath pleased him, and to every seed his own body.

pleased him and <u>17\_EST\_02\_09</u> # And the maiden pleased him, and she obtained kindness of him; and he speedily gave her her things for purification, with such things as belonged to her, and seven maidens, [which were] meet to be given her, out of the king's house: and he preferred her and her maids unto the best [place] of the house of the women.

pleased him not <u>11\_1KI\_09\_12</u># And Hiram came out from Tyre to see the cities which Solomon had given him; and they pleased him not.

pleased him <u>46\_1CO\_12\_18</u># But now hath God set the members every one of them in the body, as it hath pleased him.

pleased him <u>09\_1SA\_18\_20</u># And Michal Saul's daughter loved David: and they told Saul, and the thing pleased him.

pleased I will <u>40\_MAT\_12\_18</u># Behold my servant, whom I have chosen; my beloved, in whom my soul is well pleased: I will put my spirit upon him, and he shall show judgment to the Gentiles.

pleased it the <u>44\_ACT\_15\_22</u># Then pleased it the apostles and elders, with the whole church, to send chosen men of their own company to Antioch with Paul and Barnabas; [namely], Judas surnamed Barsabas, and Silas, chief men among the brethren:

pleased me well <u>05\_DEU\_01\_23</u># And the saying pleased me well: and I took twelve men of you, one of a tribe:

pleased men I <u>48\_GAL\_01\_10</u># For do I now persuade men, or God? or do I seek to please men? for if I yet pleased men, I should not be the servant of Christ.

pleased not himself <u>45\_ROM\_15\_03</u># For even Christ pleased not himself; but, as it is written, The reproaches of them that reproached thee fell on me.

pleased not Isaac <u>01\_GEN\_28\_08</u># And Esau seeing that the daughters of Canaan pleased not Isaac his father;

pleased O LORD <u>19\_PSA\_40\_13</u># Be pleased, O LORD, to deliver me: O LORD, make haste to help me.

pleased Pharaoh well <u>01\_GEN\_45\_16</u># And the fame thereof was heard in Pharaoh's house, saying, Joseph's brethren are come: and it pleased Pharaoh well, and his servants.

pleased Samson well <u>07\_JUD\_14\_07</u># And he went down, and talked with the woman; and she pleased Samson well.

pleased Silas to <u>44\_ACT\_15\_34</u> # Notwithstanding it pleased Silas to abide there still.

pleased that did <u>19\_PSA\_135\_06</u># Whatsoever the LORD pleased, [that] did he in heaven, and in earth, in the seas, and all deep places.

pleased the children <u>06\_JOS\_22\_33</u># And the thing pleased the children of Israel; and the children of

Israel blessed God, and did not intend to go up against them in battle, to destroy the land wherein the children of Reuben and Gad dwelt.

pleased the Father <u>51\_COL\_01\_19</u># For it pleased [the Father] that in him should all fulness dwell;
